DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of one embodiment of a trekking sandal of the invention;

 FIG. 14 is a rear view of the trekking sandal of FIG. 8.

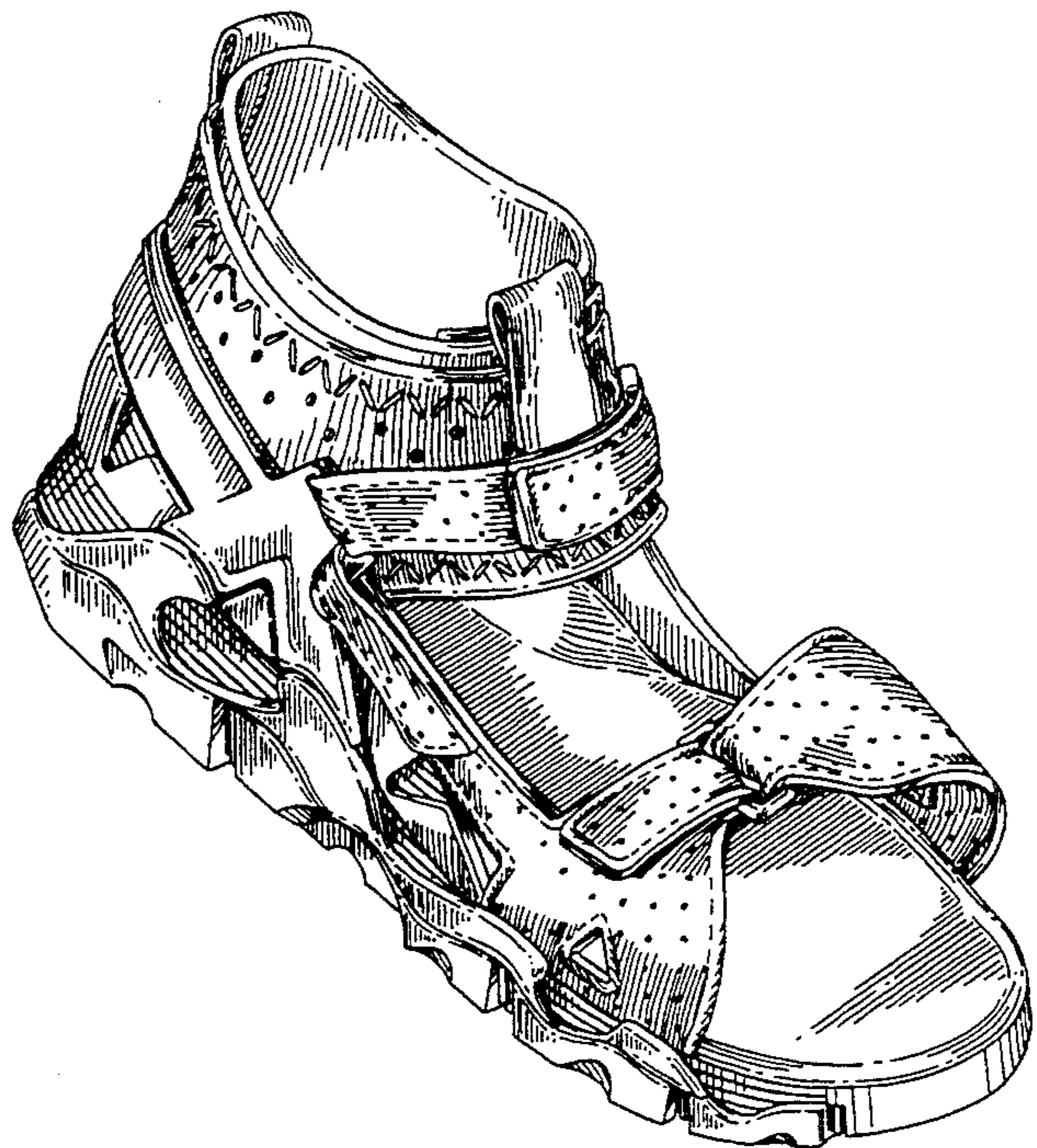

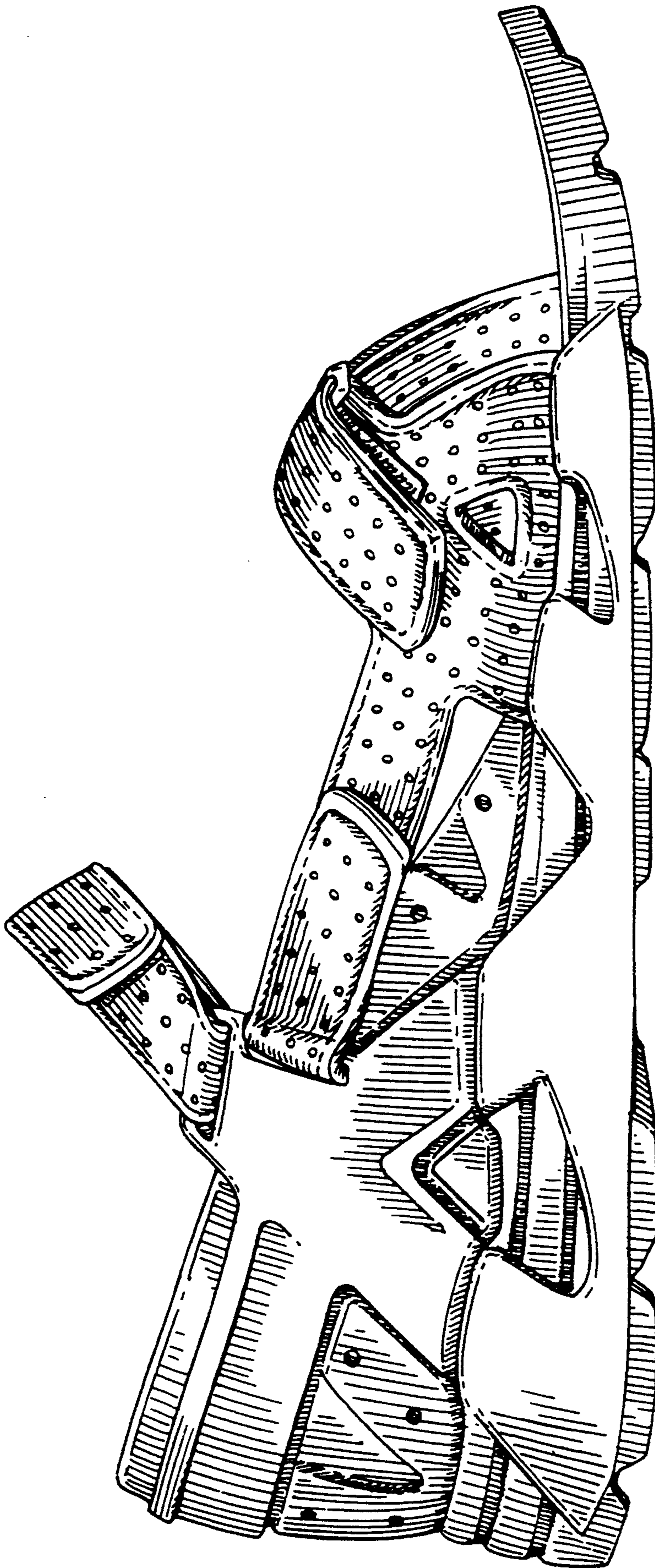

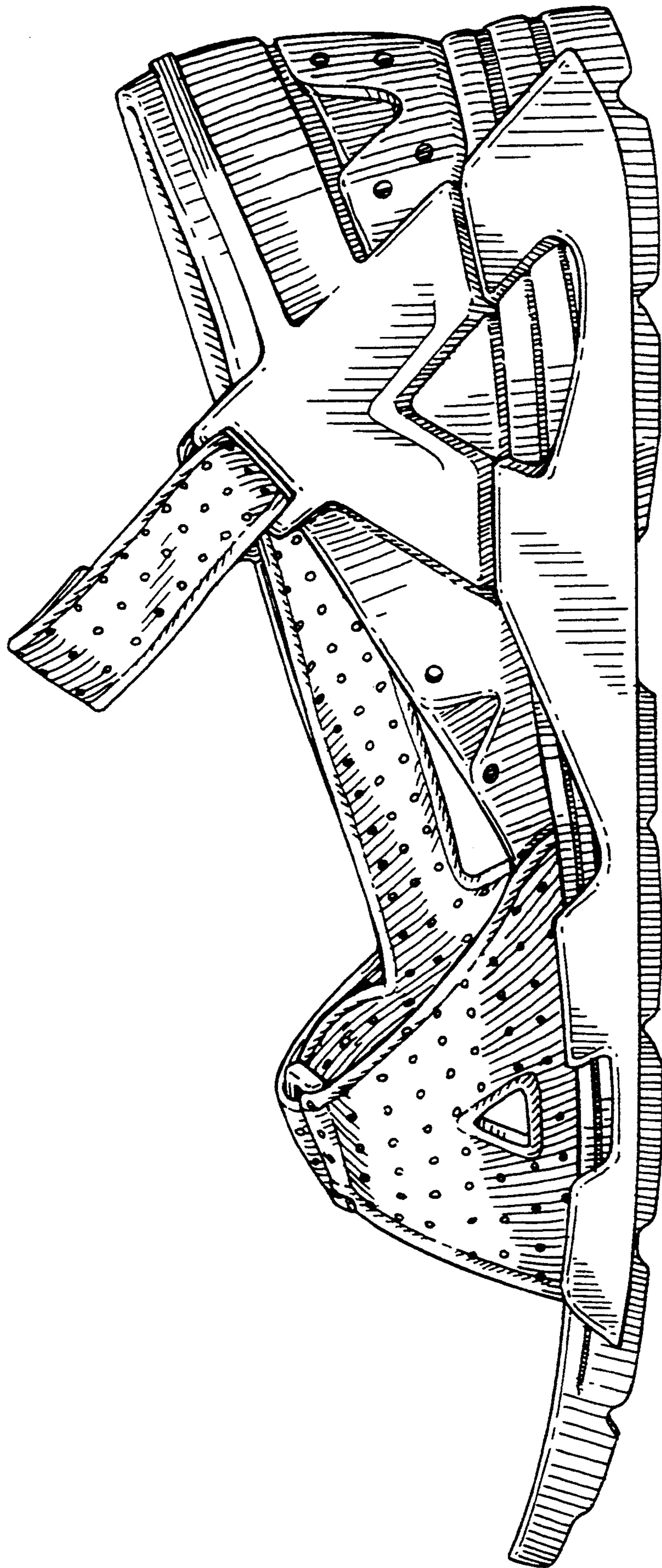

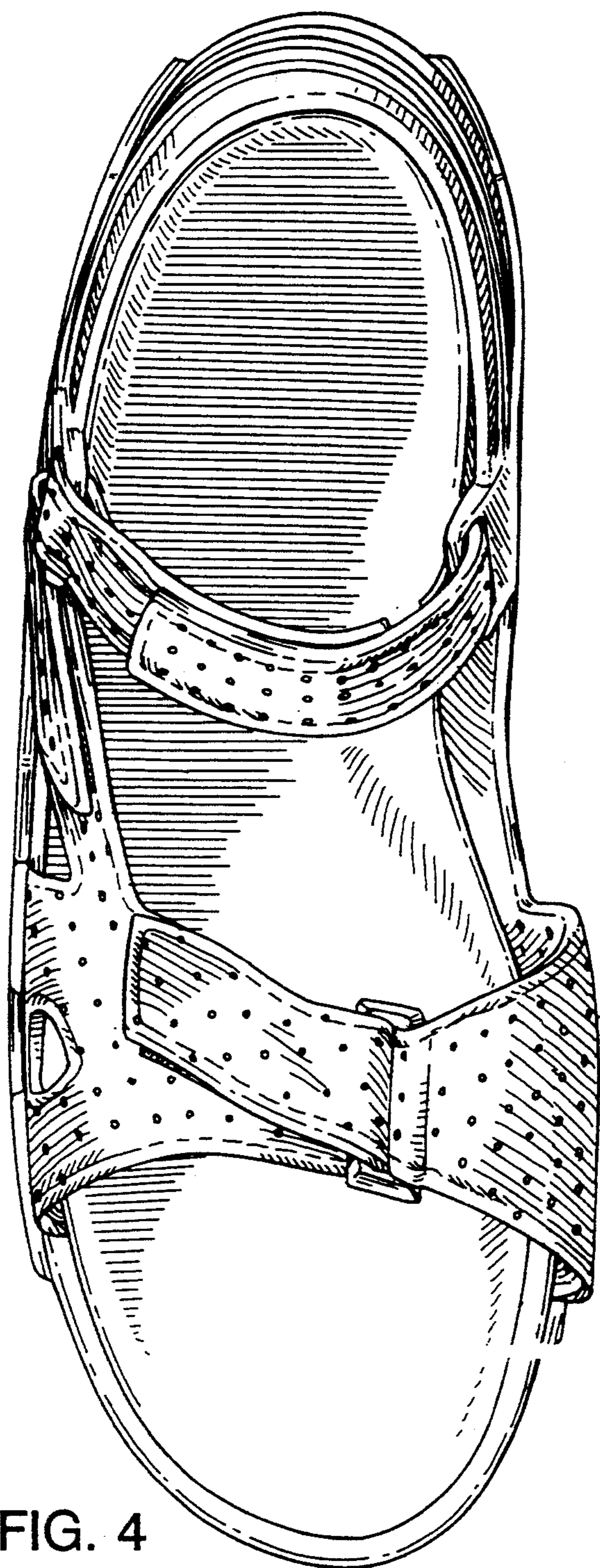

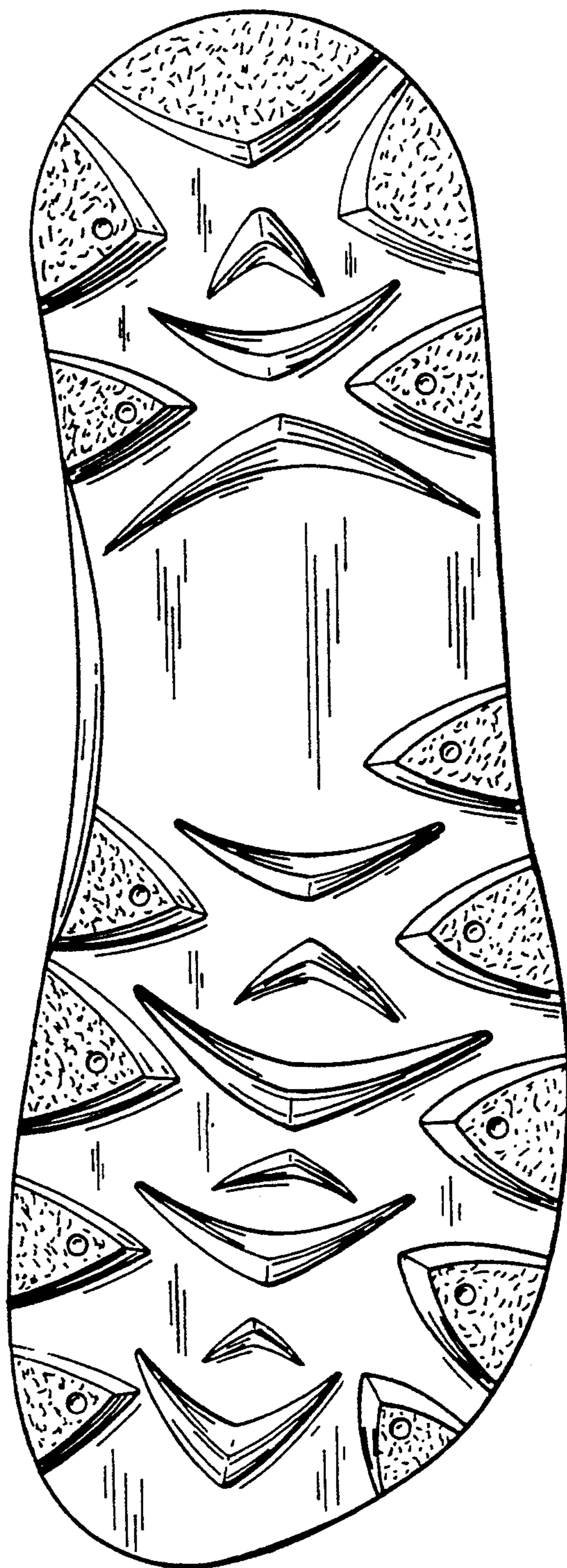

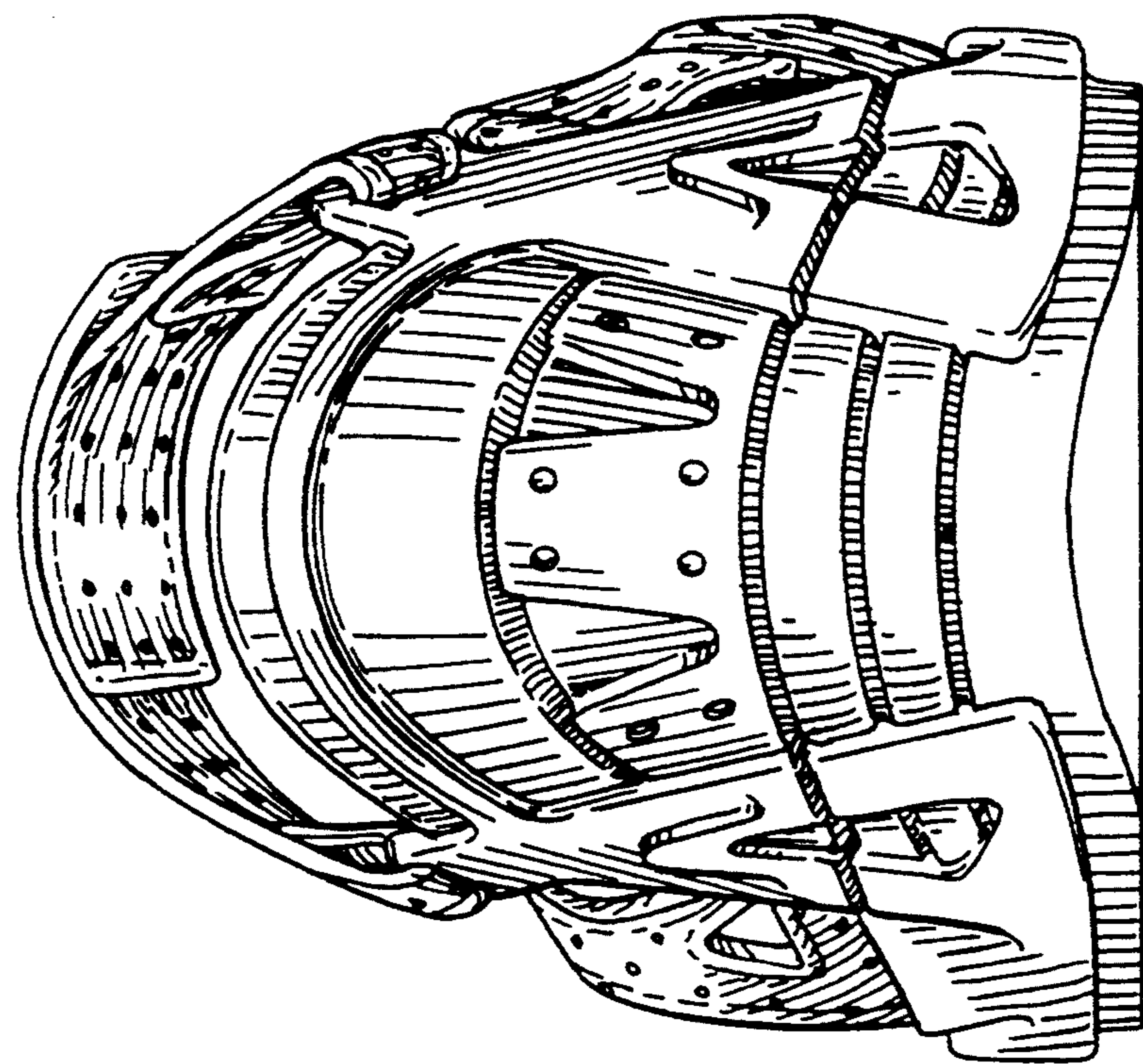

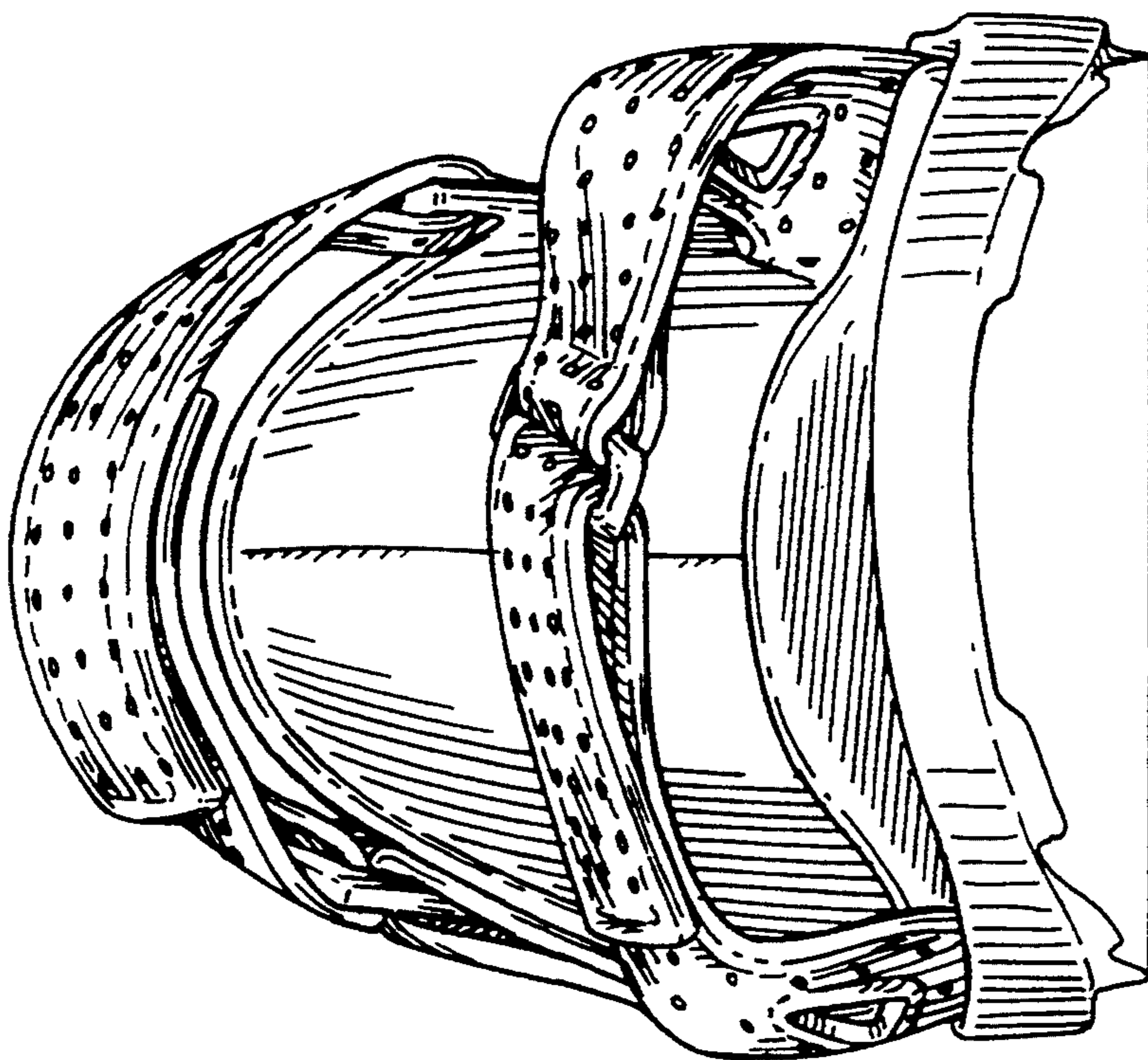

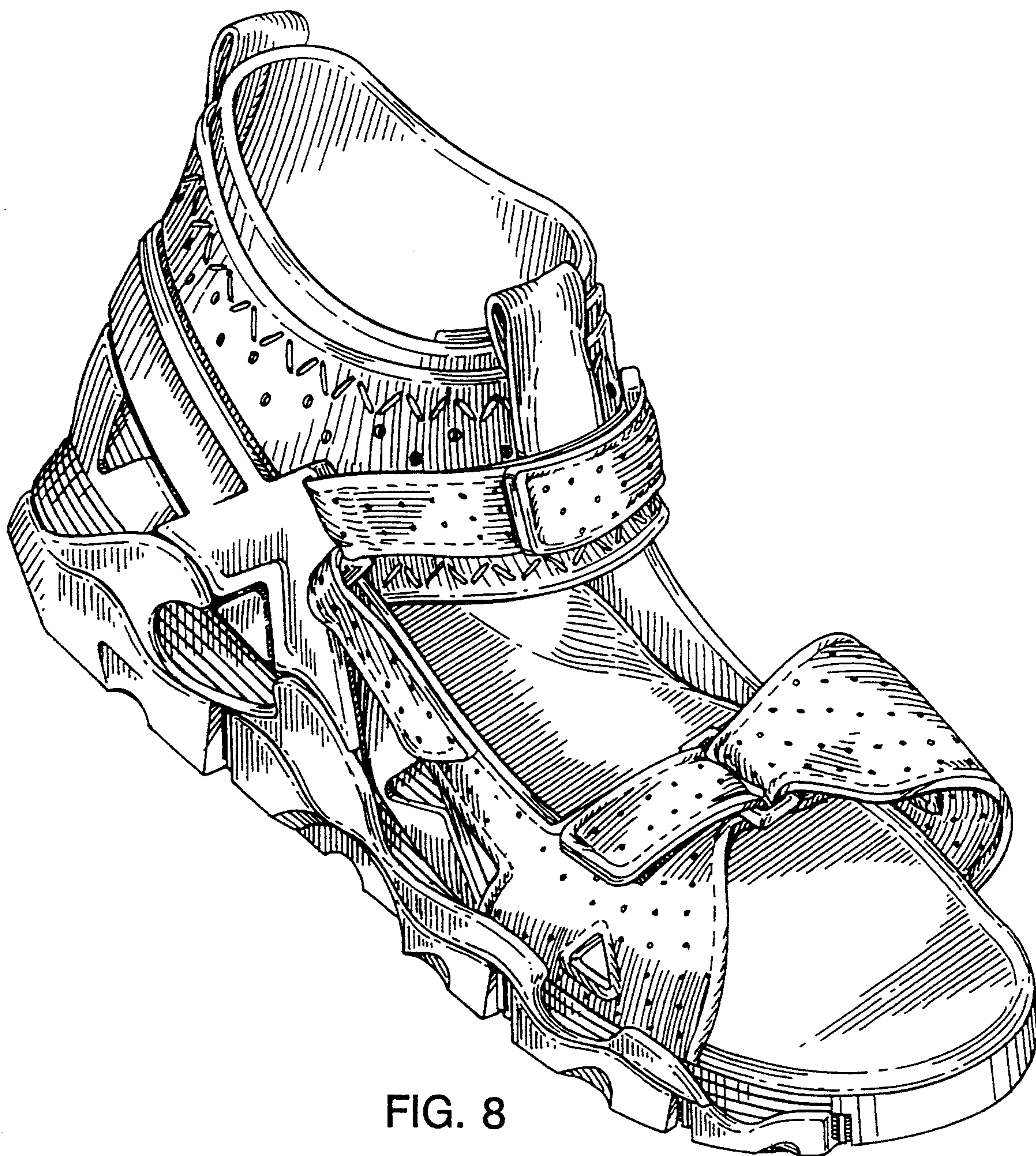

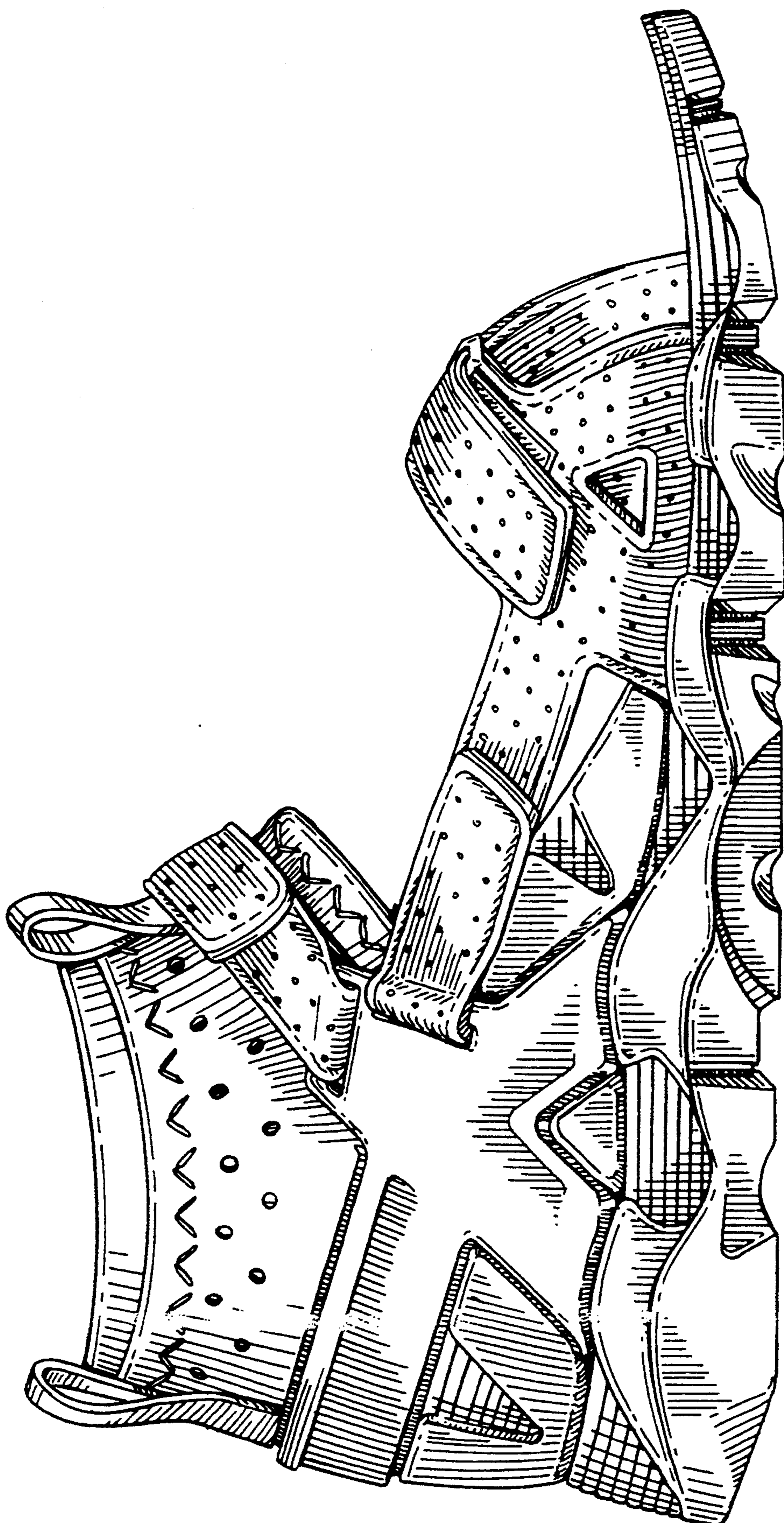

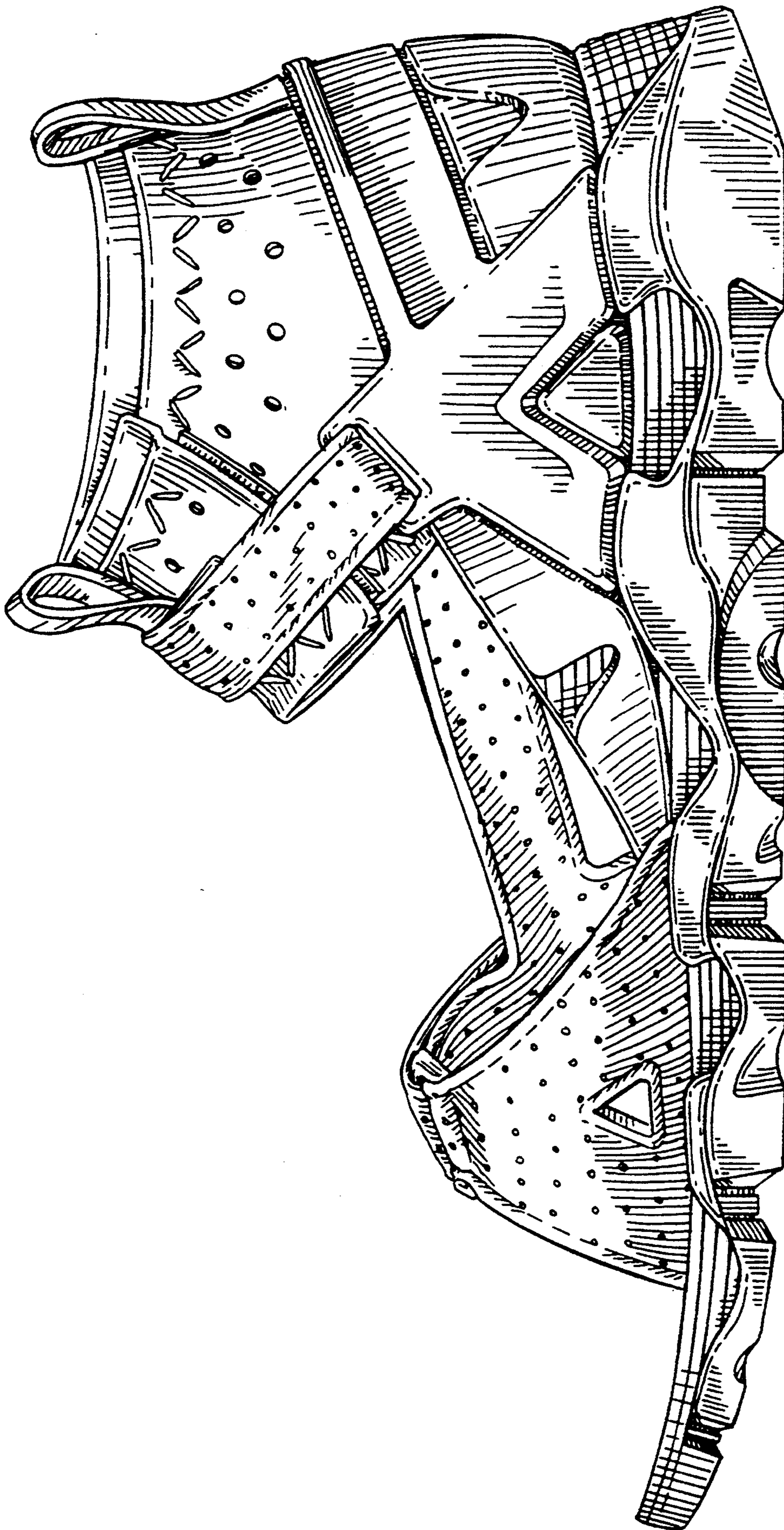

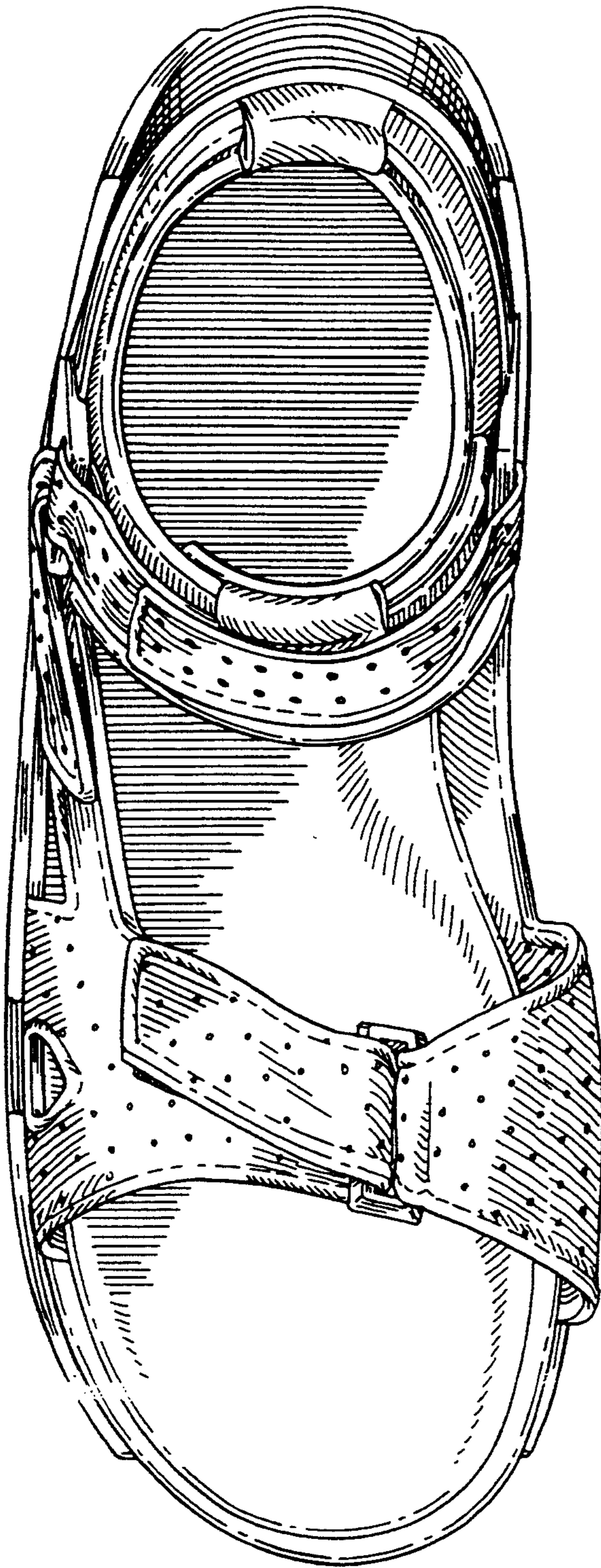

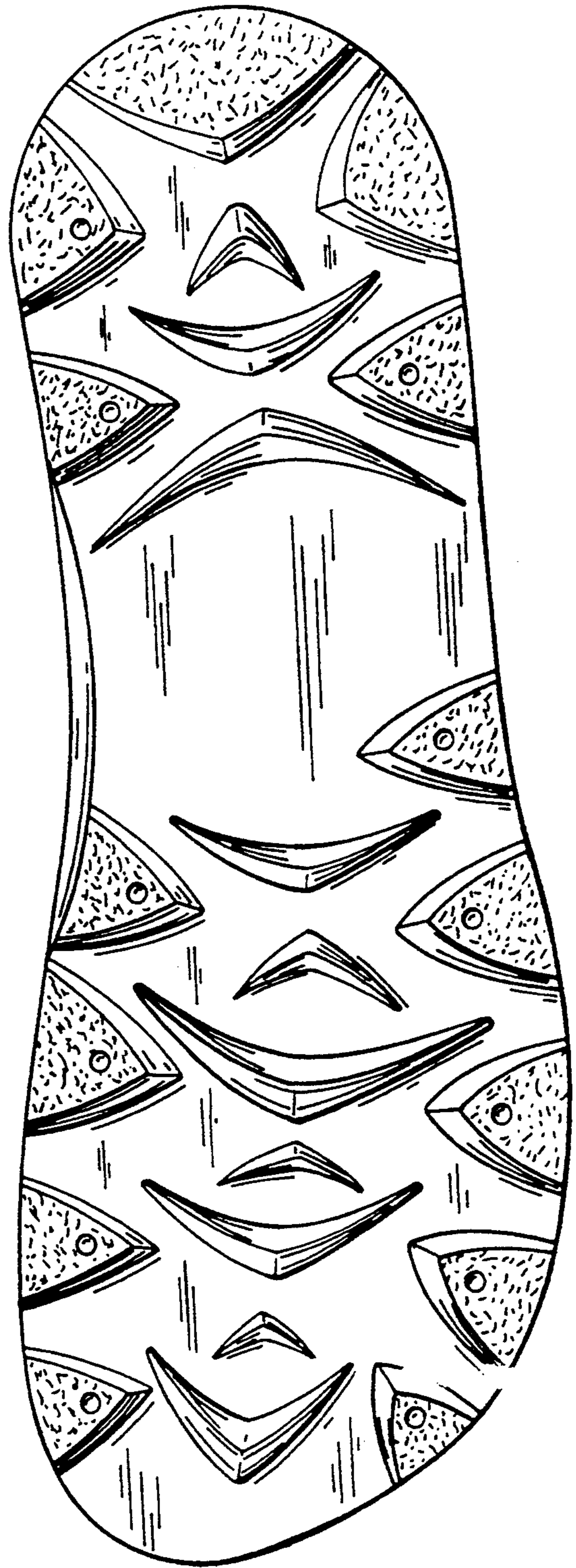

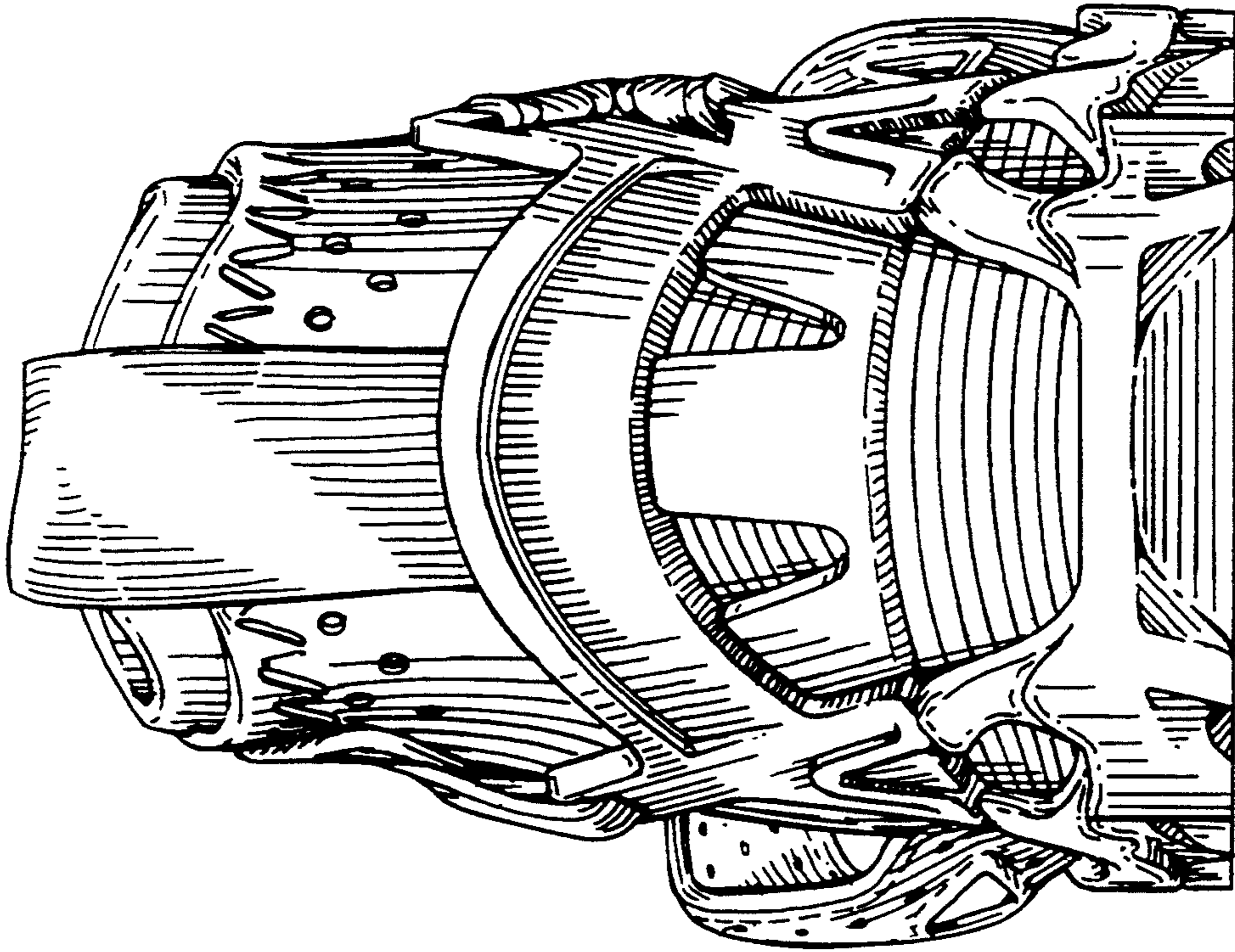

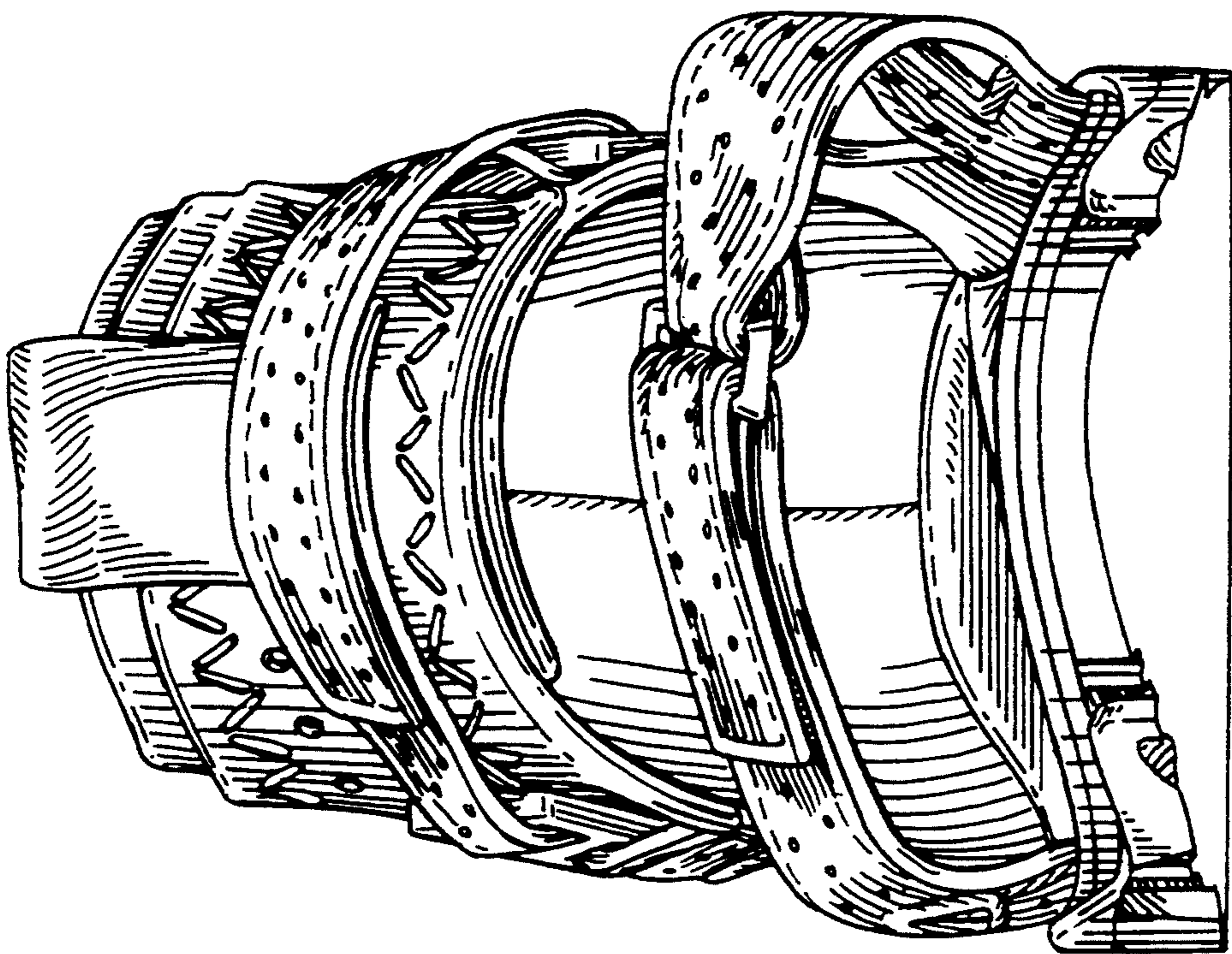
