[57] **CLAIM**
The ornamental design for an inflatable pillow, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a top view of the design of the inflatable pillow in deflated condition;
FIG. 2 is a front view taken from FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a bottom view taken from FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a left-side view taken from FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is a right side view taken from FIG. 1;
FIG. 6 is a top view of the design of the inflatable pillow in inflated condition;
FIG. 7 is a front view taken from FIG. 6;
FIG. 8 is a left side view taken from FIG. 6;
FIG. 9 is a right side view taken from FIG. 6;
FIG. 10 is a rear view taken from FIG. 6; and,
FIG. 11 is a bottom view taken from FIG. 6.
The cross-hatching represents conventional fabric and is understood to extend uniformly throughout the areas represented.









