FIG. 1 is a reduced top left perspective view of a speaker, showing a new design, shown with a cloth covering the top portion of the speaker;


FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof, the cloth shown removed, the bottom being plane and unornamented;


FIG. 3 is a front elevation view of the speaker as shown in FIG. 2;

FIG. 5 is a left-side elevation view of the speaker as shown in FIG. 2; and,


FIG. 6 is a rear elevation view of the speaker as shown in the prior figures.








