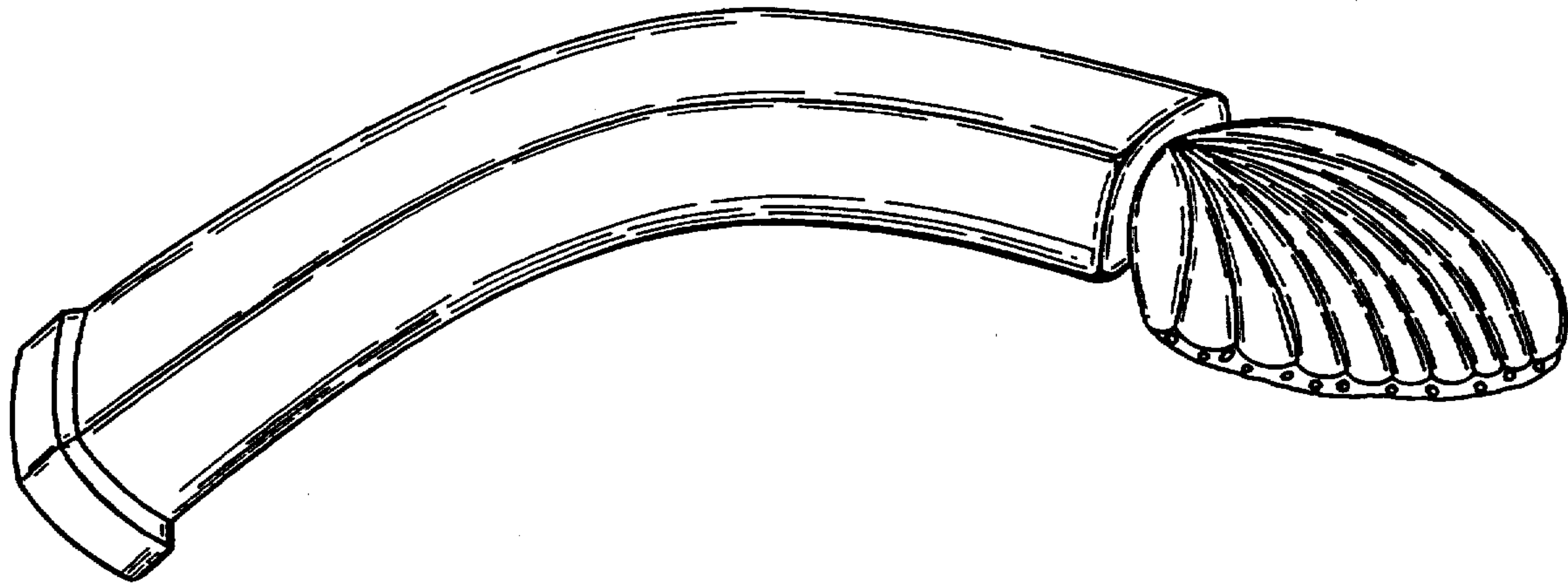

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a liquid and lotion applicator showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is an enlarged bottom view of the applicator portion, shown fragmentarily for ease of illustration;
FIG. 3 is an enlarged fragmentary view of the handle end;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view shown partially broken away for ease of illustration;
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view; and,
FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view shown partially broken away for ease of illustration, the side opposite being a mirror image of the side shown.



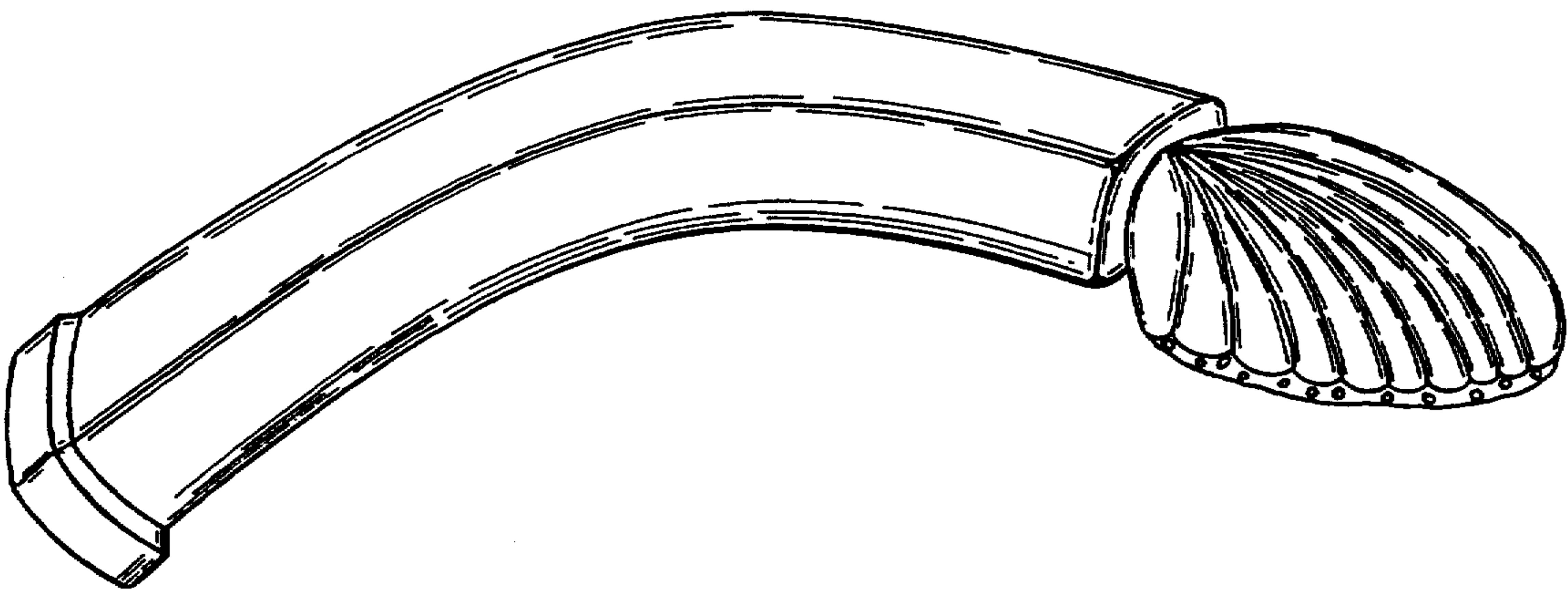

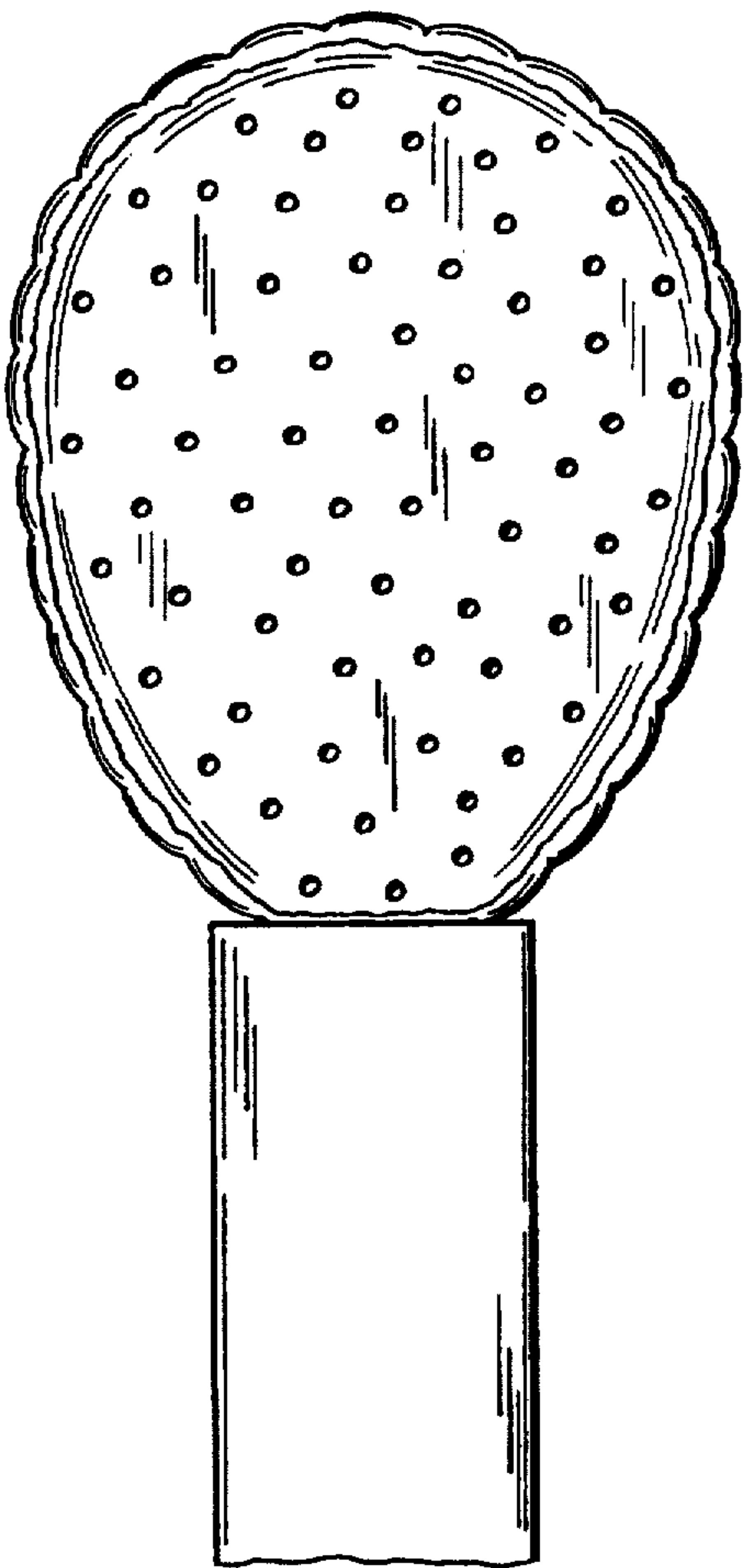

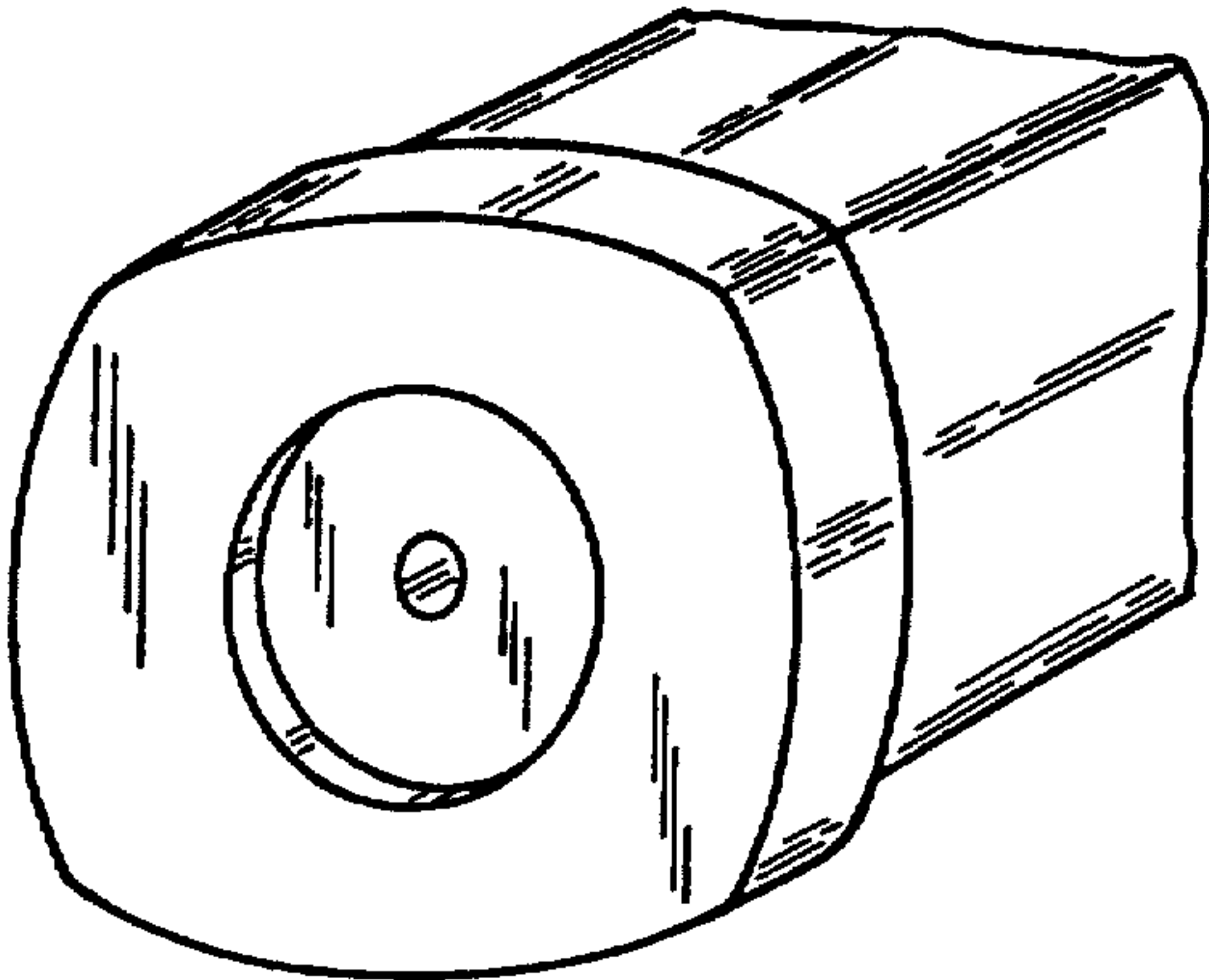

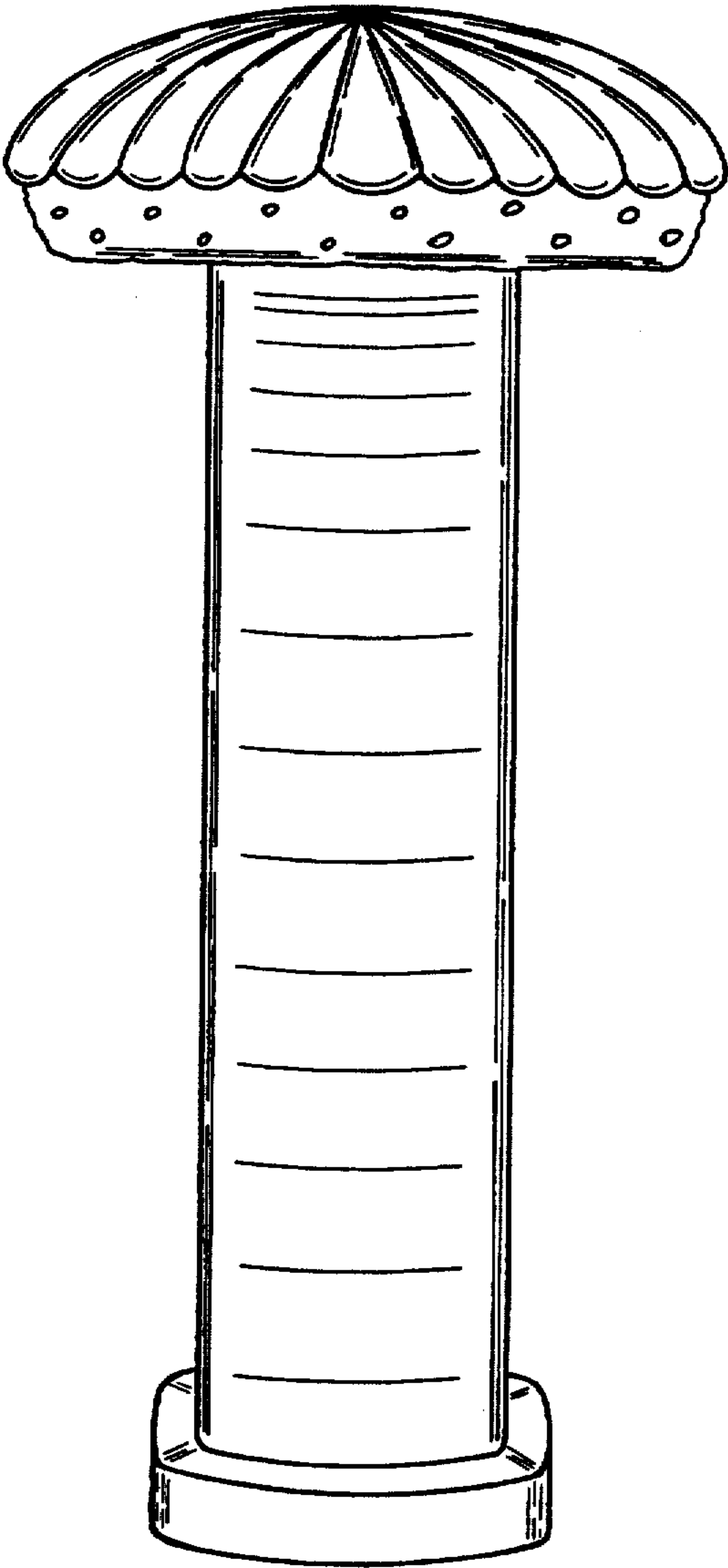

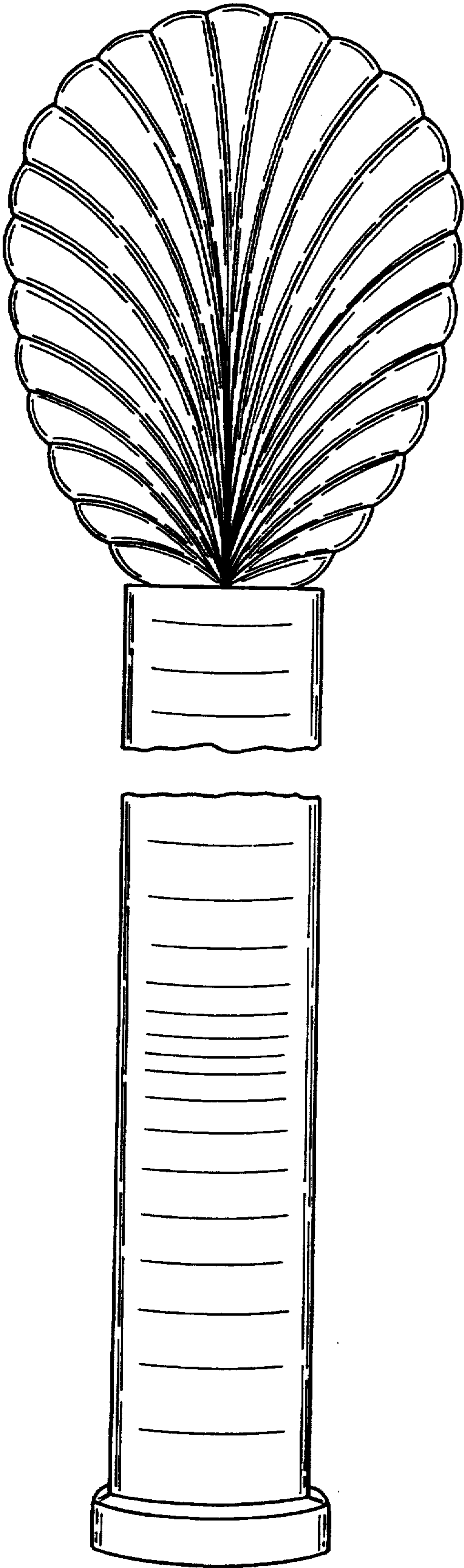

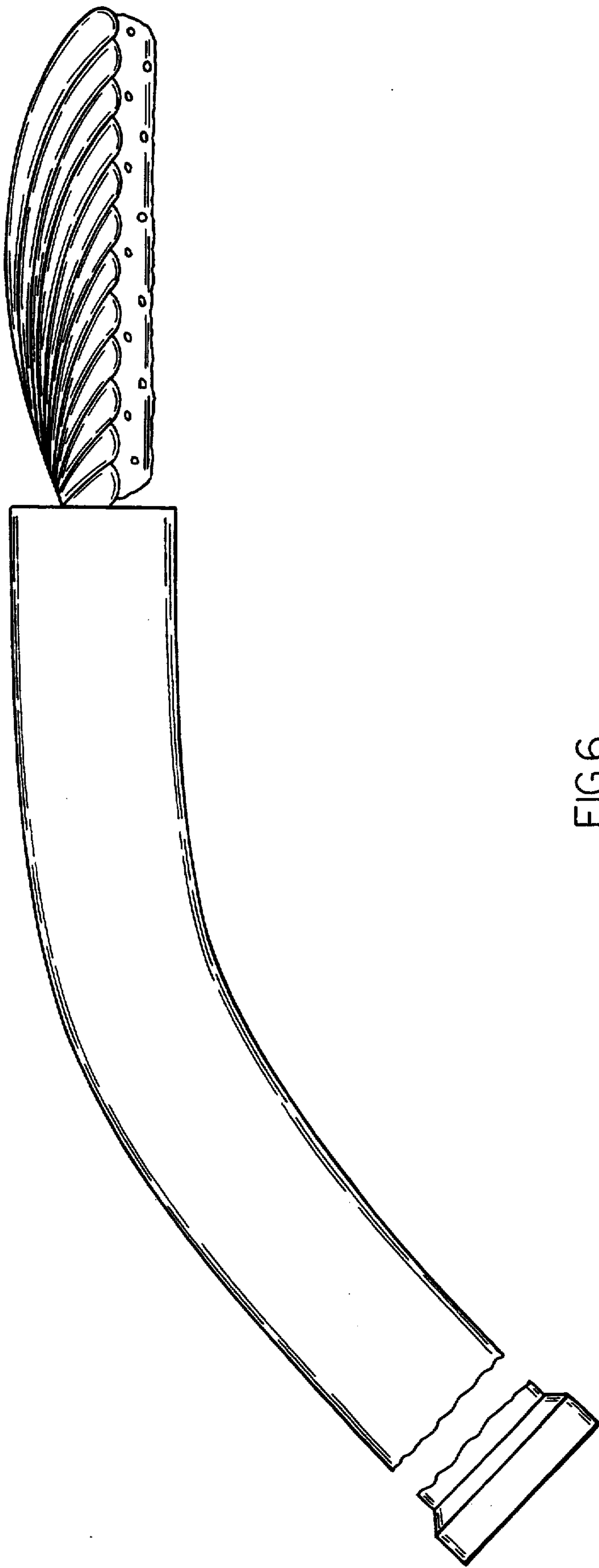
