FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;

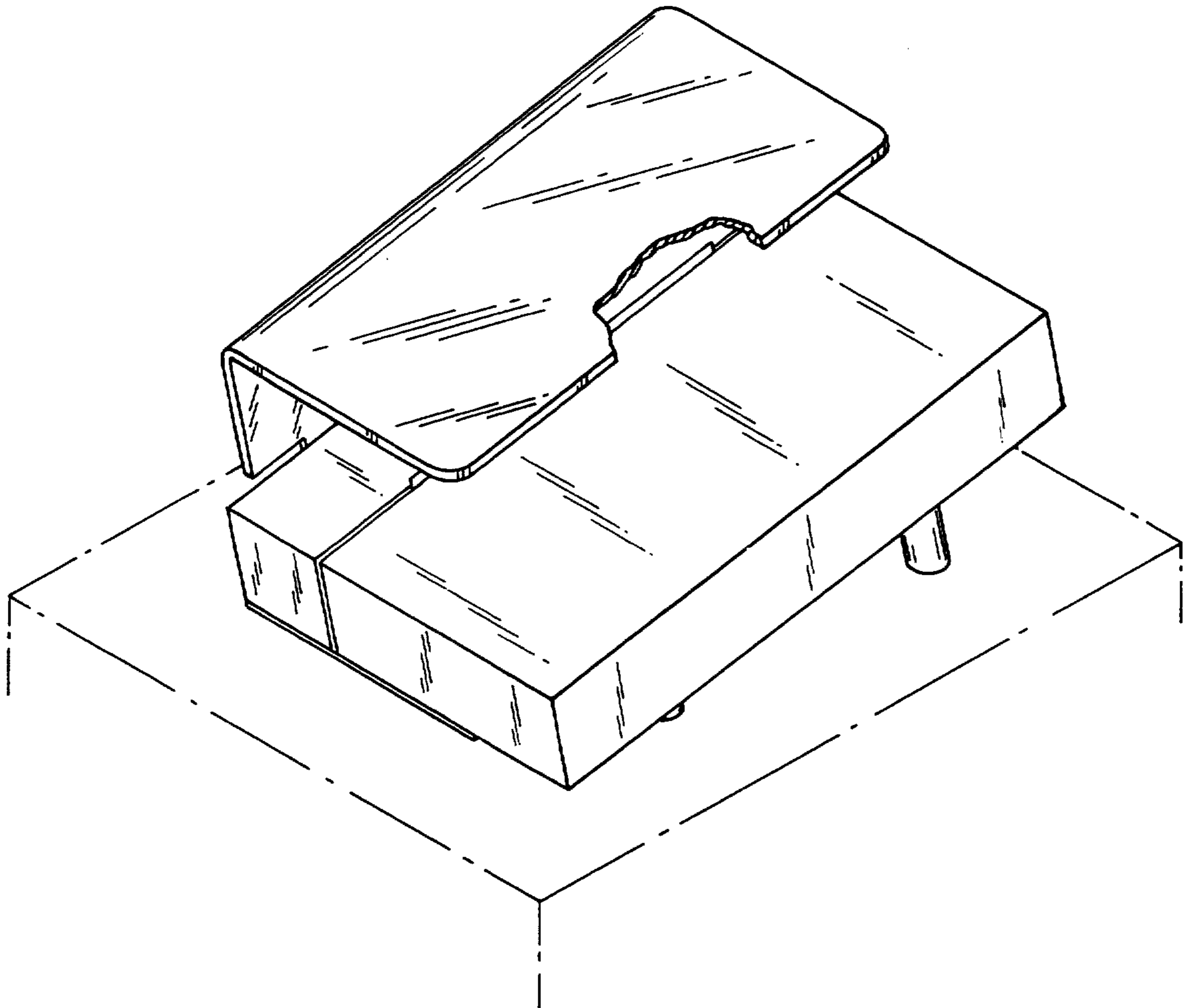
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;

The broken line showing of the table top is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



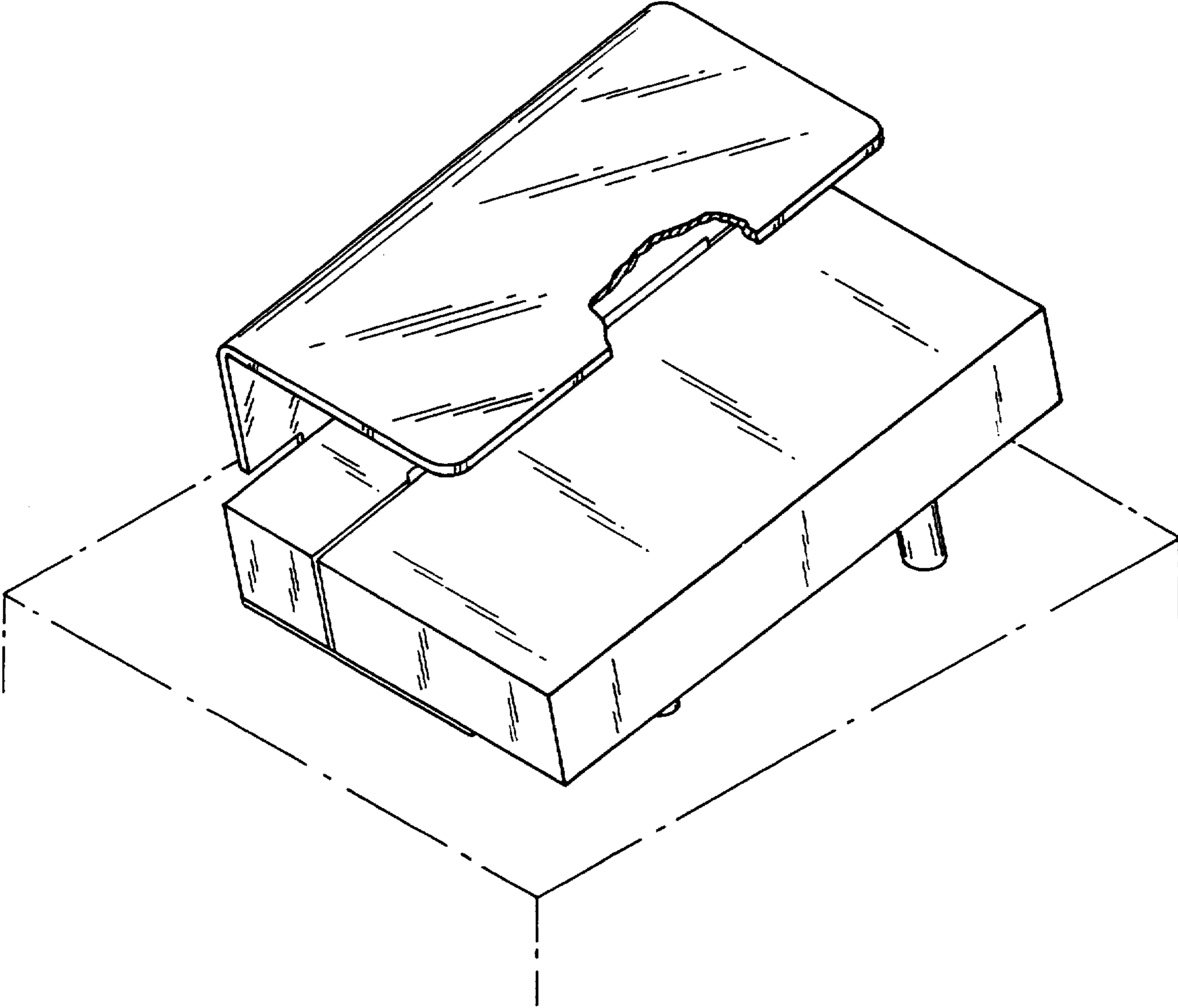

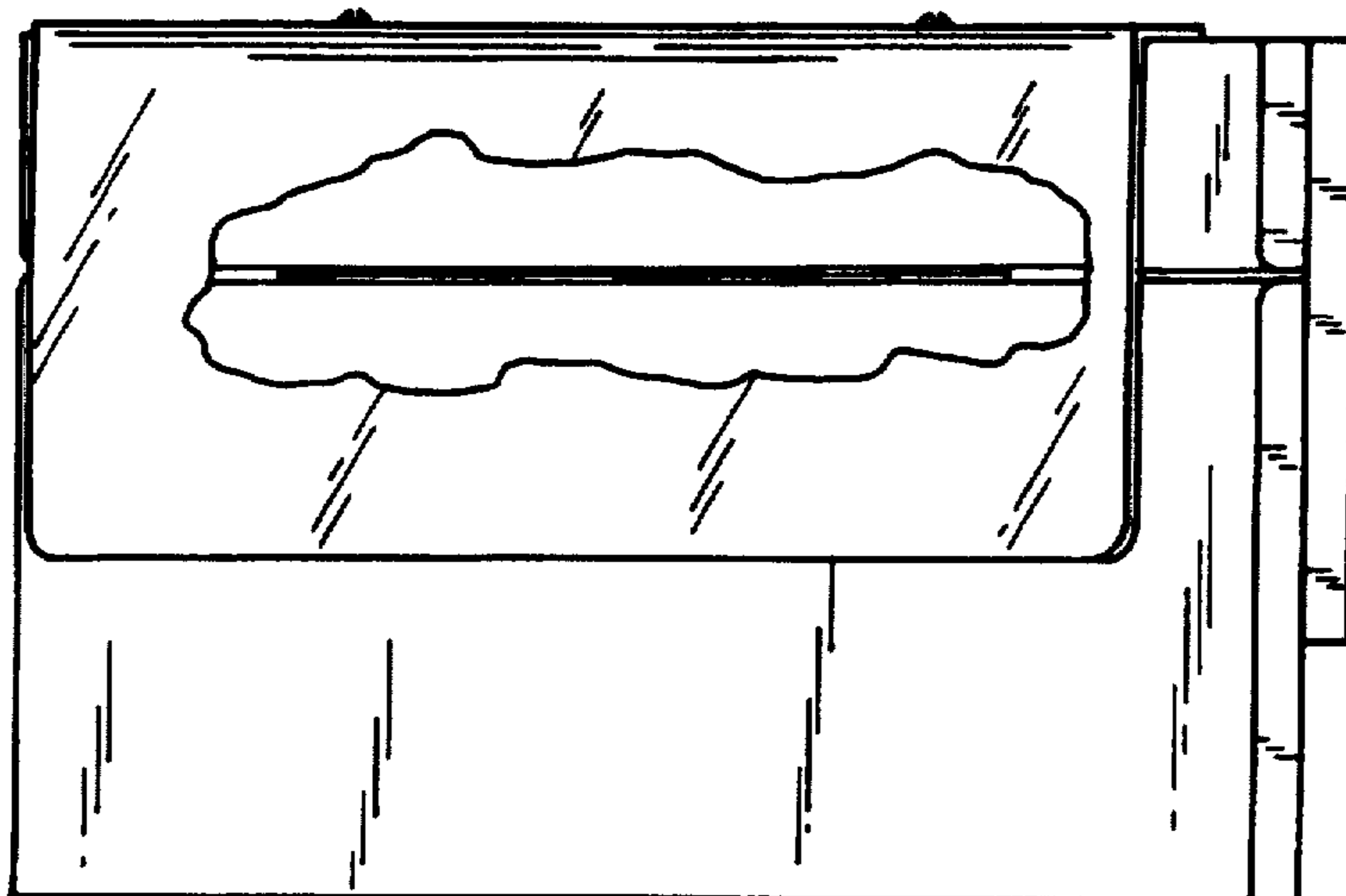

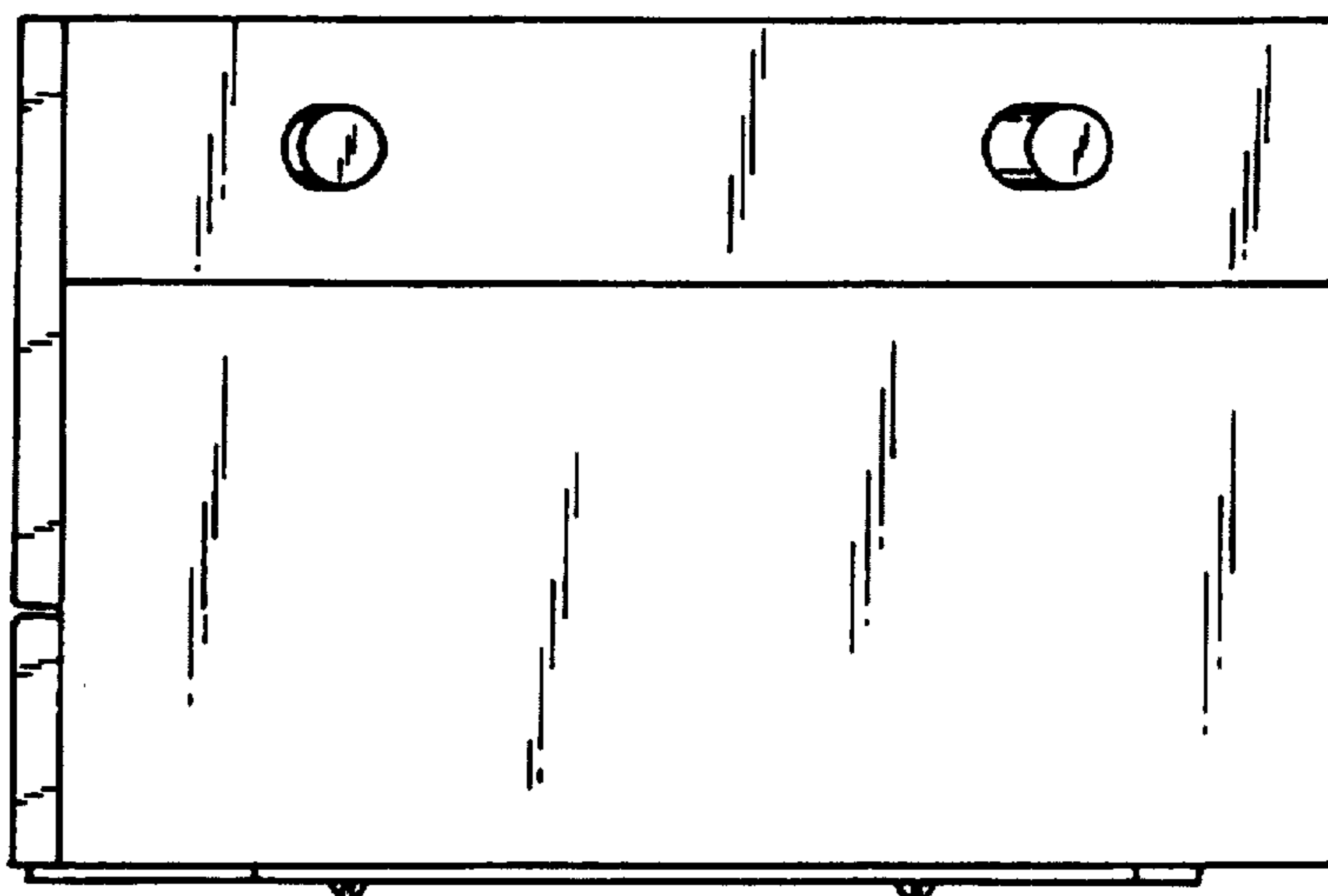

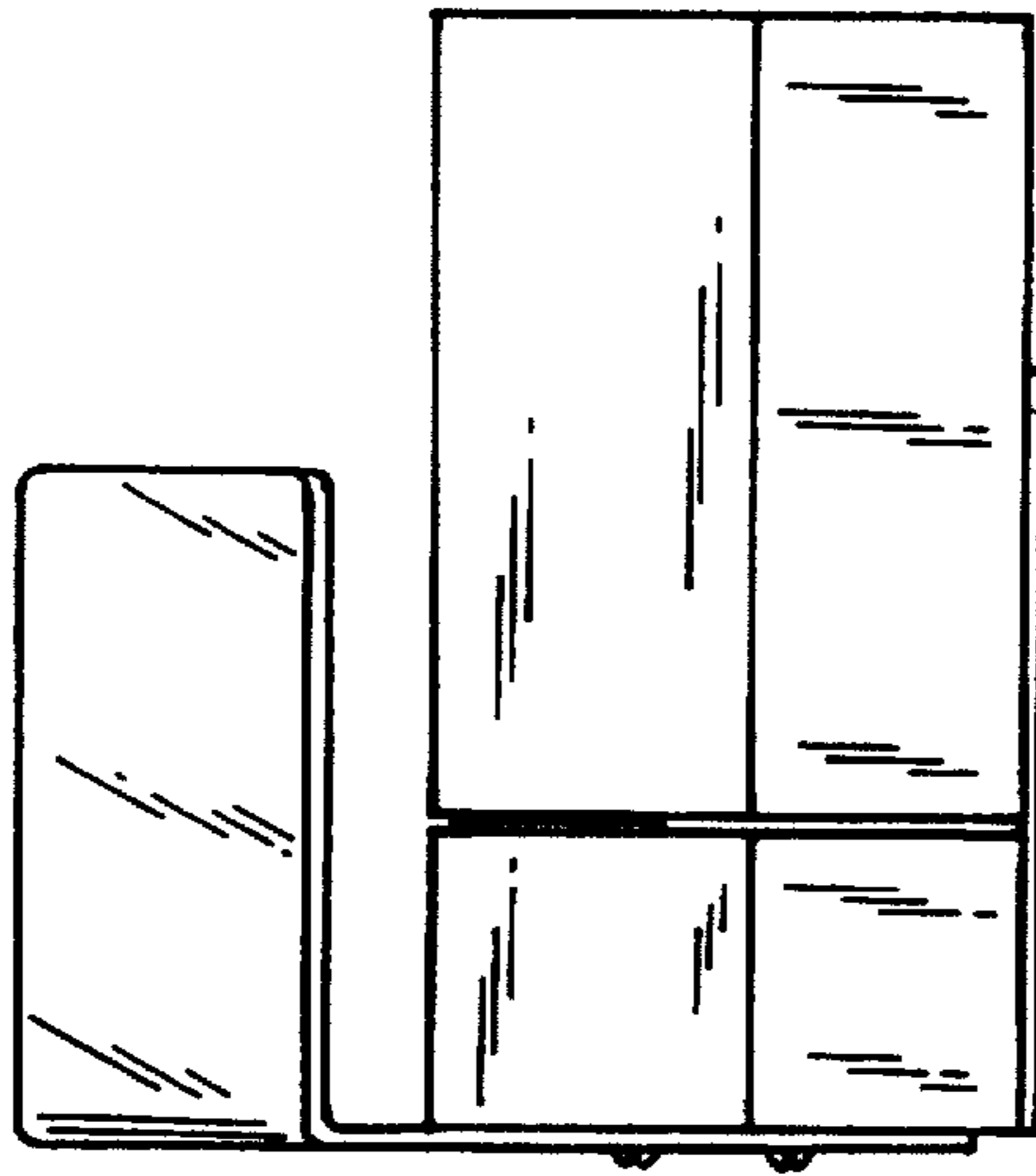

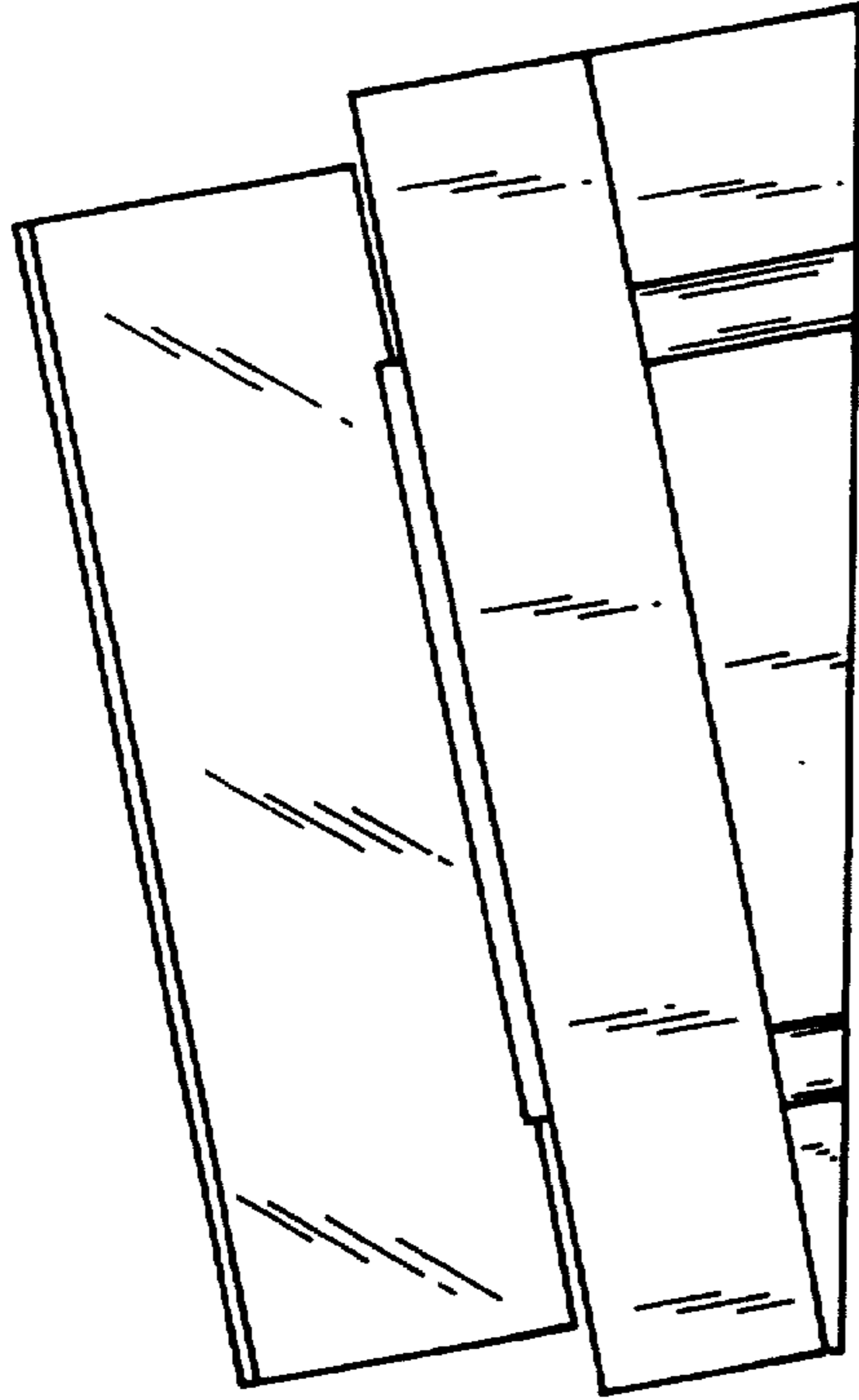

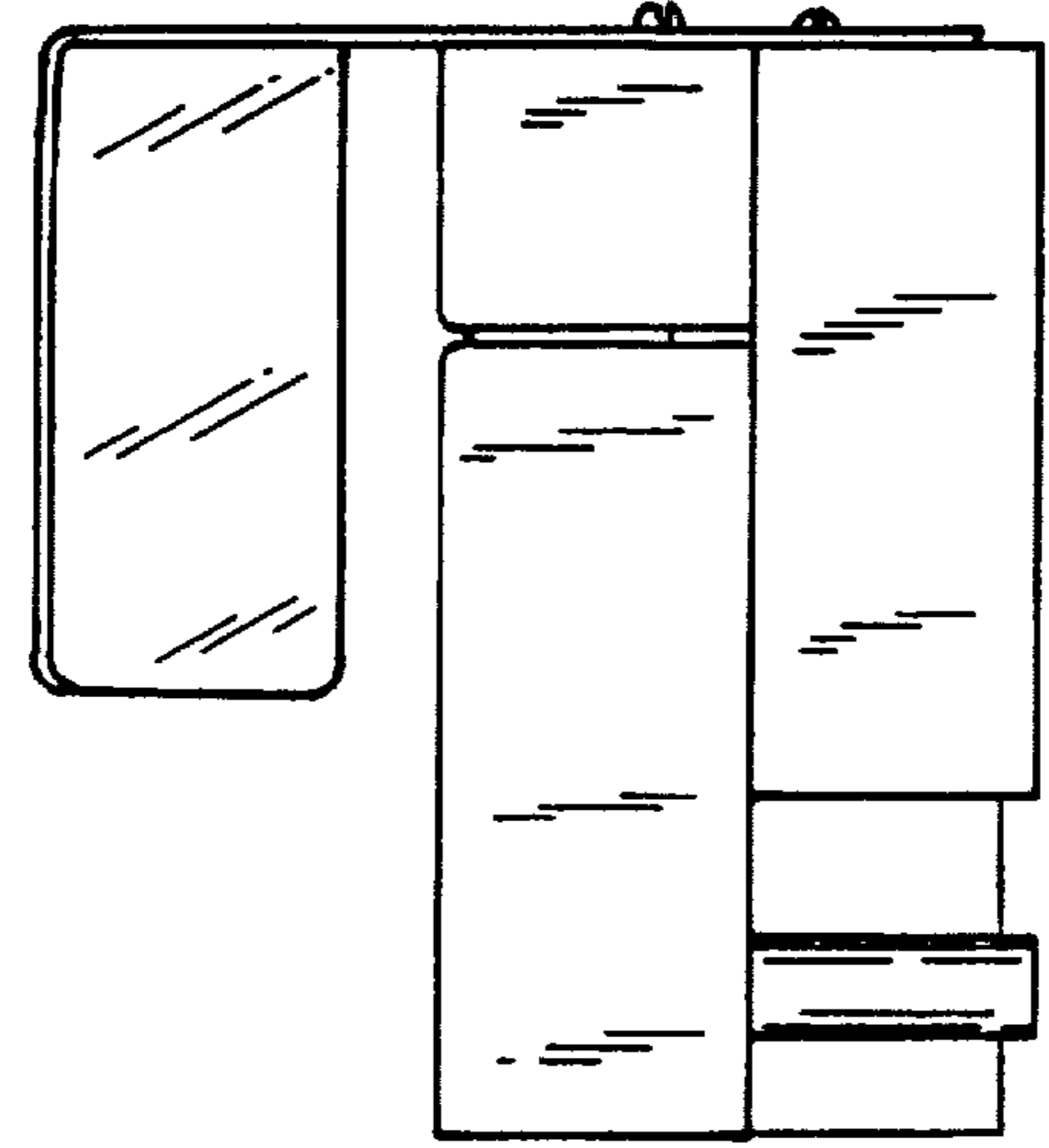

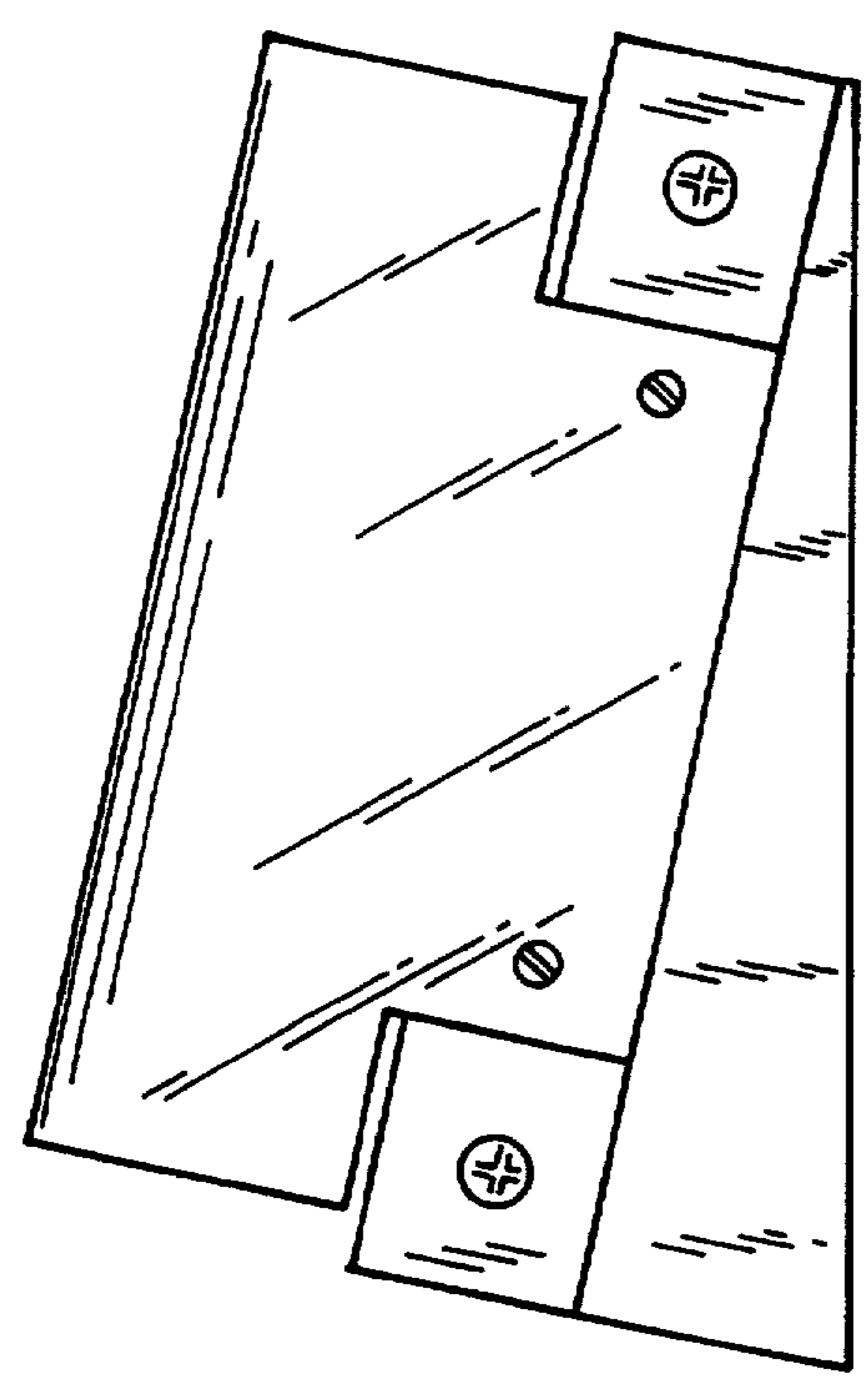
