DESCRIPTION

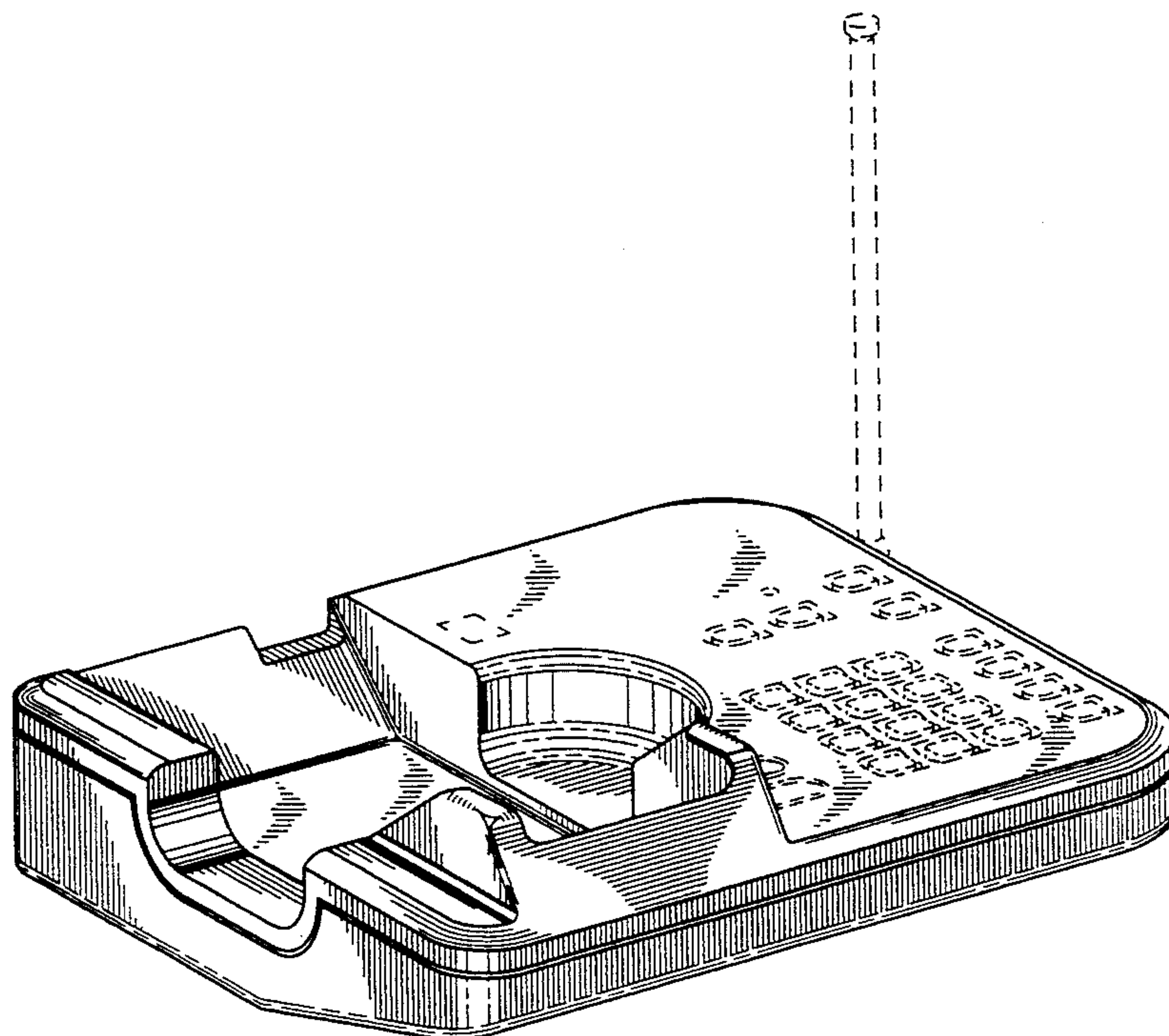

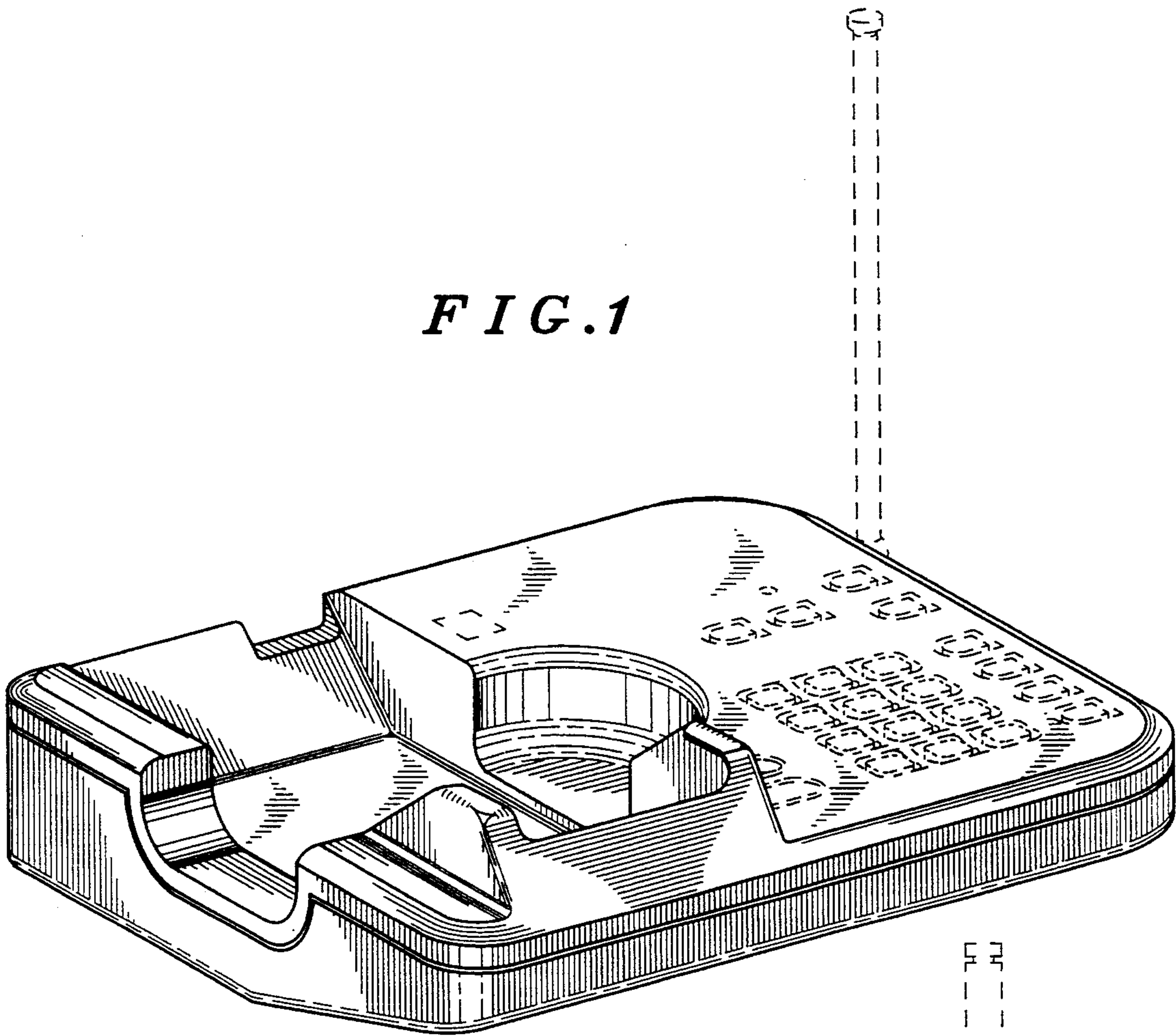

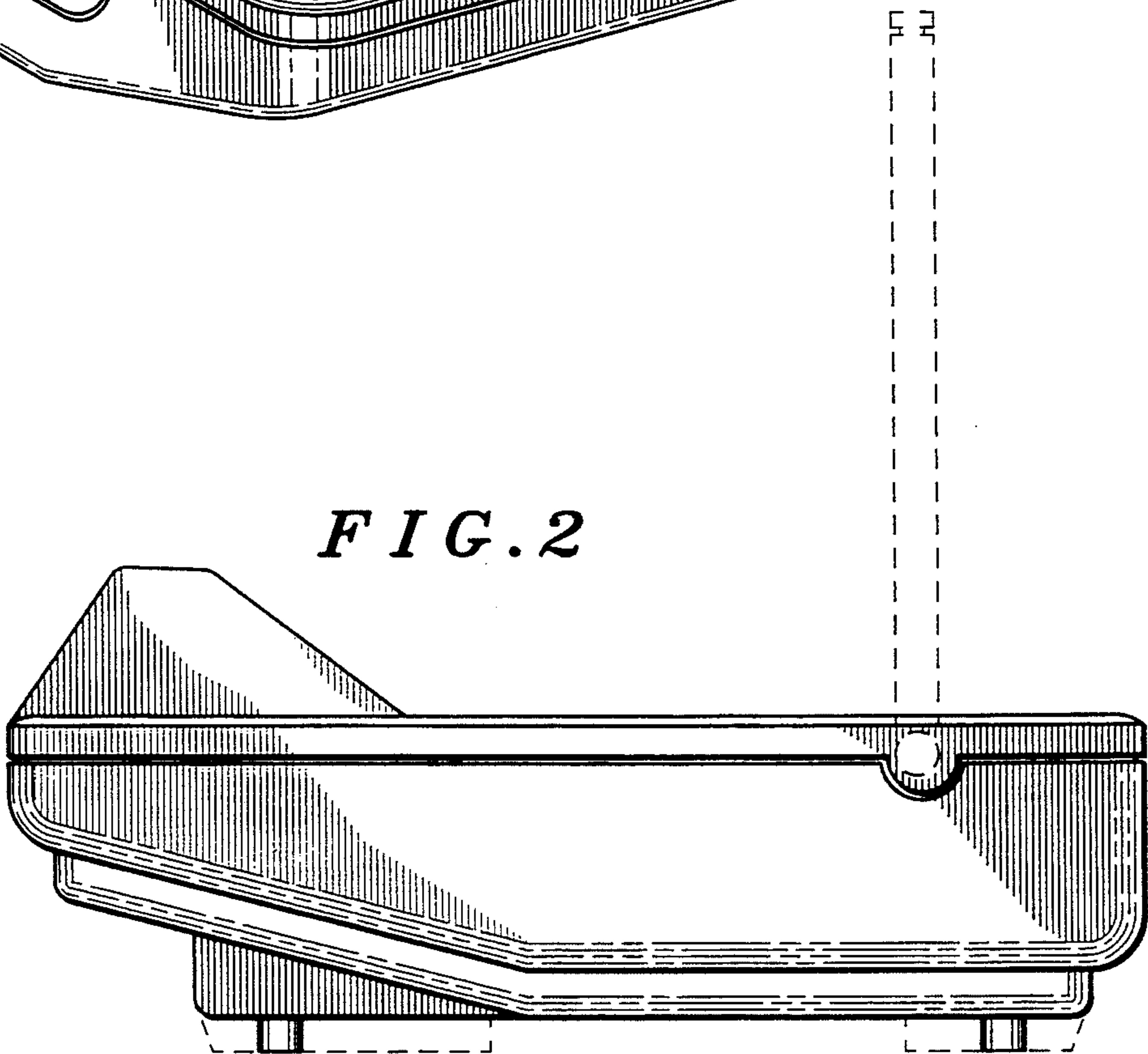
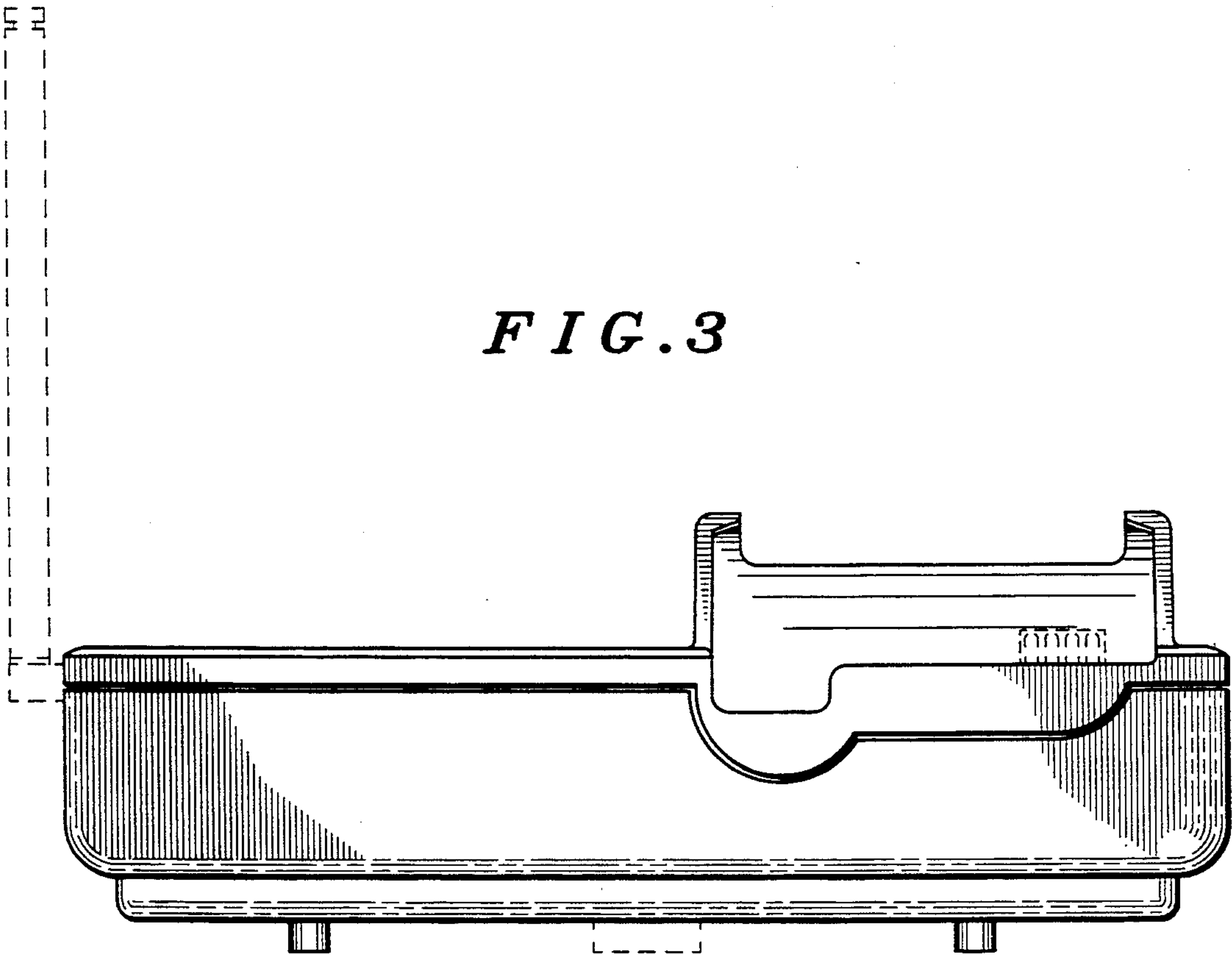

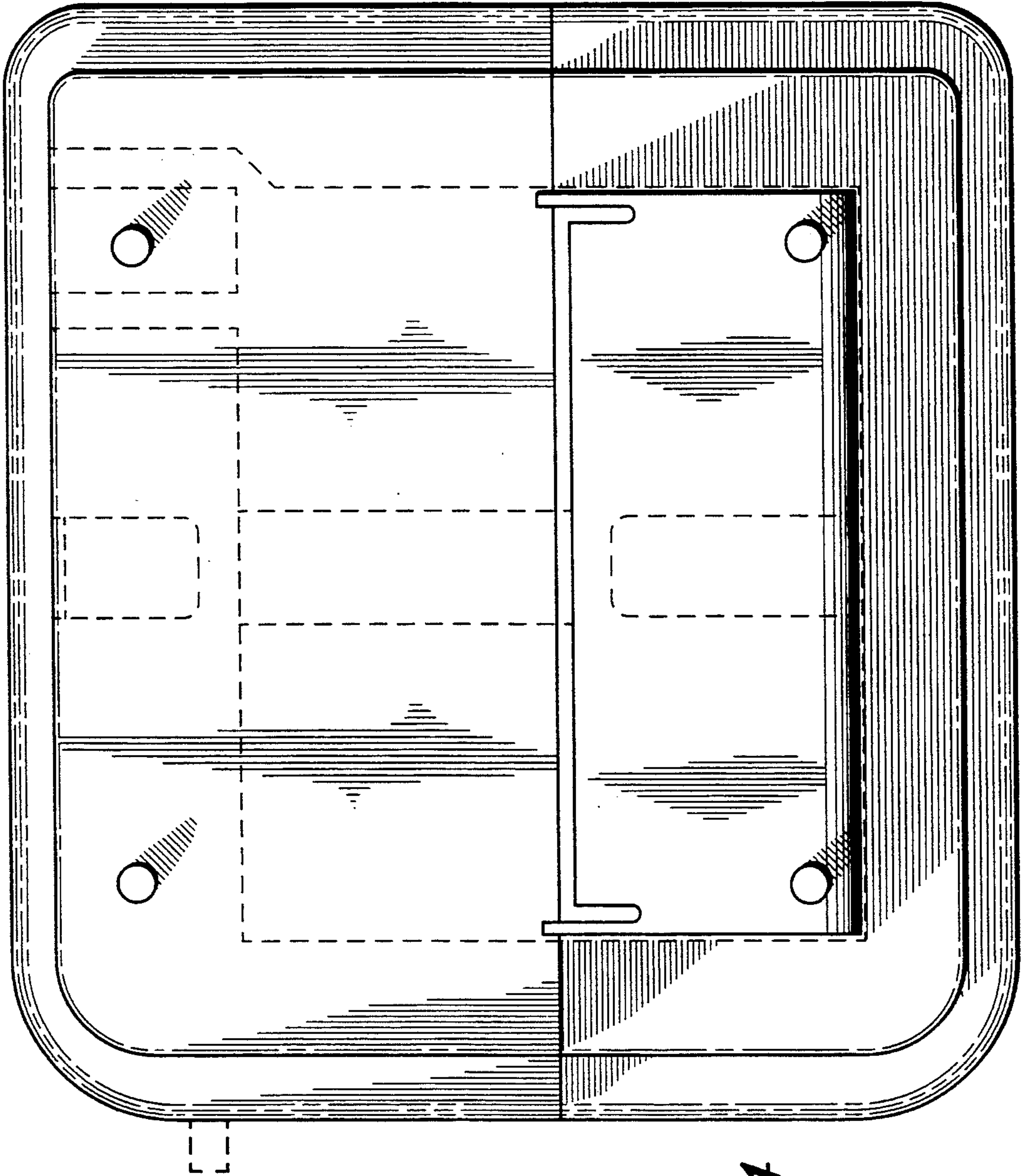

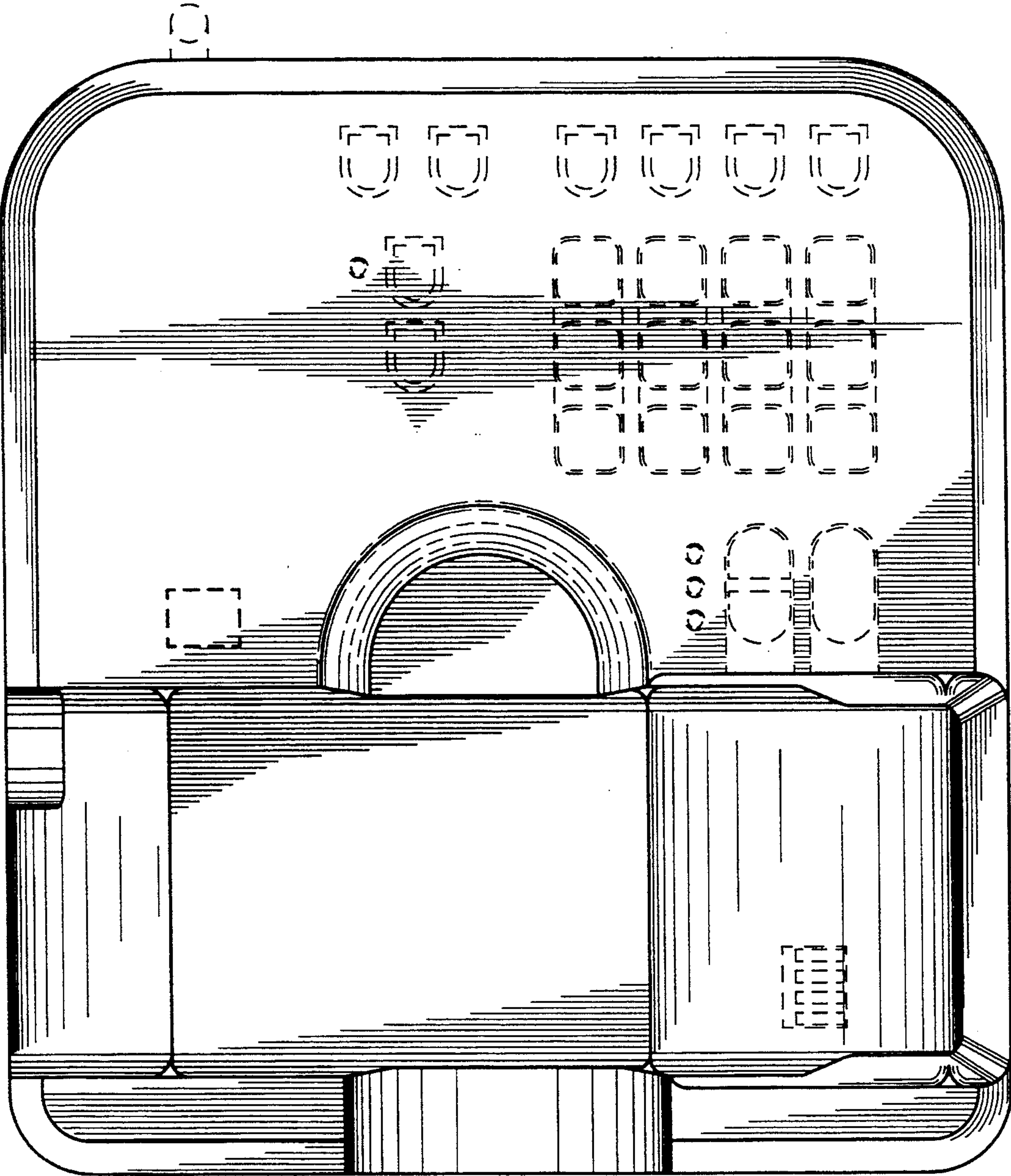
