[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a wine rack, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a wine rack according to the invention, showing a first form of my new design; FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the invented wine rack, according to FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the invented wine rack according to FIG. 1;

FIG. 15 is a front elevational view similar to FIG. 3, but showing still another construction design for my wine rack. The part not shown is the same as that shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view of the invented wine rack according to FIG. 1, the left side elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of the invented wine rack according to FIG. 1;
