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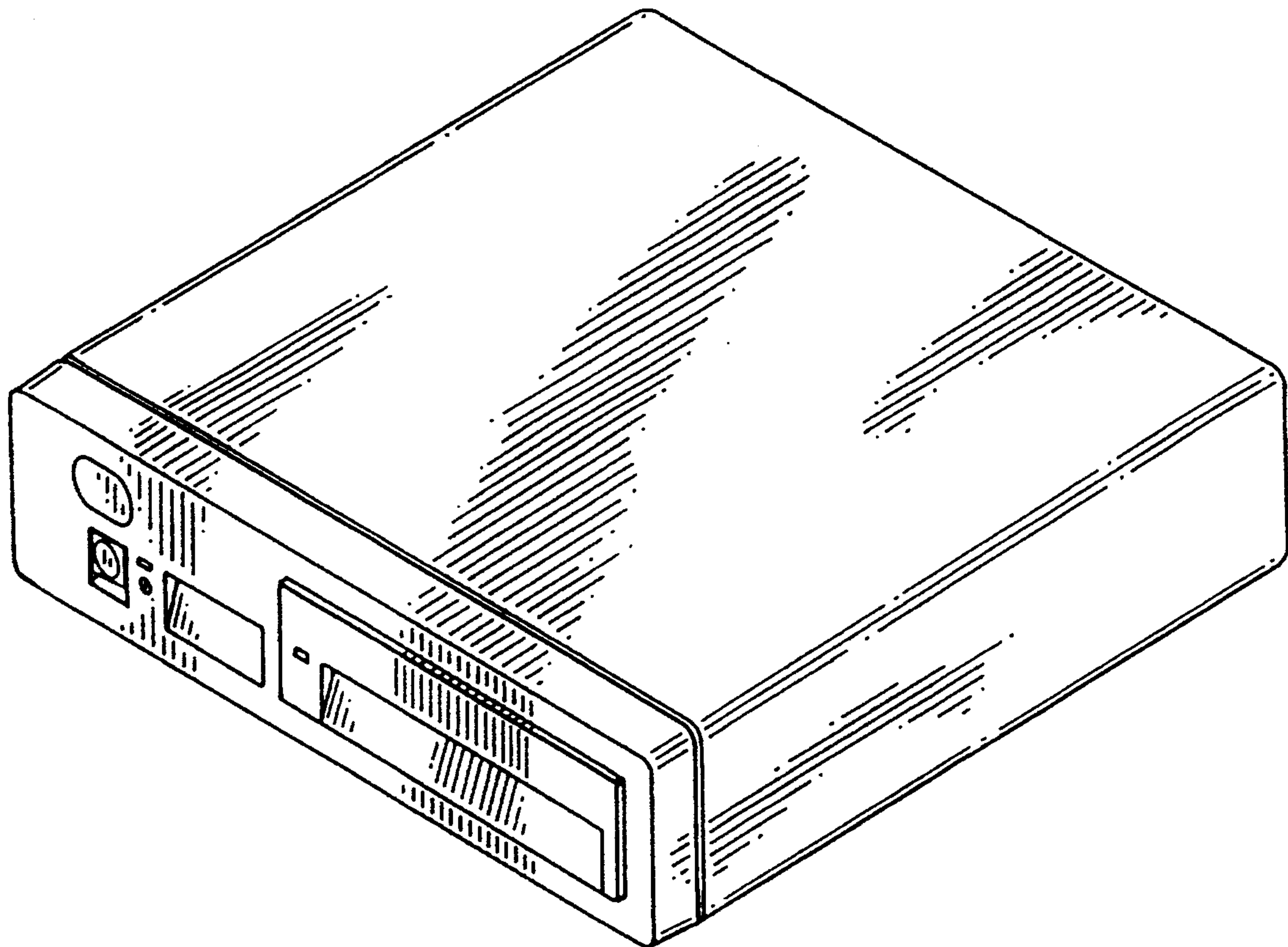

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a slightly reduced top front and right side perspective view of a magnetic disk drive for a data processing system showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side elevational view being identical in appearance; FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; and, FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



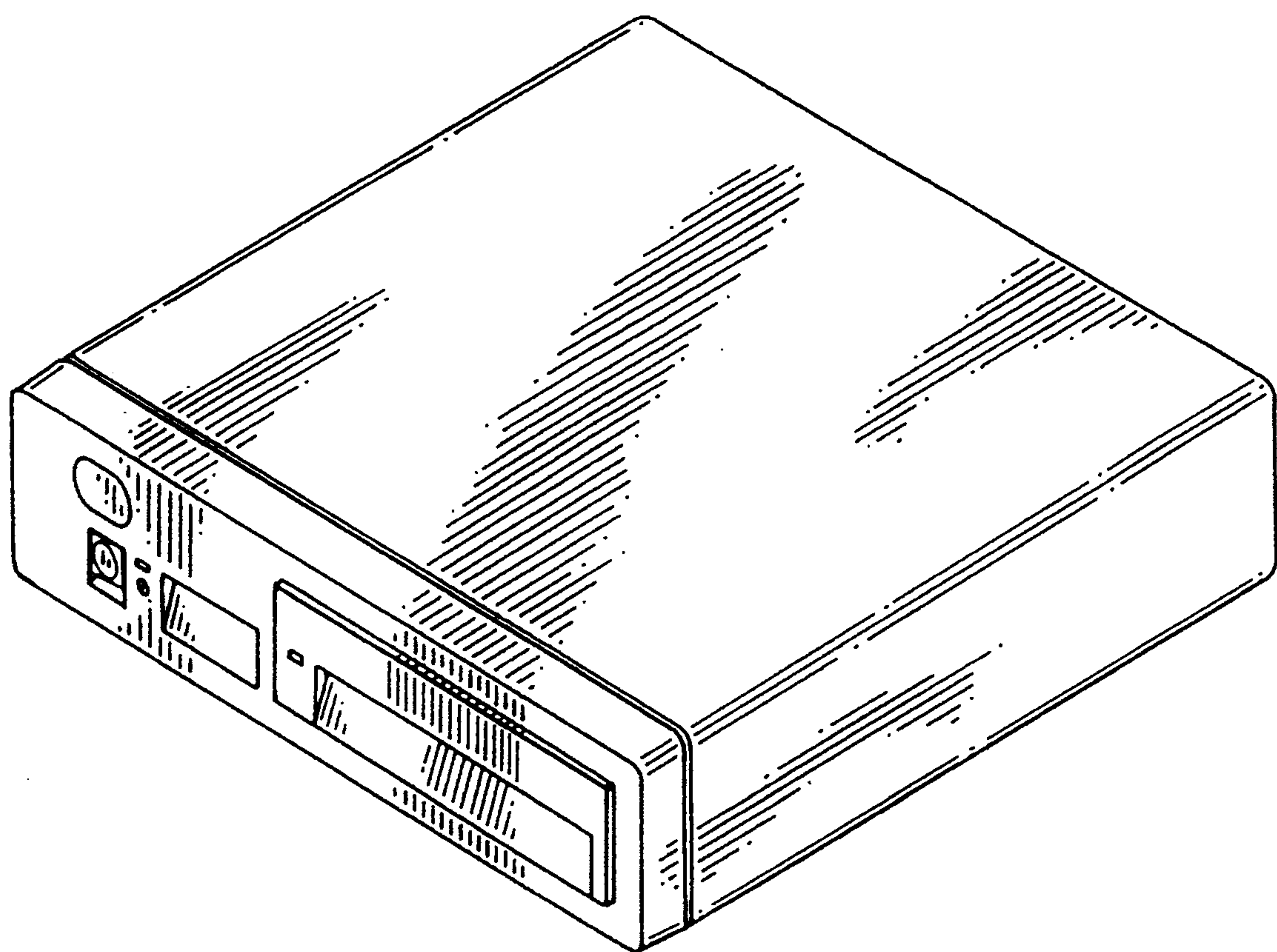

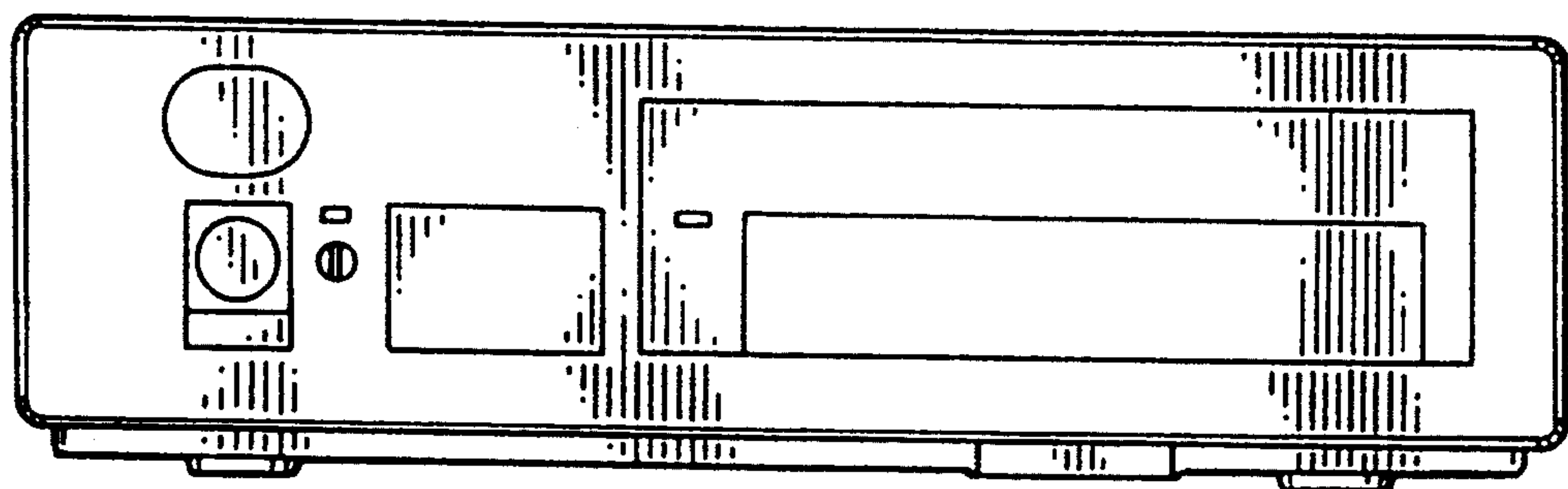

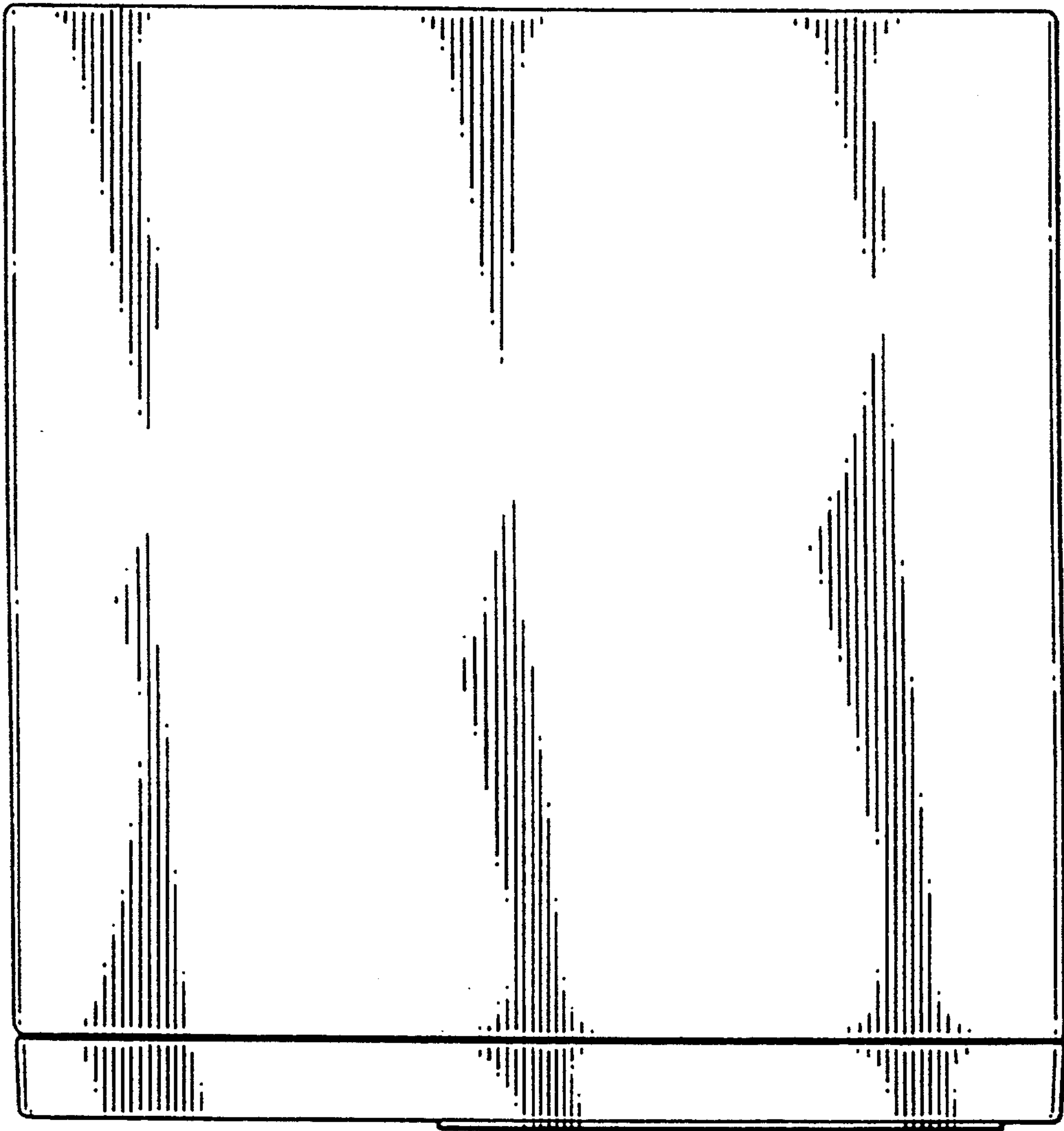

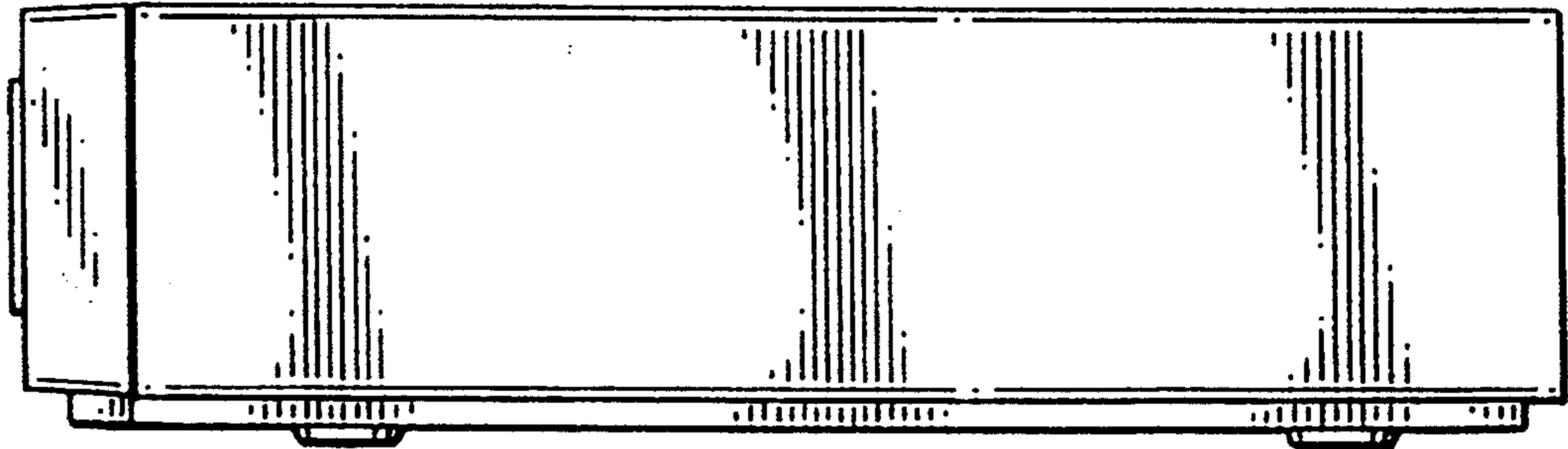

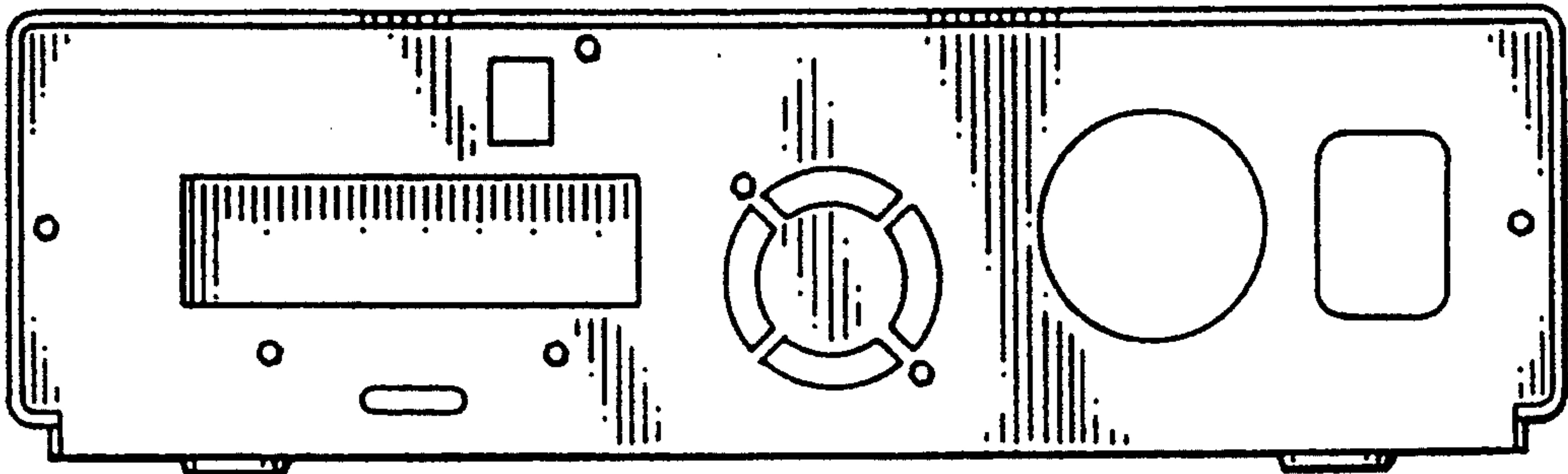

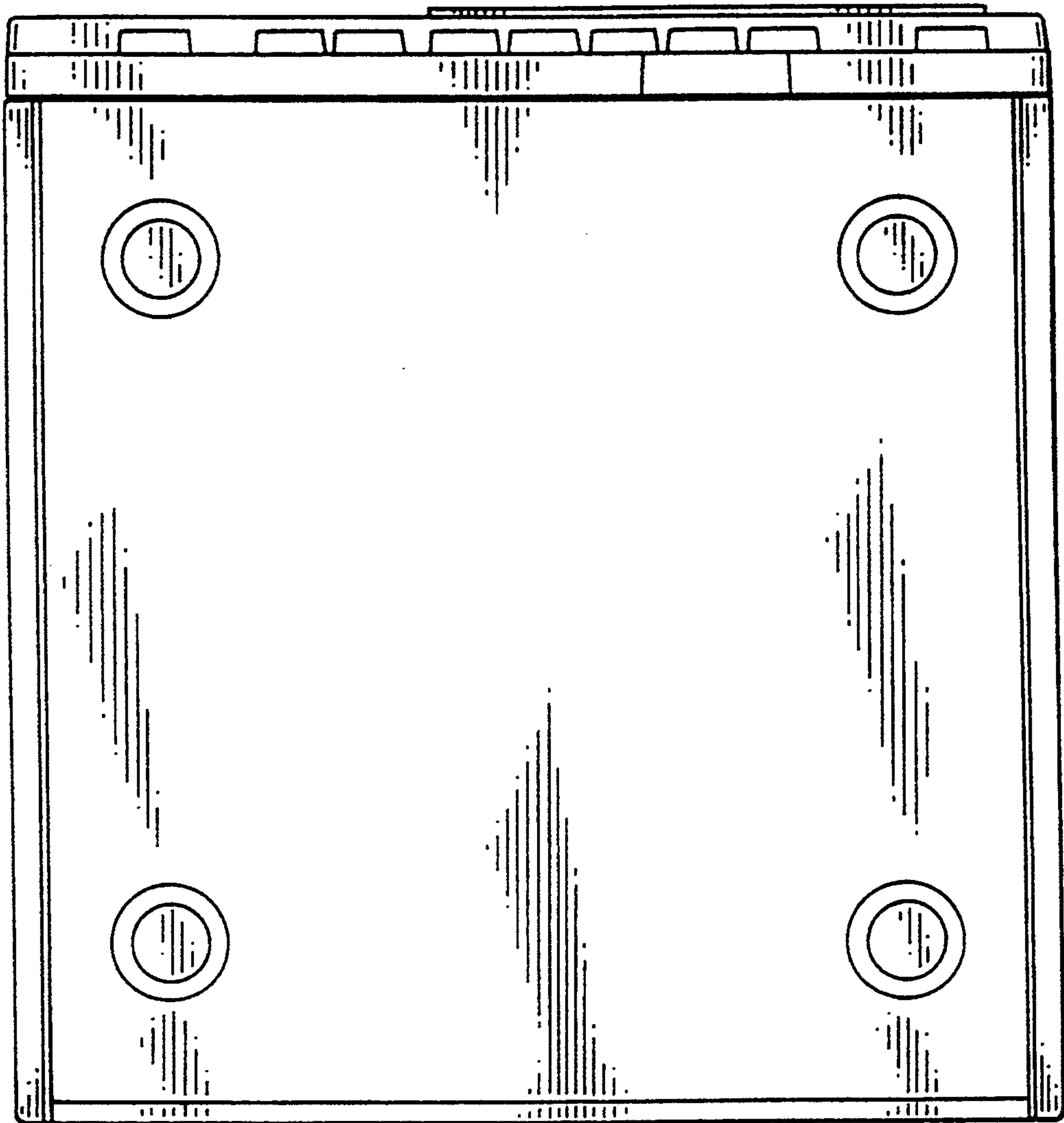
