DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and left side perspective view of a compact disc player showing my new design;

 FIG. 8 is a right side elevational view thereof.

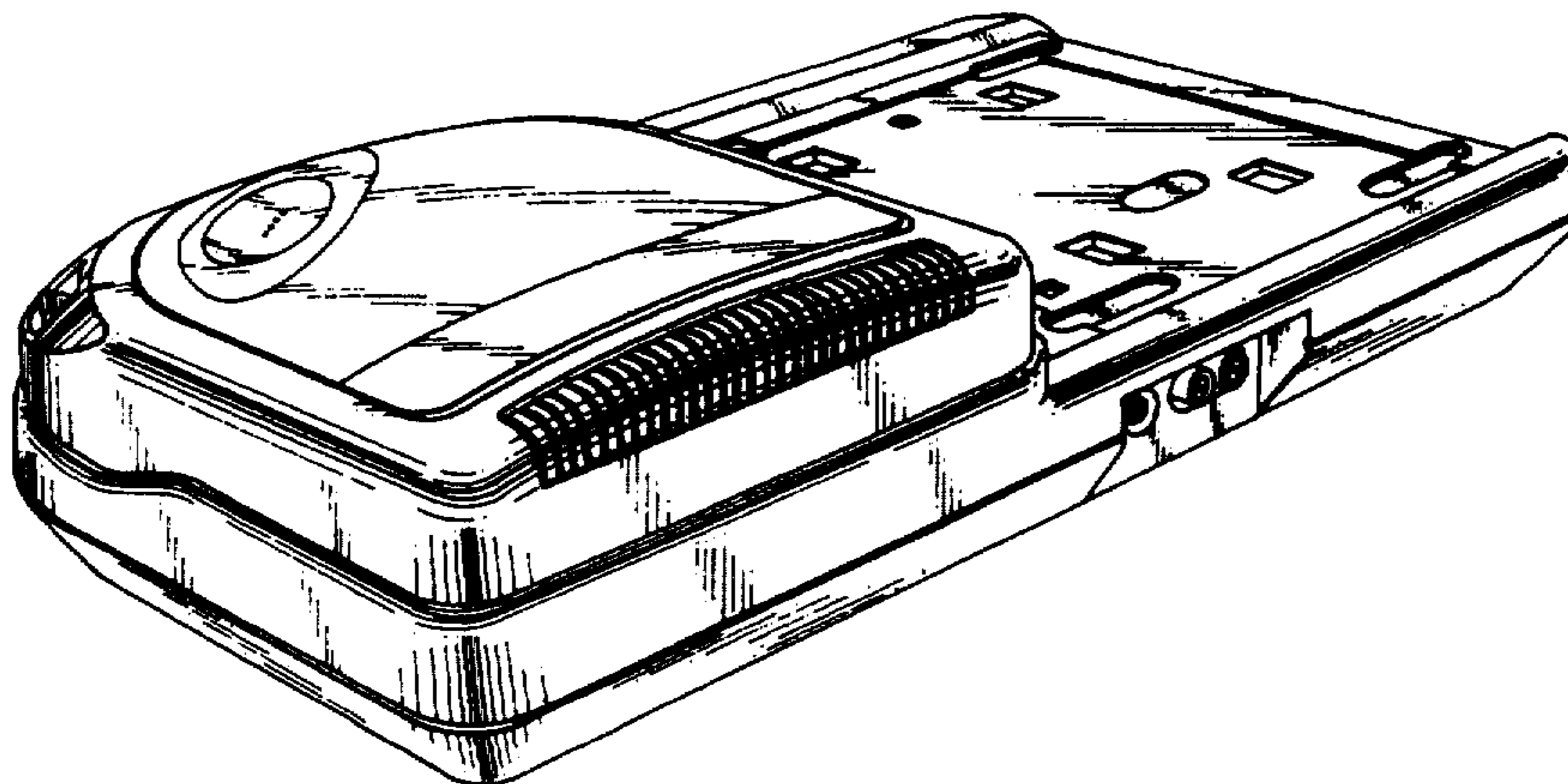
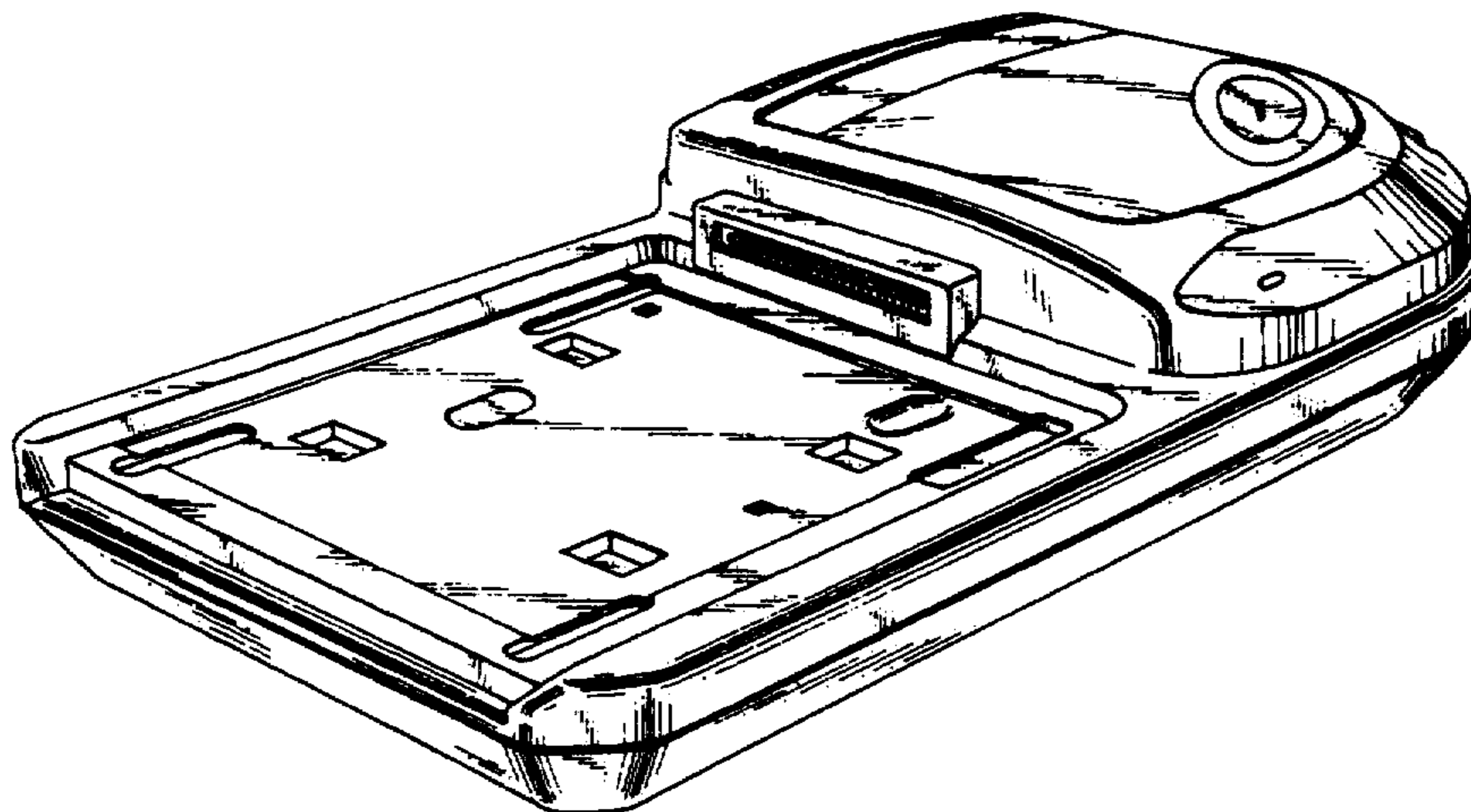

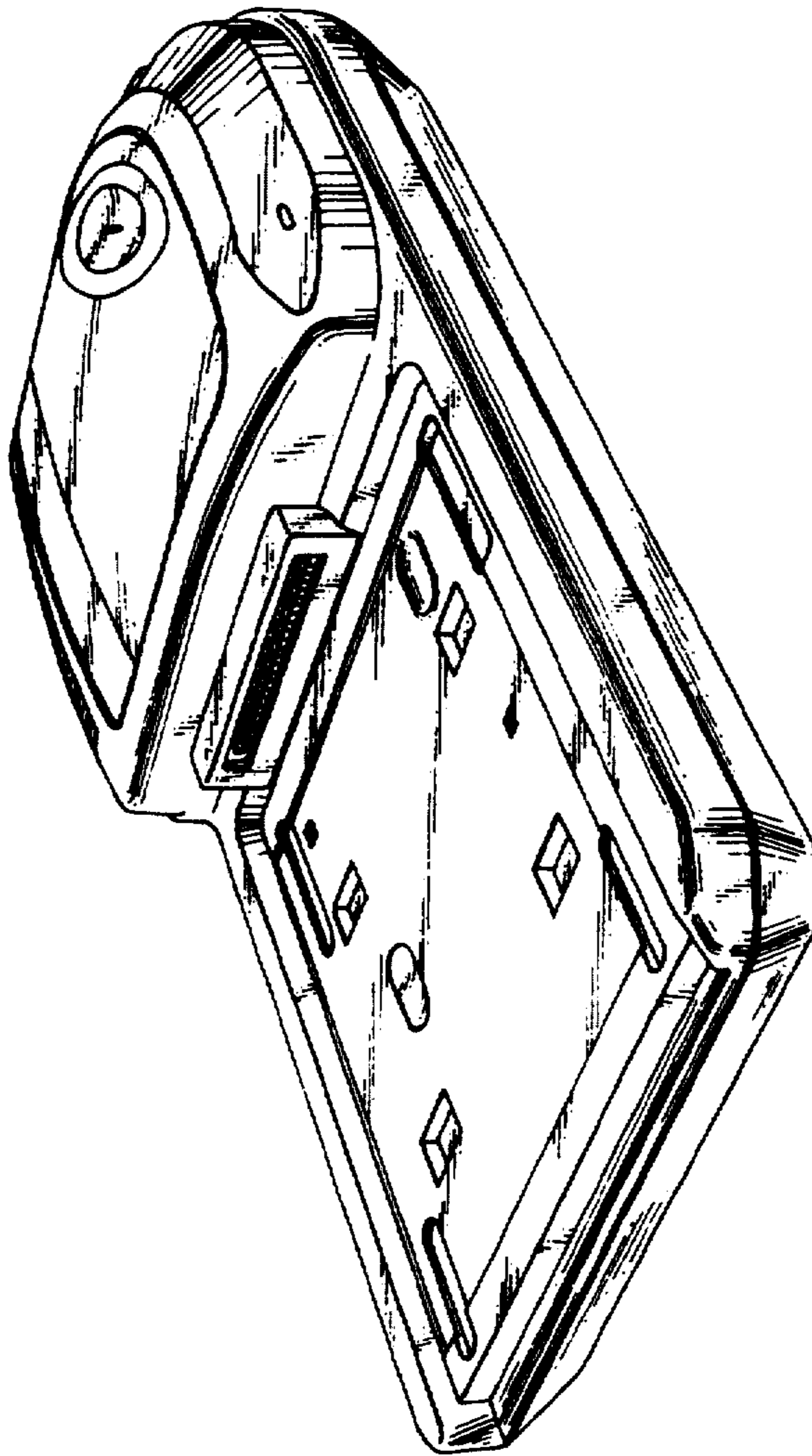

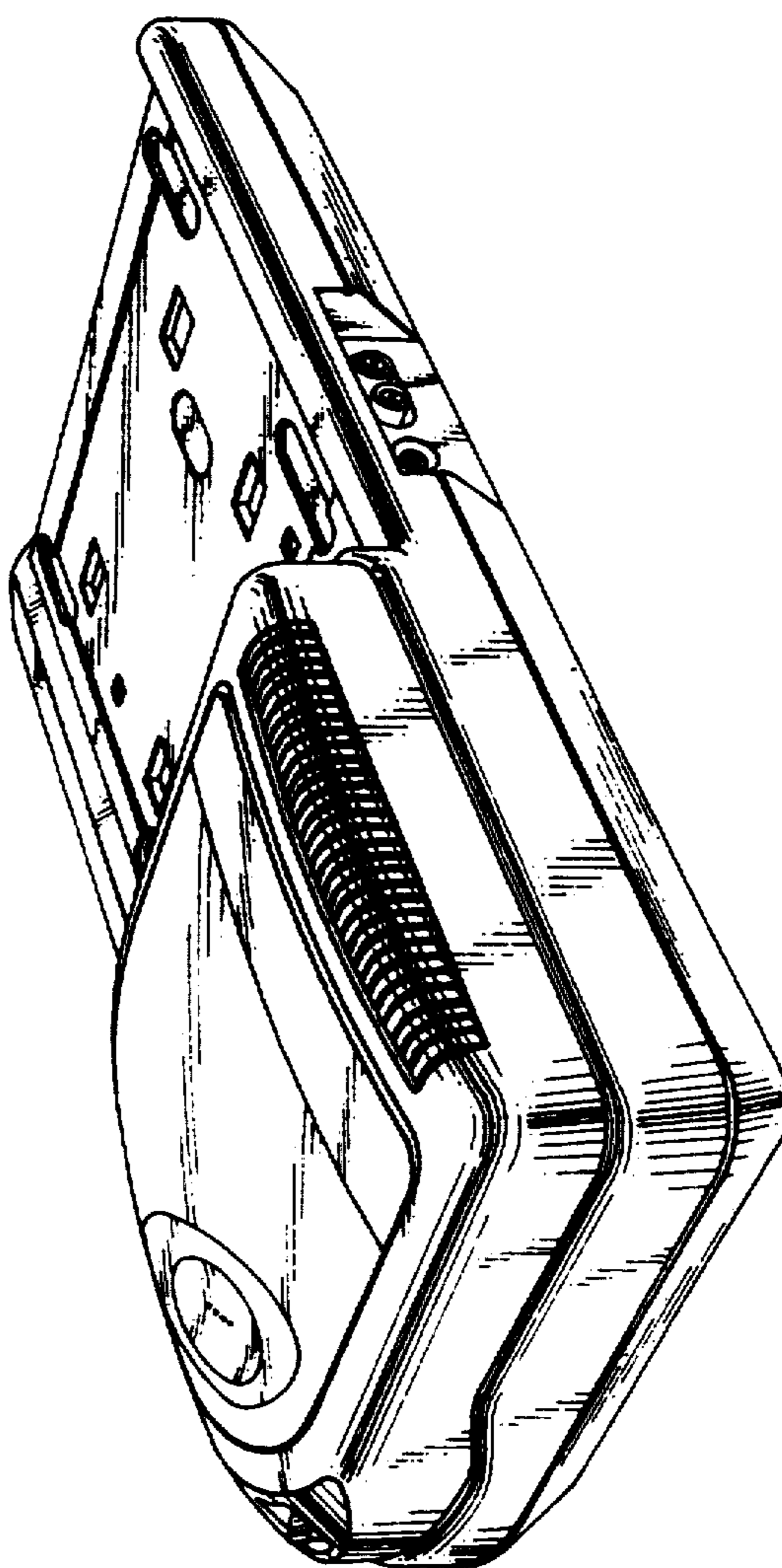

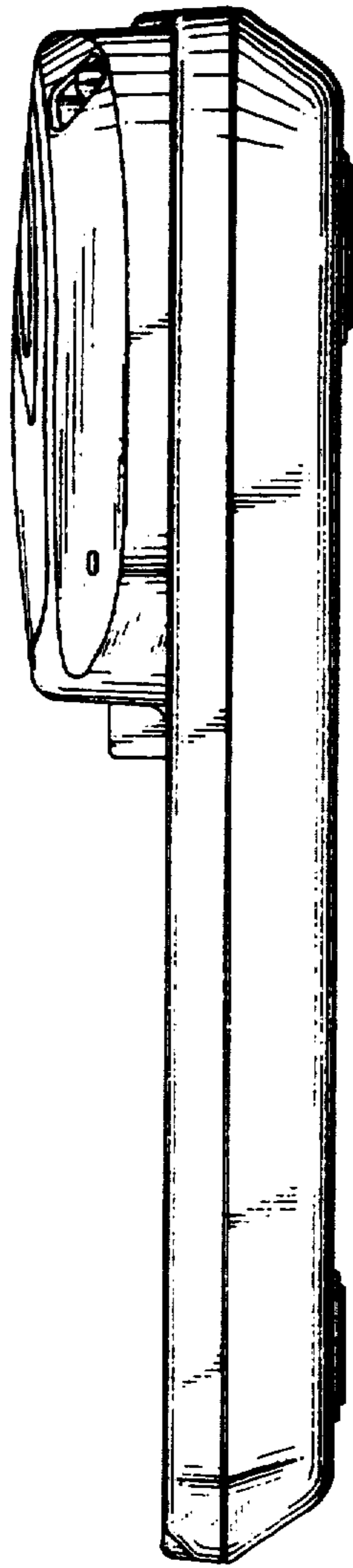

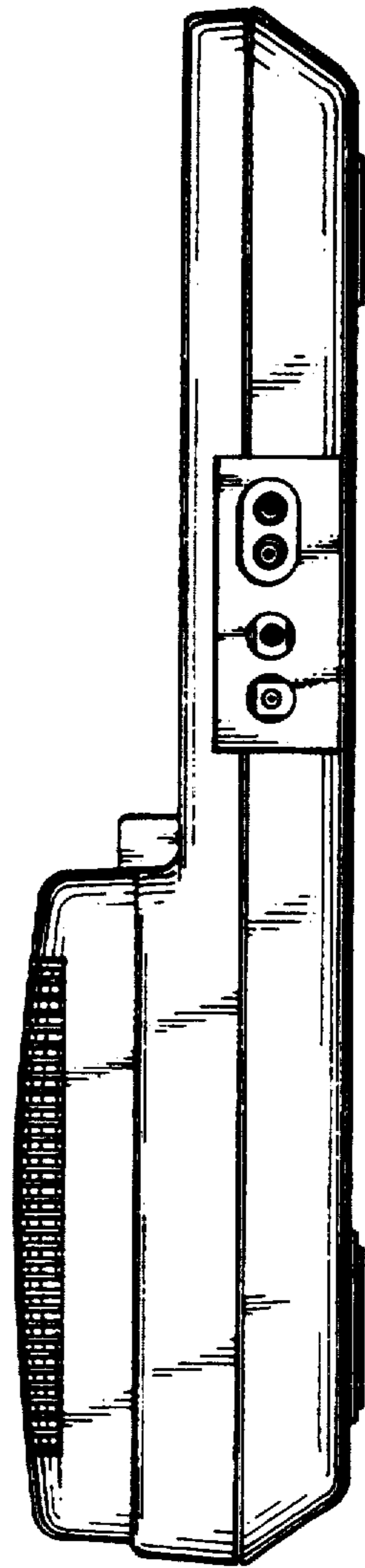

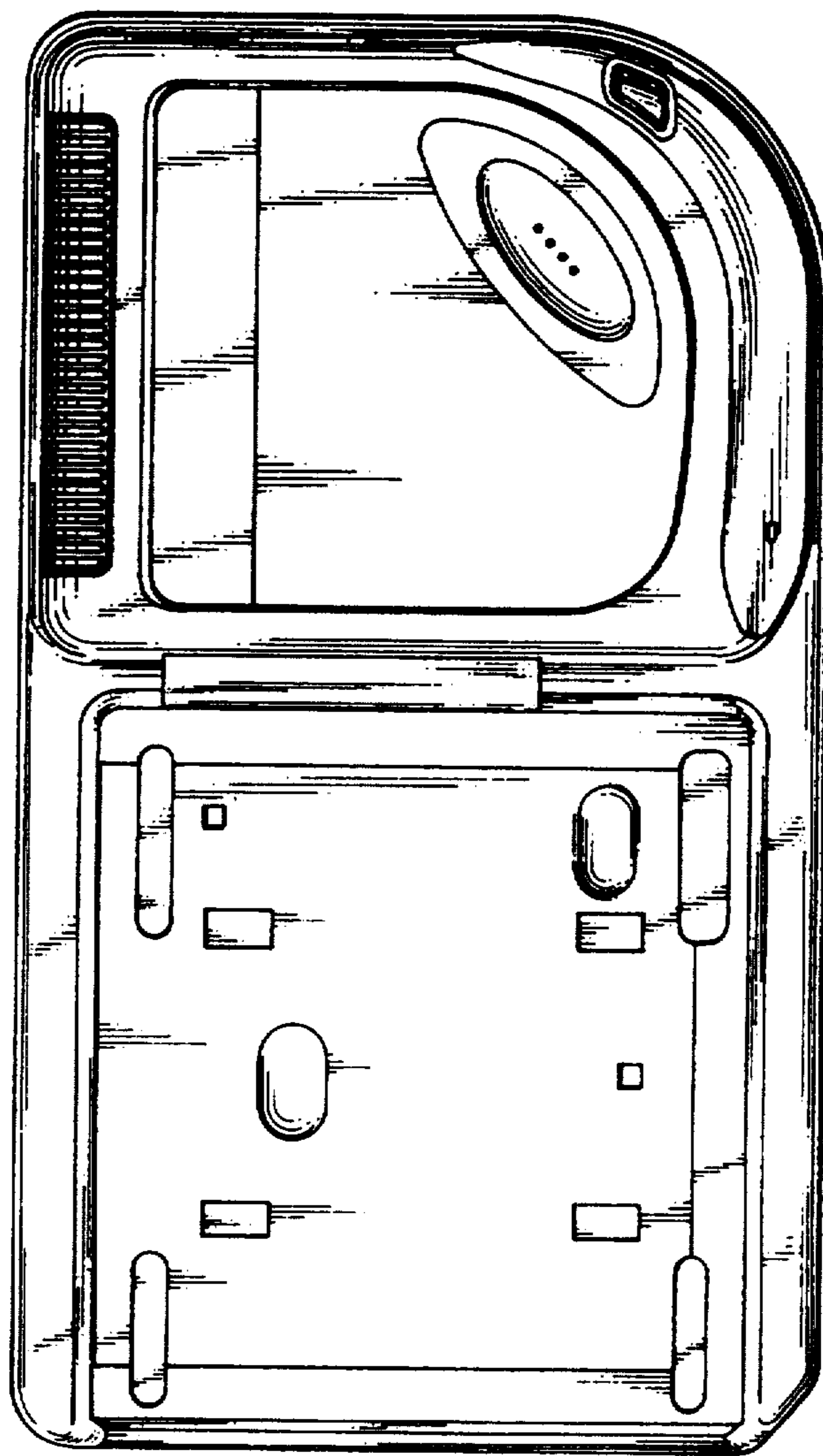

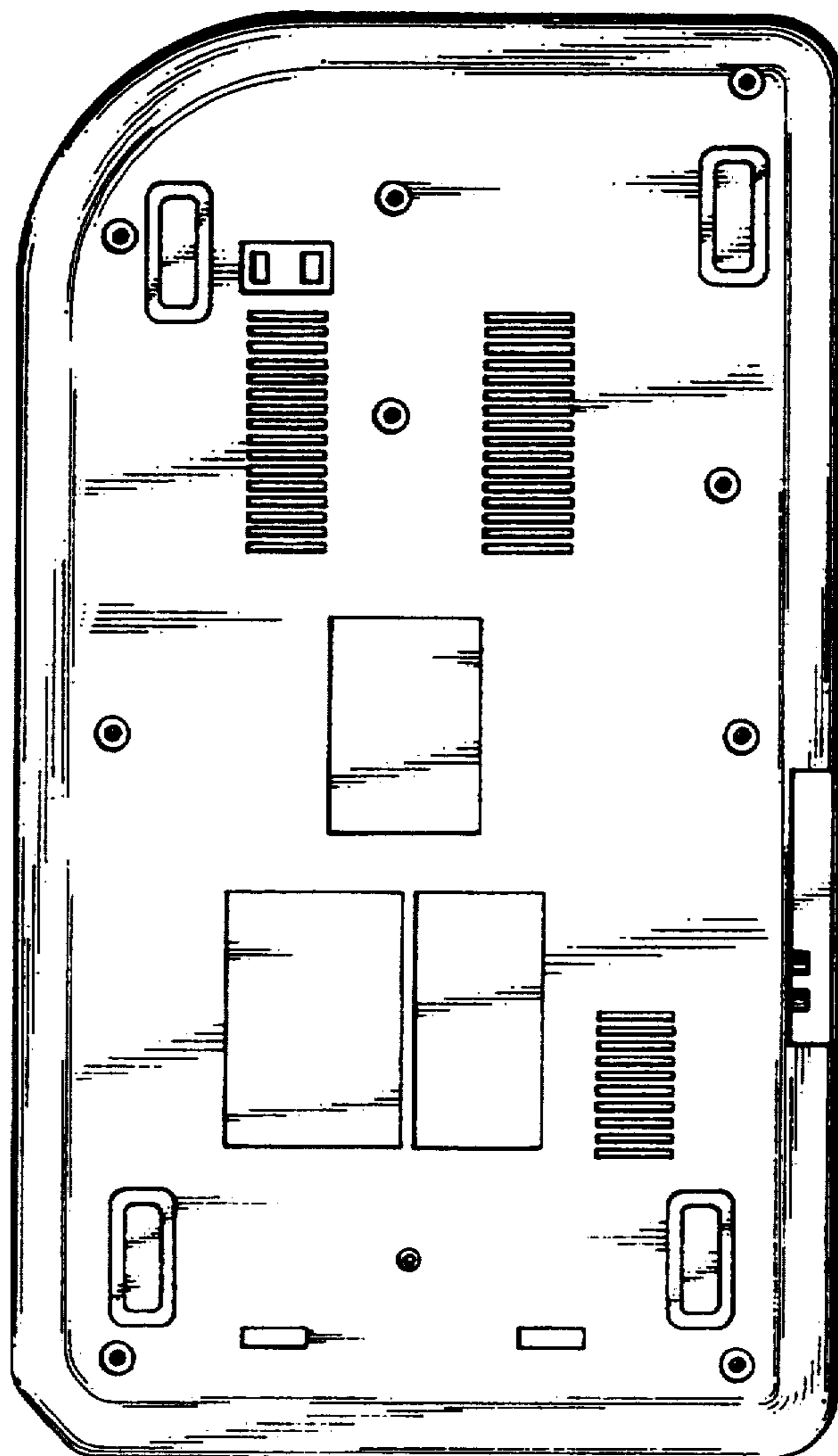

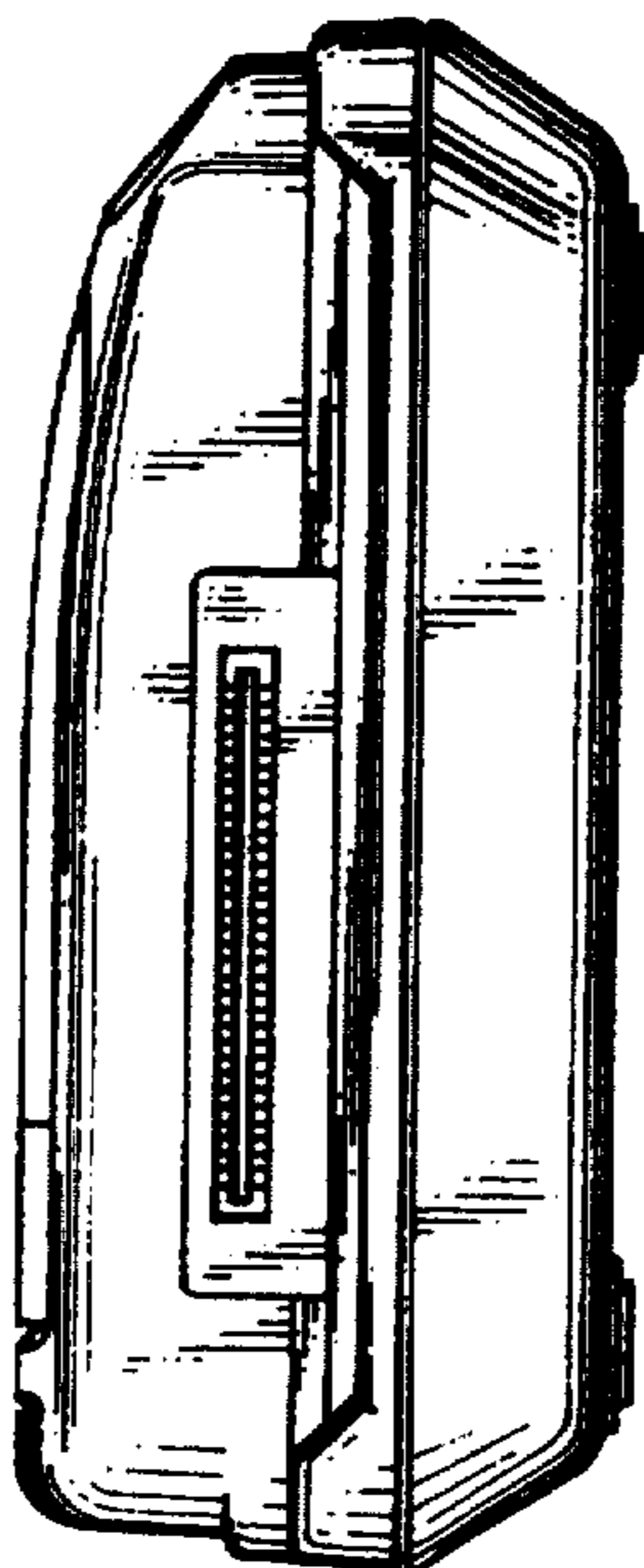
