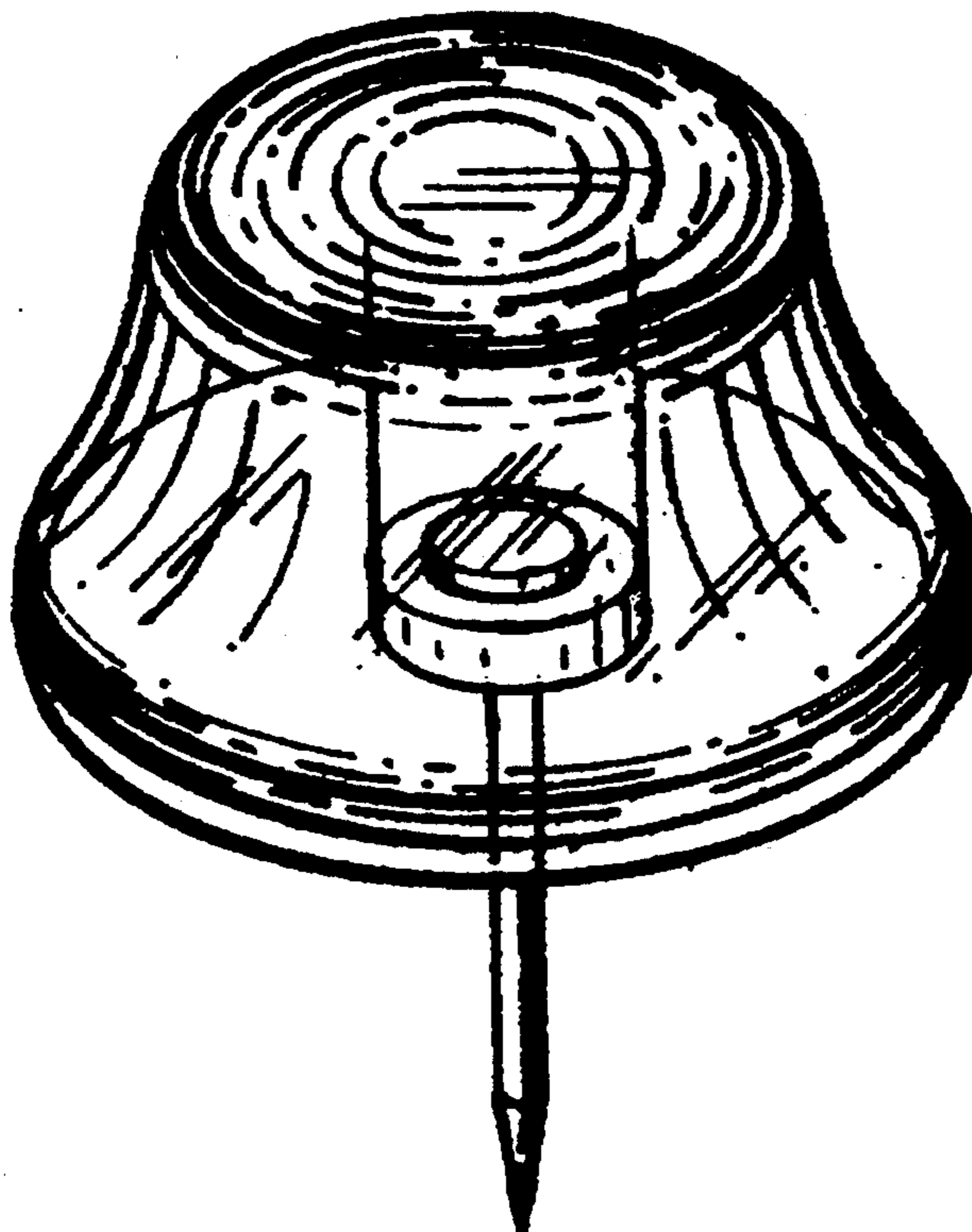

 FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof, with the opposite sides being a mirror image.



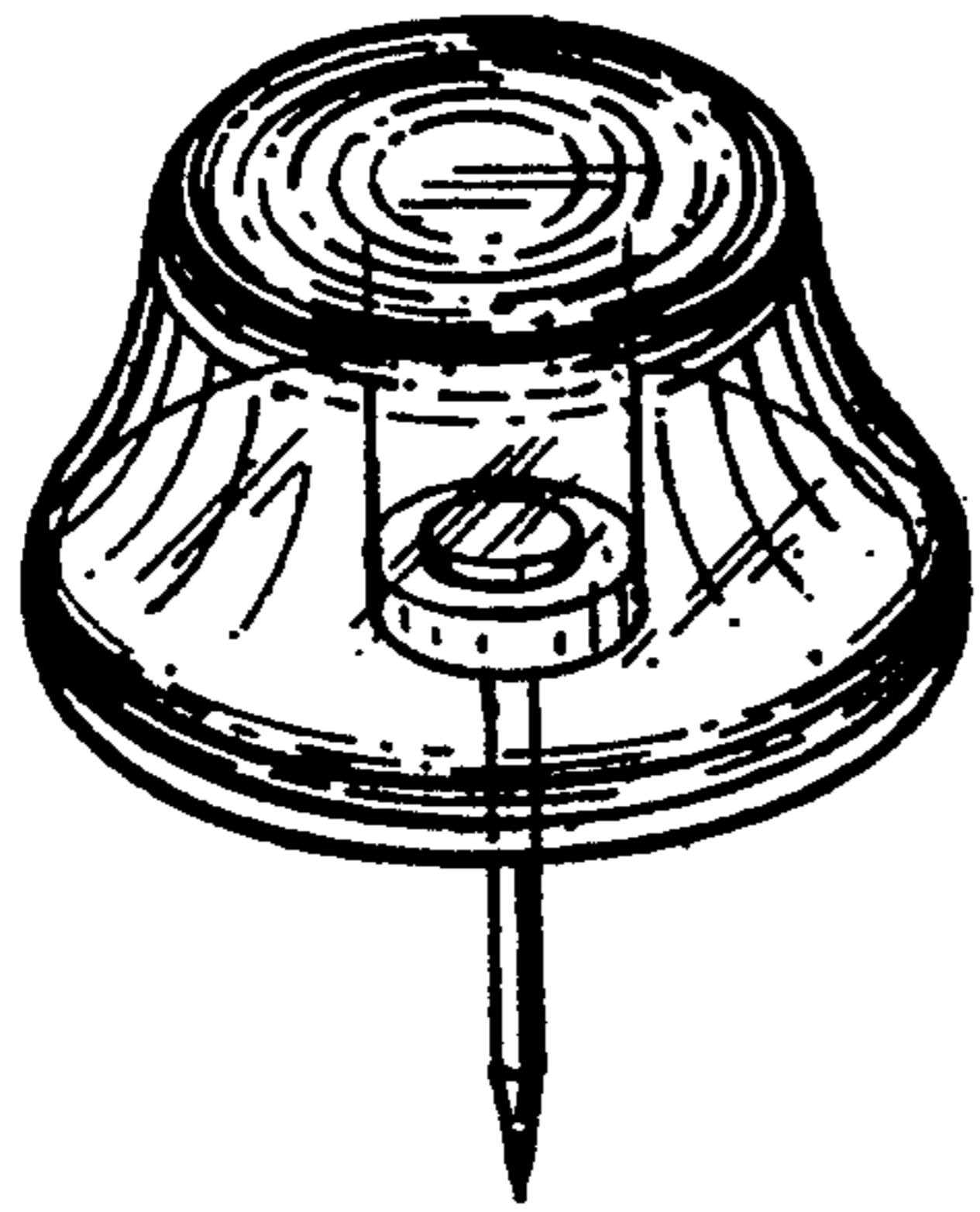

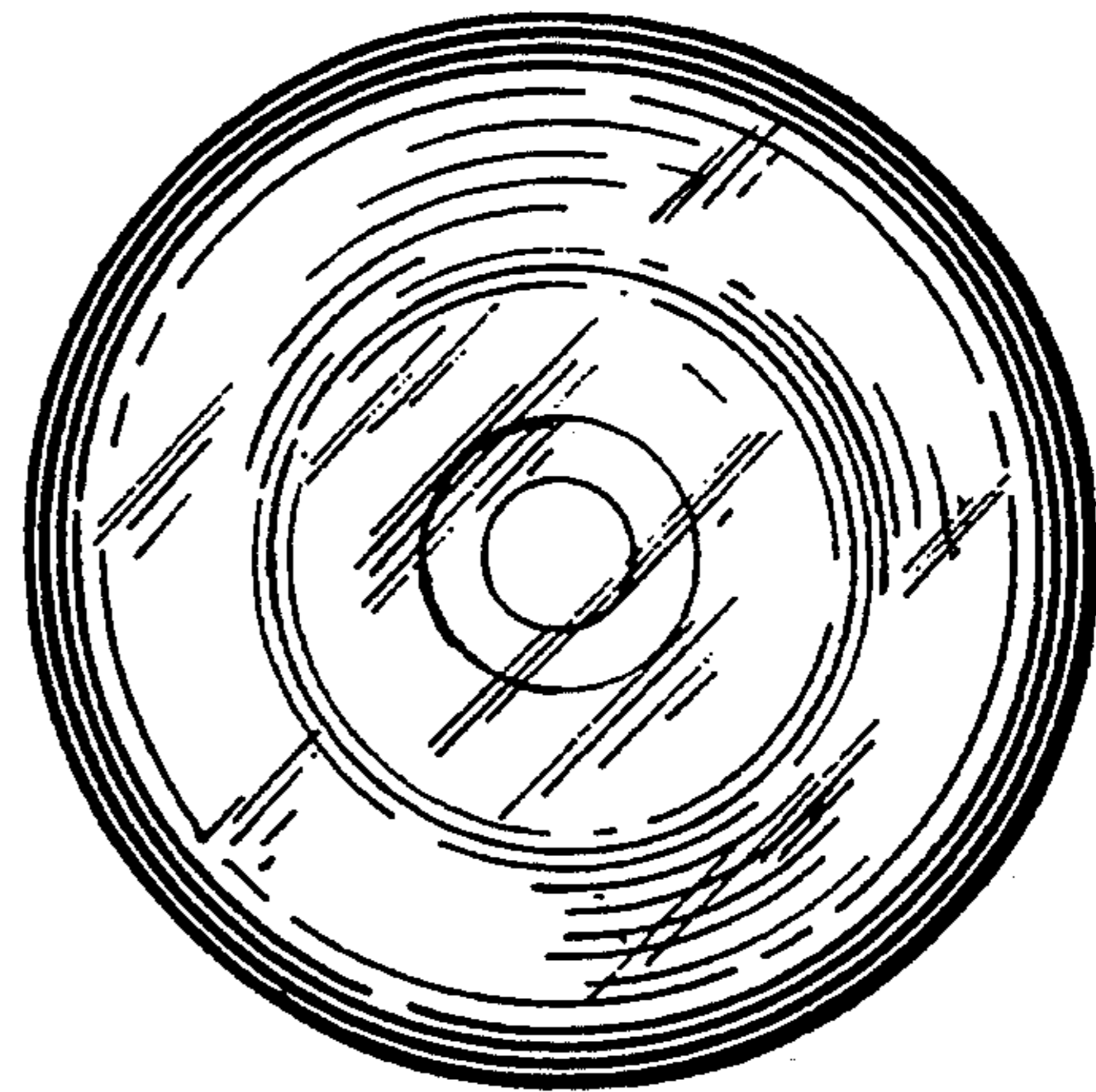

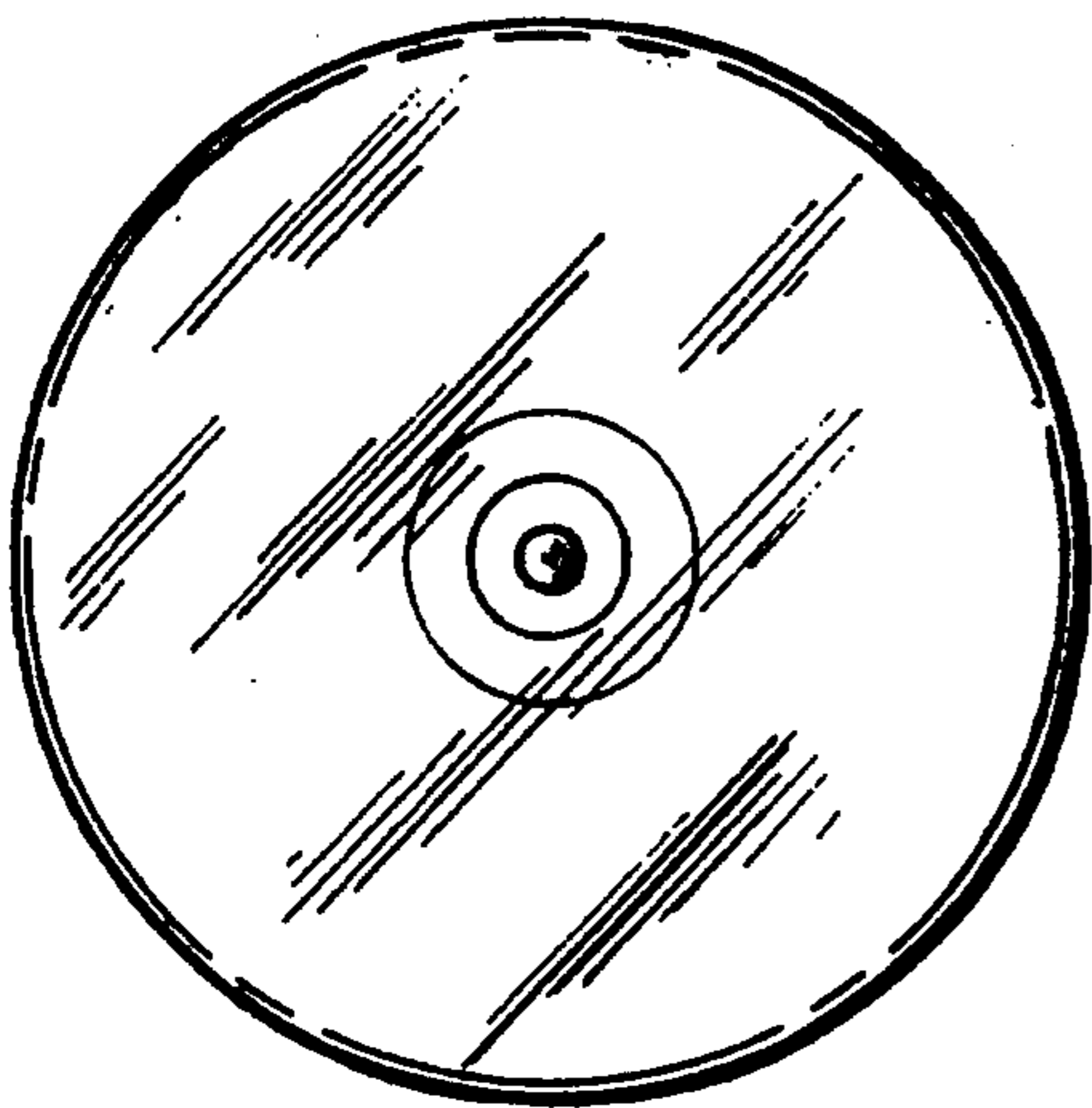

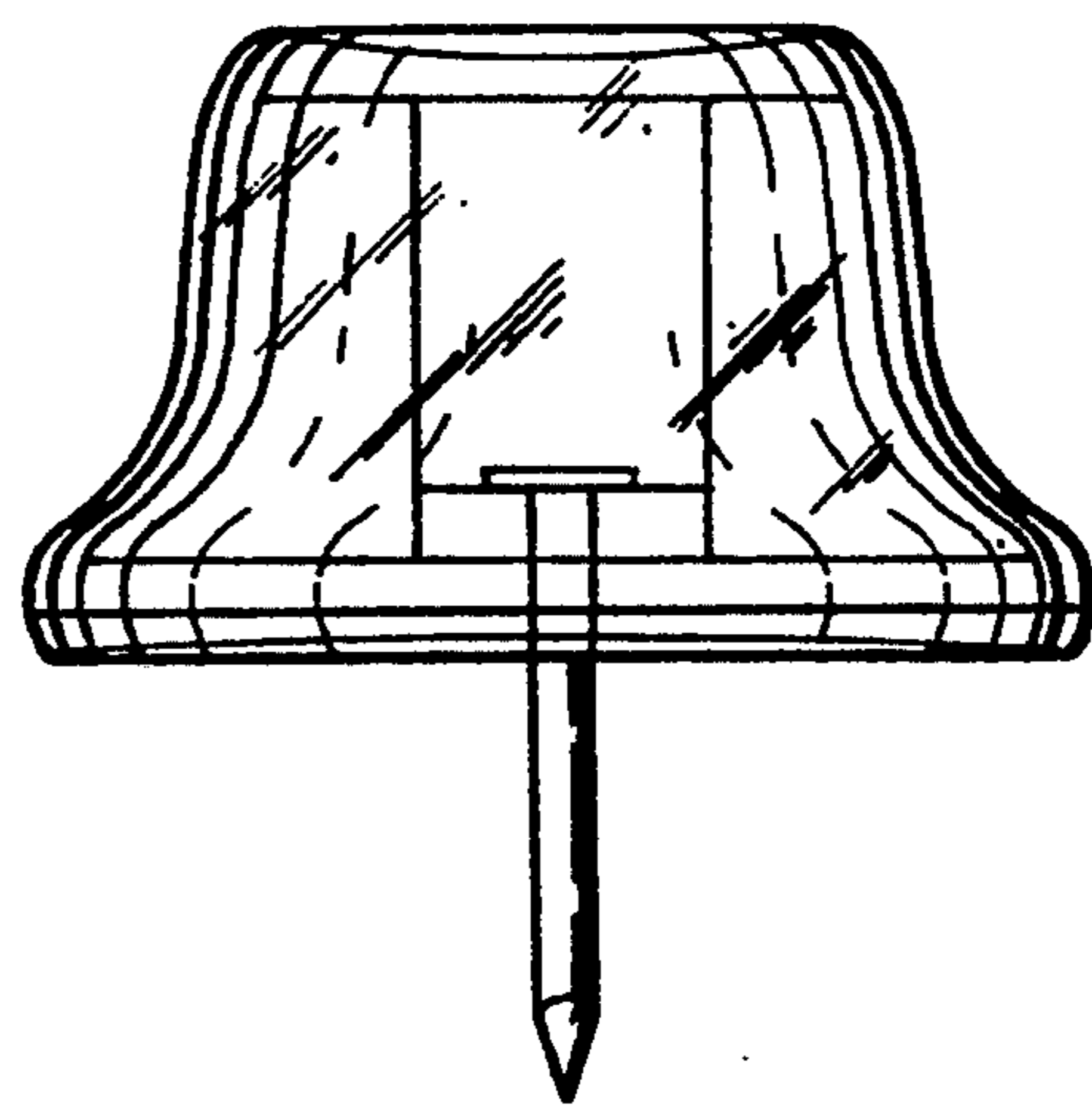
