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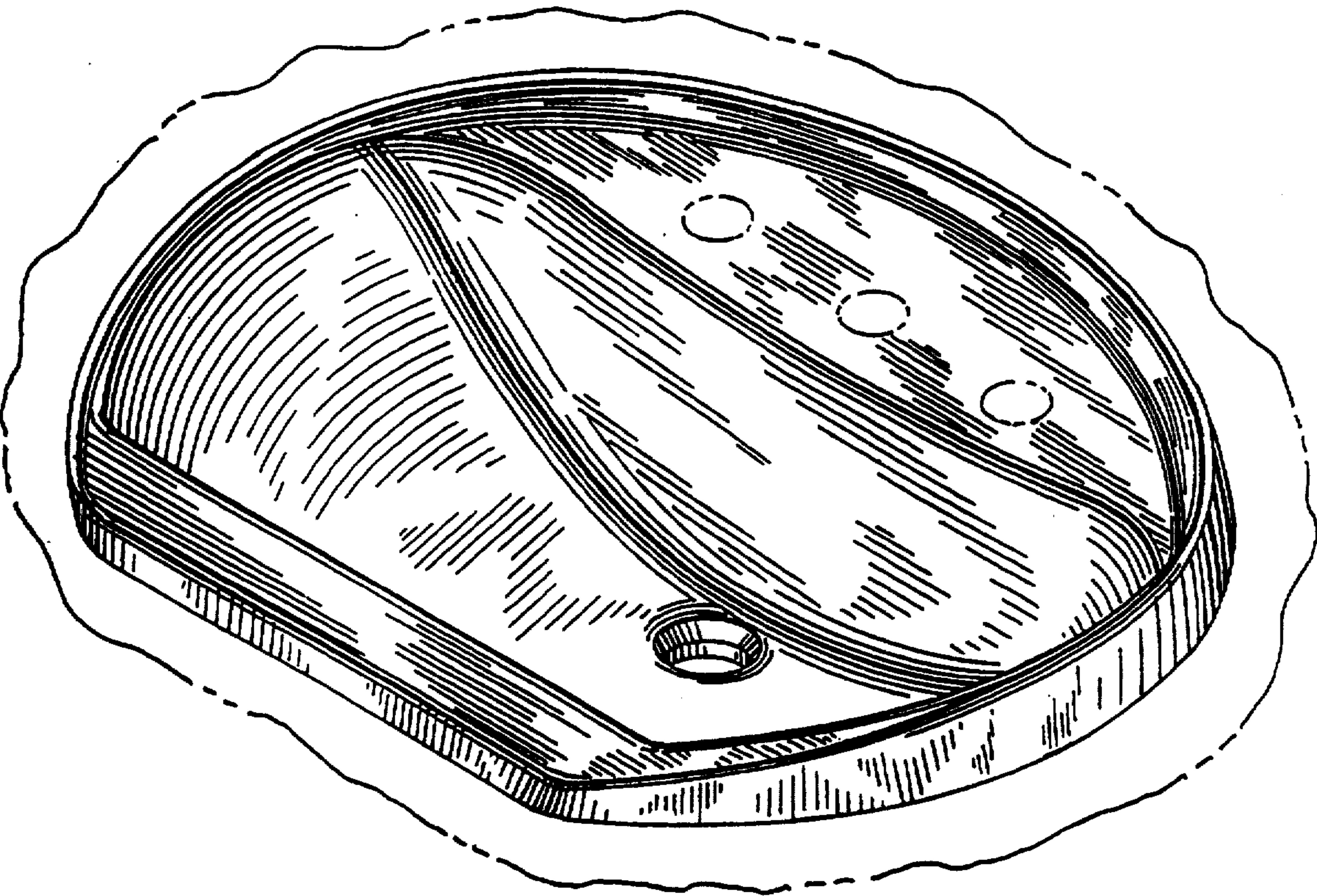

The ornamental design for a lavatory, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view taken from the top, front and right side of a lavatory embodying our new design; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a cross-sectional view taken on line 3—3 of FIG. 2; and, FIG. 4 is a cross-sectional view taken on line 4—4 of FIG. 2.
The fragmentary broken line representation of a counter top in FIG. 1 and the broken line representations of mounting holes in FIGS. 1 and 2 are for purposes of illustration only and form no part of the claimed design.



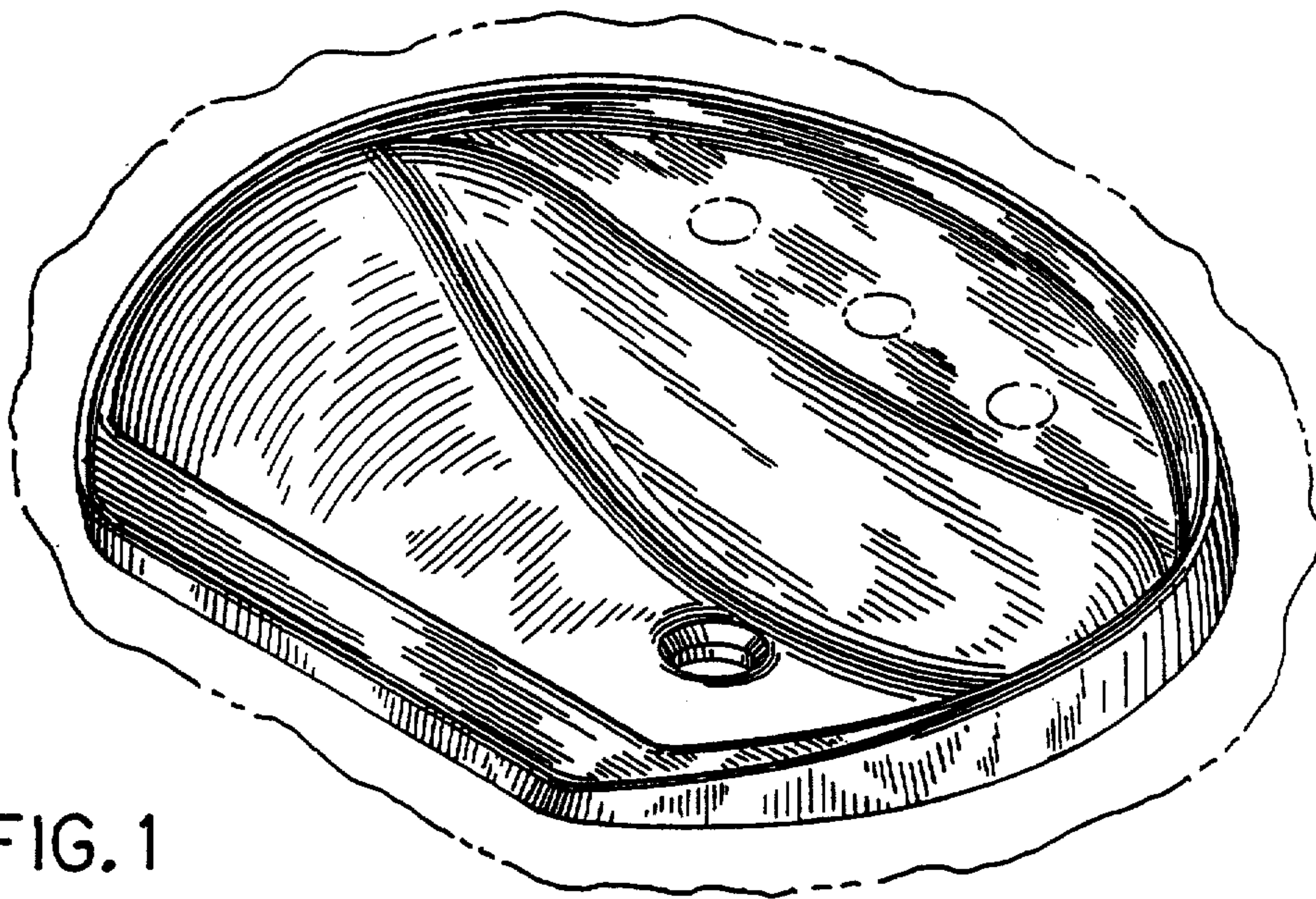

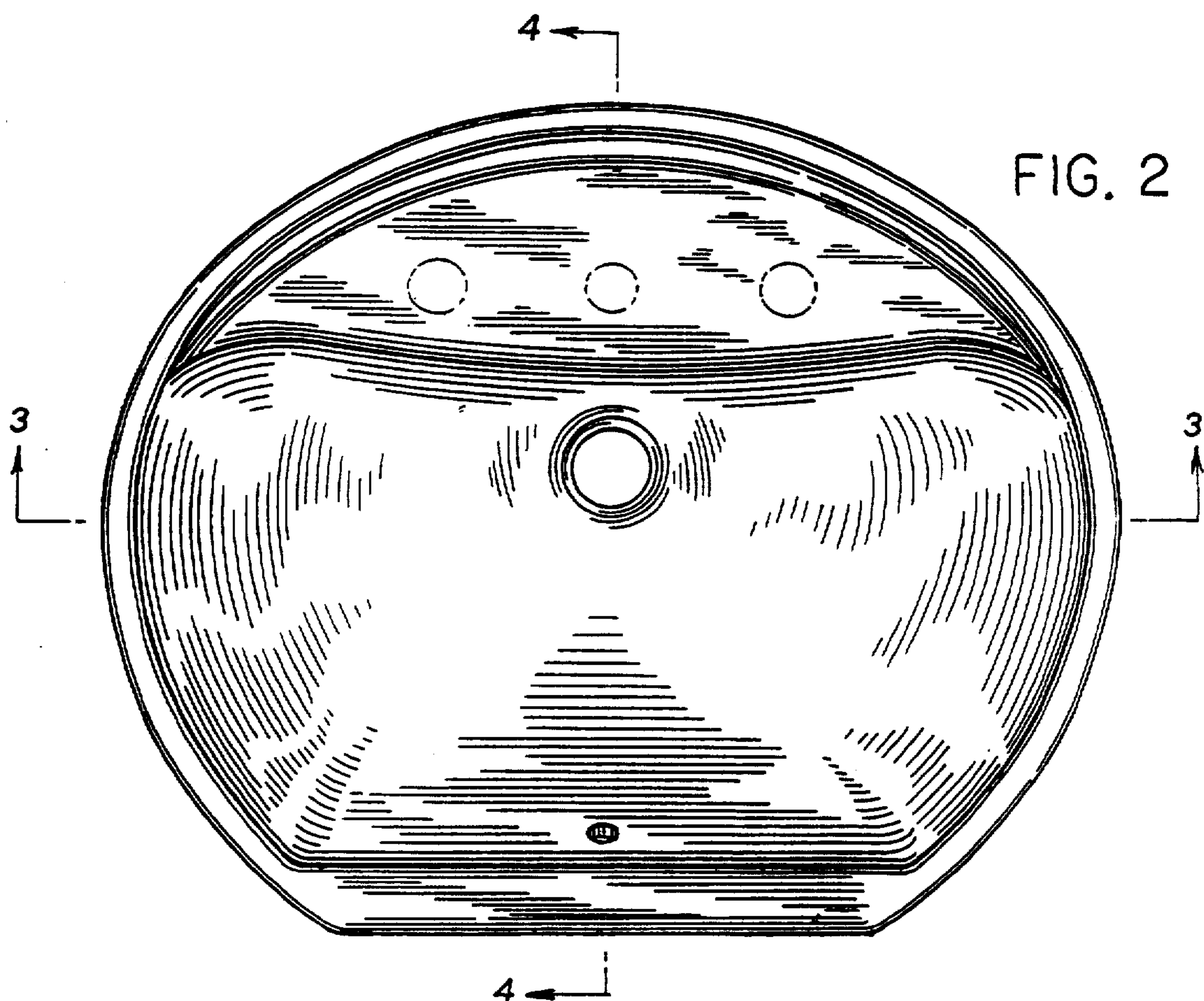

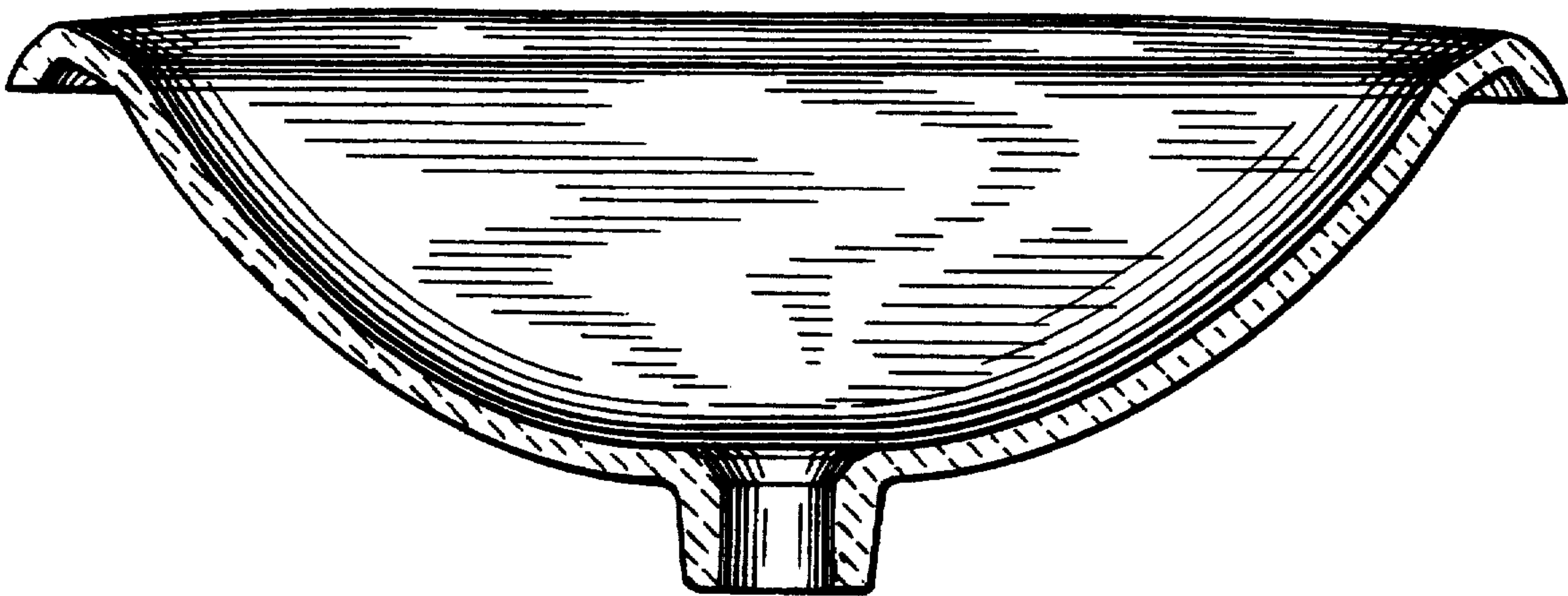

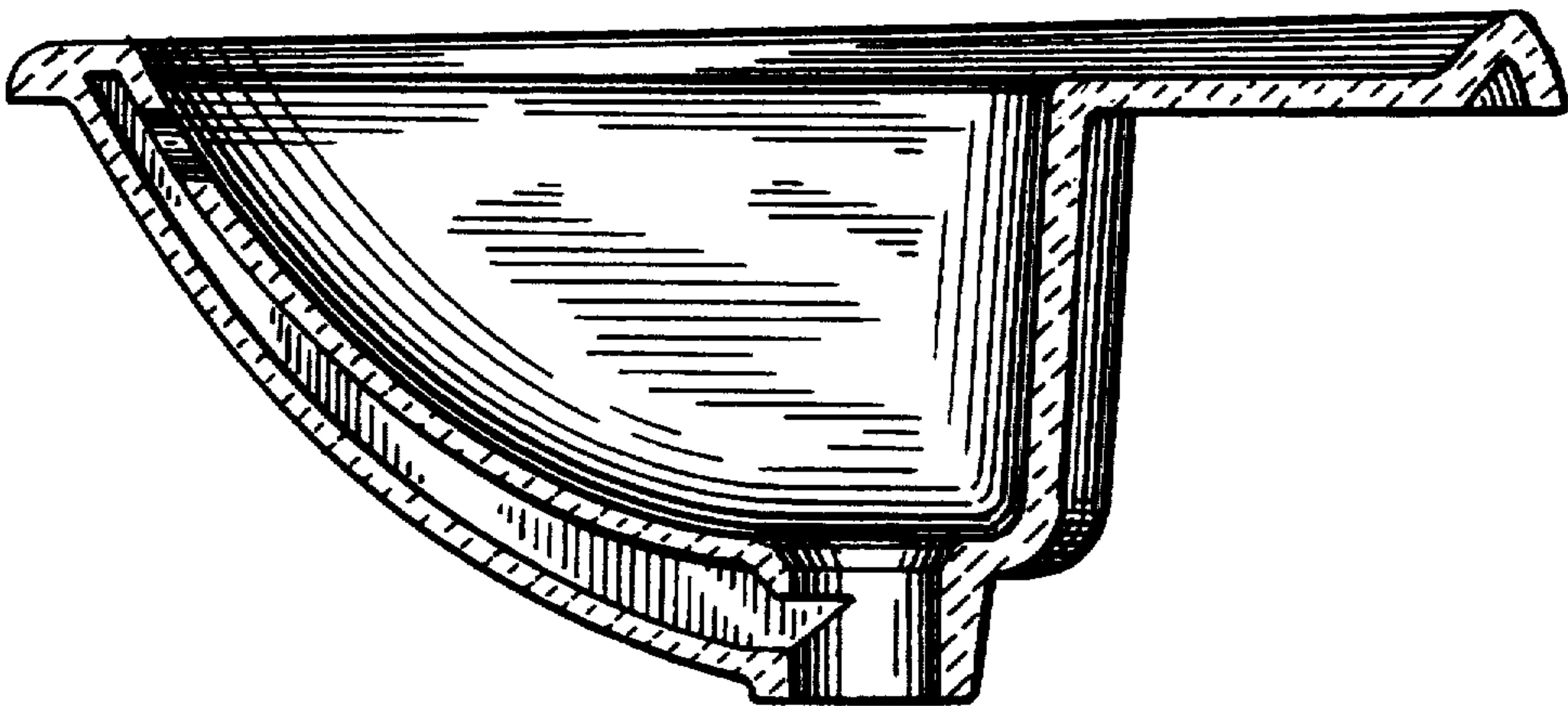
