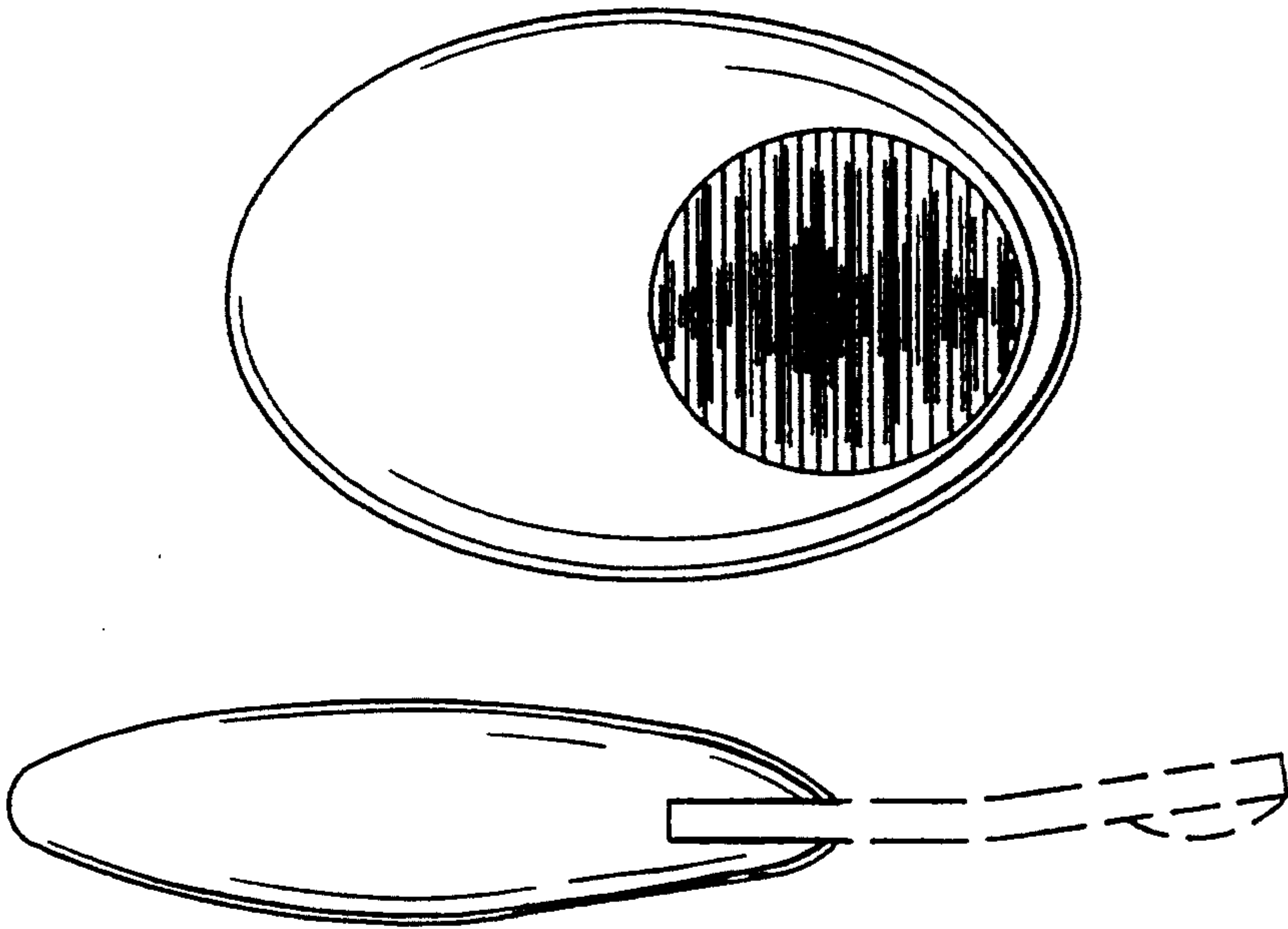

[57] **CLAIM**
The ornamental design for a razor blade handle, as
shown and described.

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a top plan view of the razor blade handle
showing my new design, the broken line showing of the
razor blade being for illustrative purposes only and
forming no part of the claimed design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view of the handle;
FIG. 3 is a front view of the handle; and,
FIG. 4 is a left side view of the handle, the right side
being a mirror image thereof and with the razor blade
again being shown in broken lines for illustrative pur-
poses only.



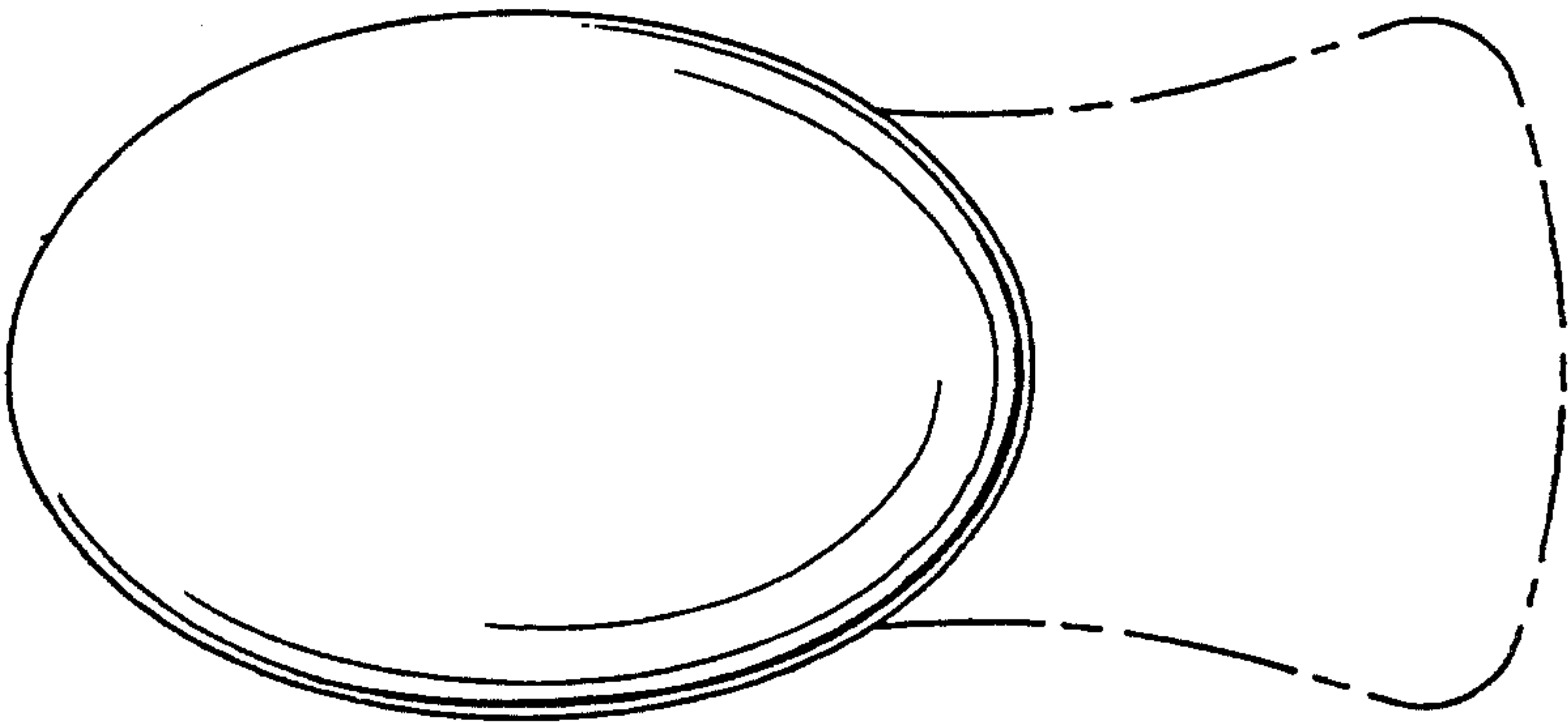

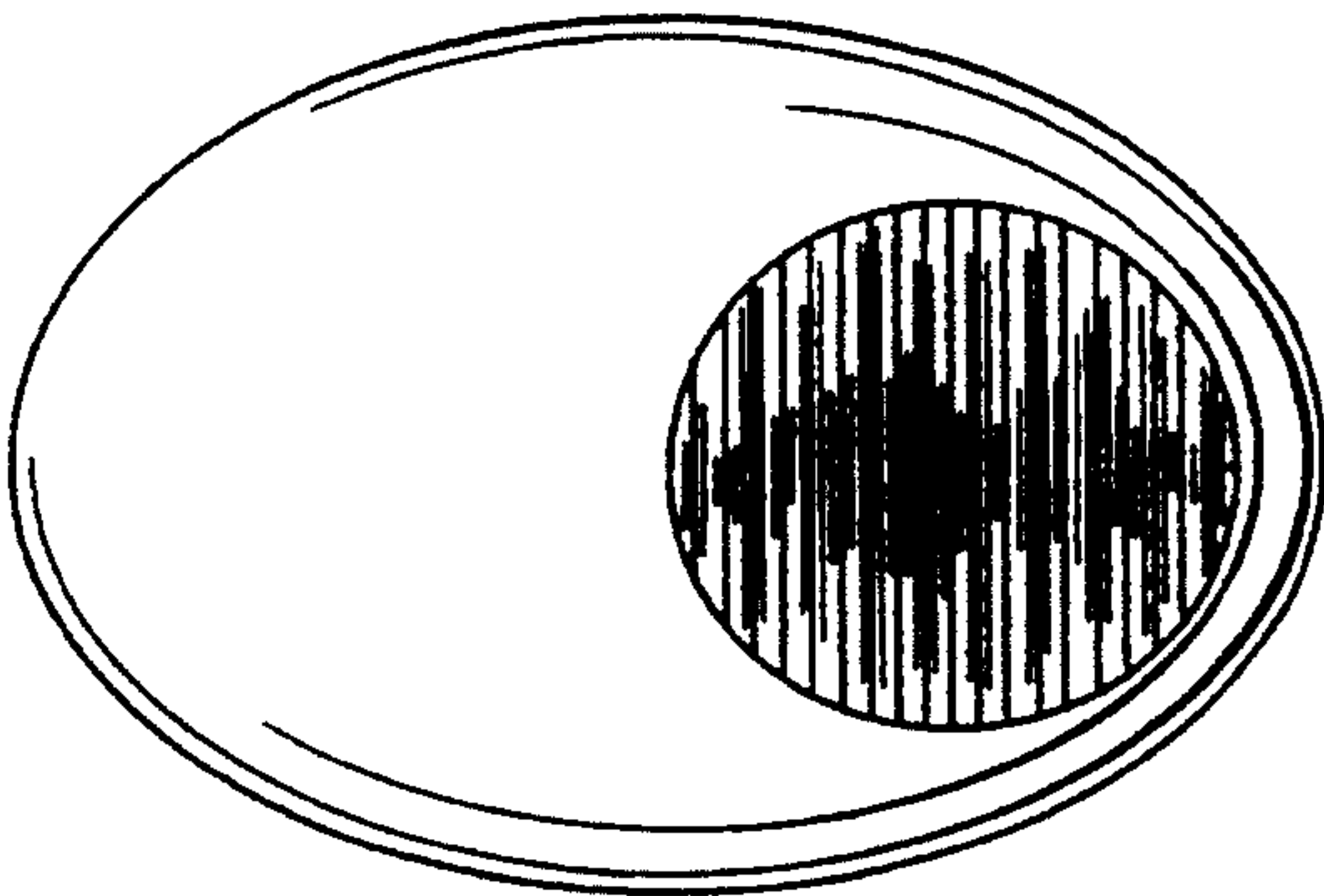

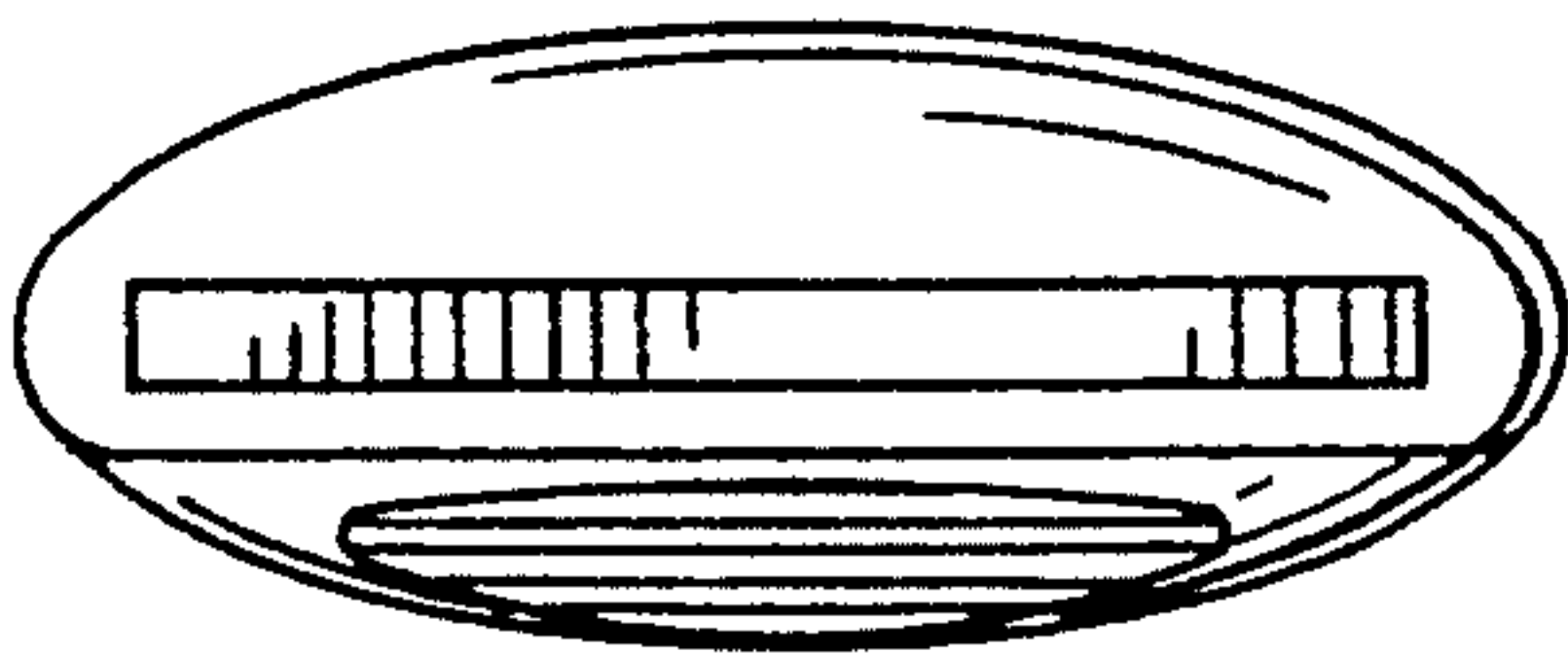

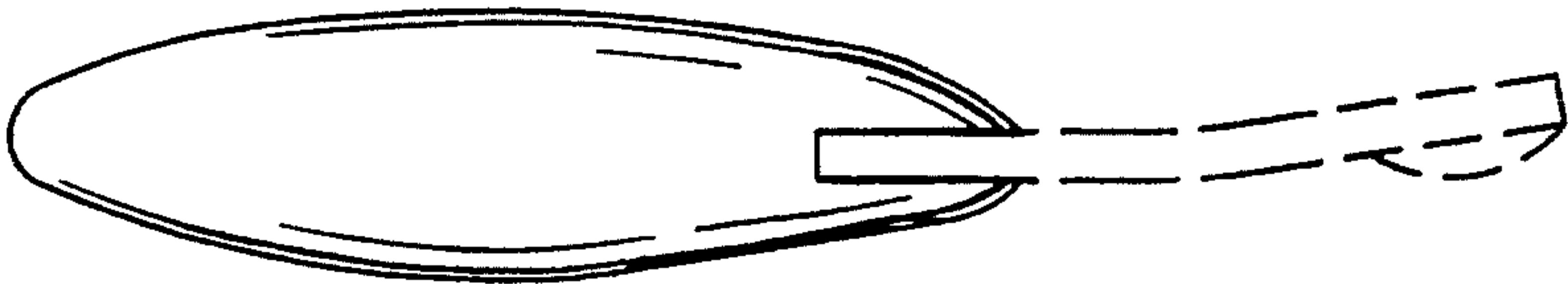
