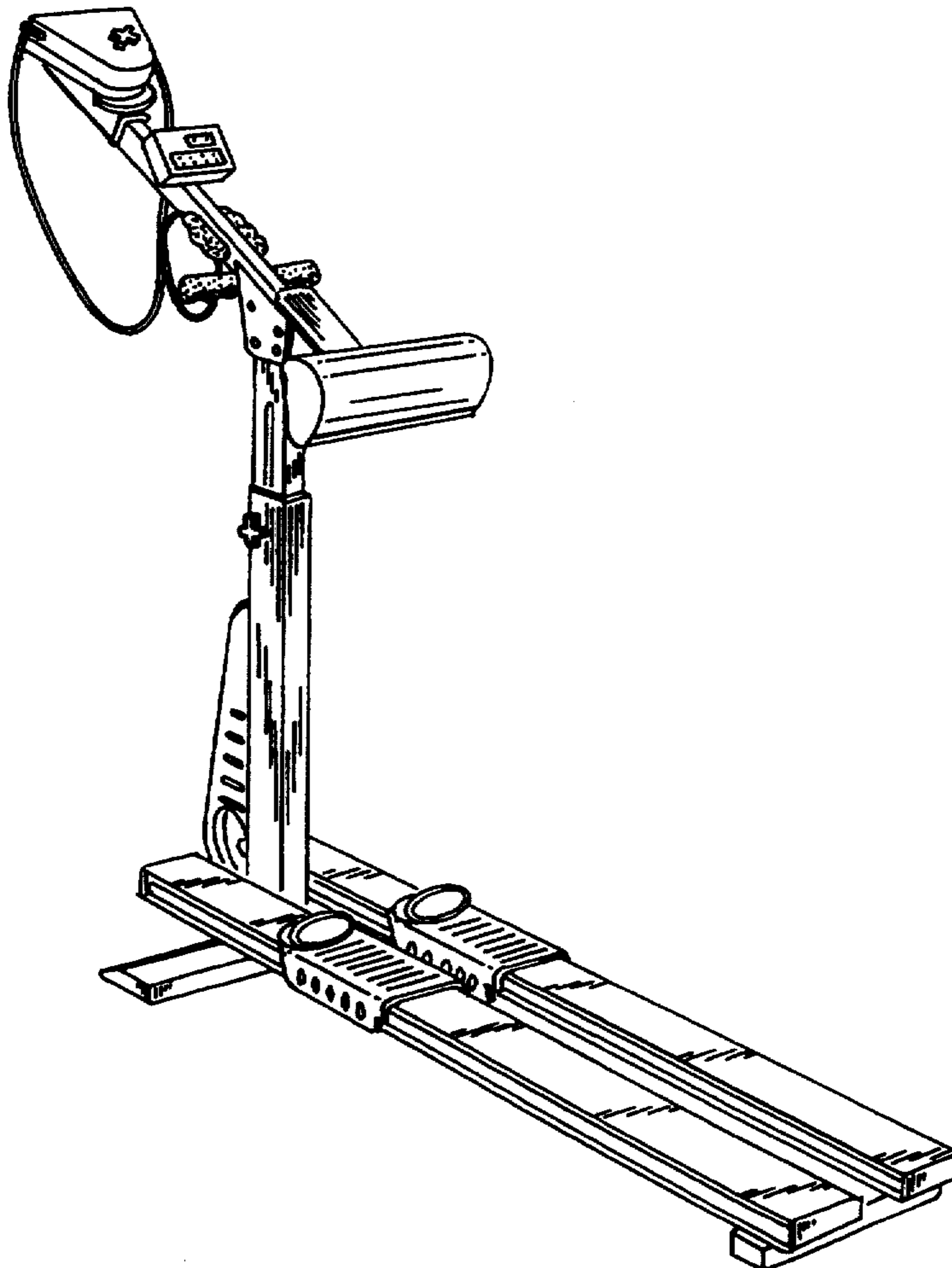

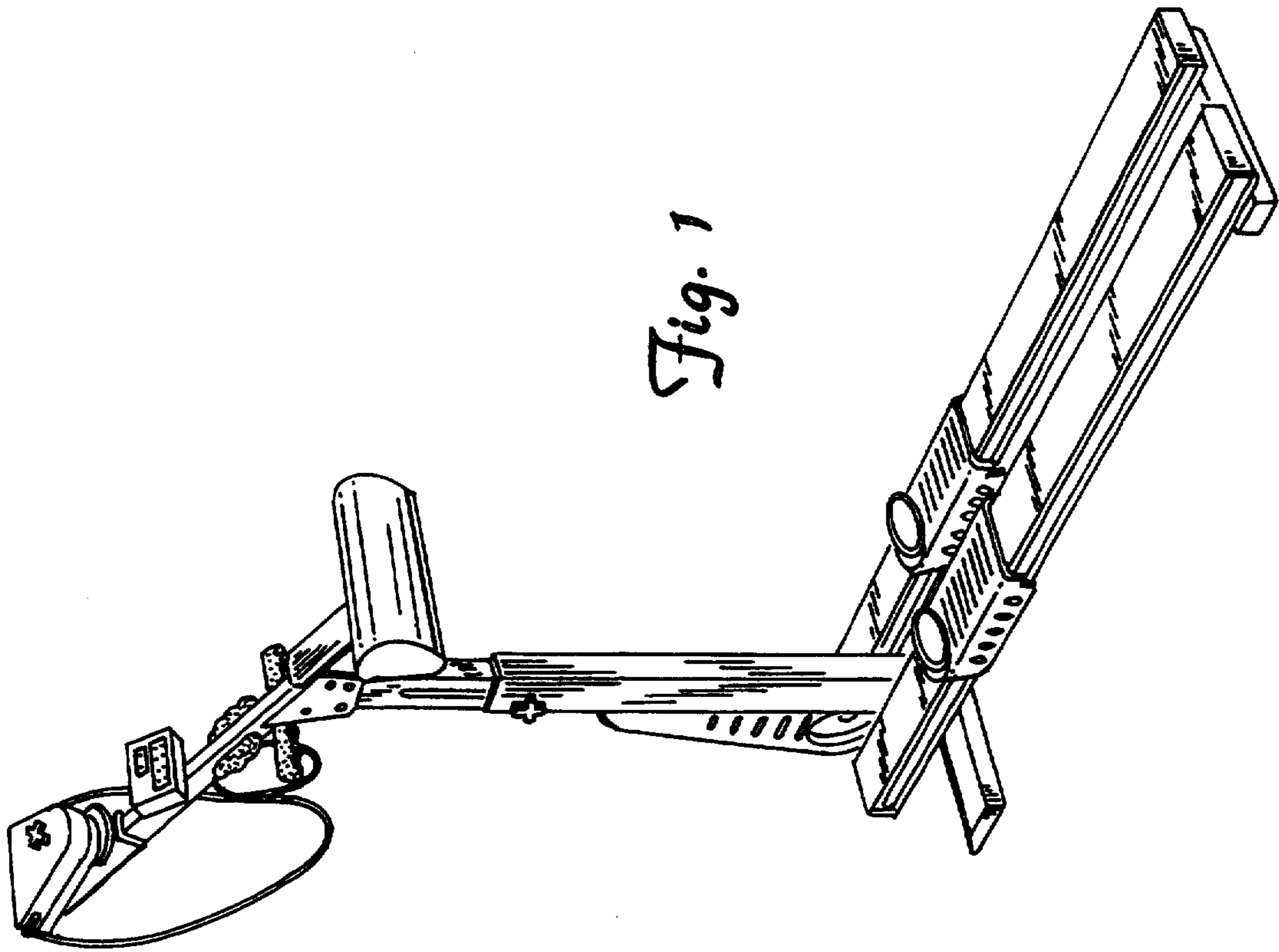
### [57] CLAIM

The ornamental design of a cross-country ski simulator exerciser, as shown and described.

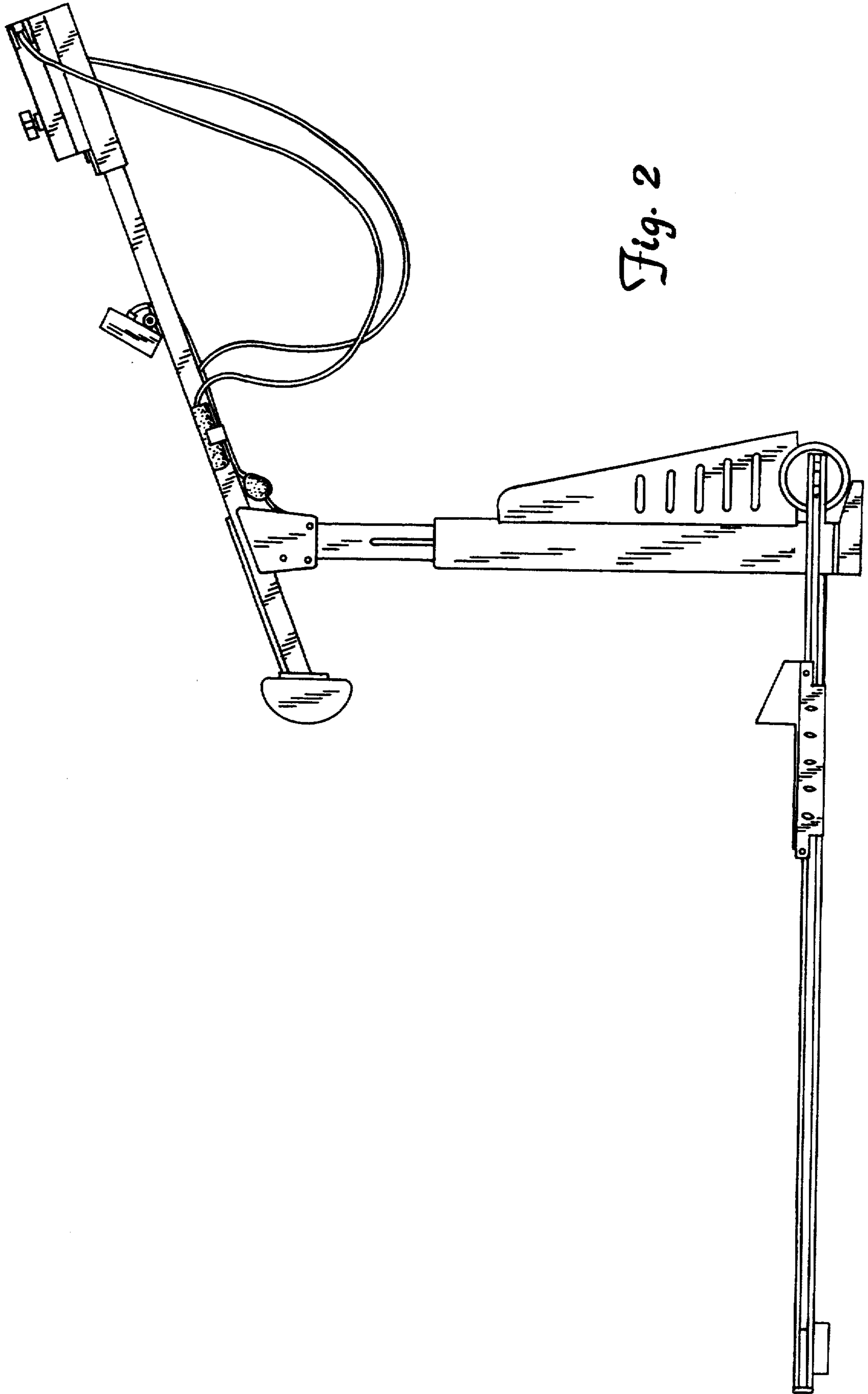
### DESCRIPTION

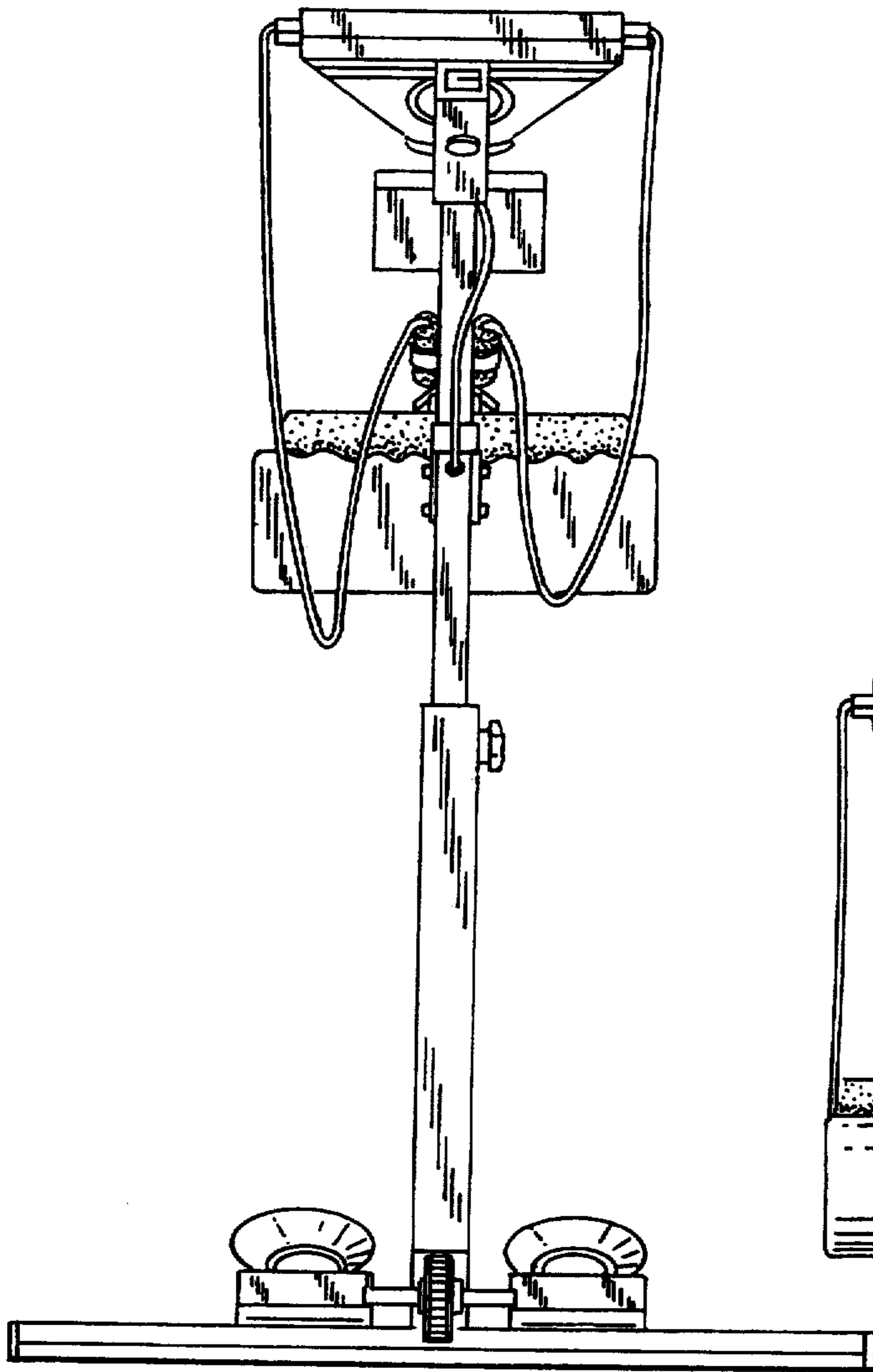




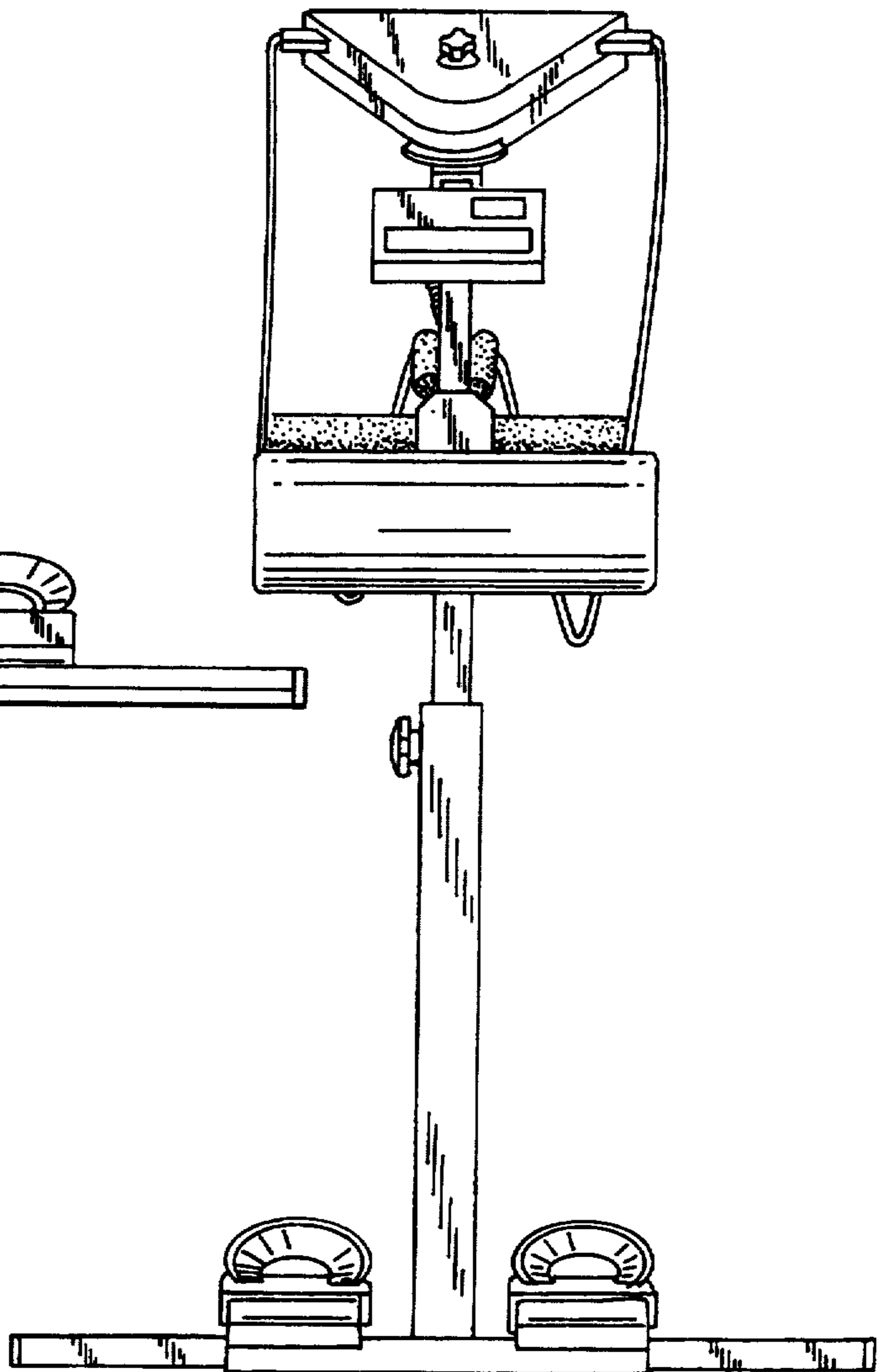
