FIG. 1 is a top right front perspective view of a sandbox showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof, in a reduced scale;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof, in reduced scale;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;

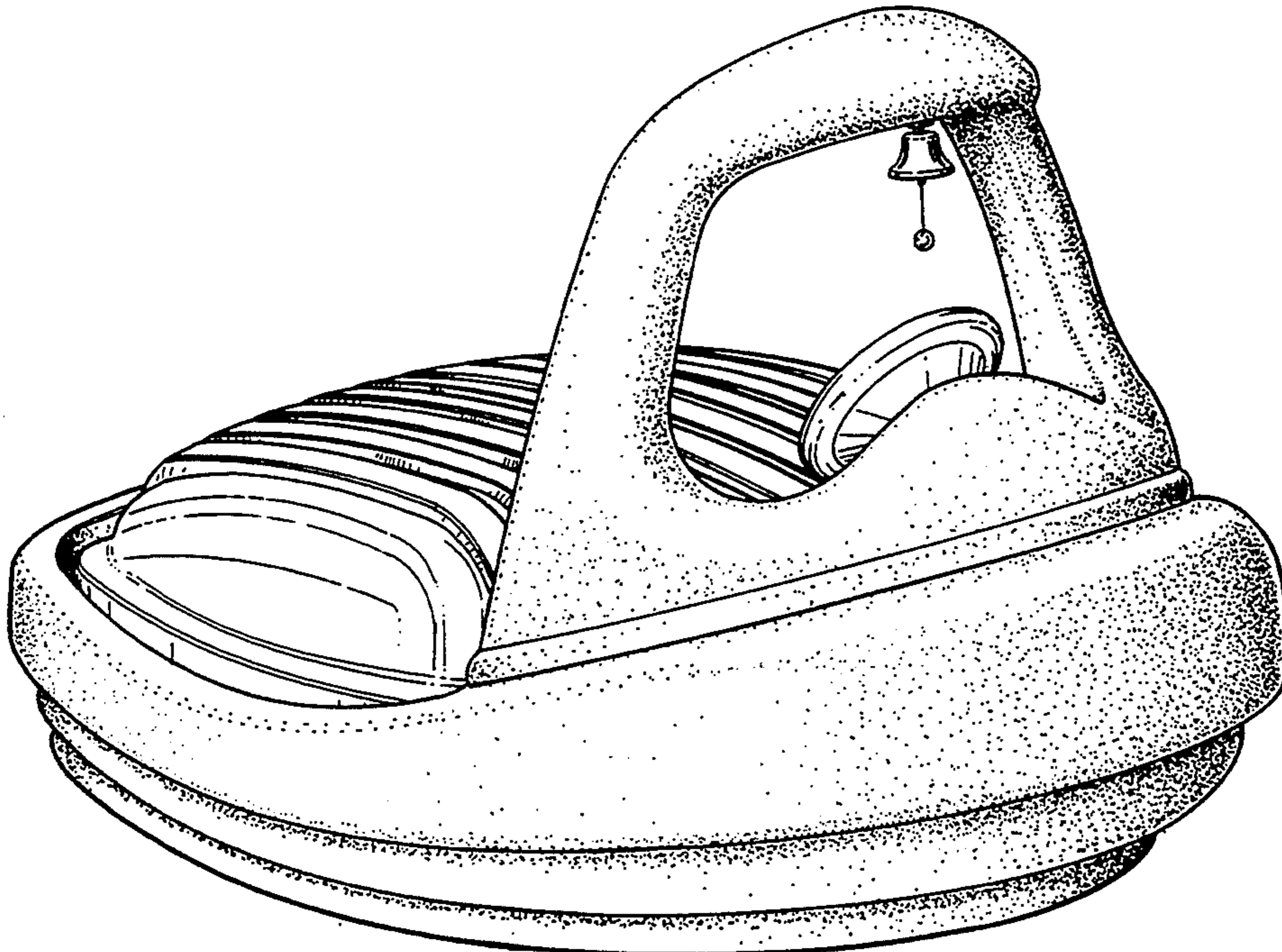
FIG. 6 is a side elevational view thereof; the opposite side being a mirror image;

FIG. 7 is a top right front perspective view of the base of the sandbox shown with the lid removed;

FIG. 8 is a right side elevational view of the sandbox base; the opposite side being a mirror image;

FIG. 10 is a top plan view of the sandbox base, in reduced scale.



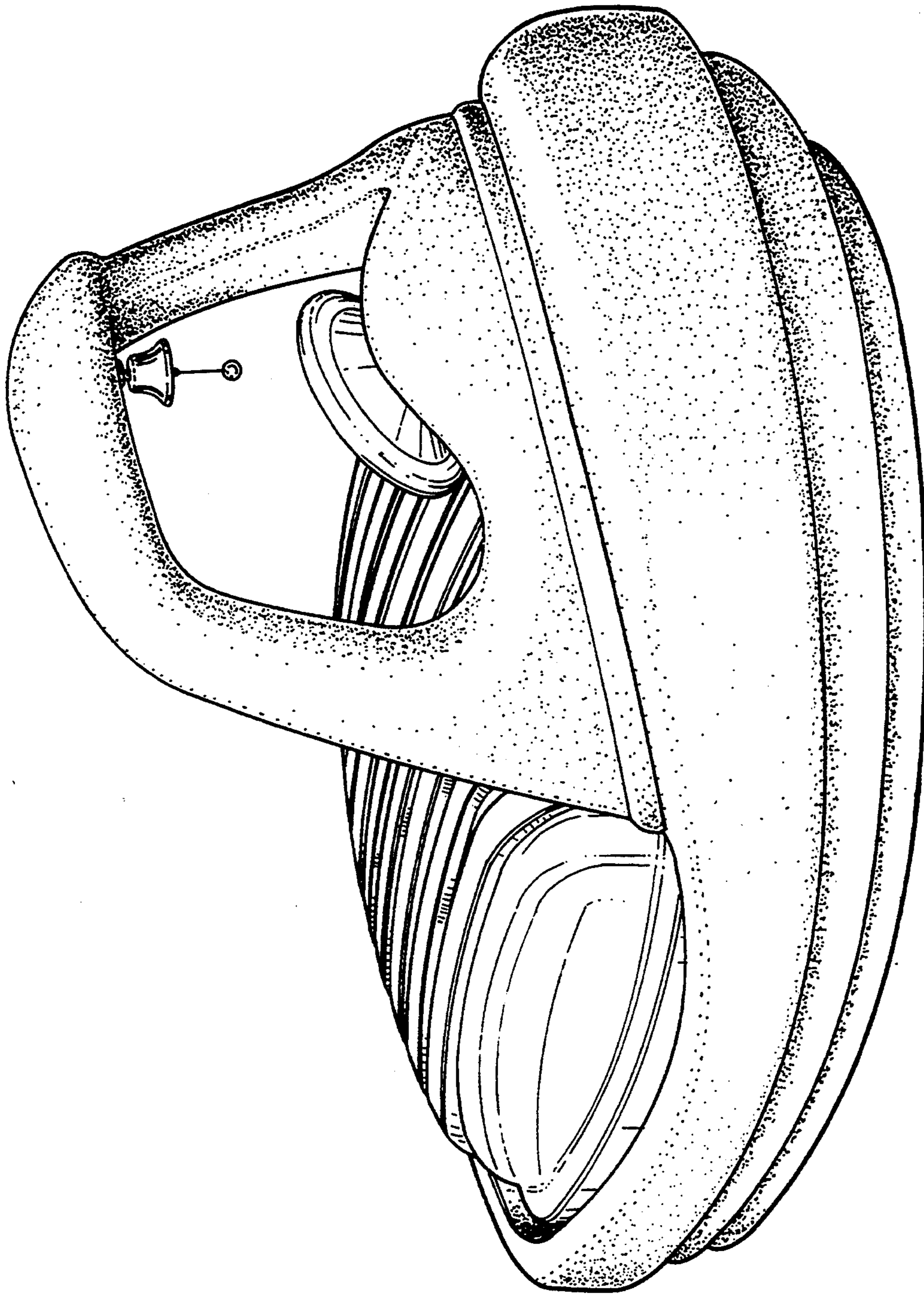

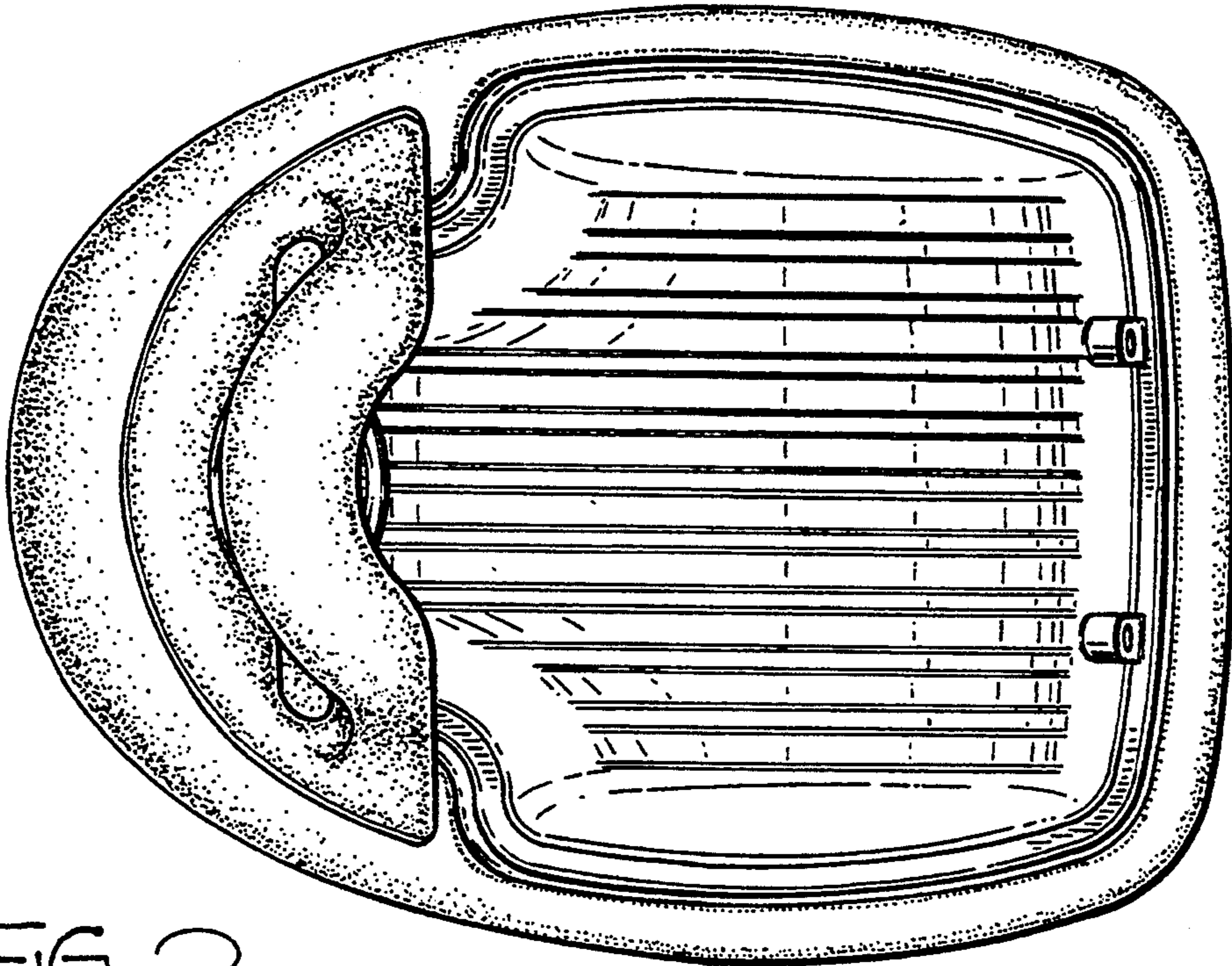

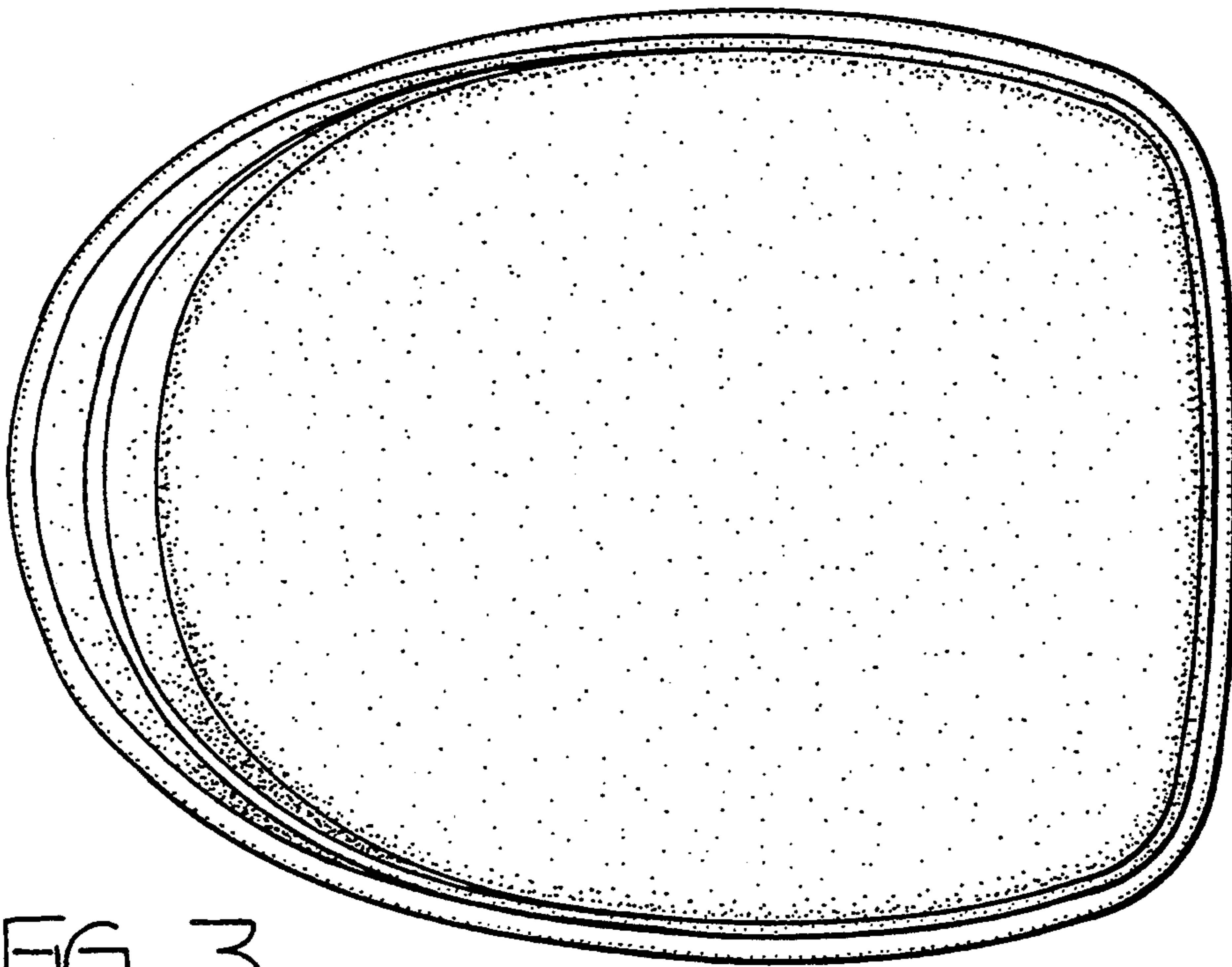

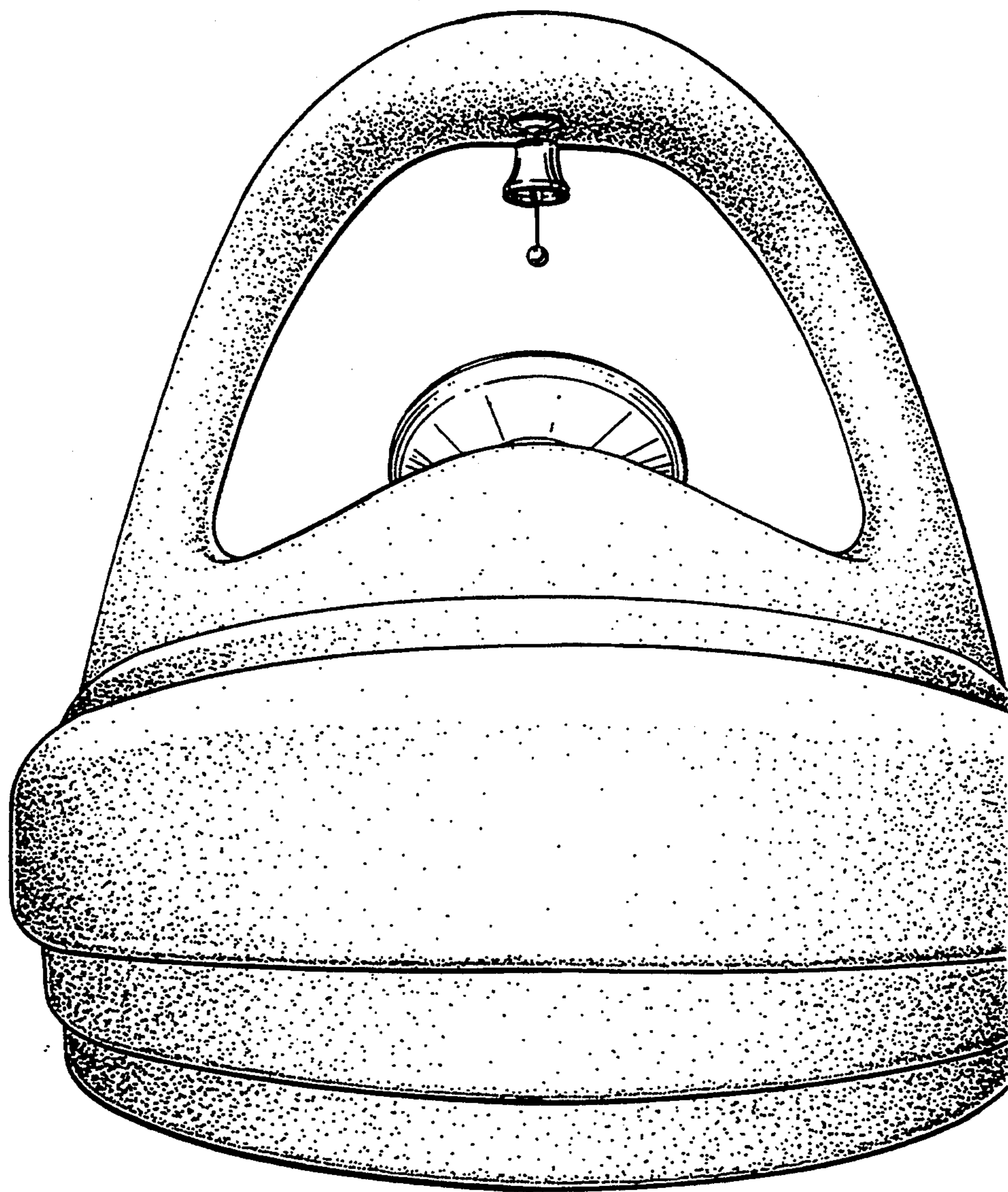

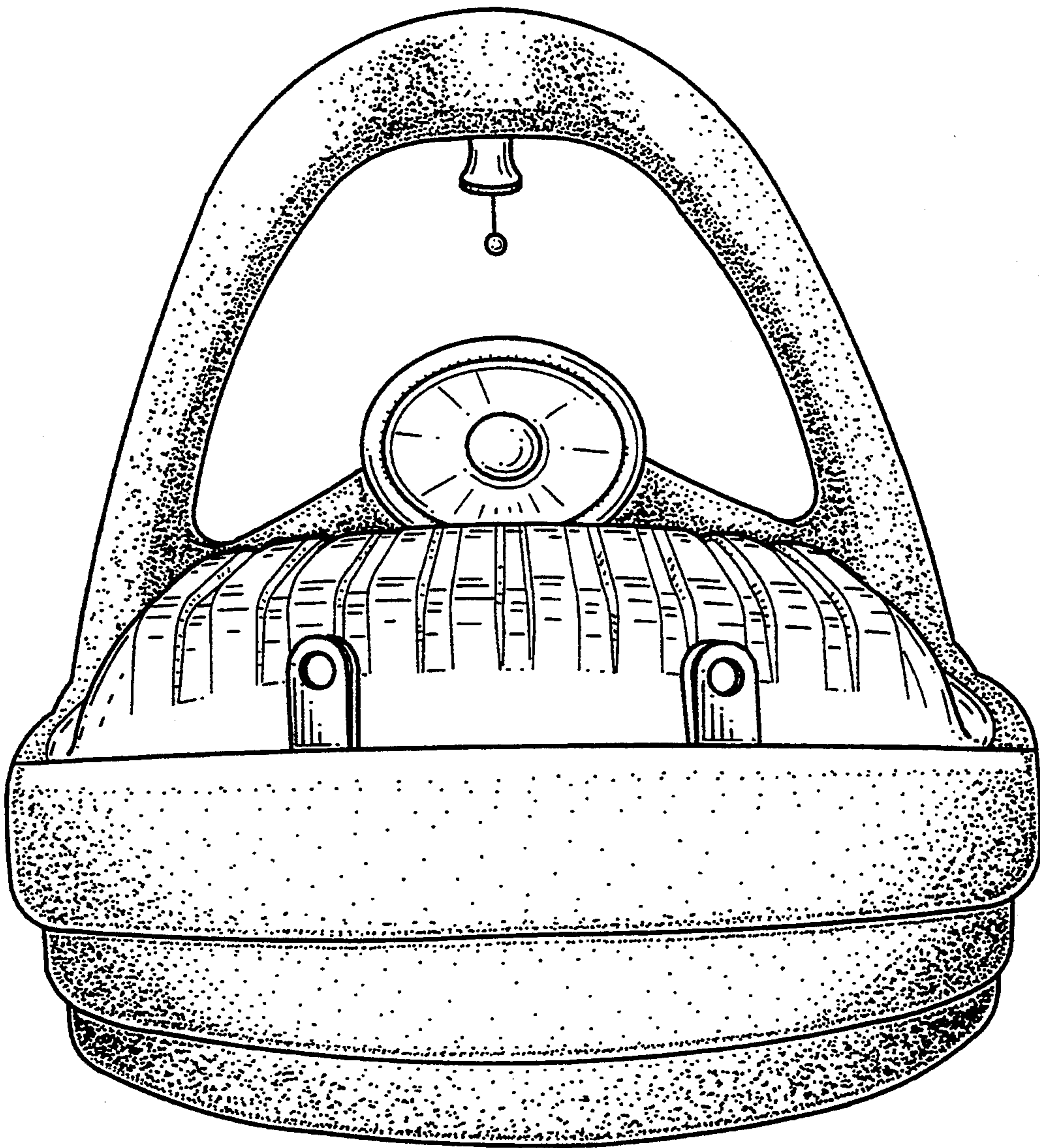

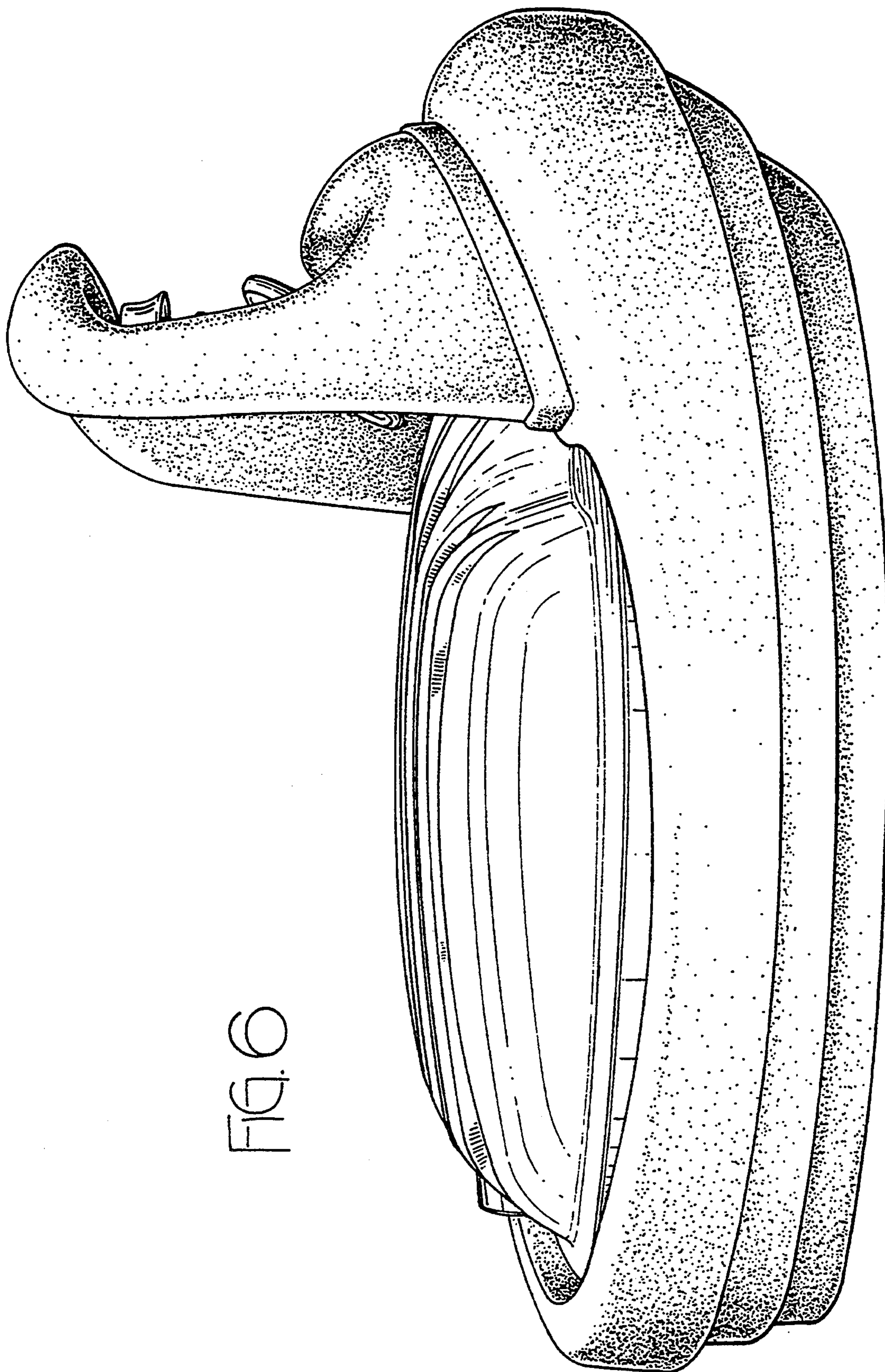

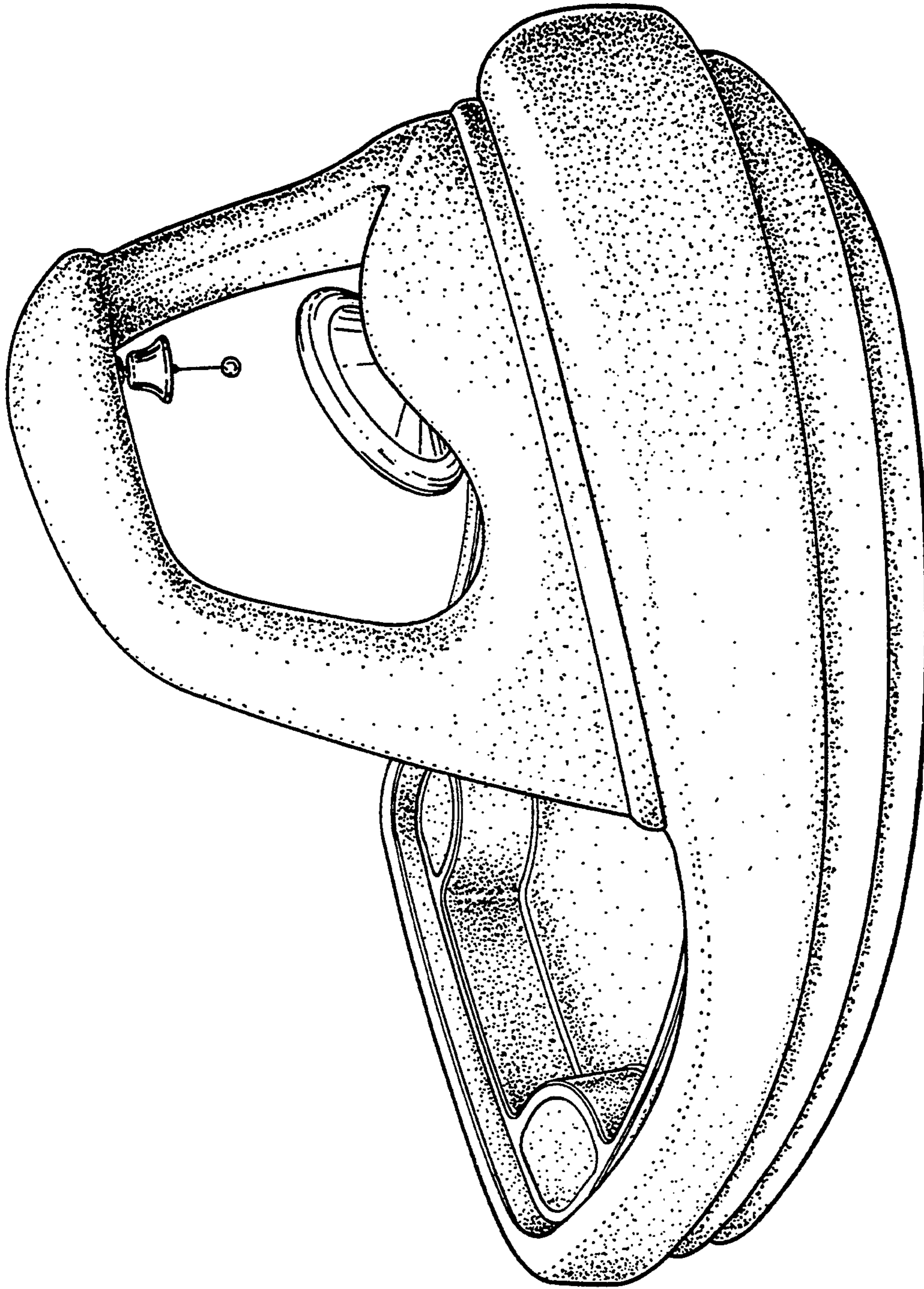

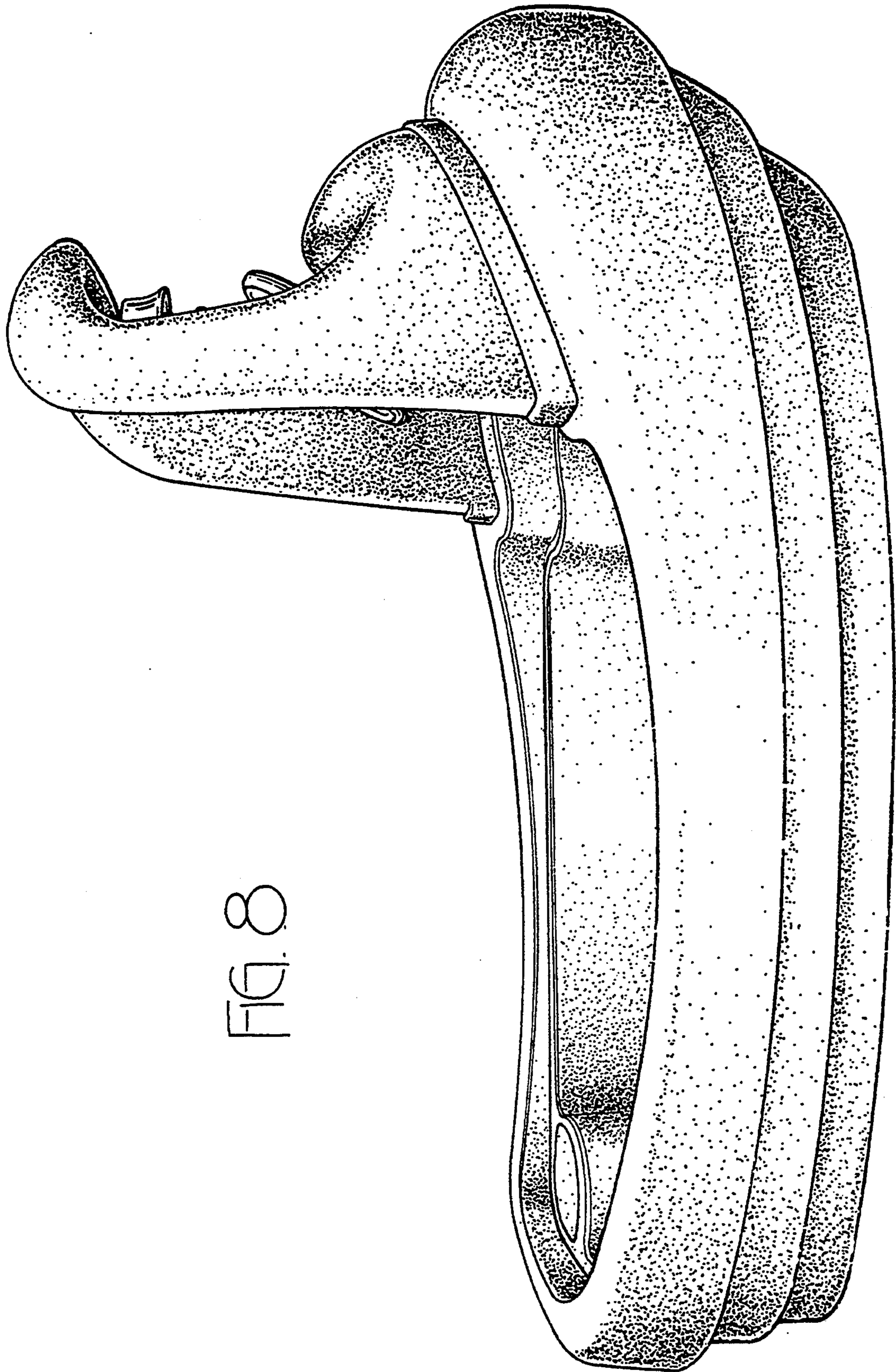

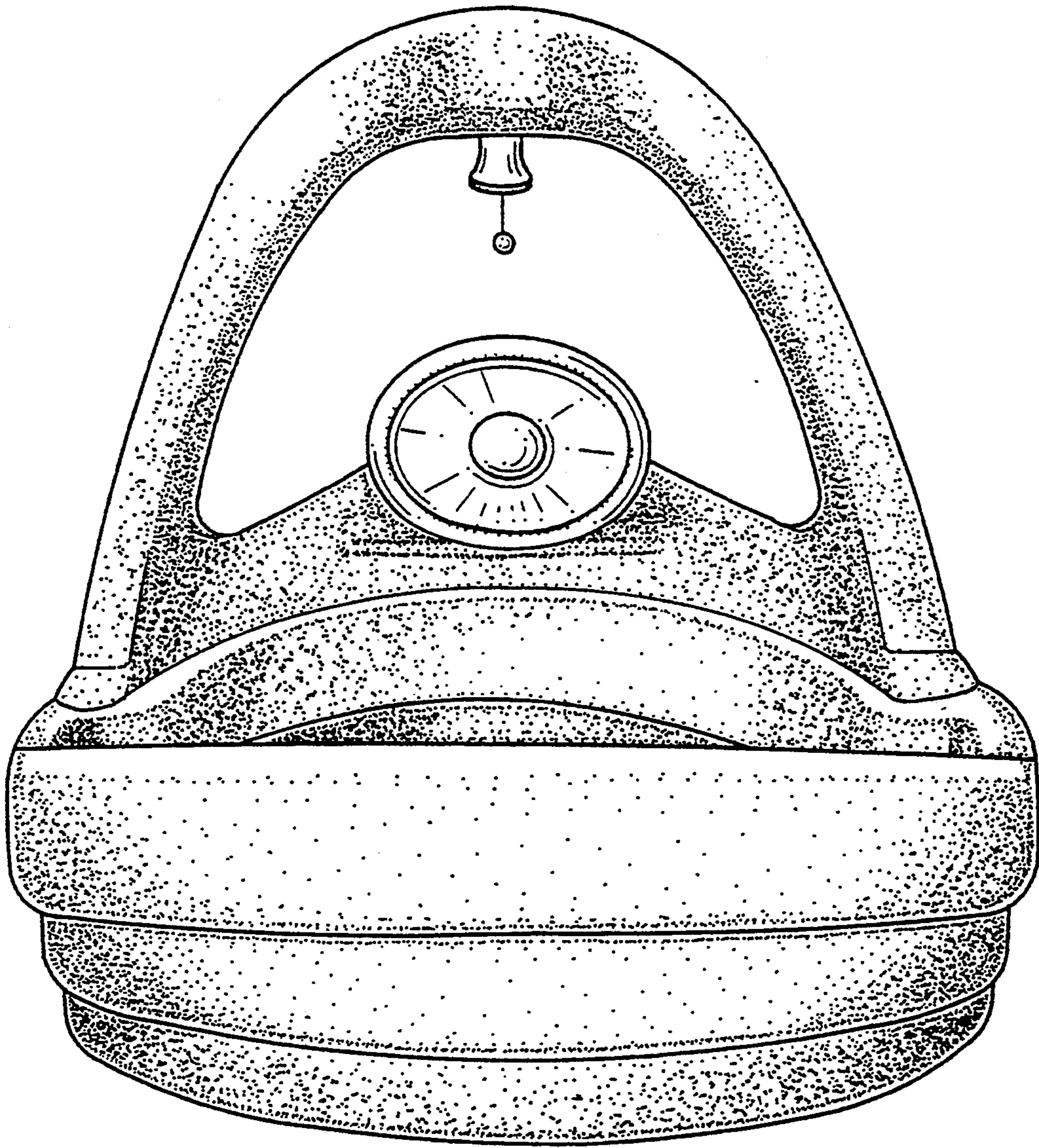

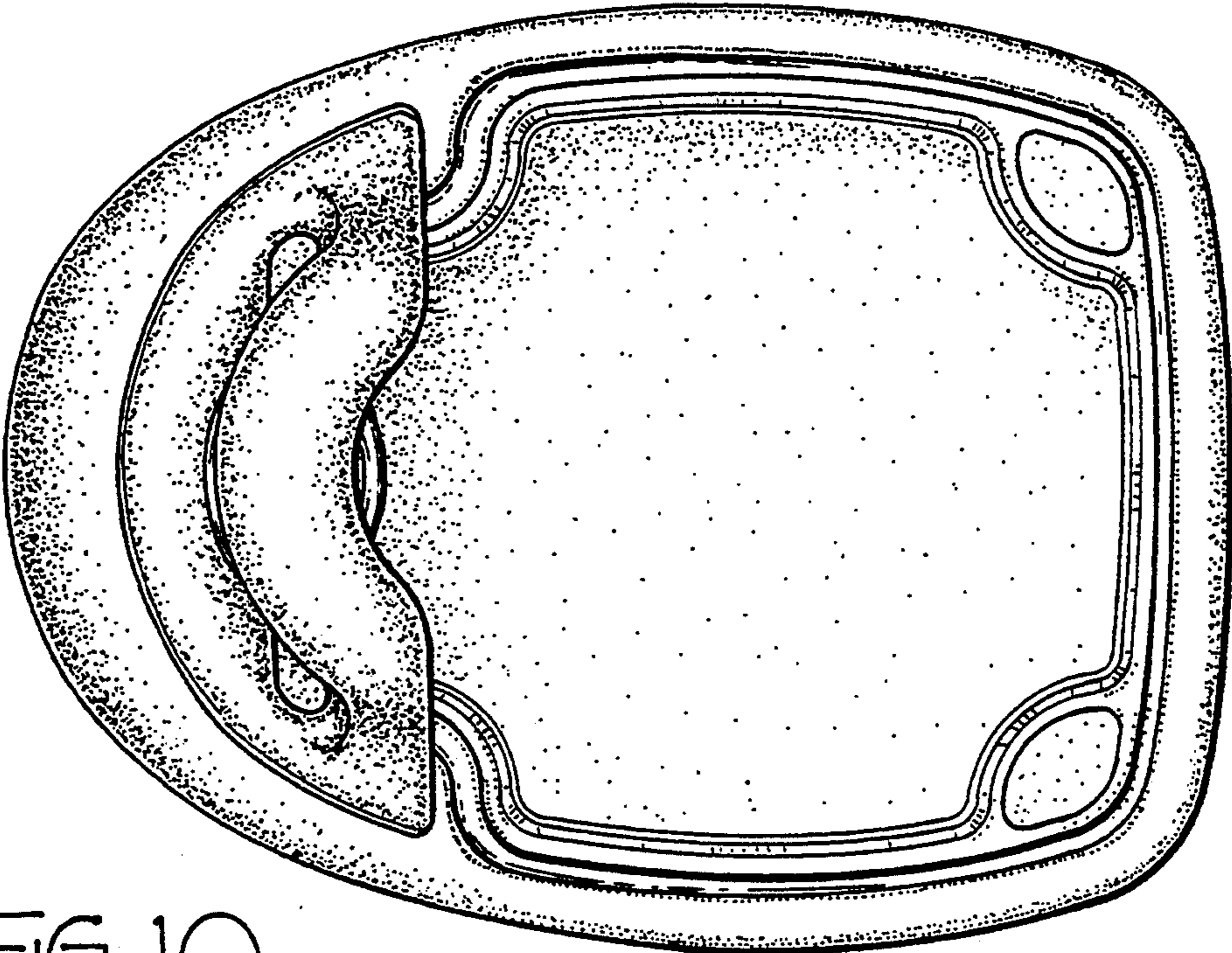
