


[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a digital disk player, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and right side perspective view of a digital disk player according to our invention;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view thereof; and,
FIG. 8 is a view similar to FIG. 1 with the cover illustrated in an open position.















