FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a chair showing my new design;


FIG. 2 is a front elevational view;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view, the left side being a mirror image thereof;


FIG. 4 is a top plan view; and,

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.


FIGS. 2 through 5 have been drawn to a reduced scale with respect to FIG. 1.








