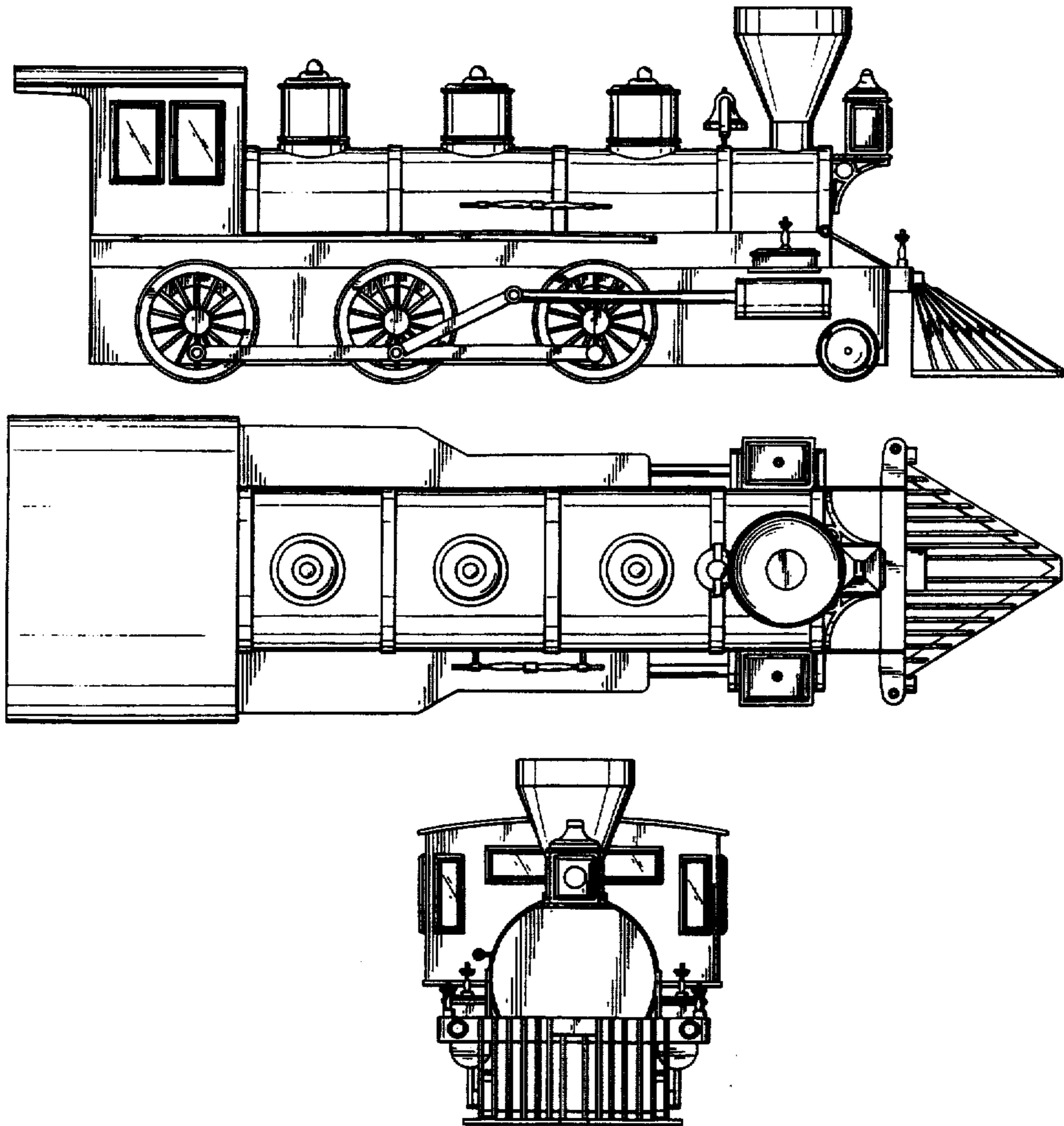

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a combined barbeque smoker and cooker, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right side elevational view of a combined barbeque smoker and cooker showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof; and, FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.



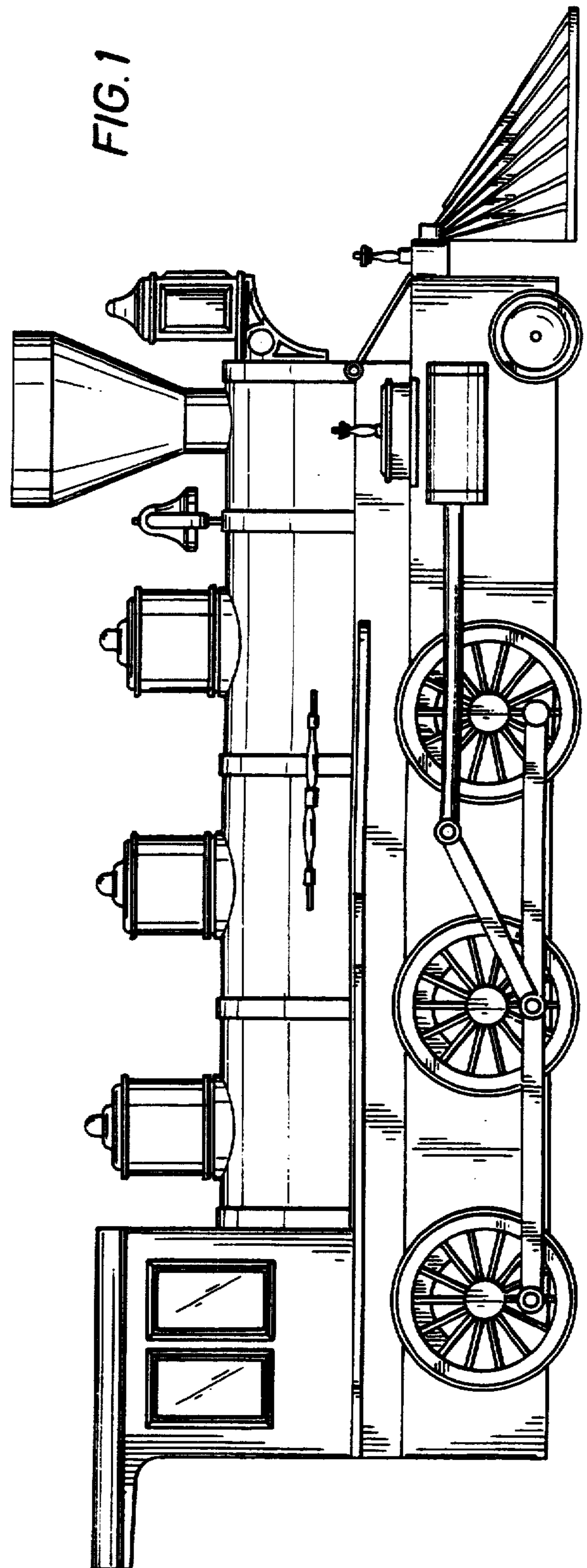
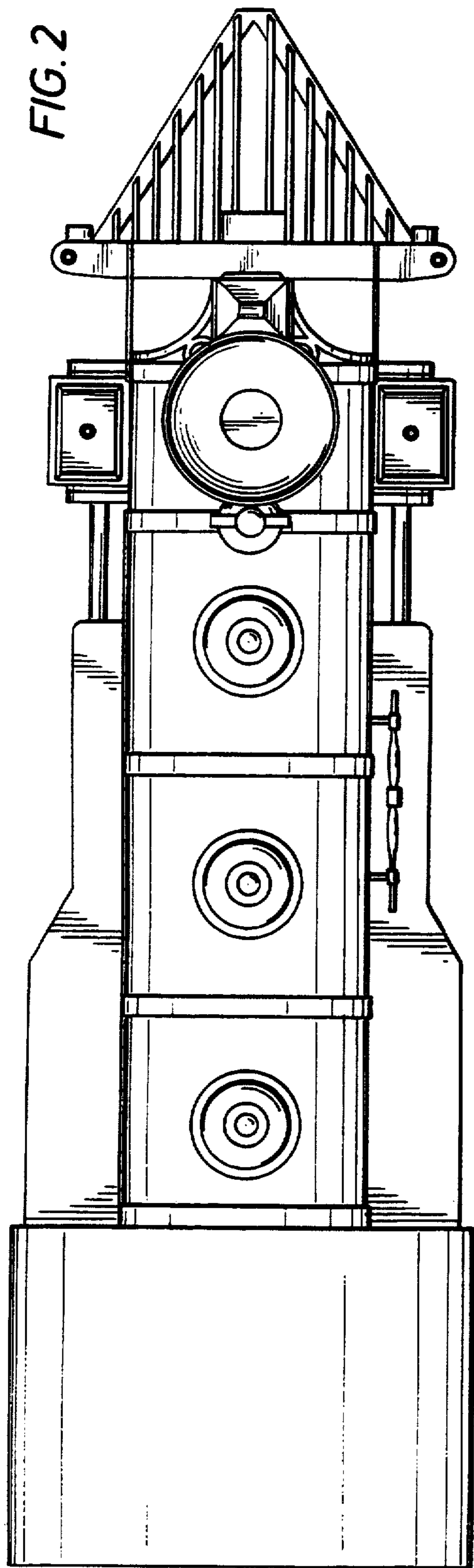

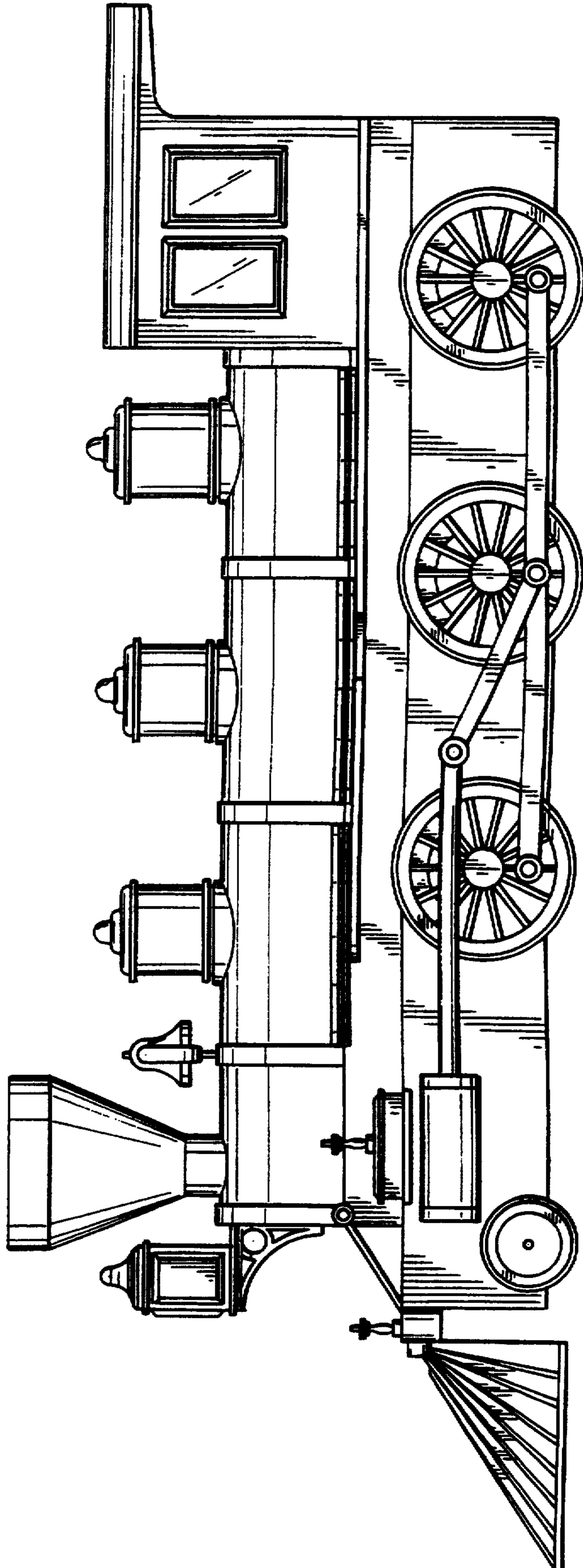

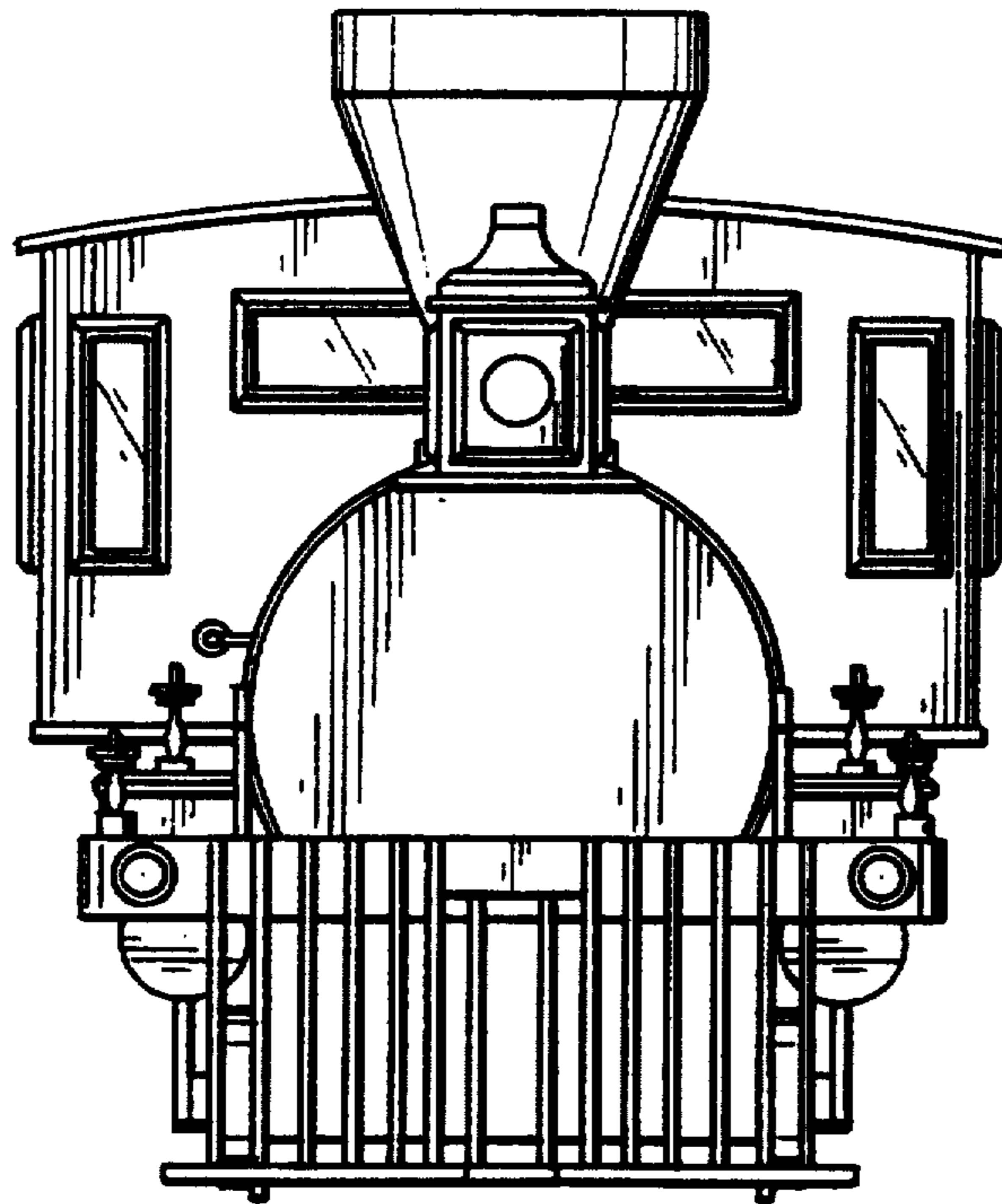
