[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined handle and side clip for umbrella, as shown and described.

## DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevation of a design for combined handle

and side clip for umbrella showing a first embodiment of my new design;

FIG. 2 is an end view looking toward the right of the side seen in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is an elevation of the side opposite that seen in FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is an end view looking toward the right of the side seen in FIG. 3;

FIG. 5 is a plan view of the first embodiment;

FIG. 6 is a bottom view of the first embodiment;

FIG. 7 is a cross-section taken through line 7—7 of

FIG. 3 looking in the direction of arrows 7—7;

FIG. 8 is a cross-section taken through line 8—8 of FIG. 4 looking in the direction of arrows 8—8;

FIG. 9 is a side elevation showing a second embodiment of my new design;

FIG. 10 is an elevation looking toward the right end of the side seen in FIG. 9;

FIG. 11 is an elevation of the side opposite that seen in FIG. 9;

FIG. 12 is an end view looking toward the right of the side seen in FIG. 11;


FIG. 13 is a plan view of the second embodiment;

FIG. 14 is a bottom view of the second embodiment;


FIG. 15 is a cross-section taken through the line 15—15 of FIG. 11 looking in the direction of arrows 15—15; and

FIG. 16 is a cross-section taken through line 16—16 of FIG. 12 looking in the direction of arrows 16—16.
