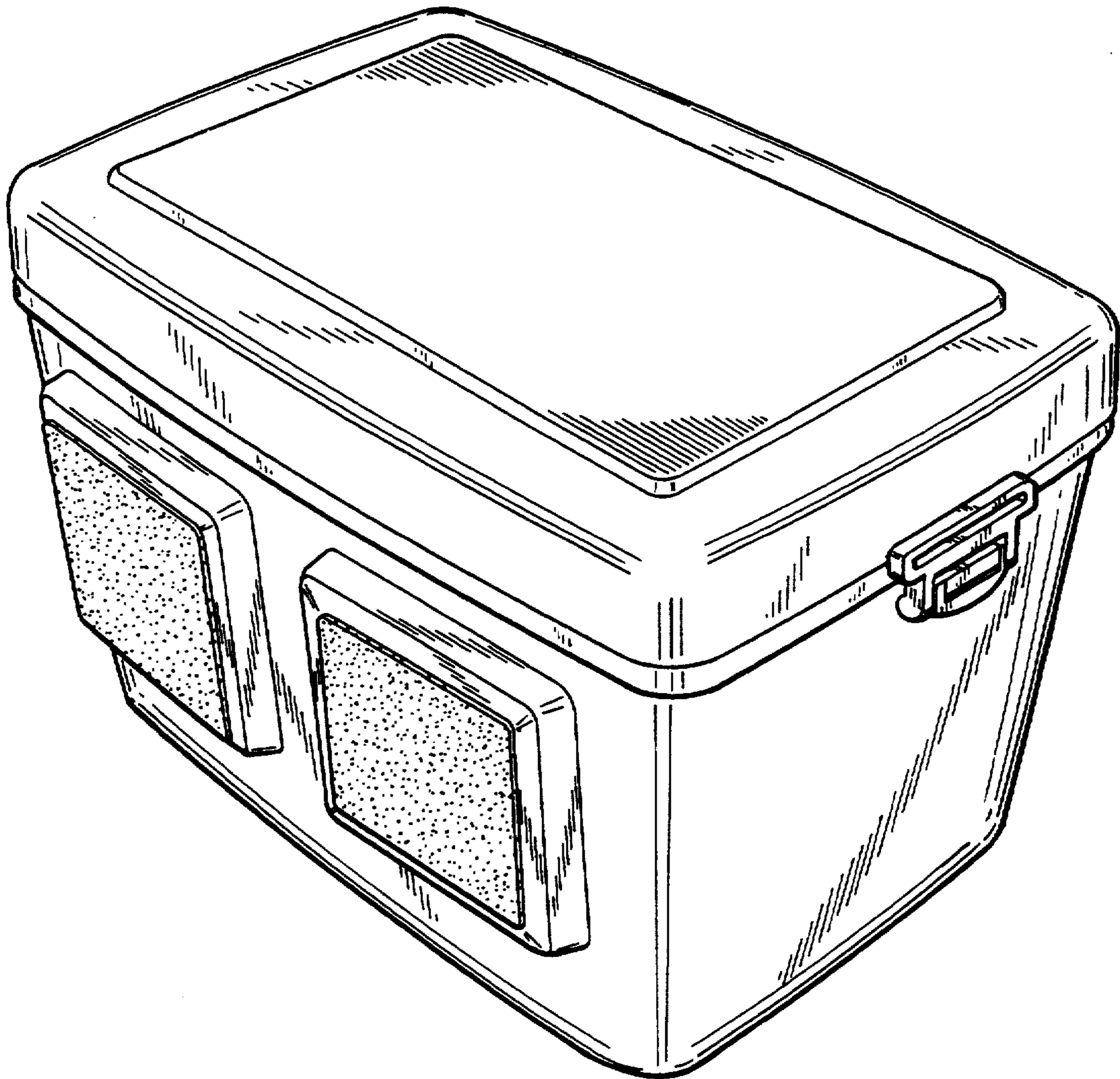
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a recreational stereo cooler showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

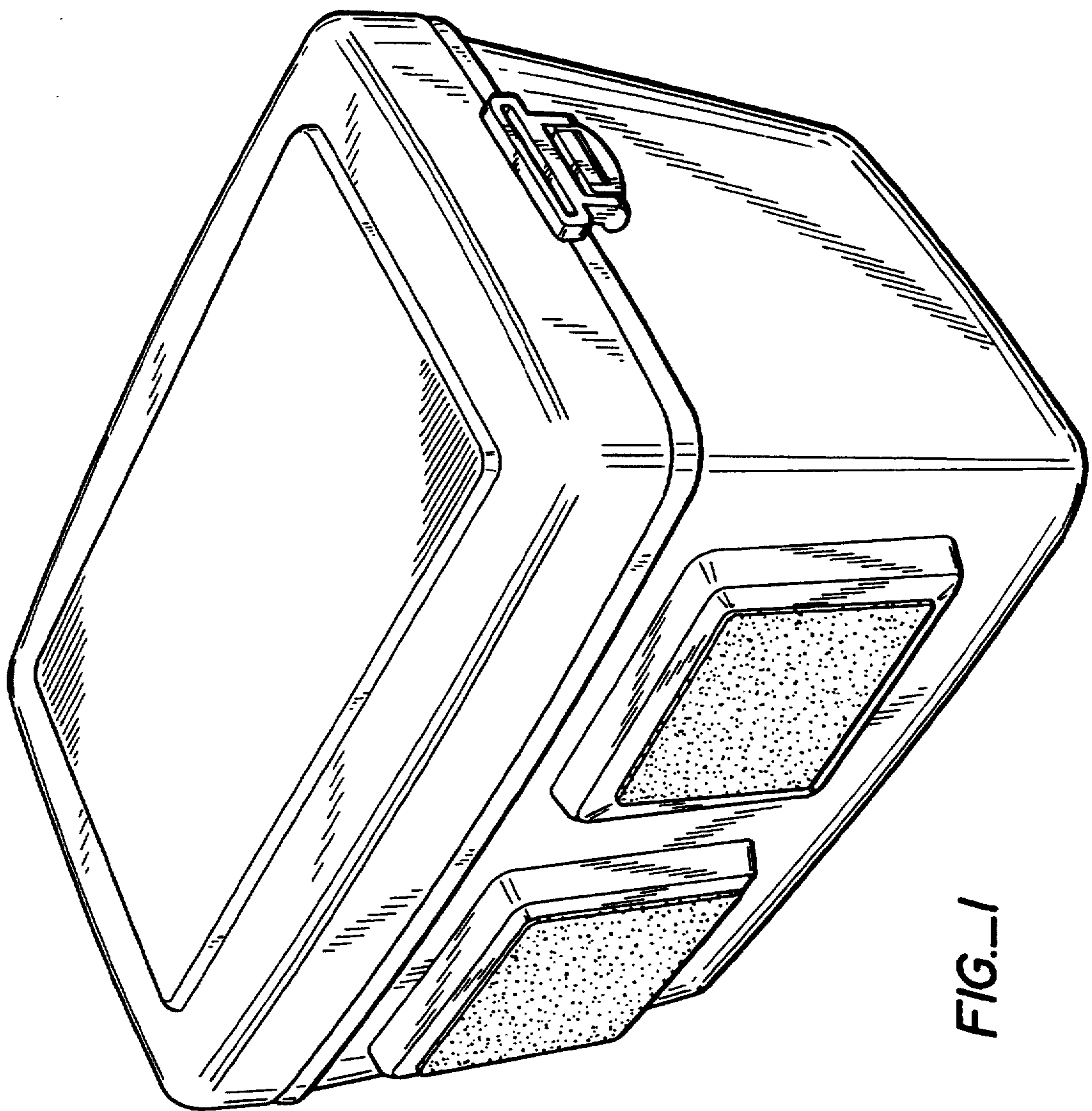

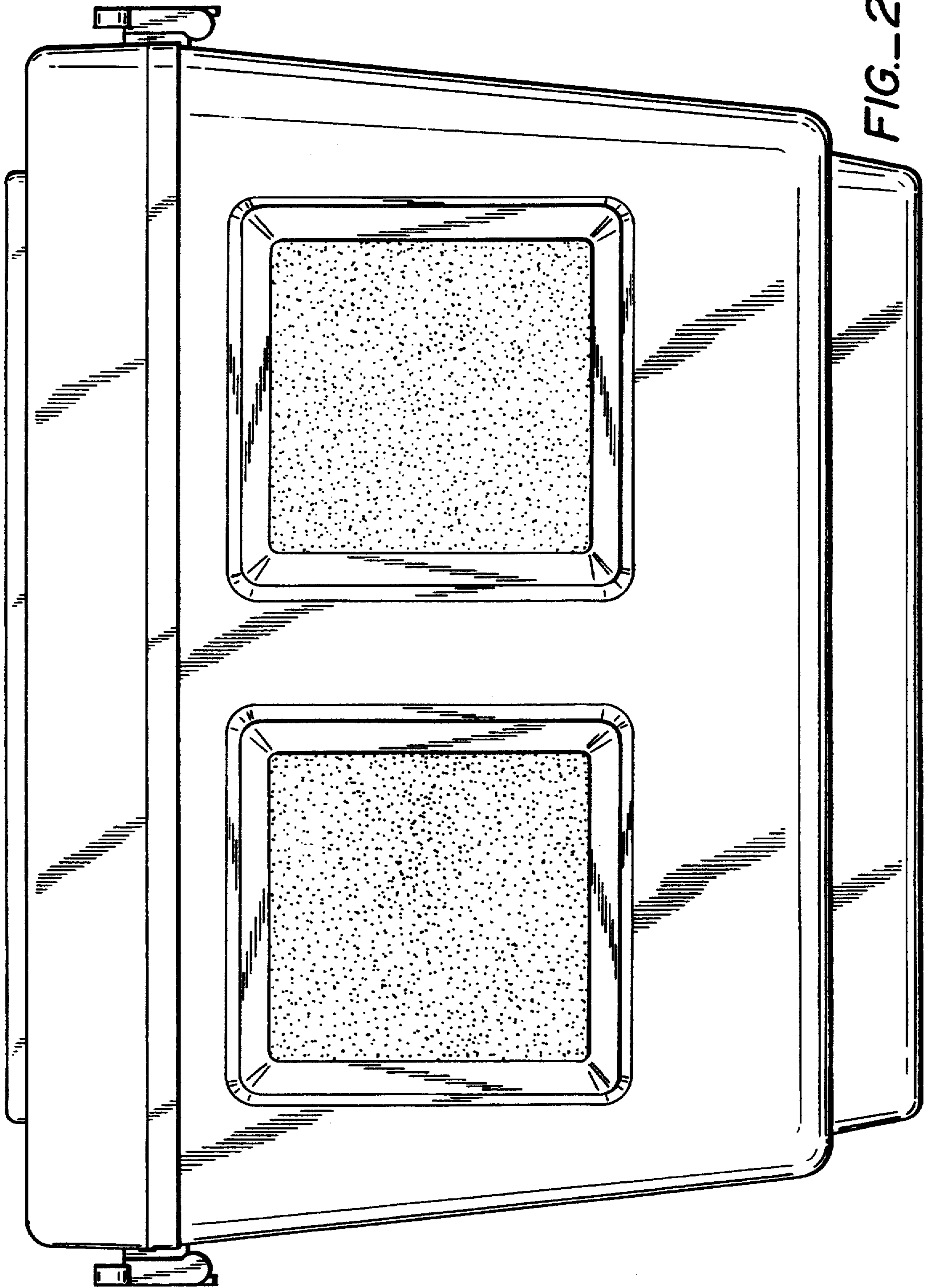

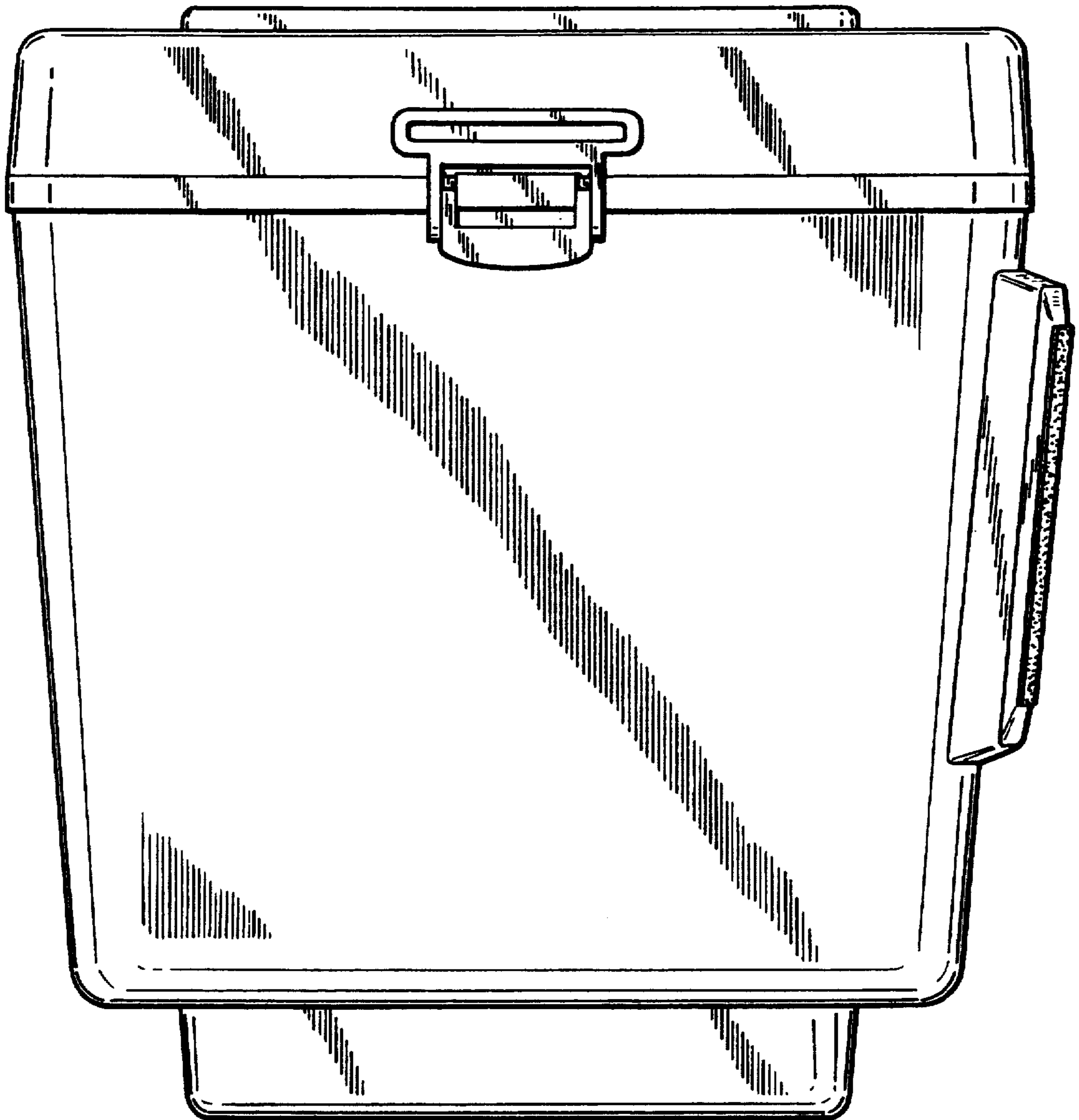

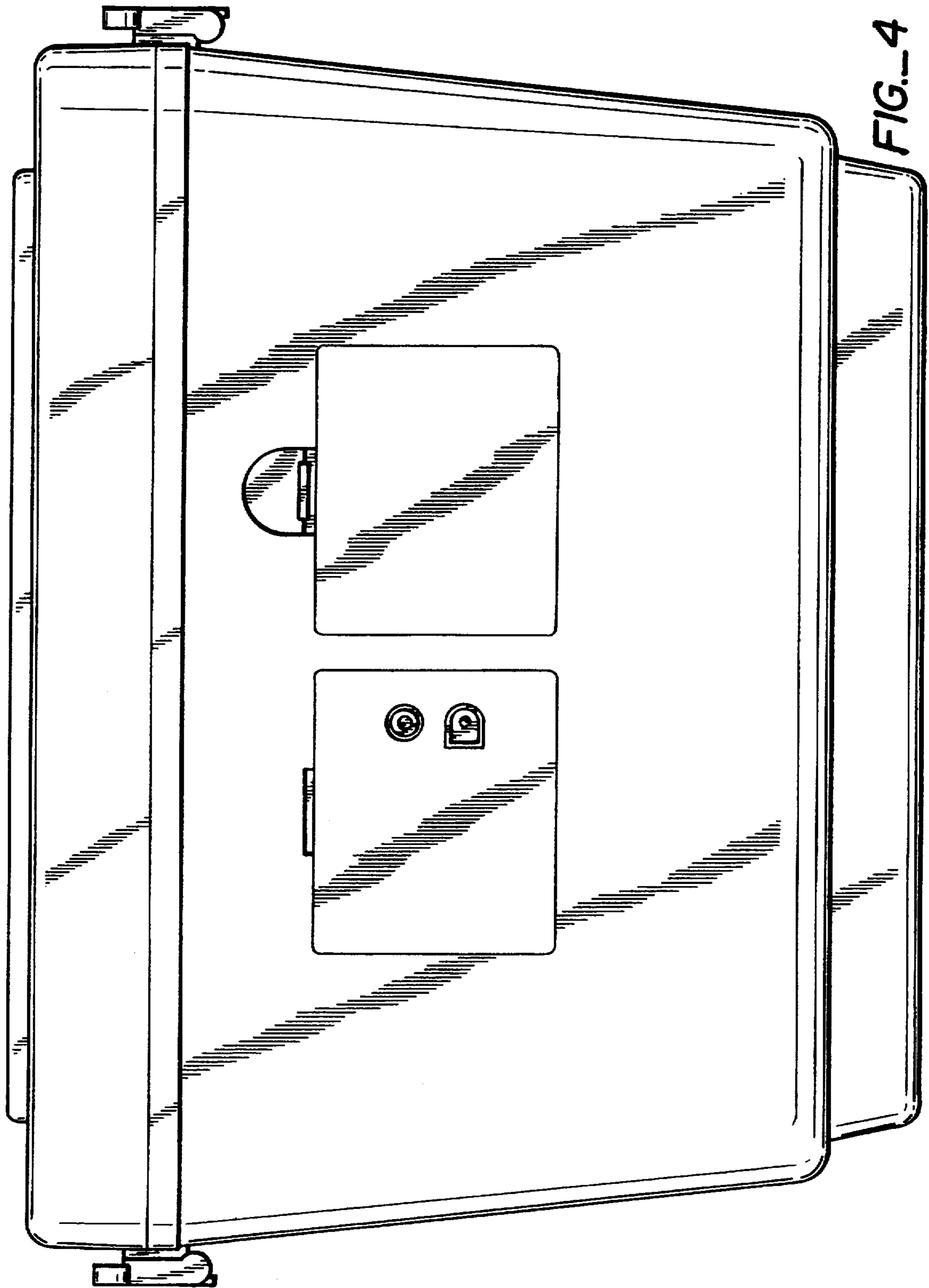

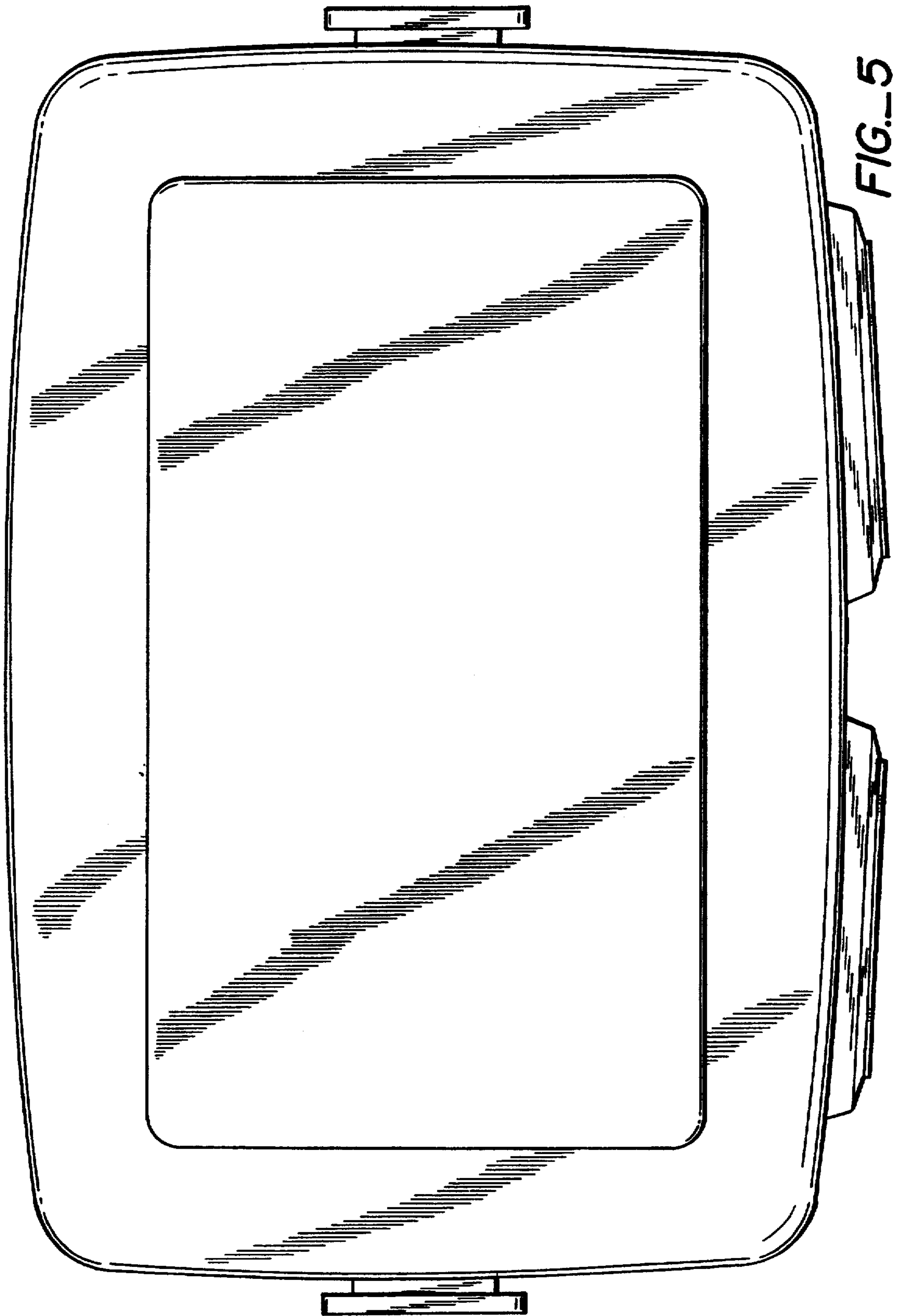

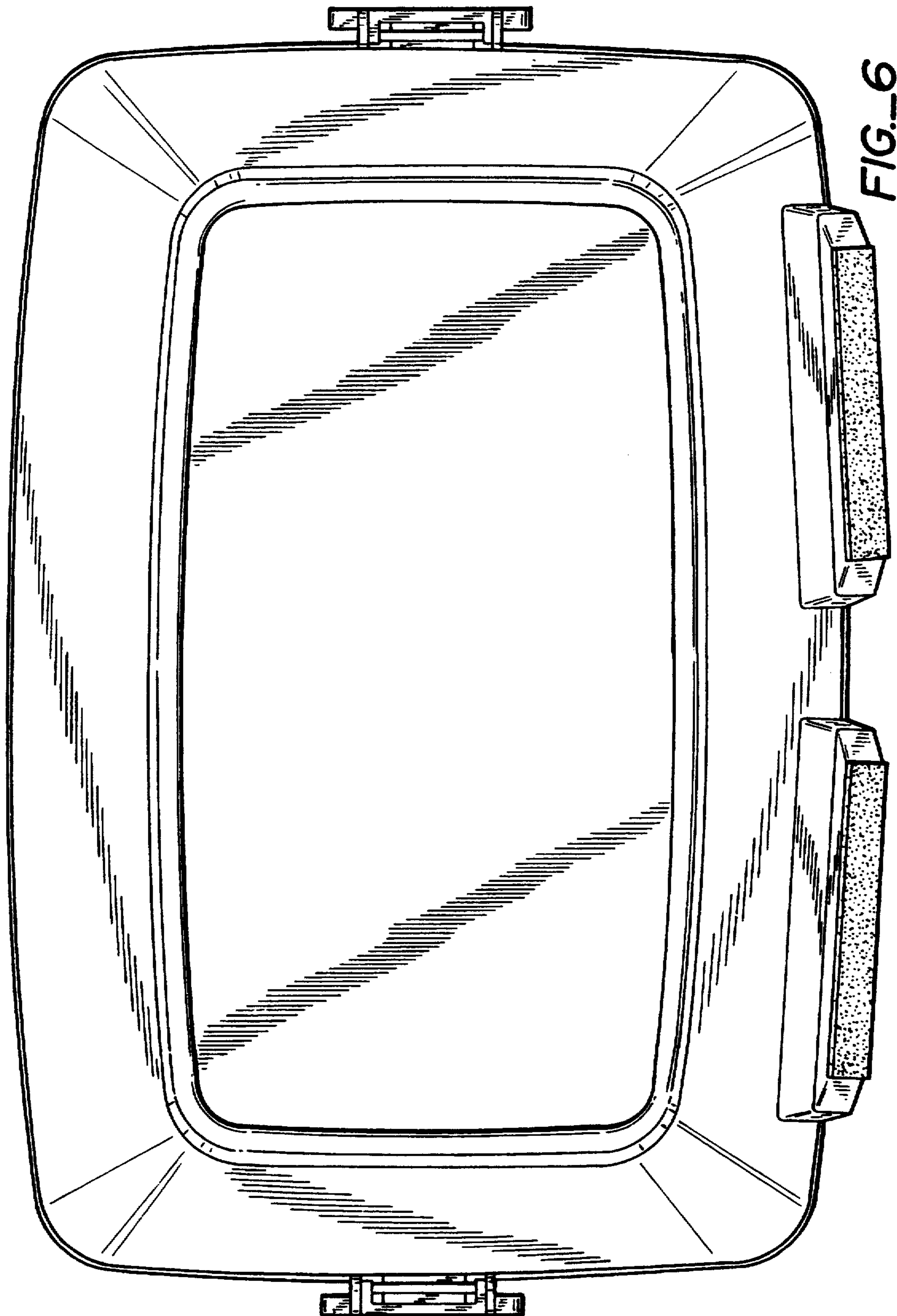
