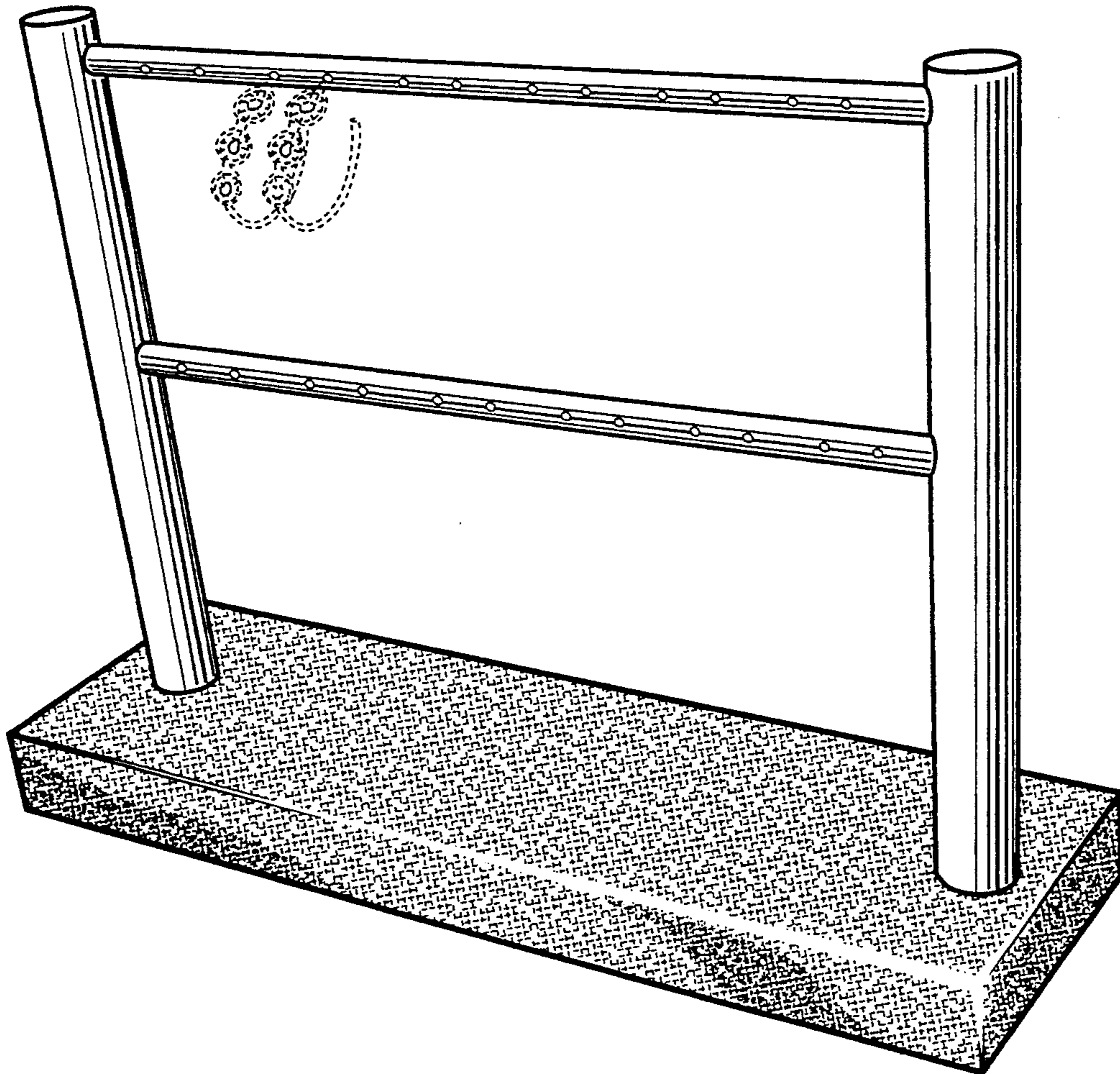

claimed design.



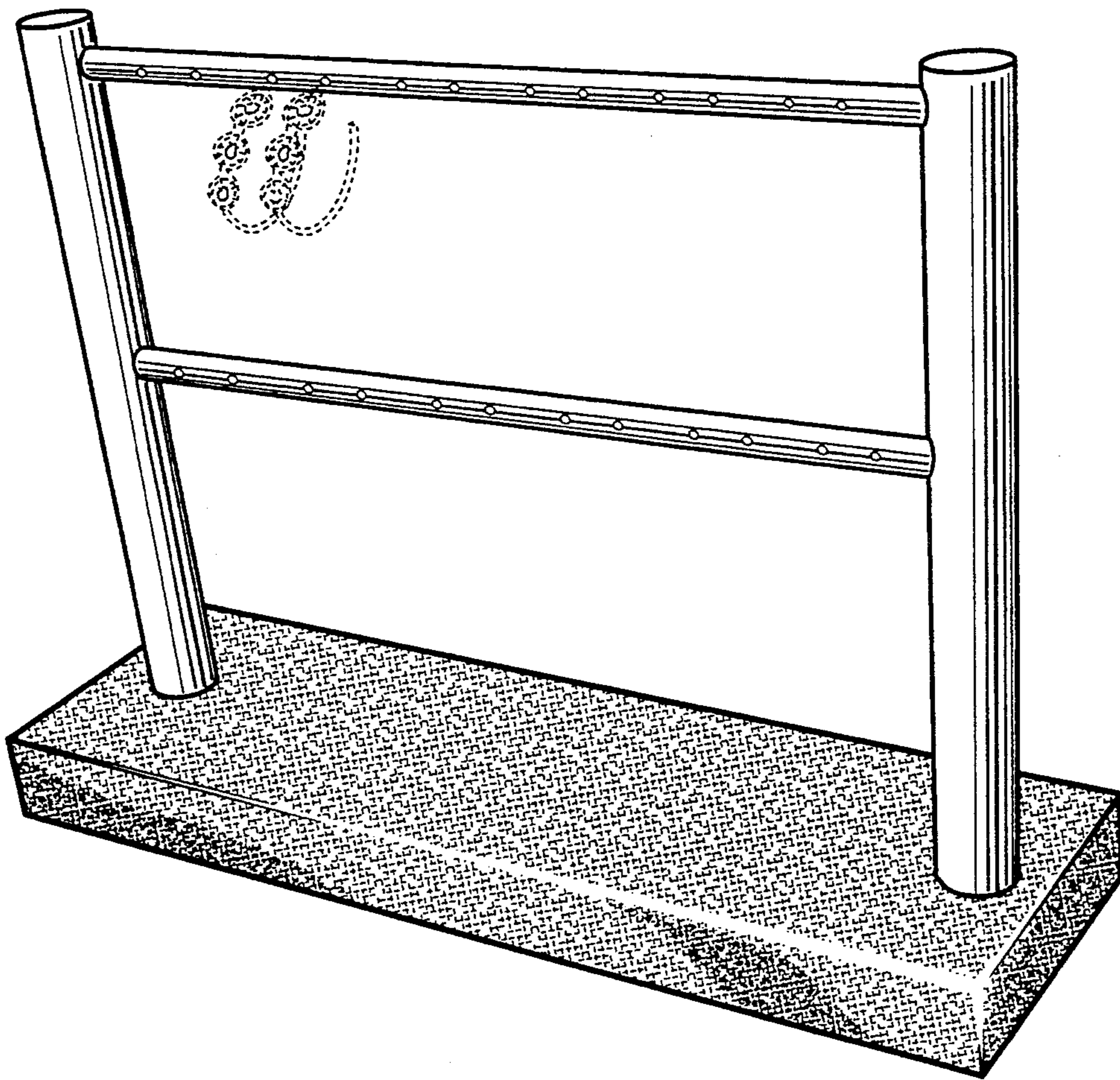

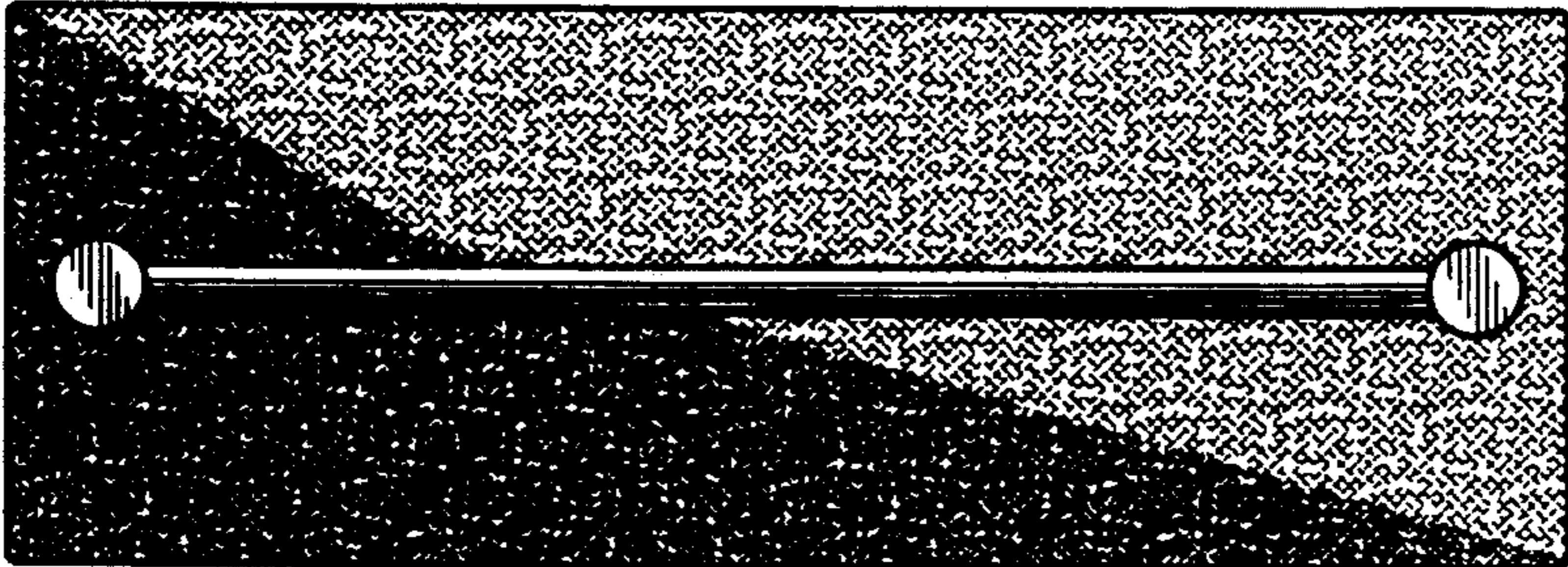

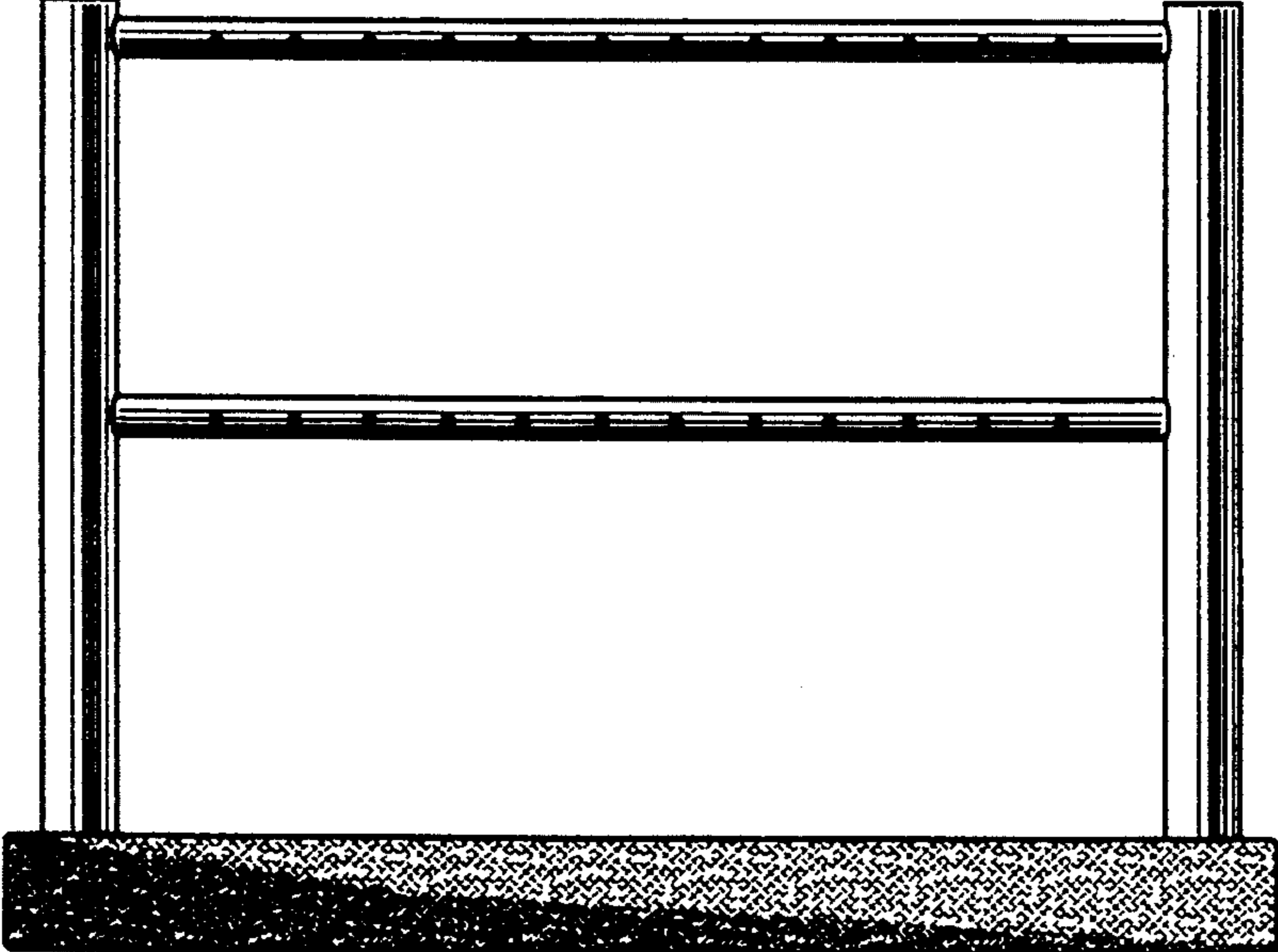

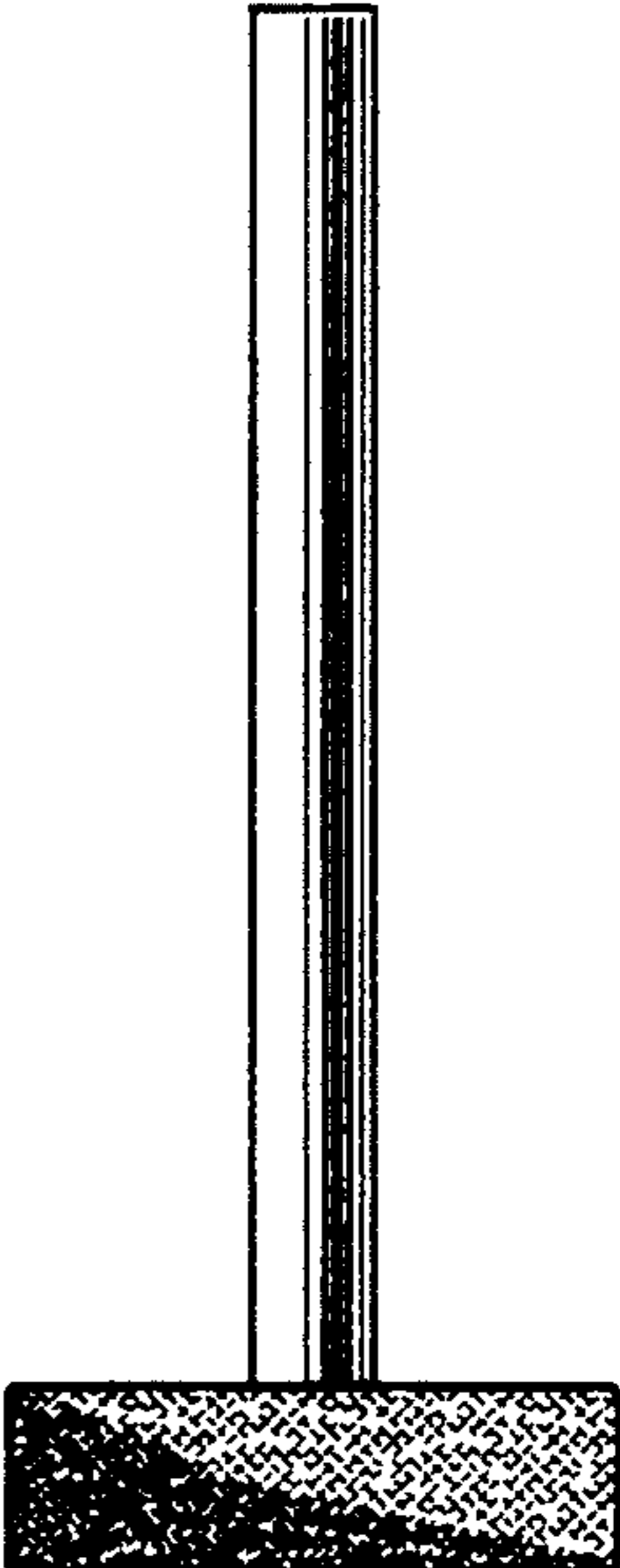

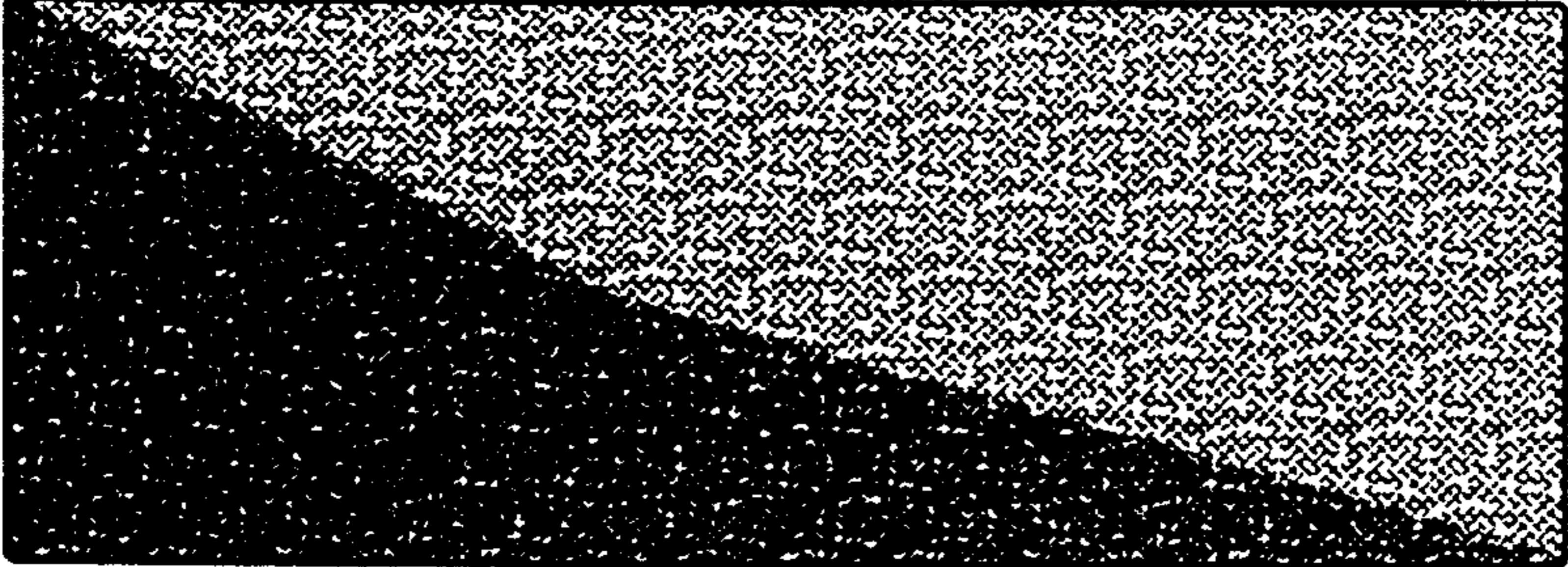
