
CLAIM

The ornamental design for a chandelier, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a chandelier showing our new design, the opposite side being identical; FIG. 2 is another side elevational view of said chandelier, as seen from a point directly facing the outer end of one of the arms of said fixture;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; and, FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.










