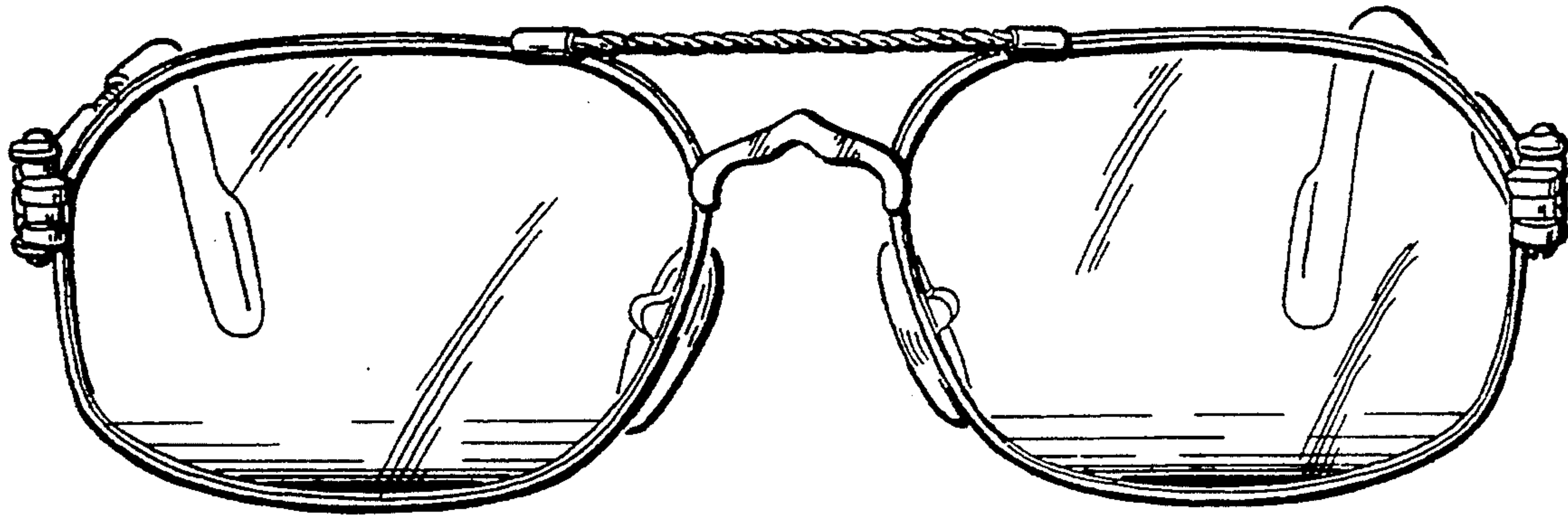

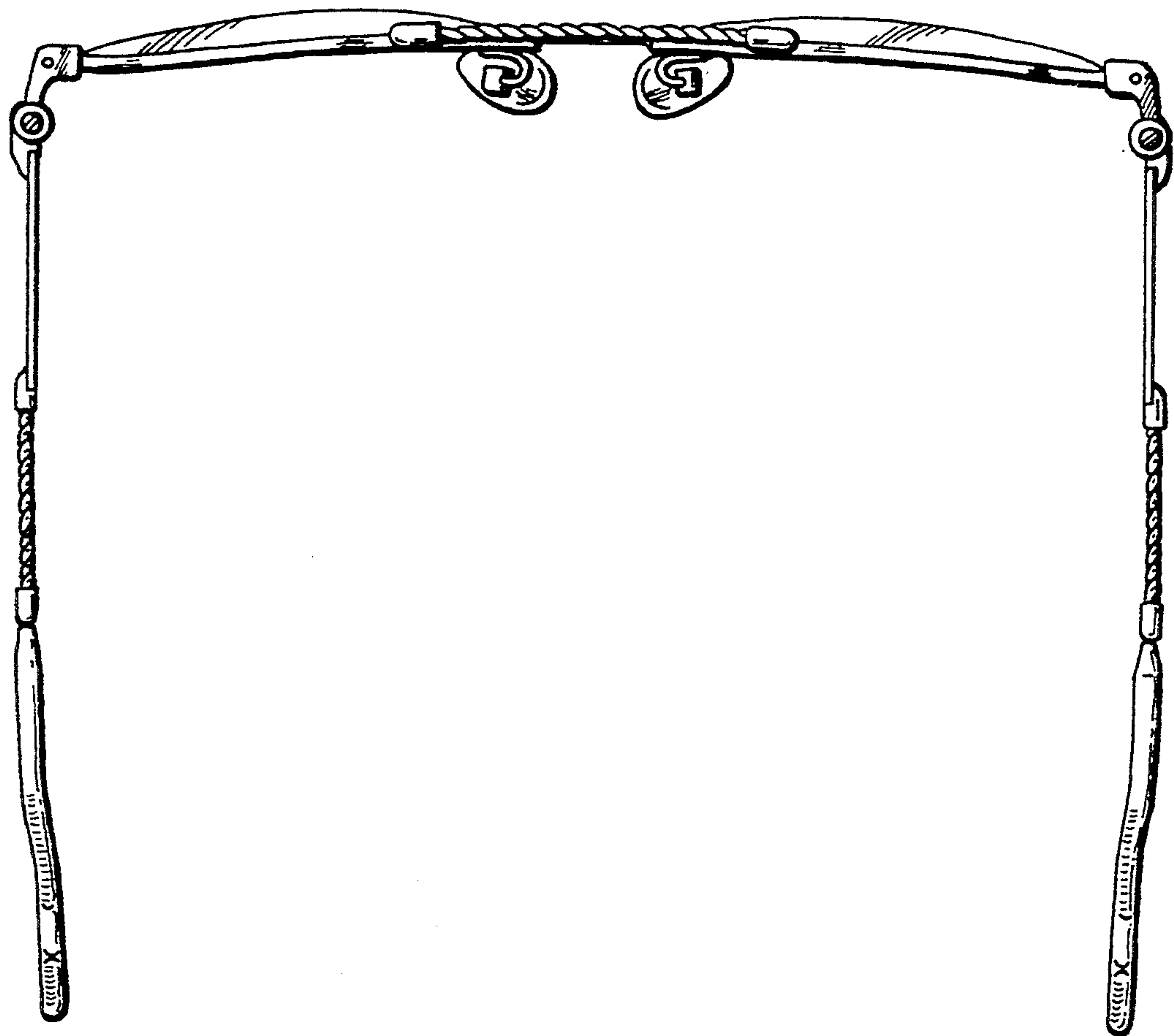
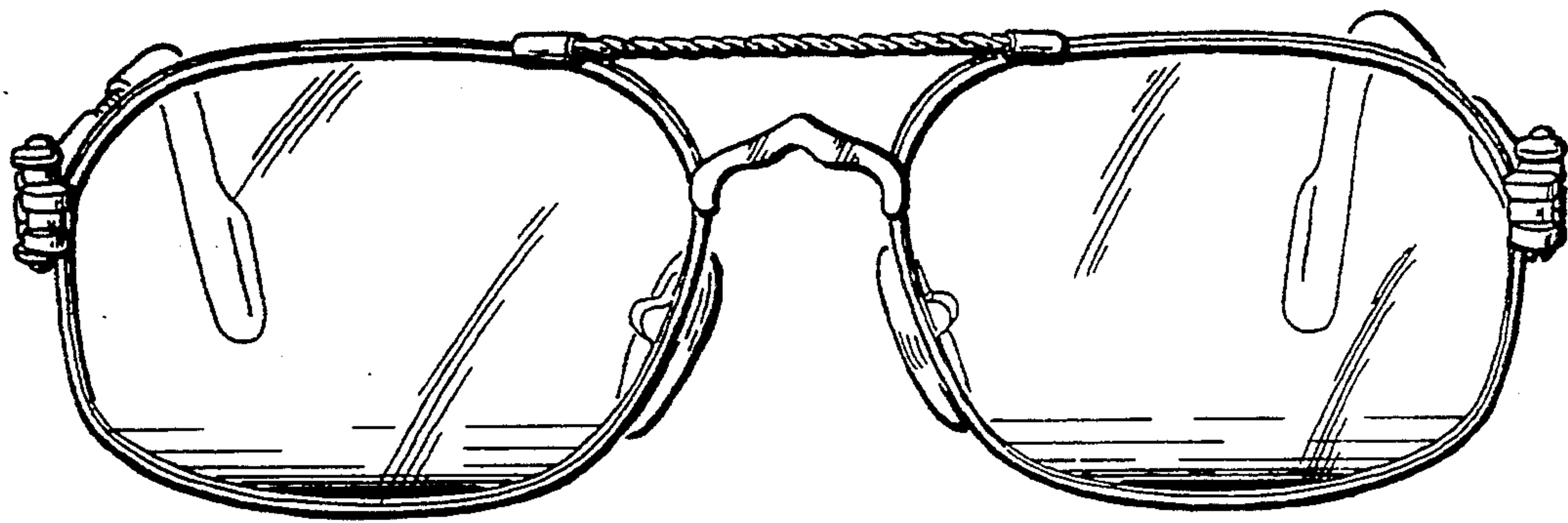
The ornamental design for glasses, as shown and described.

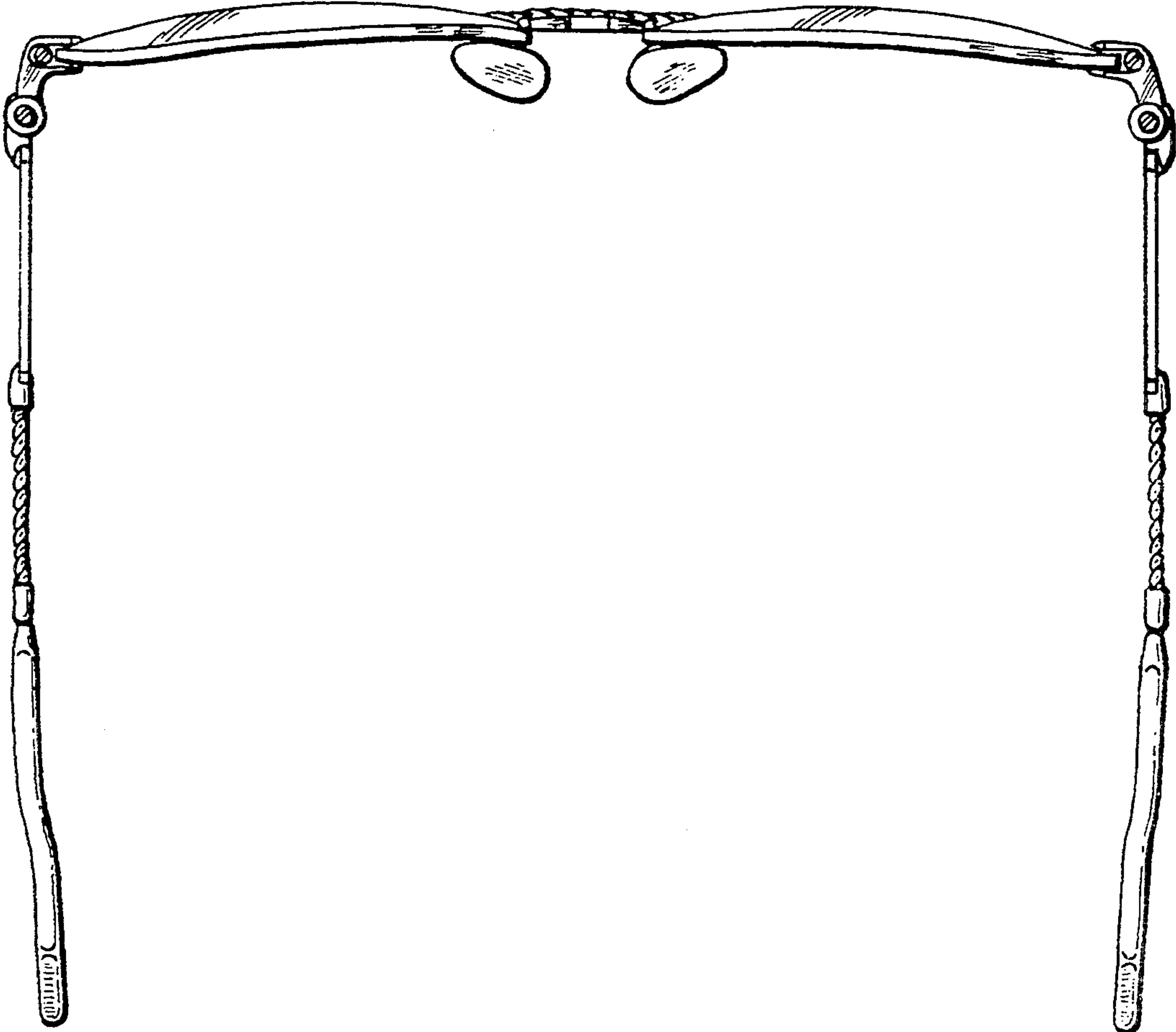
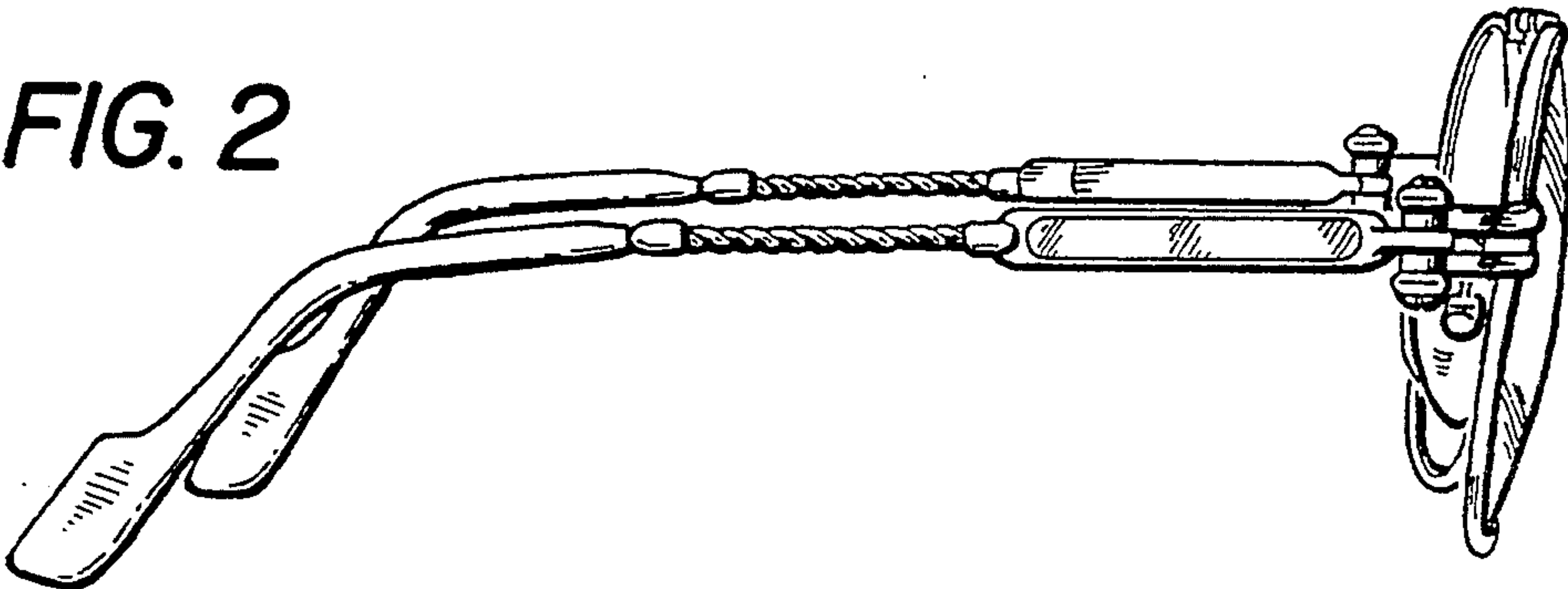
