**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a transverse connector for a spinal implant;  
FIG. 2 is another perspective view of the transverse connector for a spinal implant of FIG. 1;  
FIG. 3 is a top view of the transverse connector for a spinal implant of FIG. 1;  
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of the transverse connector for a spinal implant of FIG. 1;  
FIG. 5 is a side view of the transverse connector for a spinal implant of FIG. 1;  
FIG. 6 is a side view of the transverse connector for a spinal implant thereof, opposite that shown in FIG. 5;  
FIG. 7 is an end view of the transverse connector for a spinal implant of FIG. 1; and,  
FIG. 8 is an end view of the transverse connector for a spinal implant thereof, opposite that shown in FIG. 7.
