DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a side perspective view of an extension for a chipper/shredder inlet chute, showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front perspective view thereof; FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof; and, FIG. 4 is a top perspective view.
The broken lines showing typical inlet chute for a chipper/shredder is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

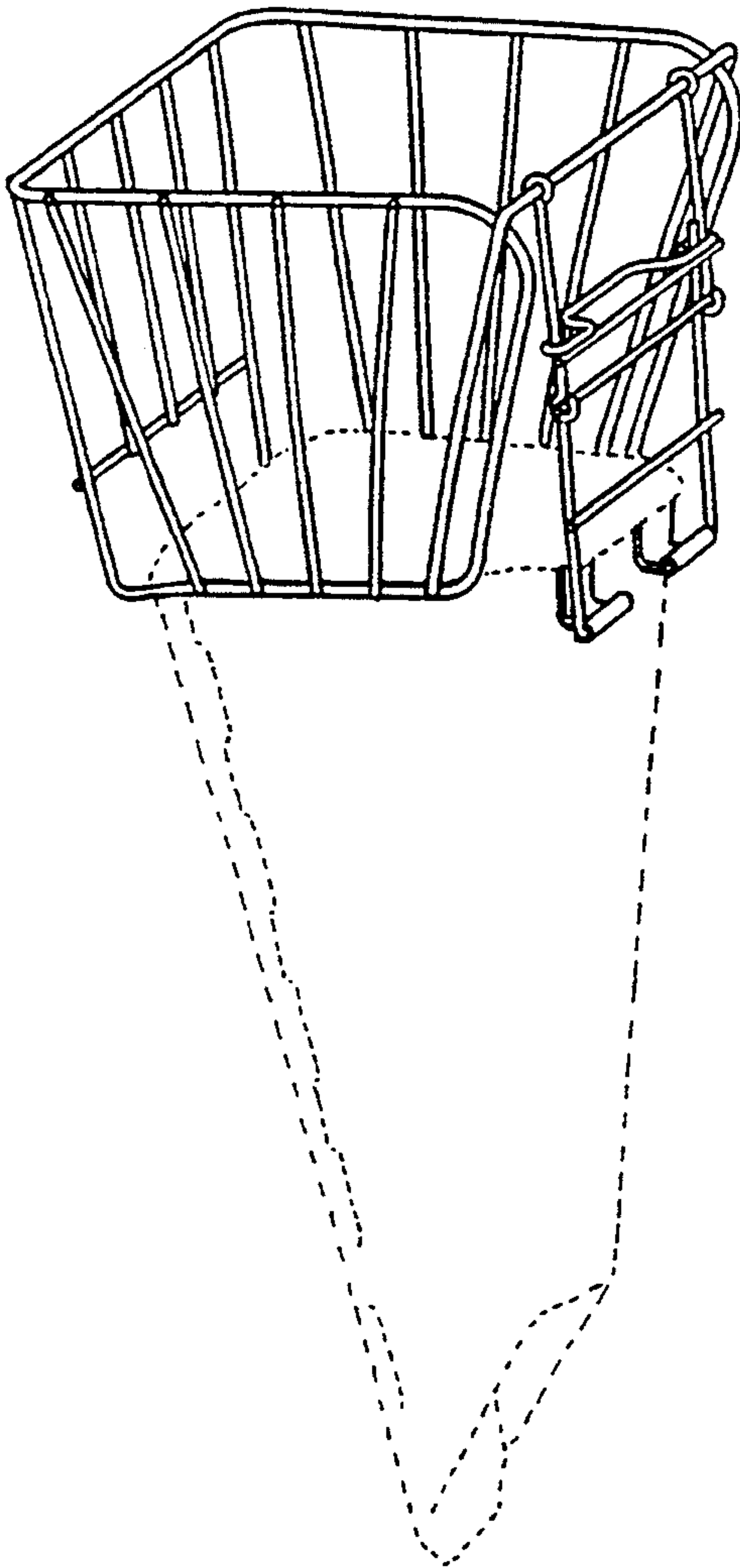

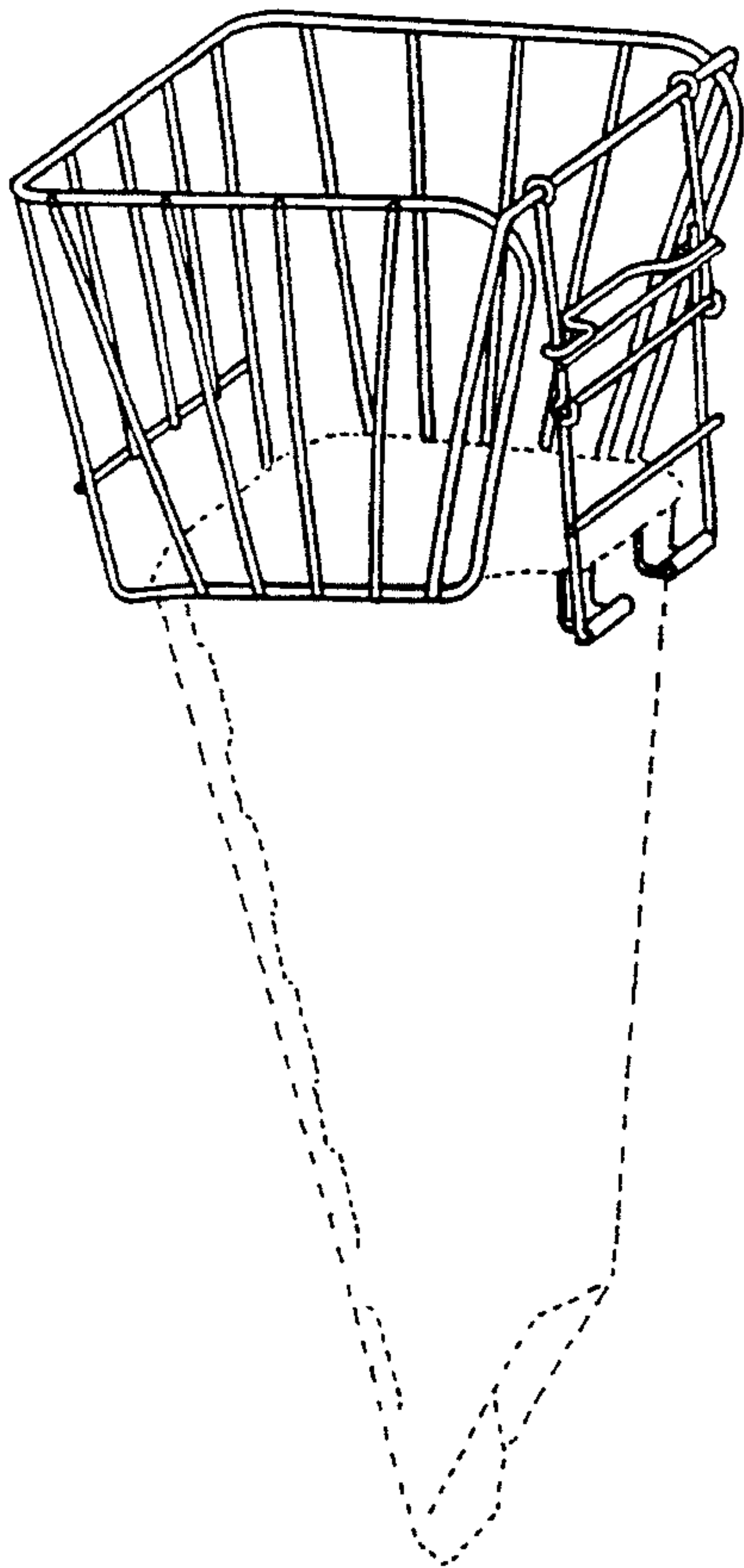

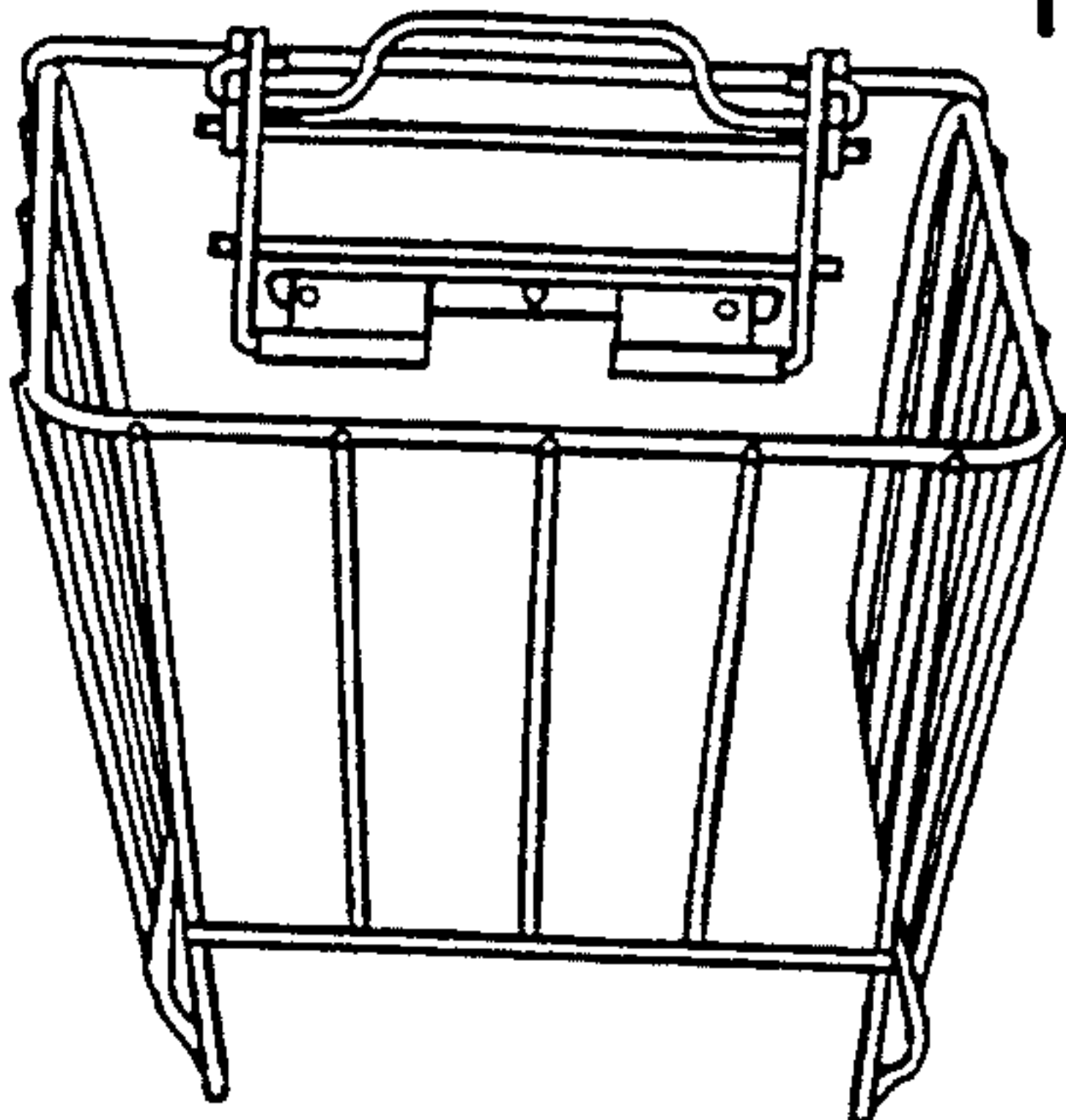

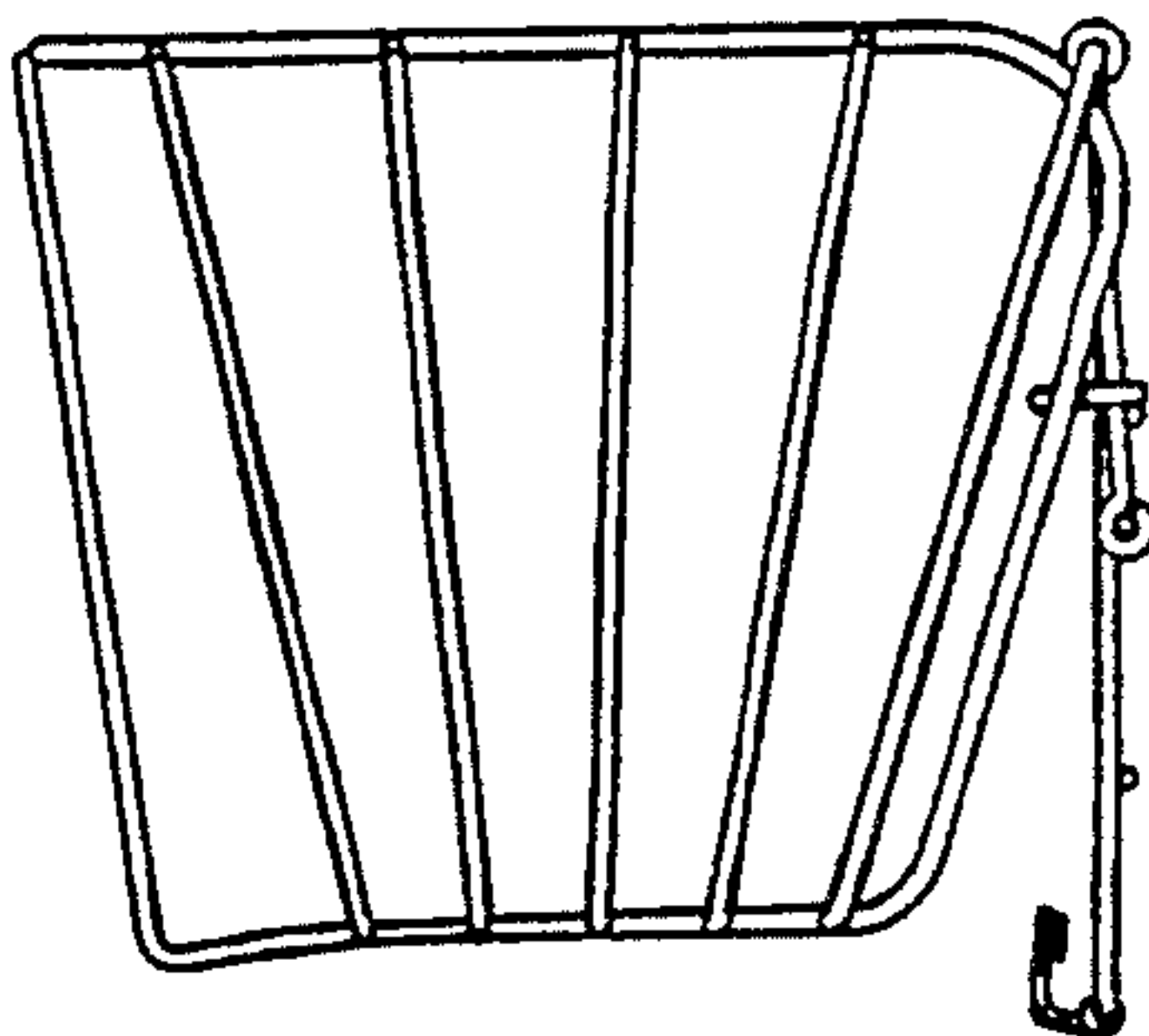
