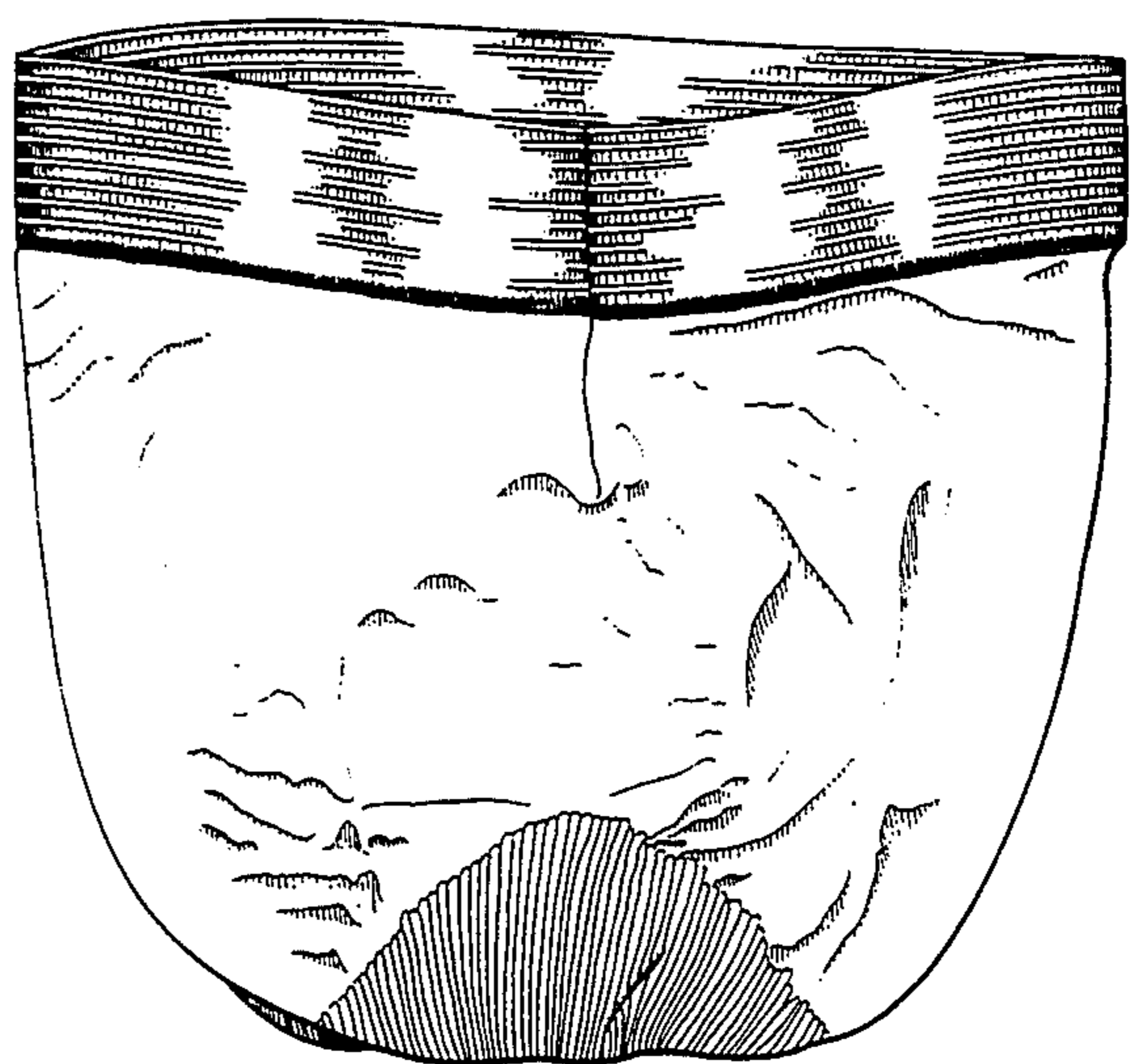
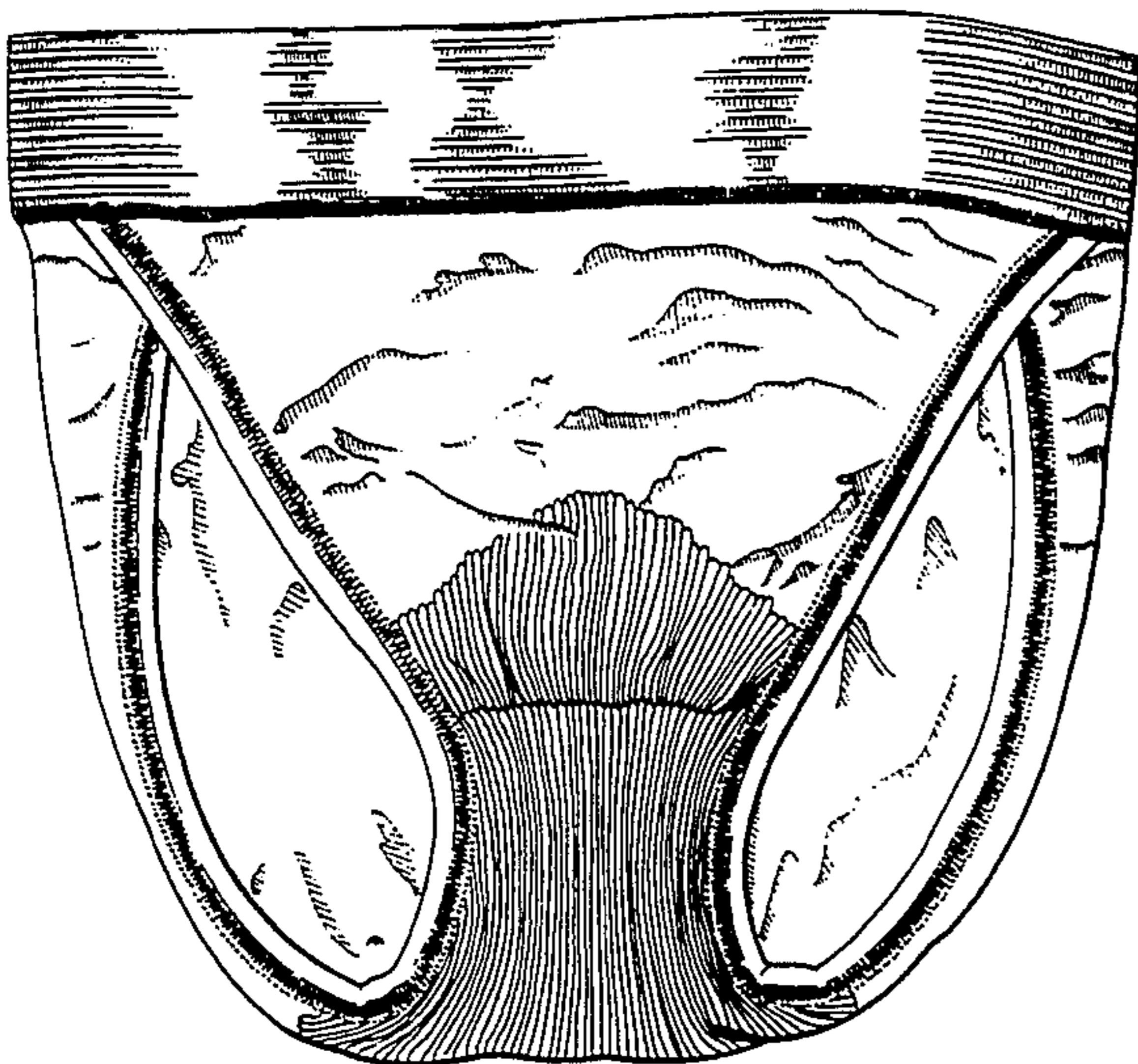
The ornamental design for a brief, as shown and described.

The broken lines shown in both Figures are understood to represent conventional stitching.



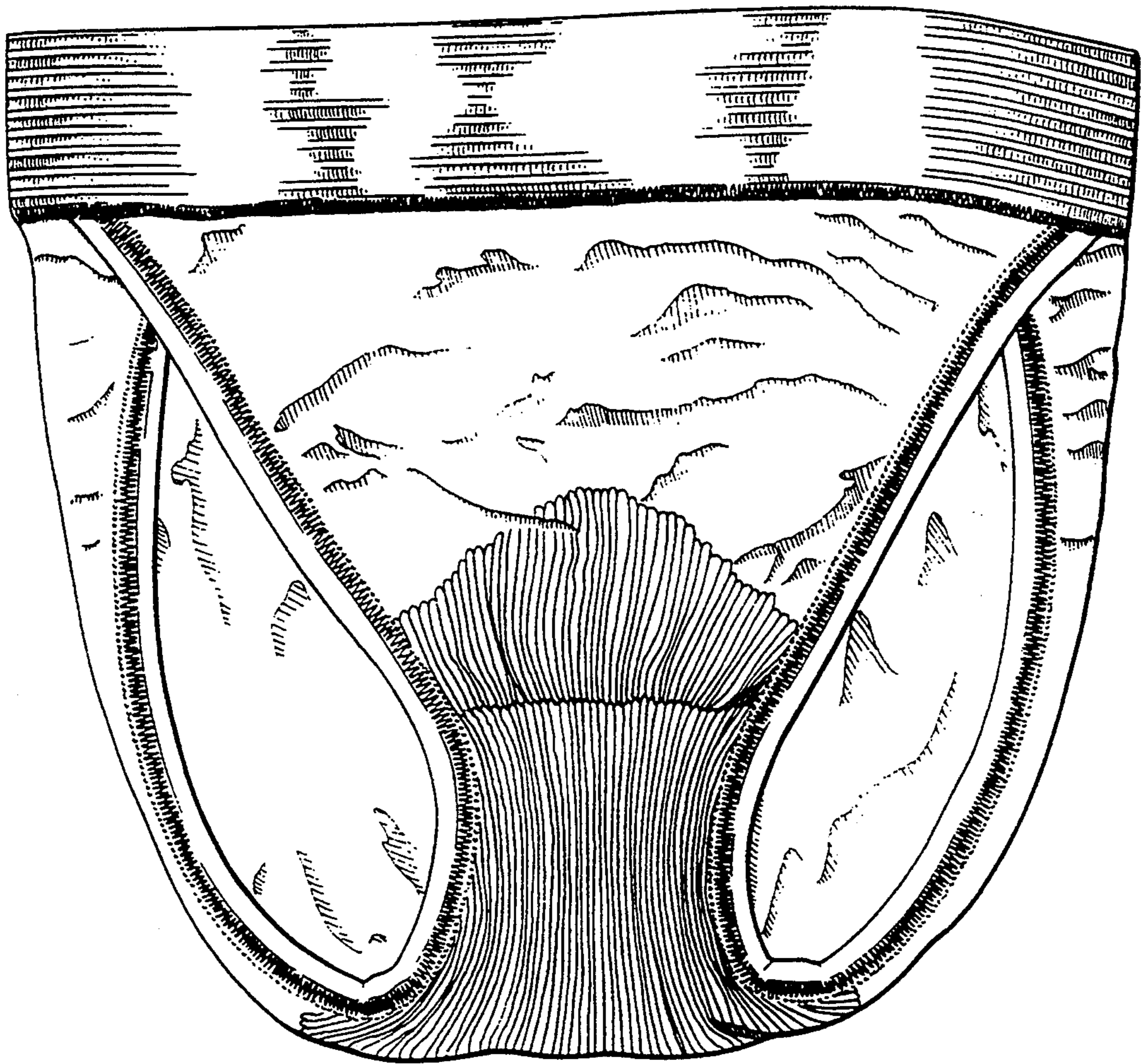

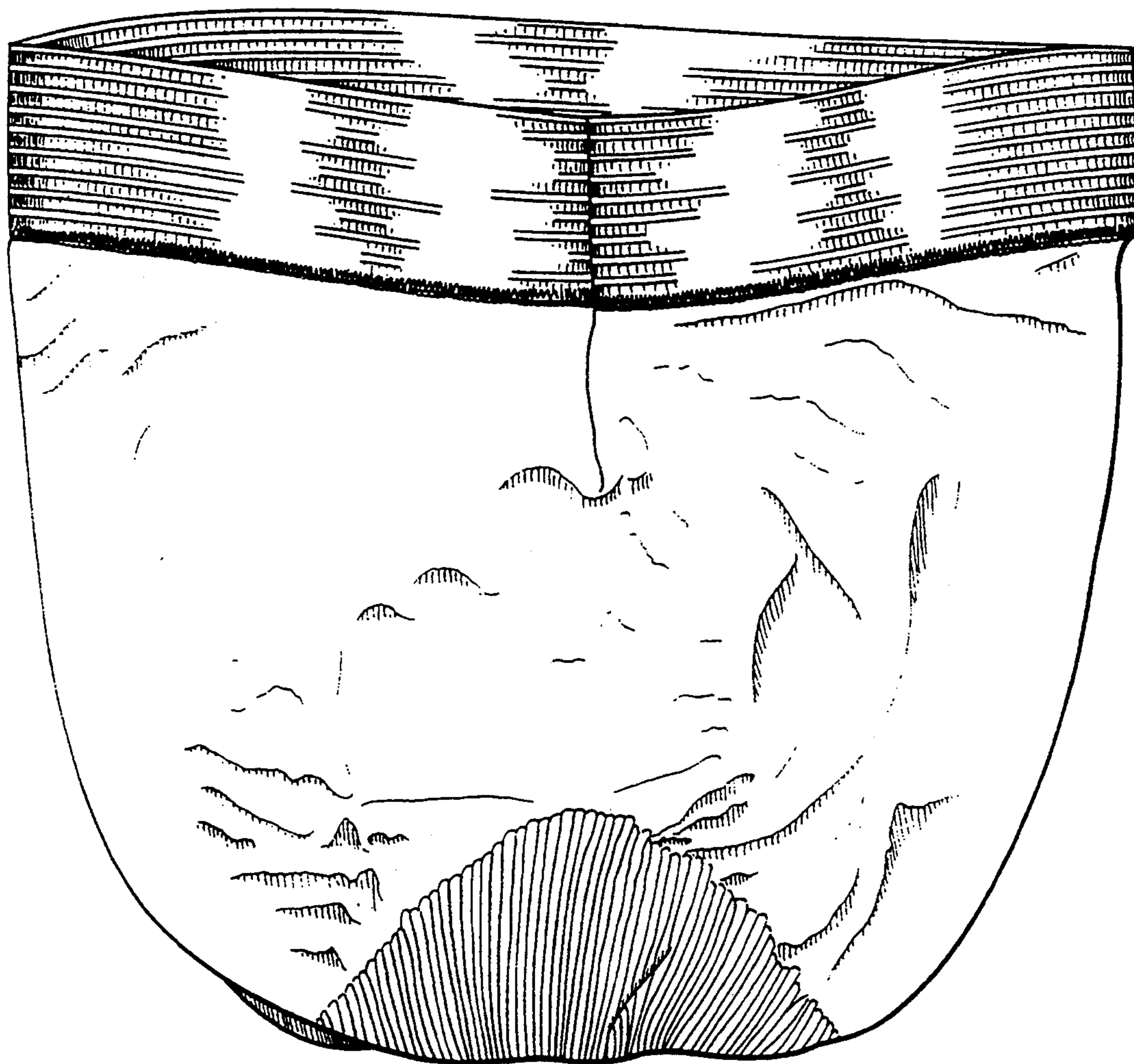
