DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a burial casket showing my new design, with the upper part of the two-part cover in the open position and the lower part in the closed position;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the casket in the closed position, the appearance being the same on both sides;

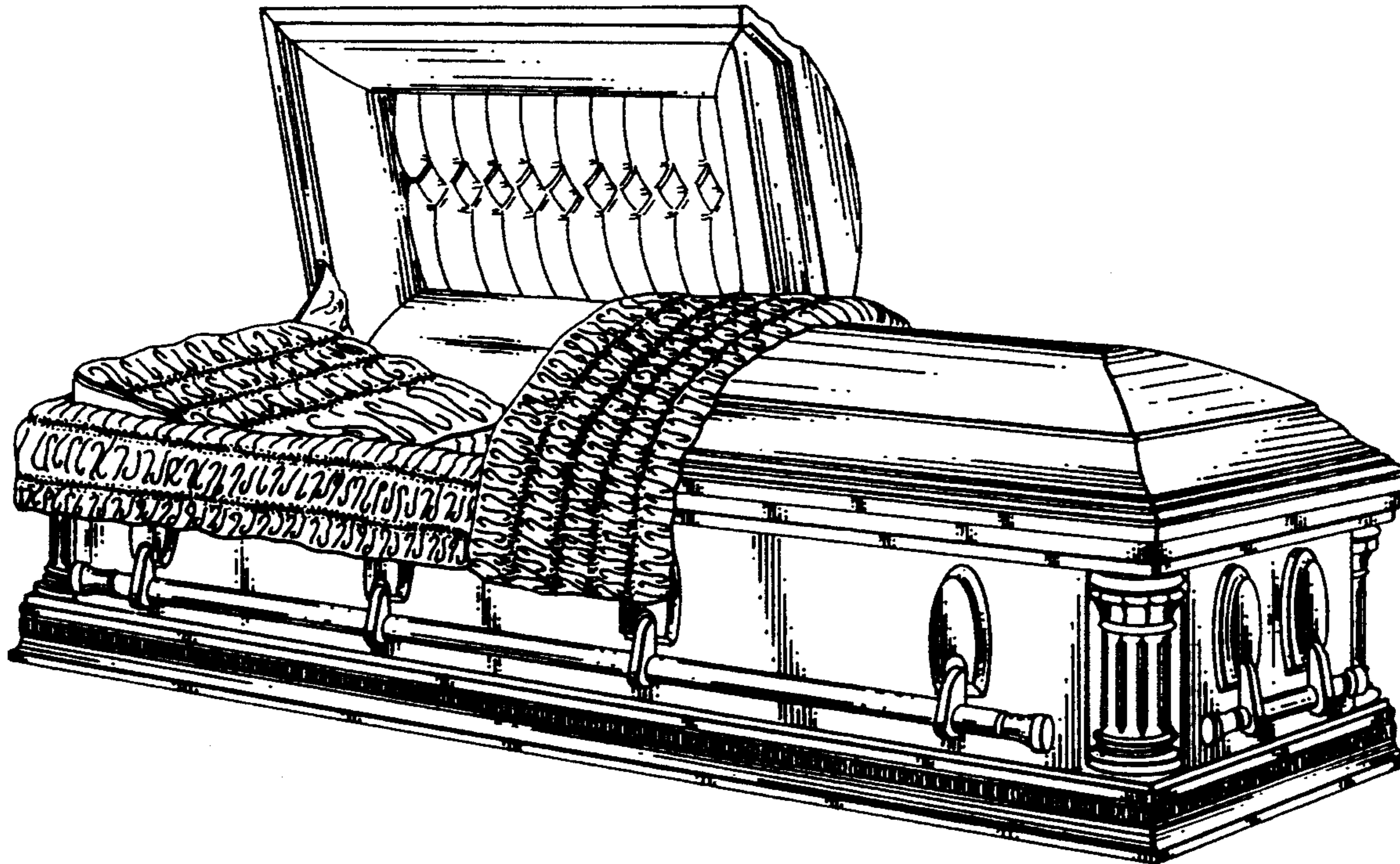
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; and,

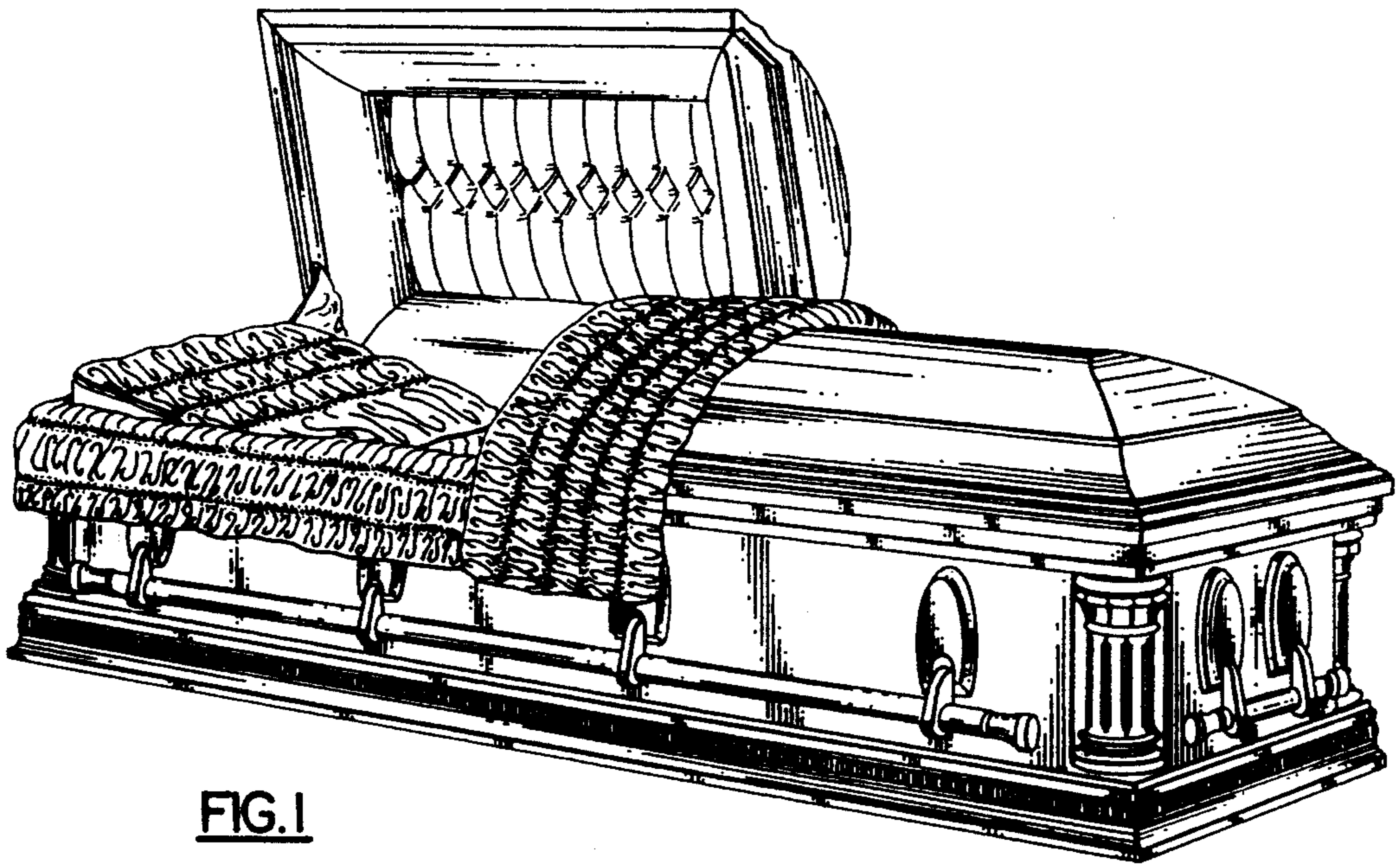

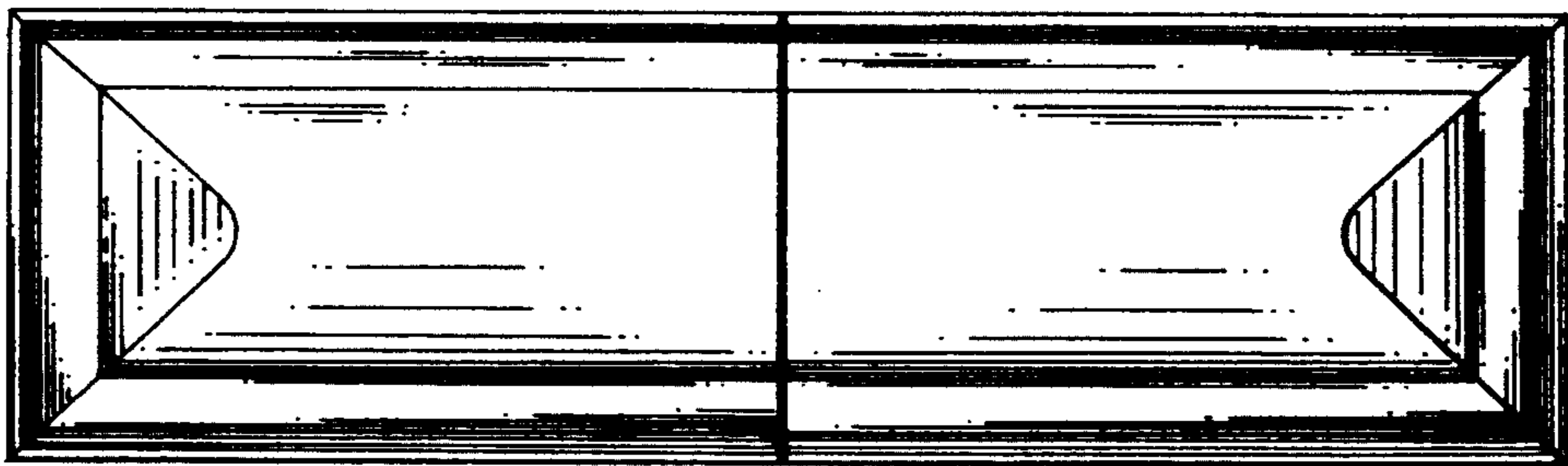

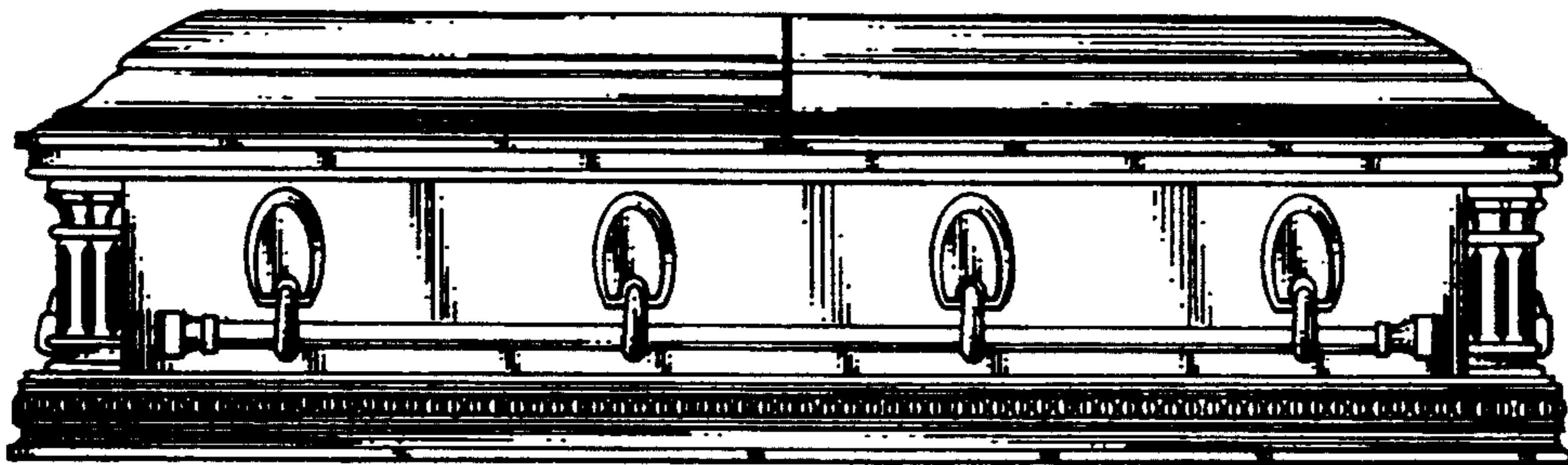

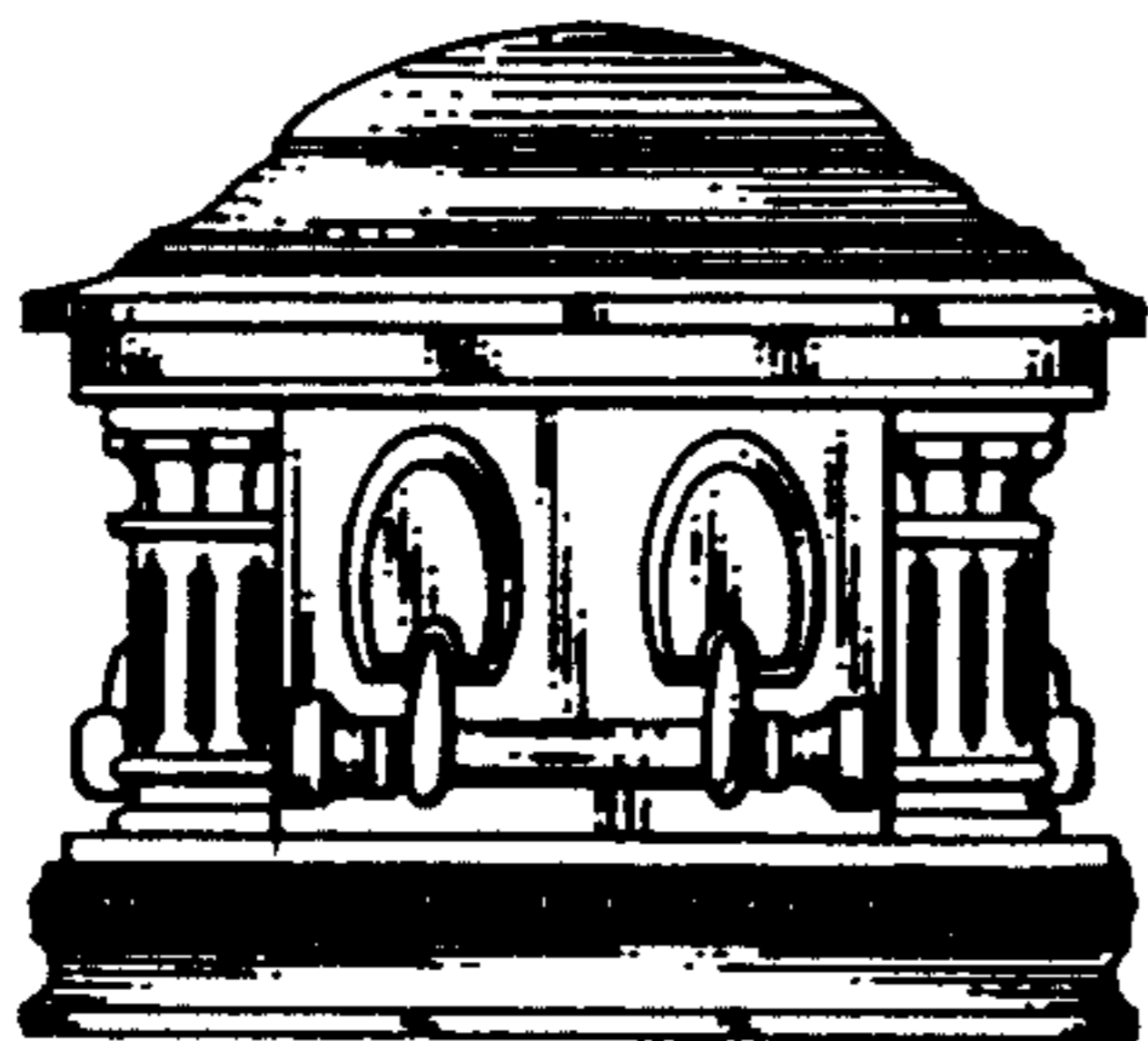
