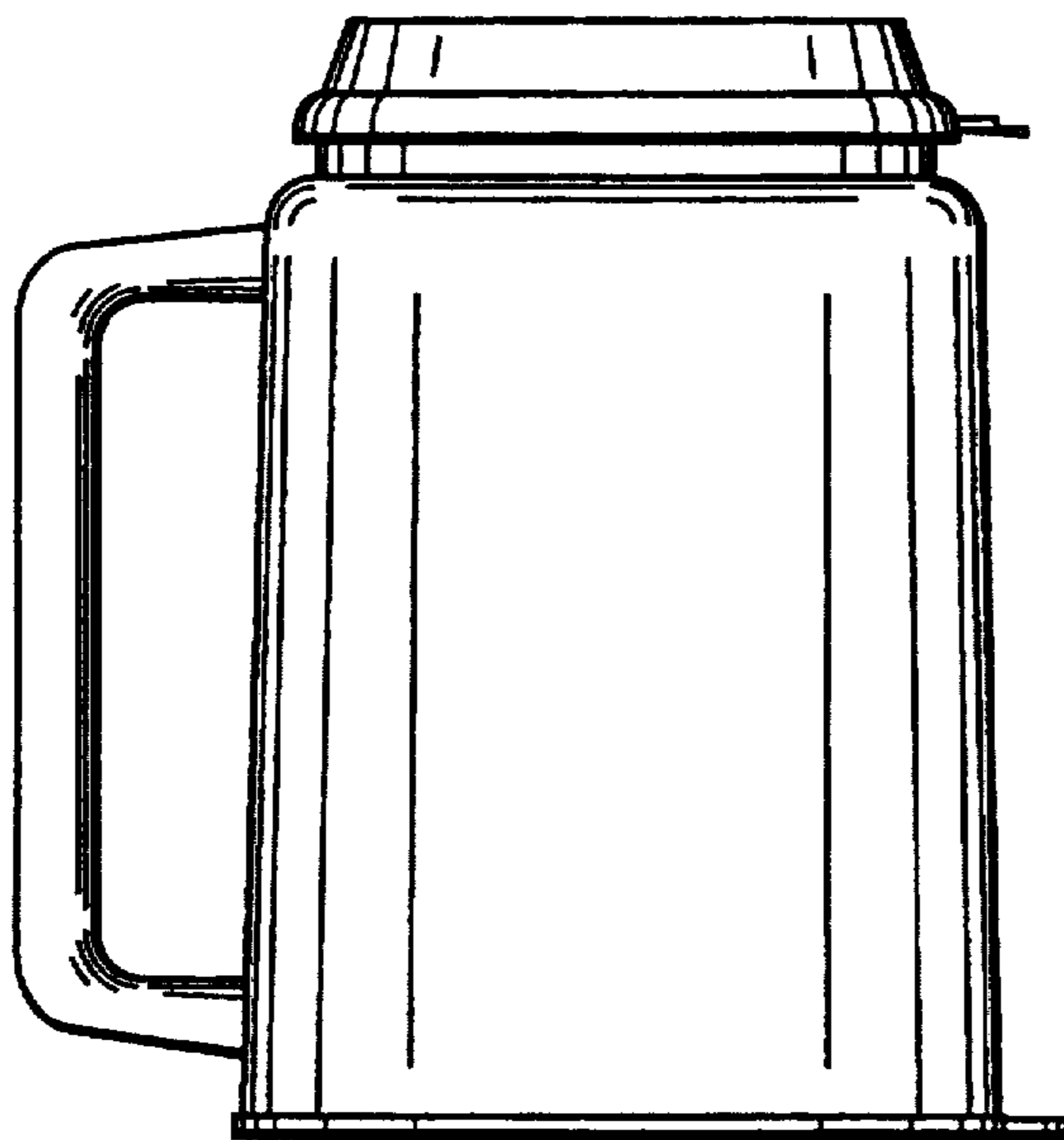

### [57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a thermo mug with removable bottom, as shown.

### DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side view of a thermo mug with removable bottom, with the removable bottom shown in place at the lower portion of the mug and the lid shown in place at the upper portion of the mug;  
 FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the mug with the lid and removable bottom in place;  
 FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view of the mug with the removable bottom in place;  
 FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of the mug with the bottom removed;  
 FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the mug with the lid removed;  
 FIG. 6 is a front view of the mug with the lid and bottom in place;  
 FIG. 7 is a rear view of the mug with the lid and bottom in place;  
 FIG. 8 is a top perspective view of the mug with the lid and bottom in place; and,  
 FIG. 9 is a bottom perspective view of the mug with the lid and bottom in place.



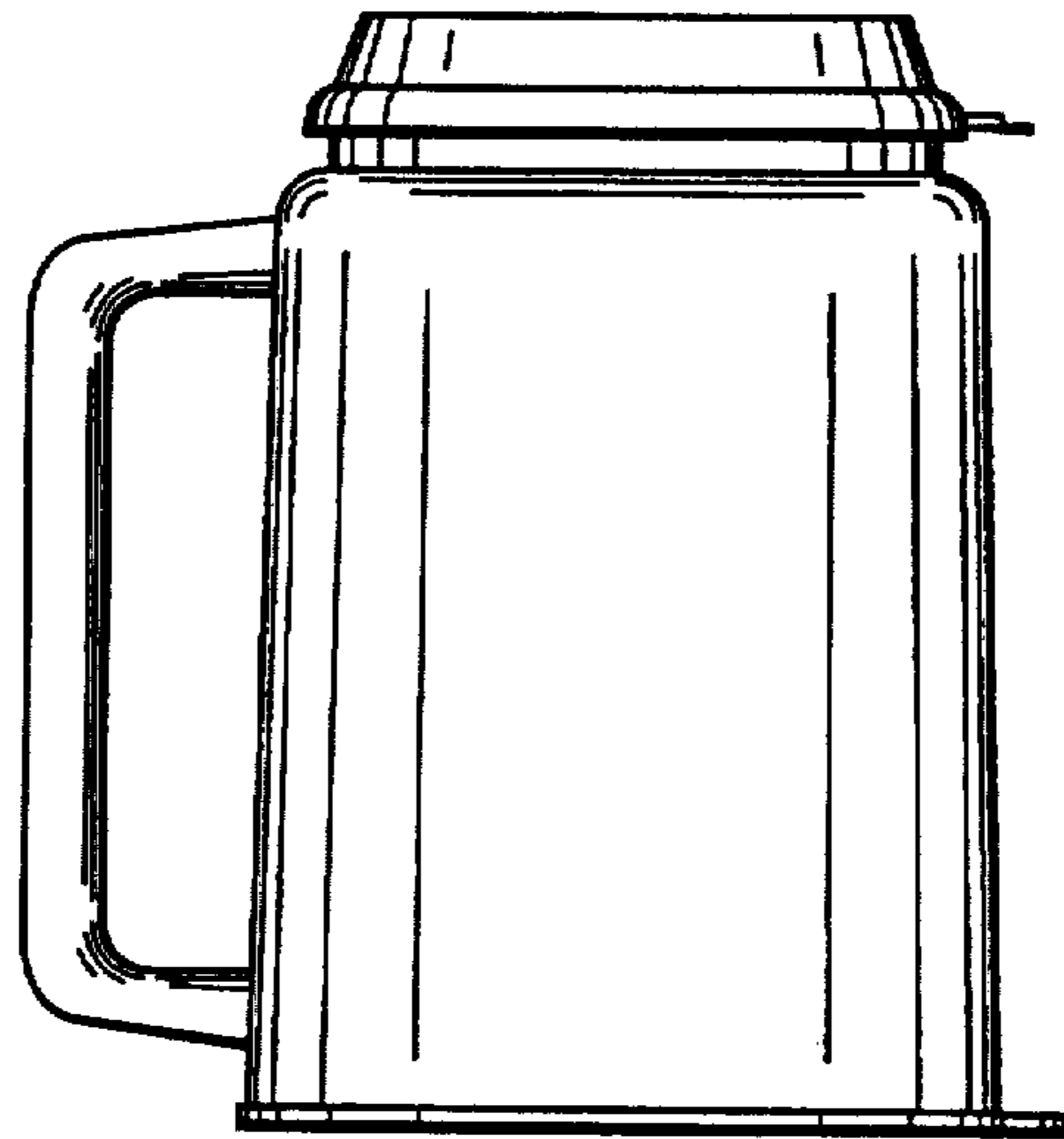

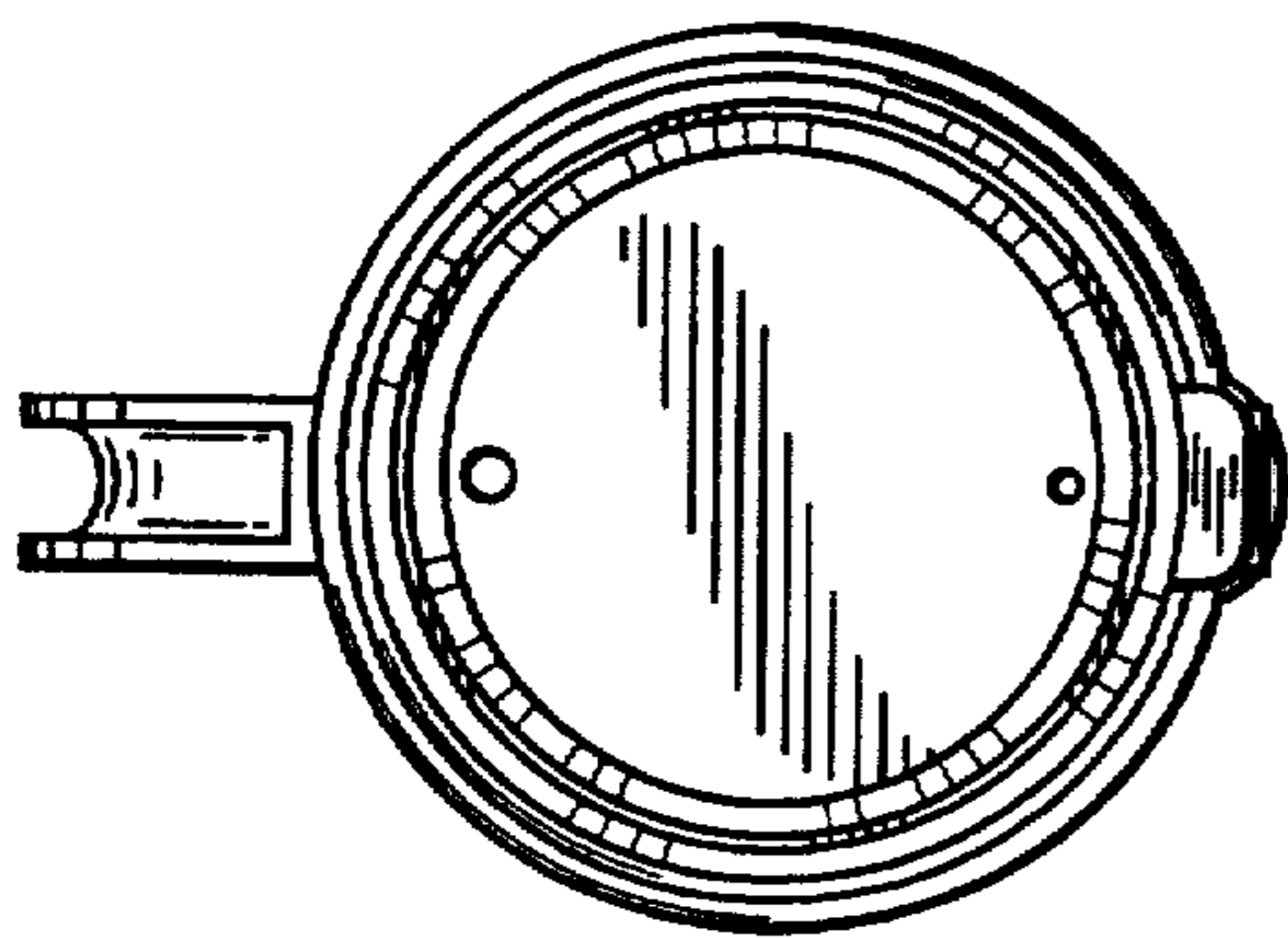

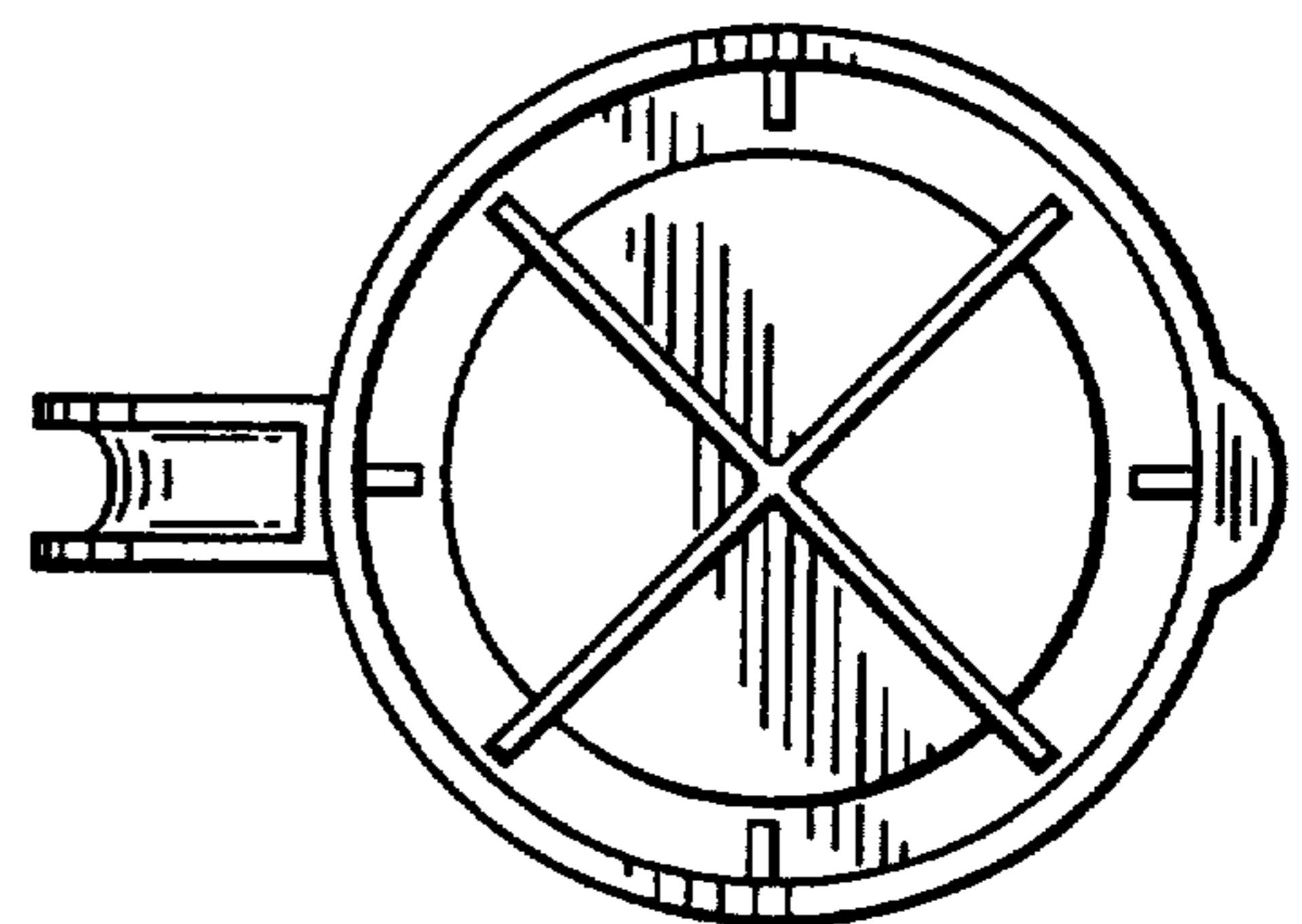

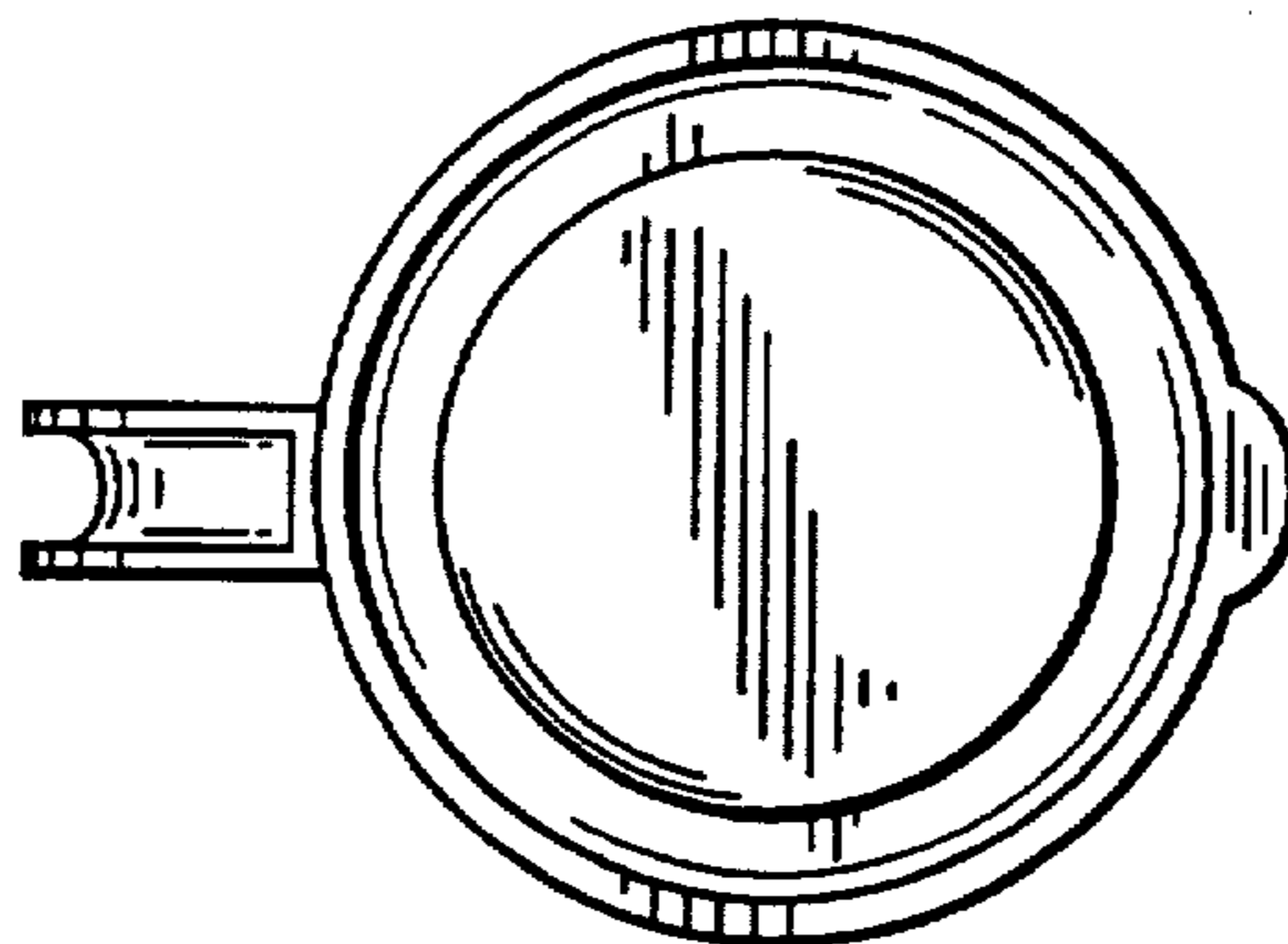

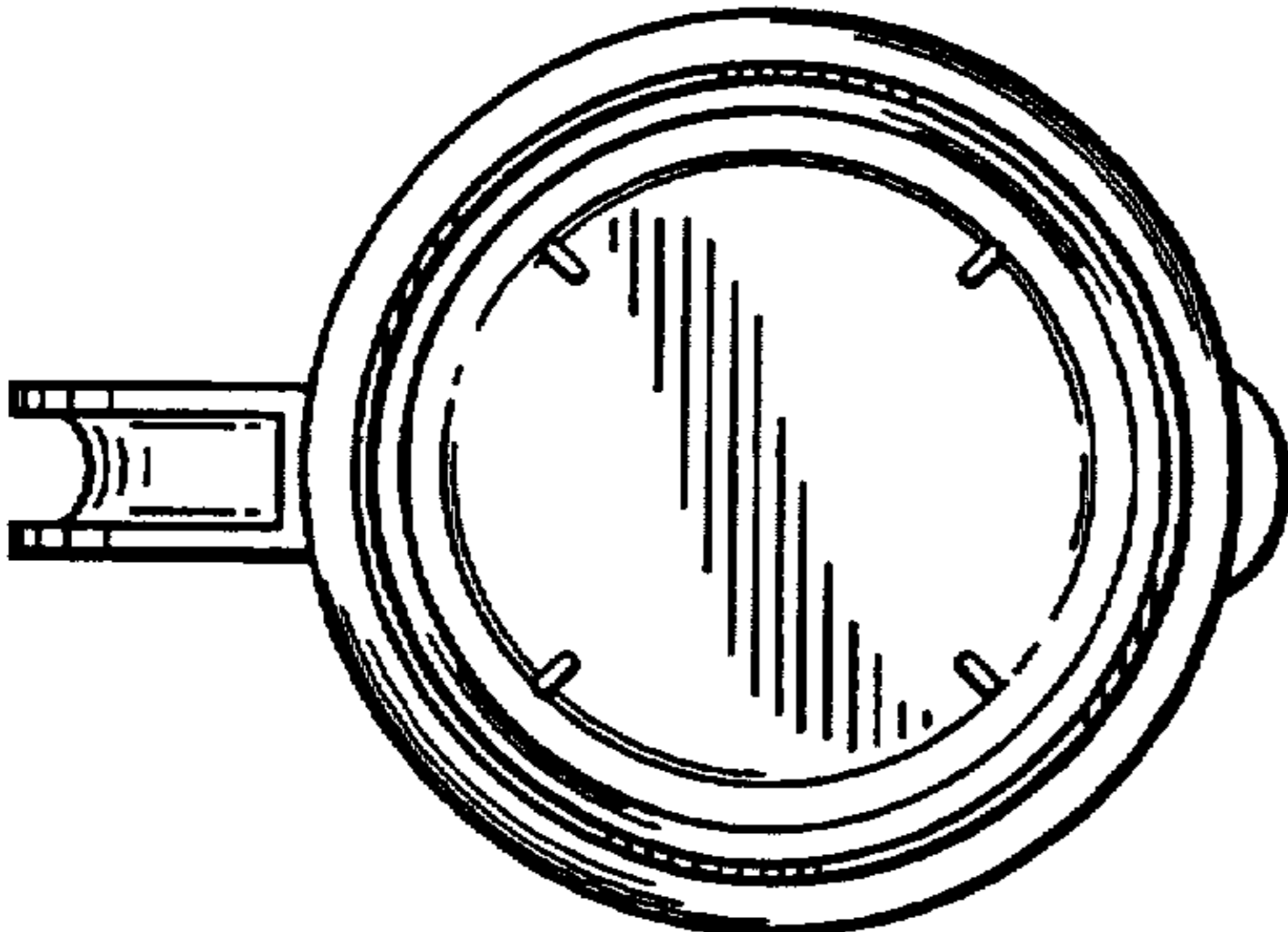

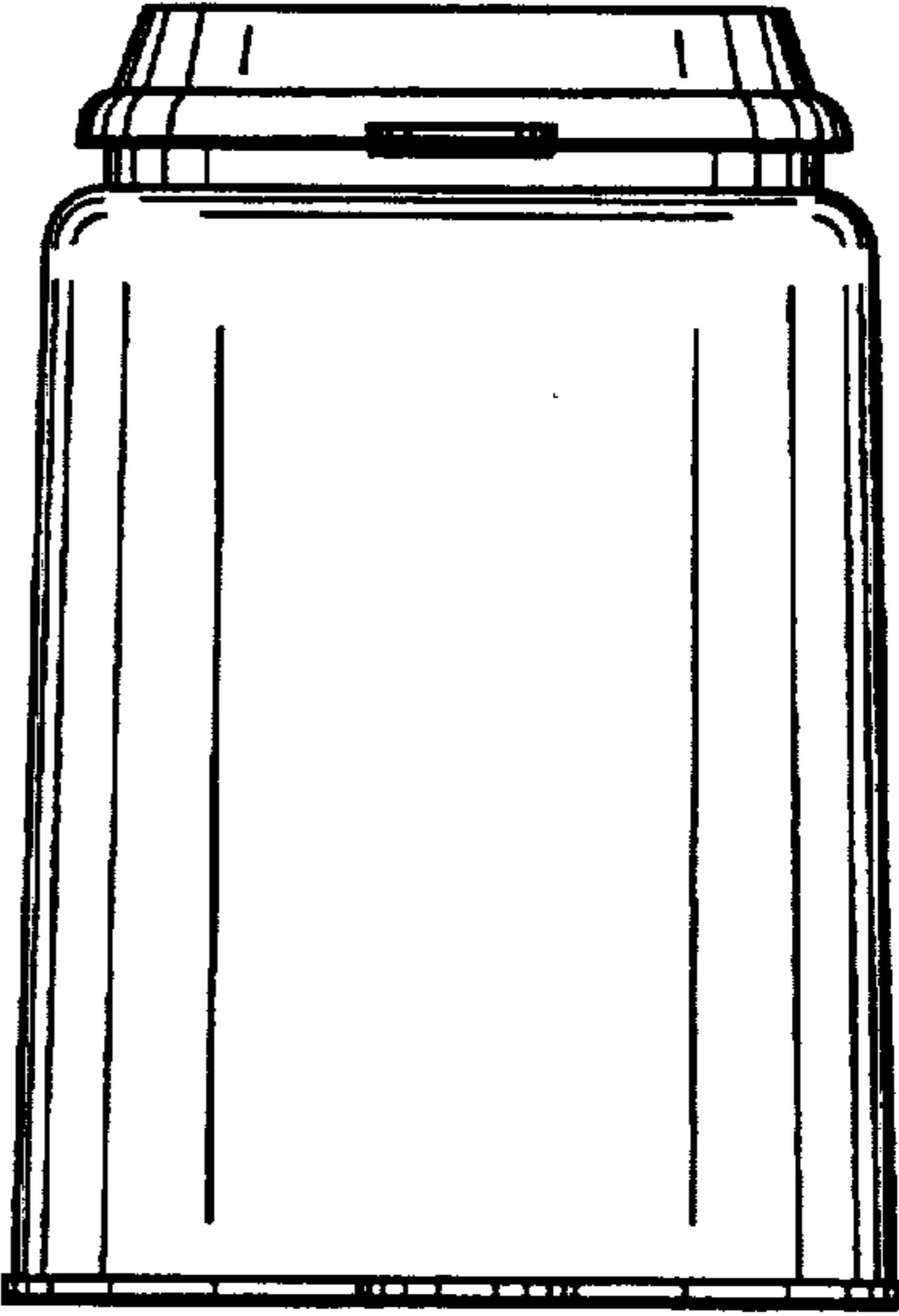

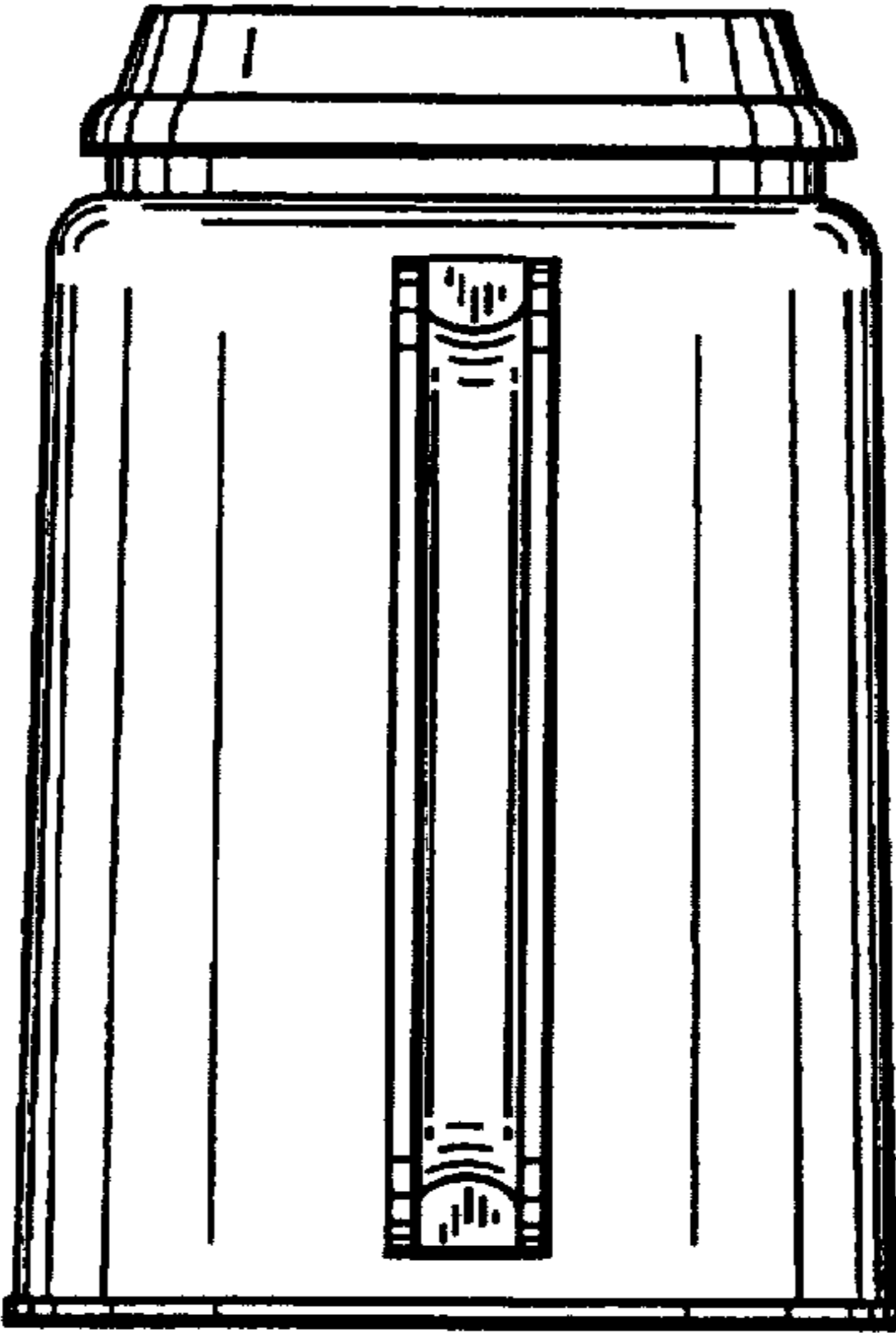

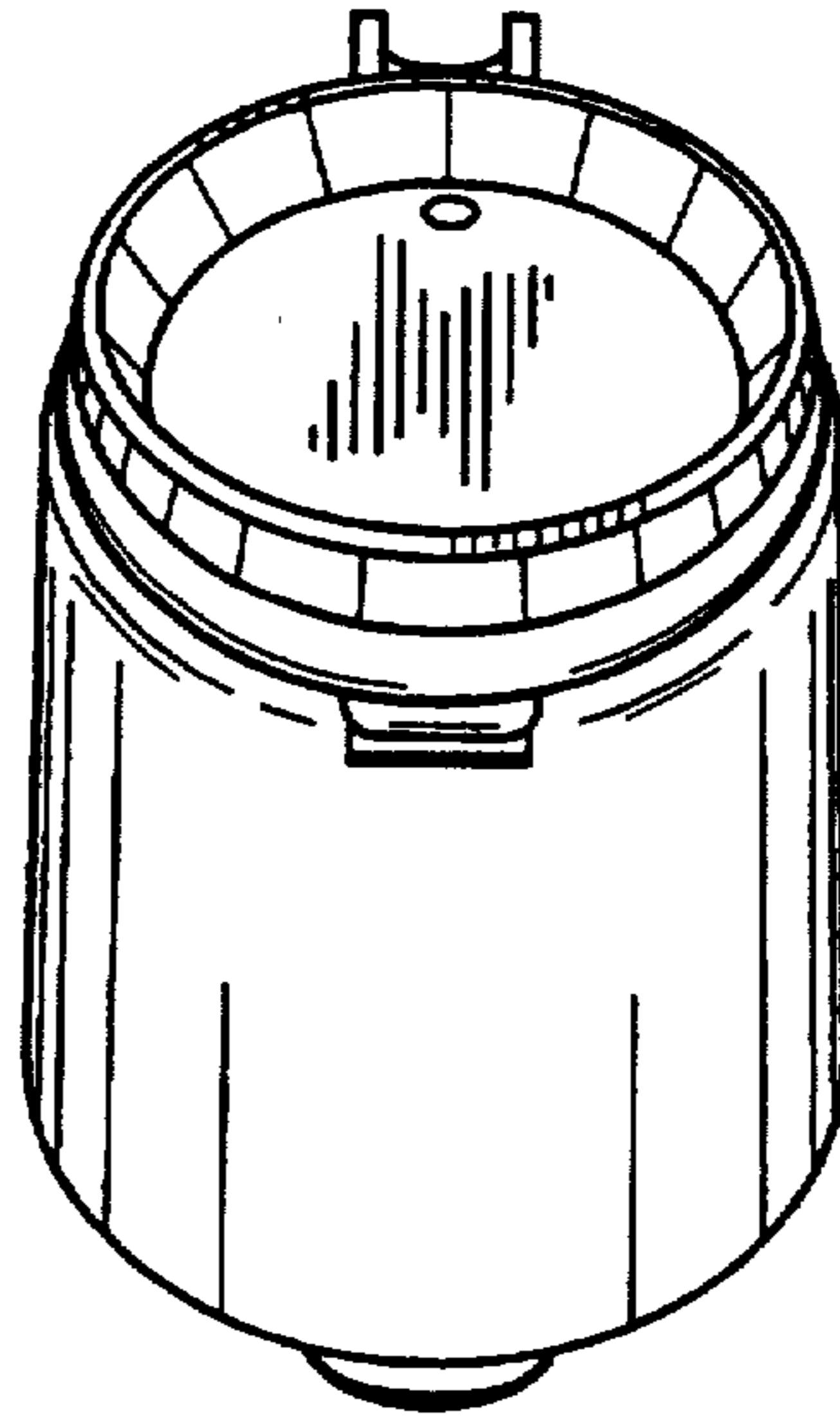

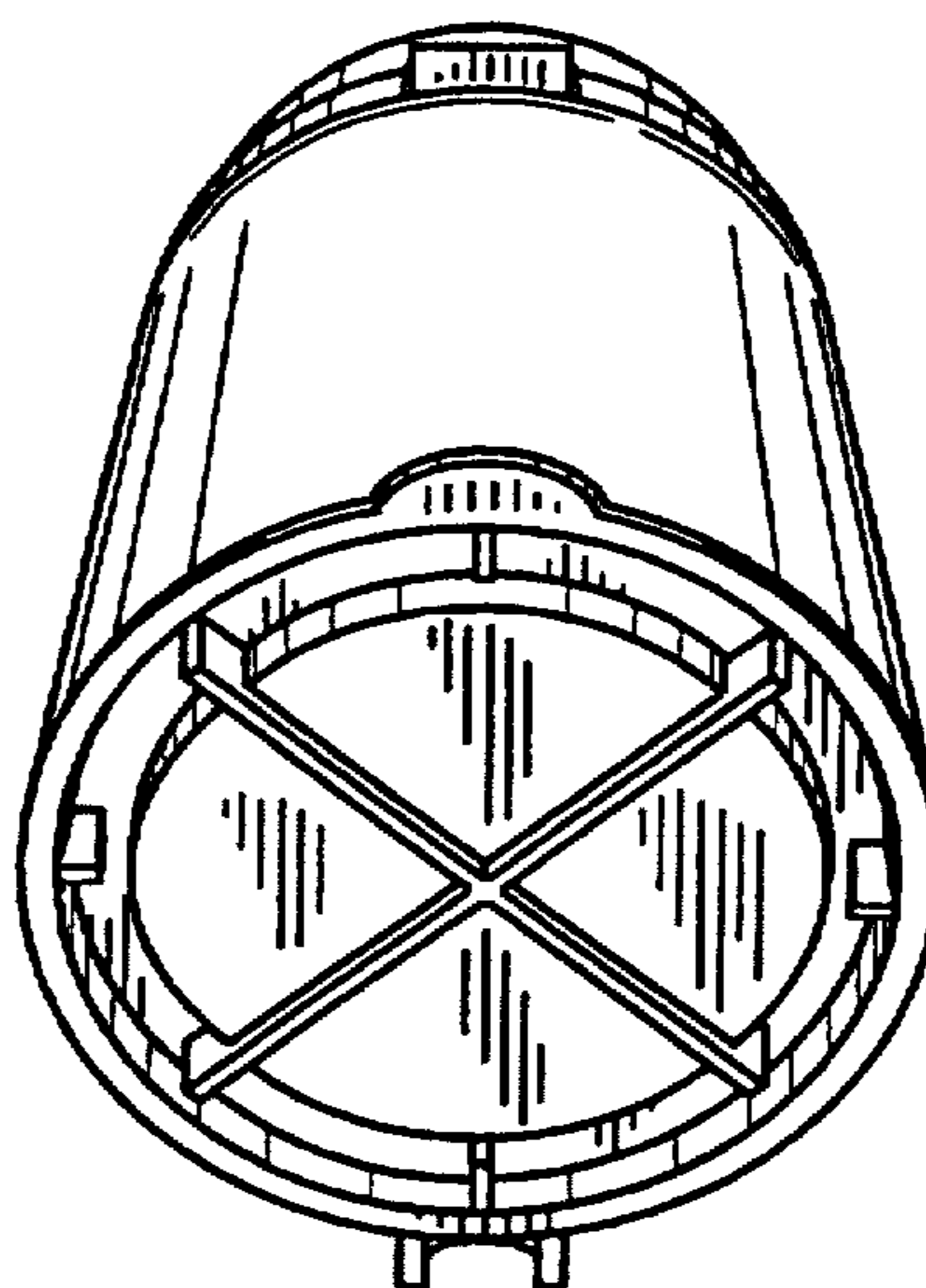
