The ornamental design for a patient's chair, as shown and described.


DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevation of a patient's chair, showing the design adapted for wheelchair use;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevation;
FIG. 3 is a front elevation with one leg rest in raised position;
FIG. 4 is a front elevation with the seat adapted for toilet use;
FIG. 5 is a side elevation with one leg rest in raised position;
FIG. 6 is an enlarged perspective of the seat, with one leg rest in raised position;
FIG. 7 is a front perspective of the device adapted for horizontal toilet use with both leg rests extended; and,
FIG. 8 is a side perspective showing one arm rest extended vertically for movement of a patient.
















