The ornamental design for a charm, as shown and described.

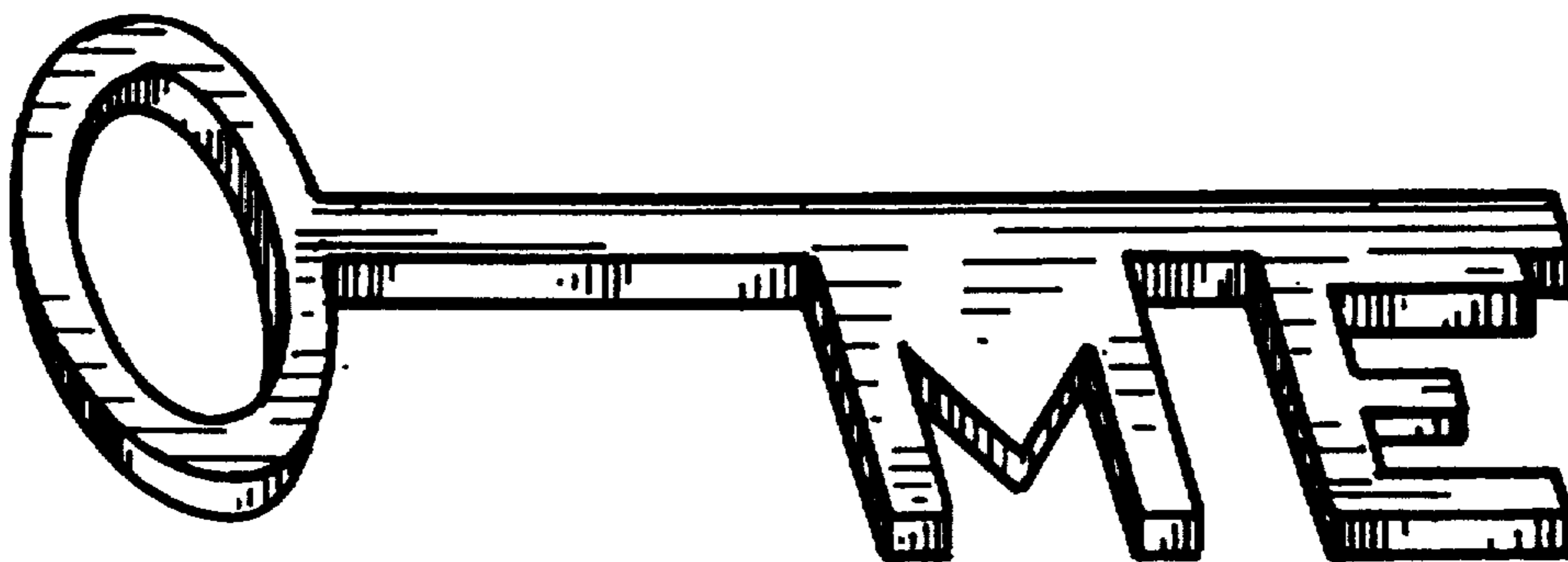
**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front plan view of the charm showing my new design, a back plan view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view; and,

The surfaces of the design not shown are plain and unornamented.



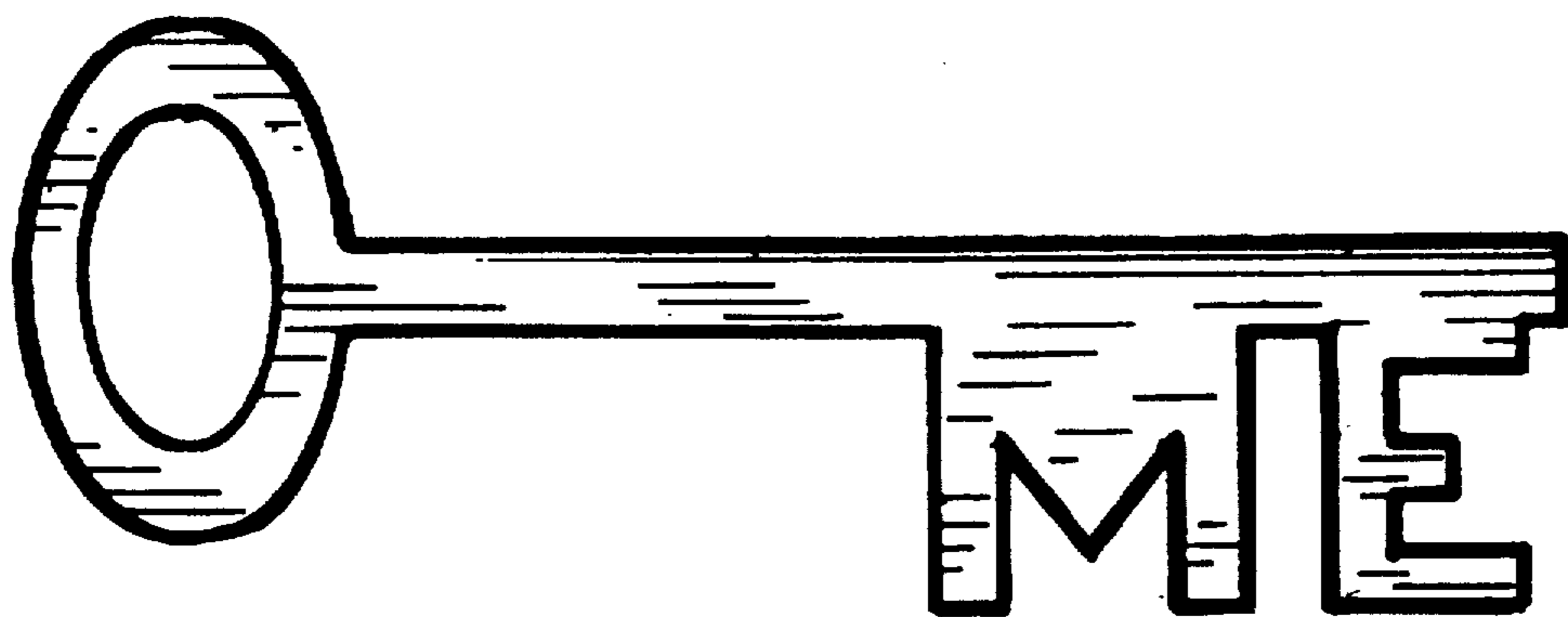

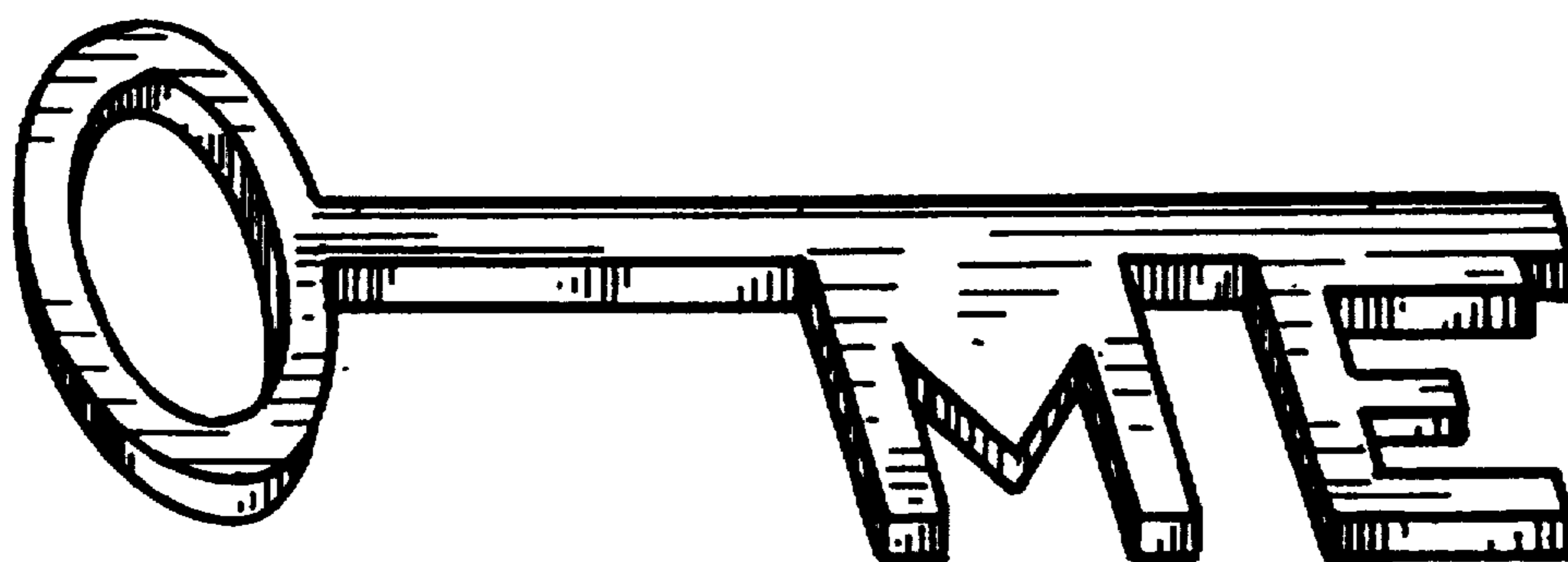
