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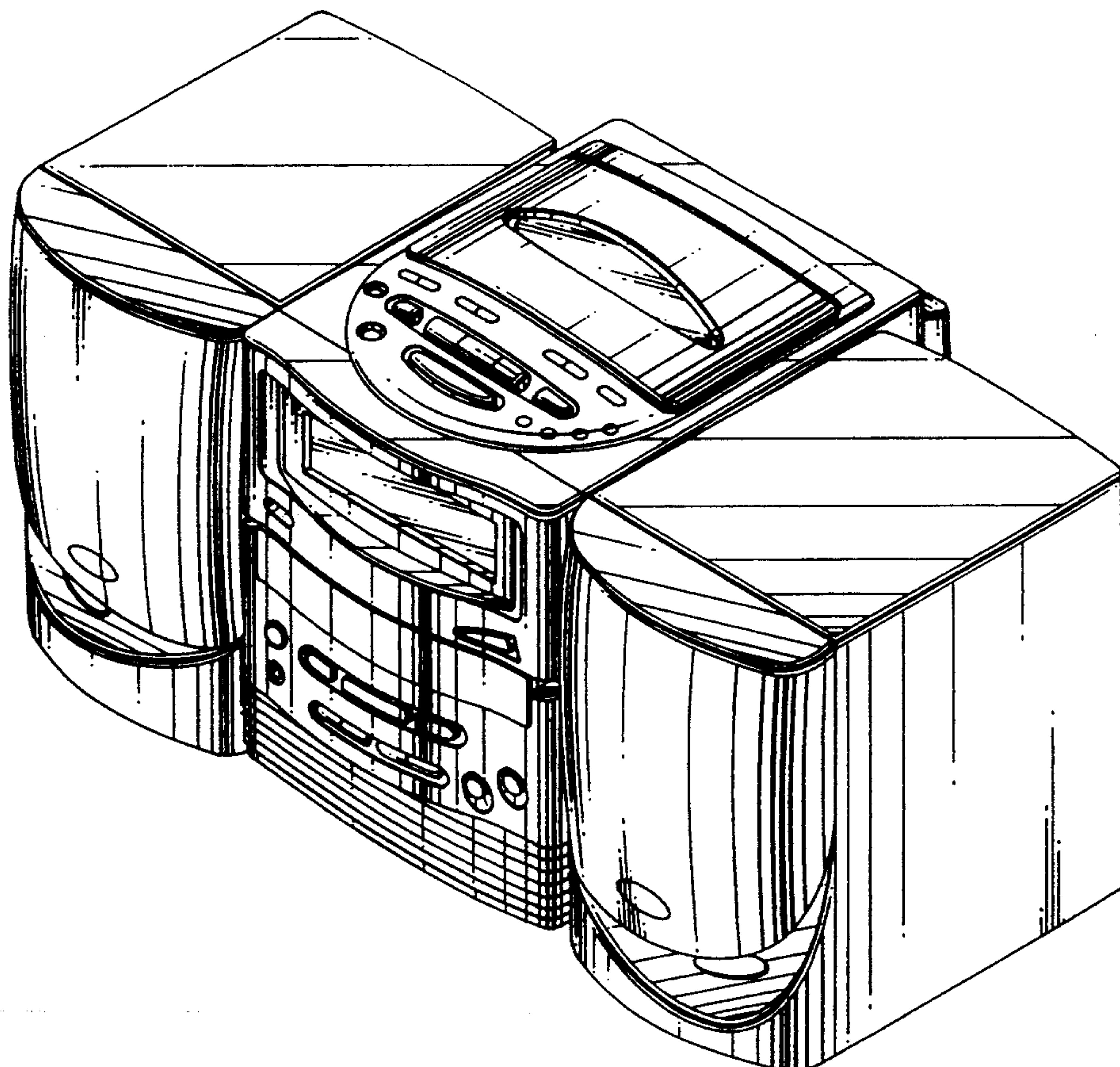

FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view thereof.



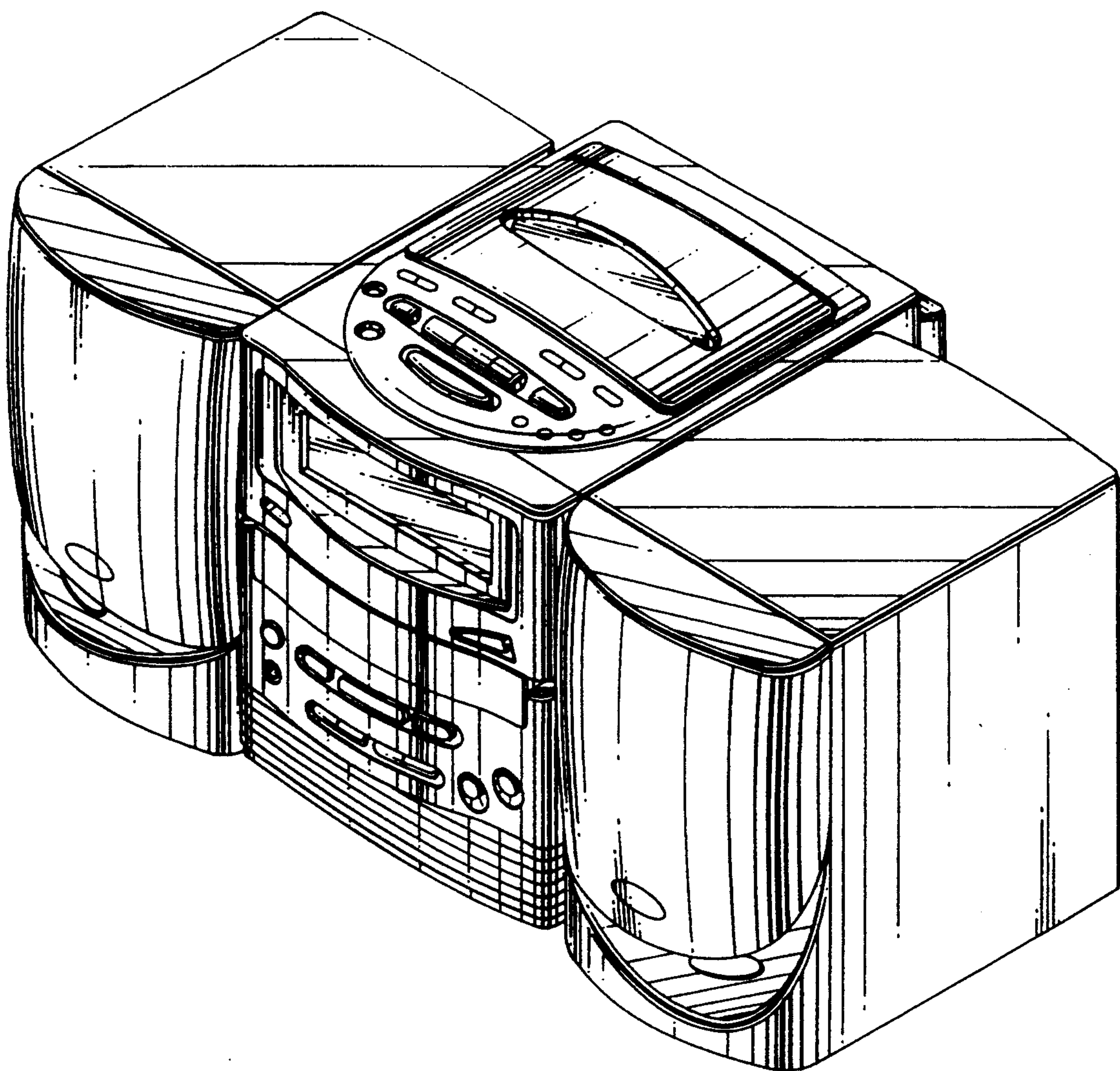

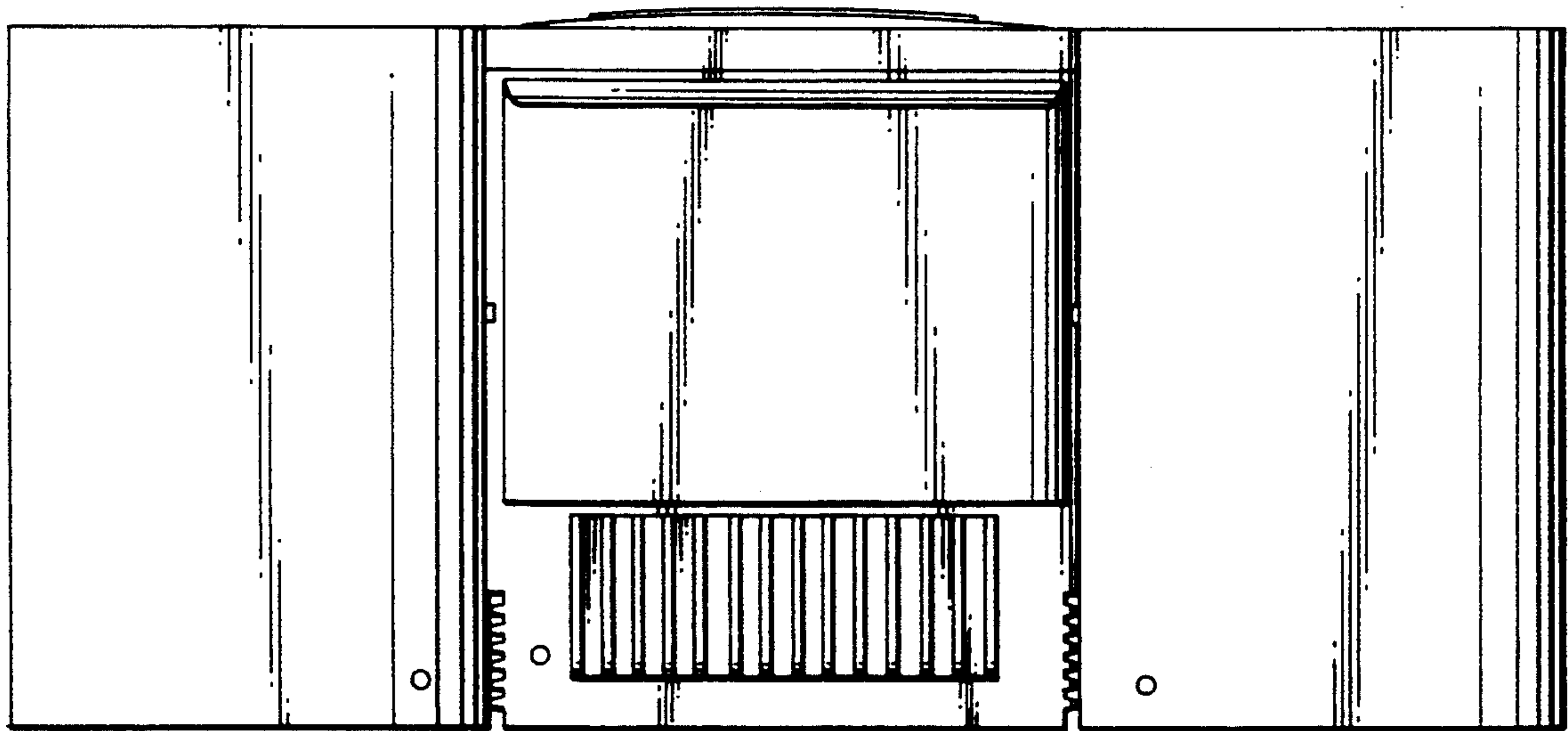
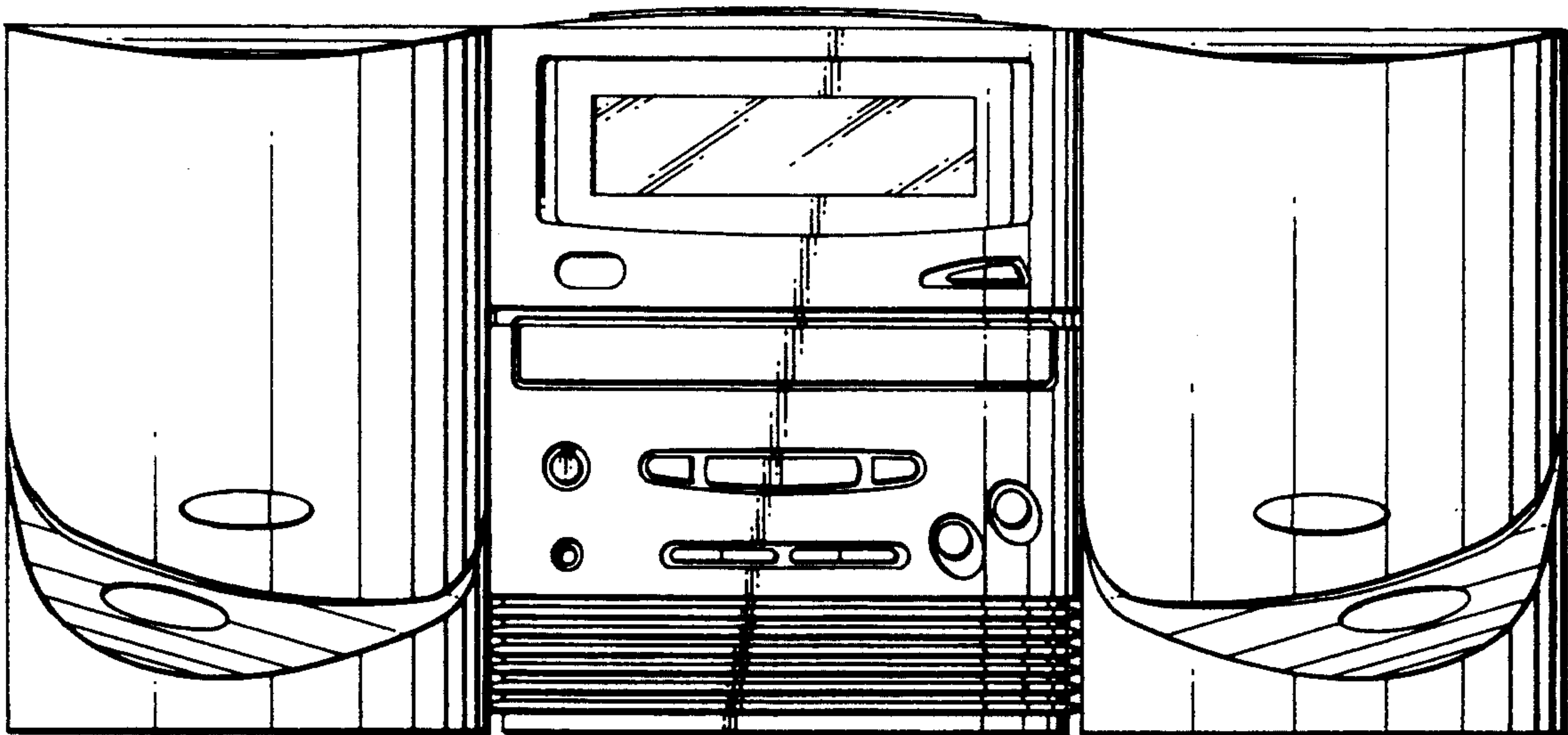

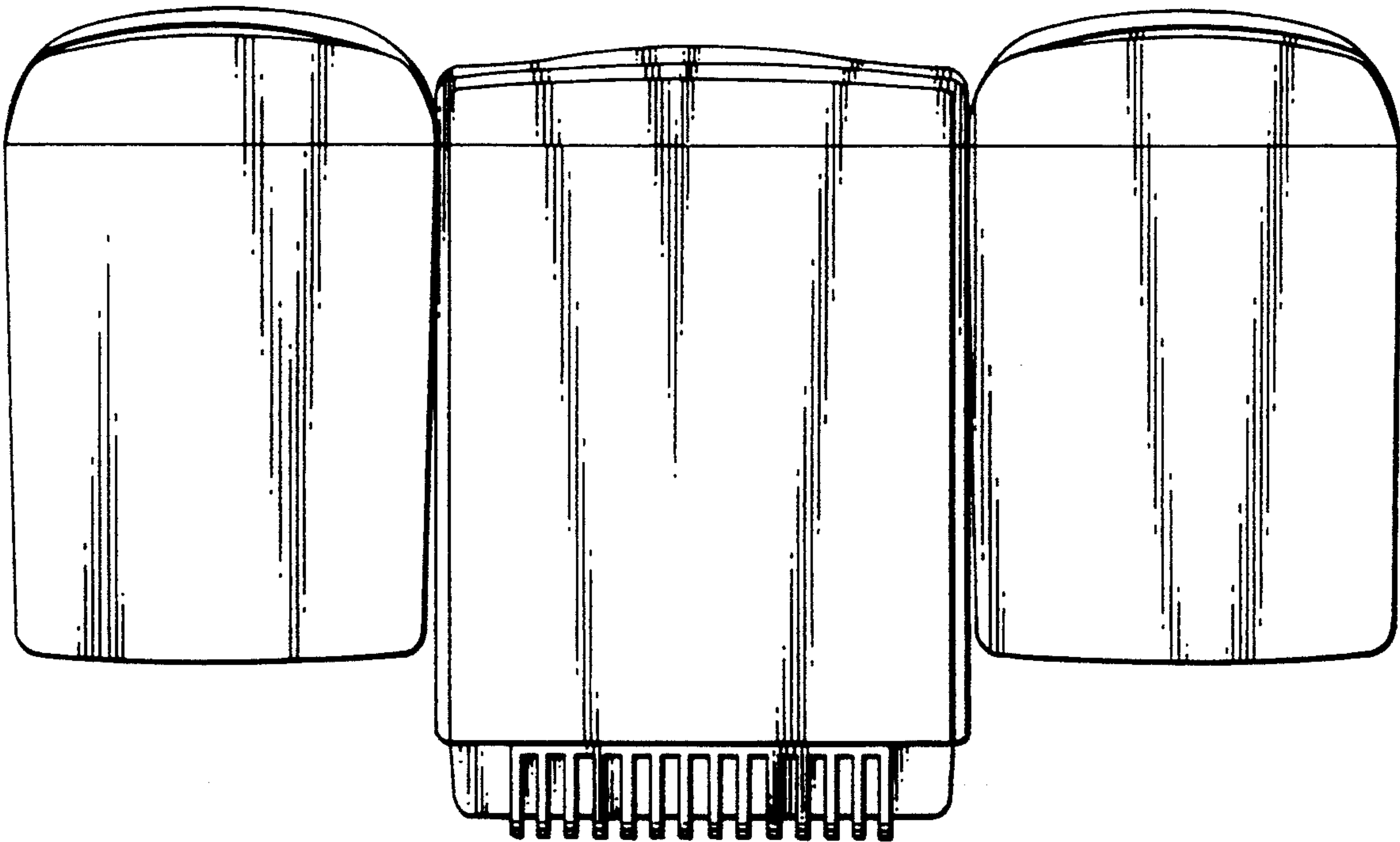
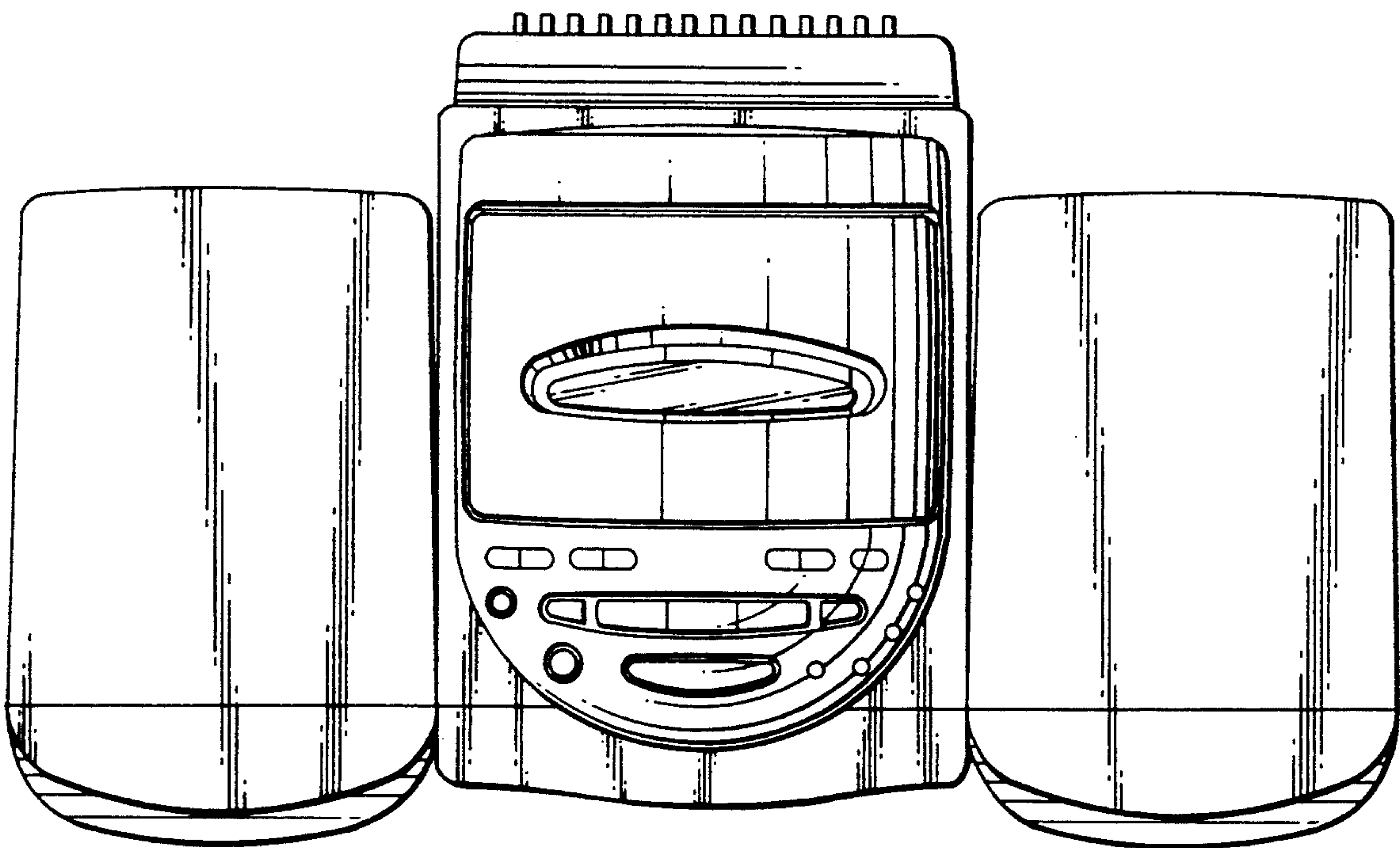

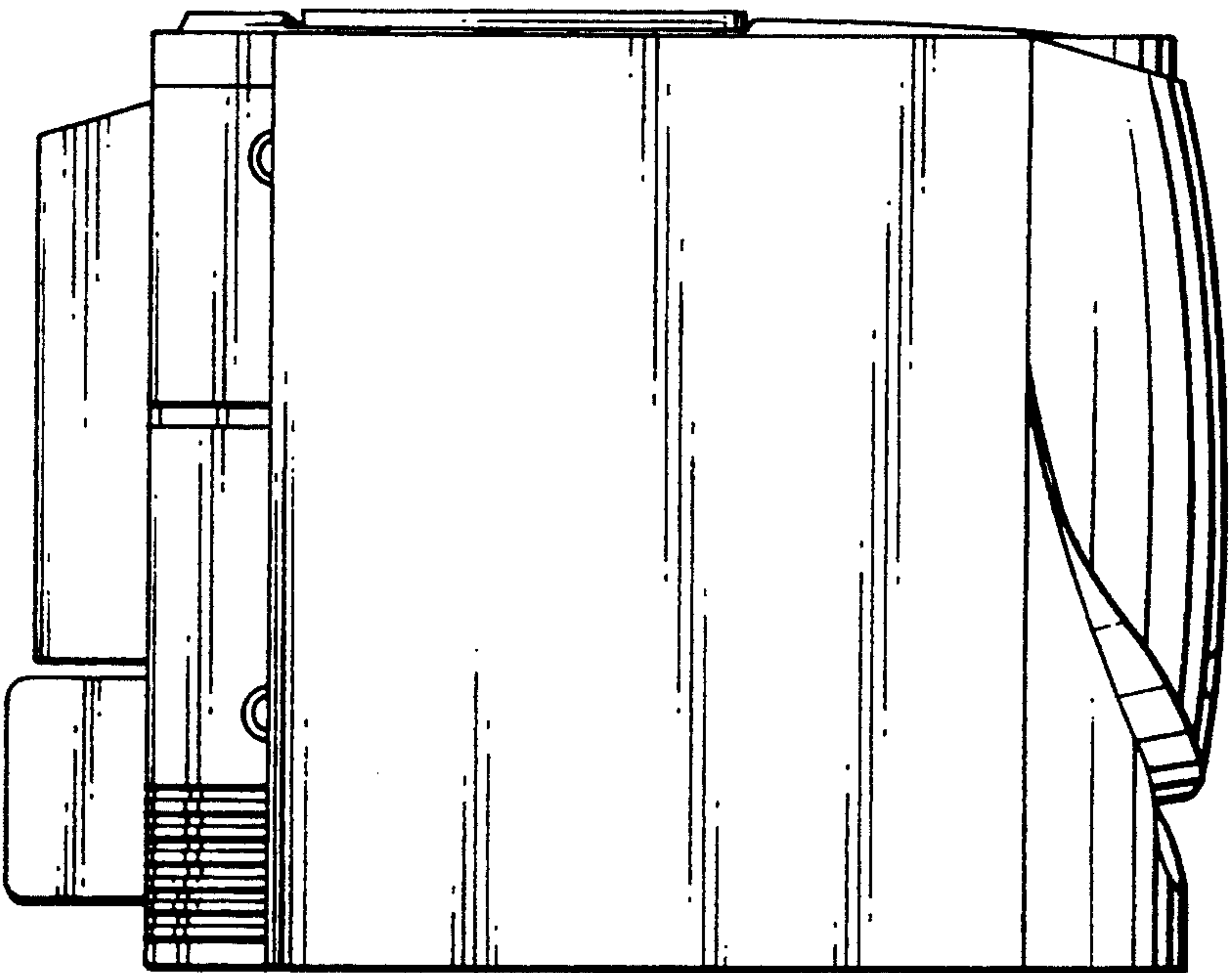
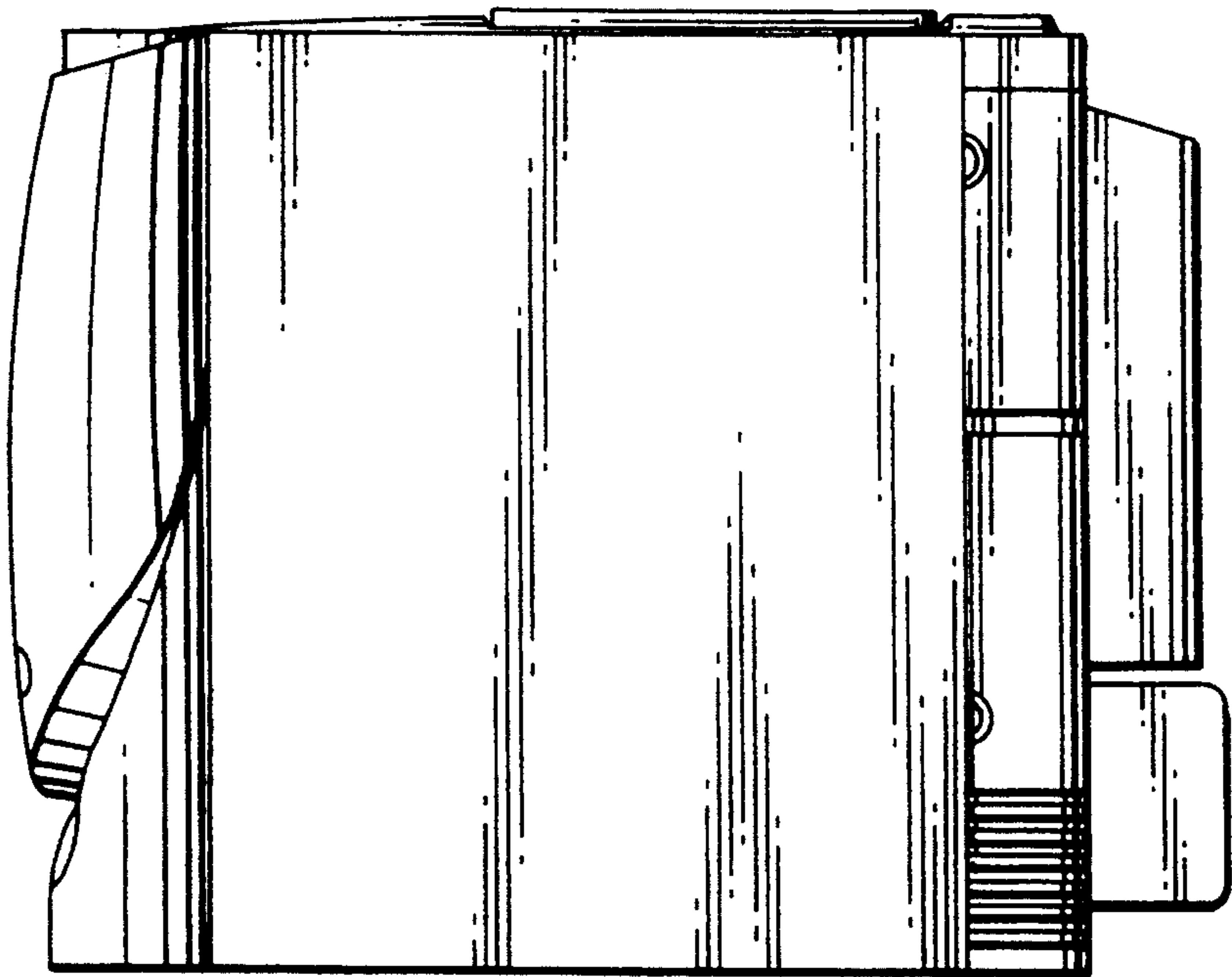
