[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a warning signal for diverting animals away from moving vehicles, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a reduced perspective view of the warning signal for diverting animals away from moving vehicles showing our new ornamental design therefor; FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof with the opposite side being a mirror image; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and, FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

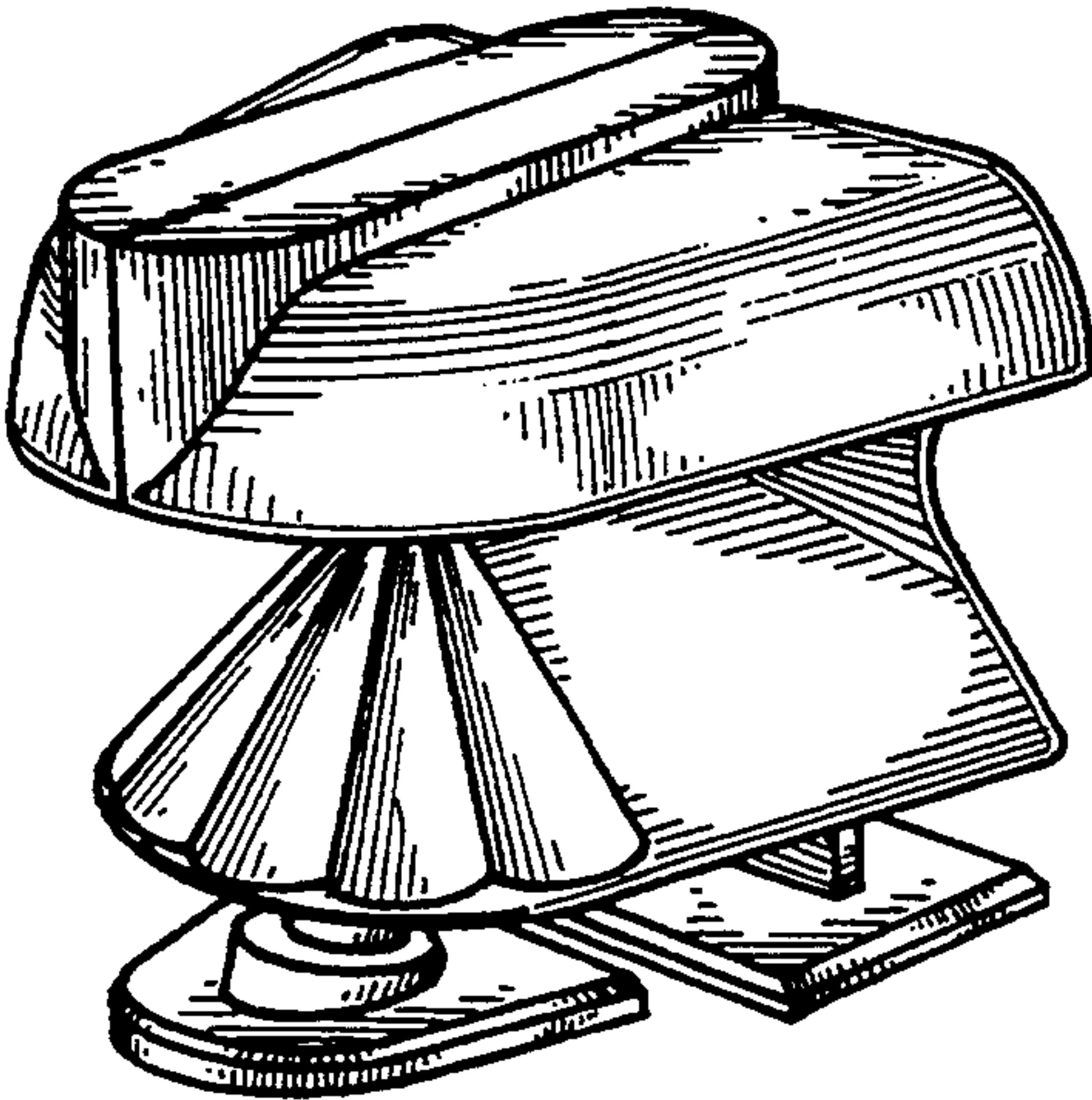

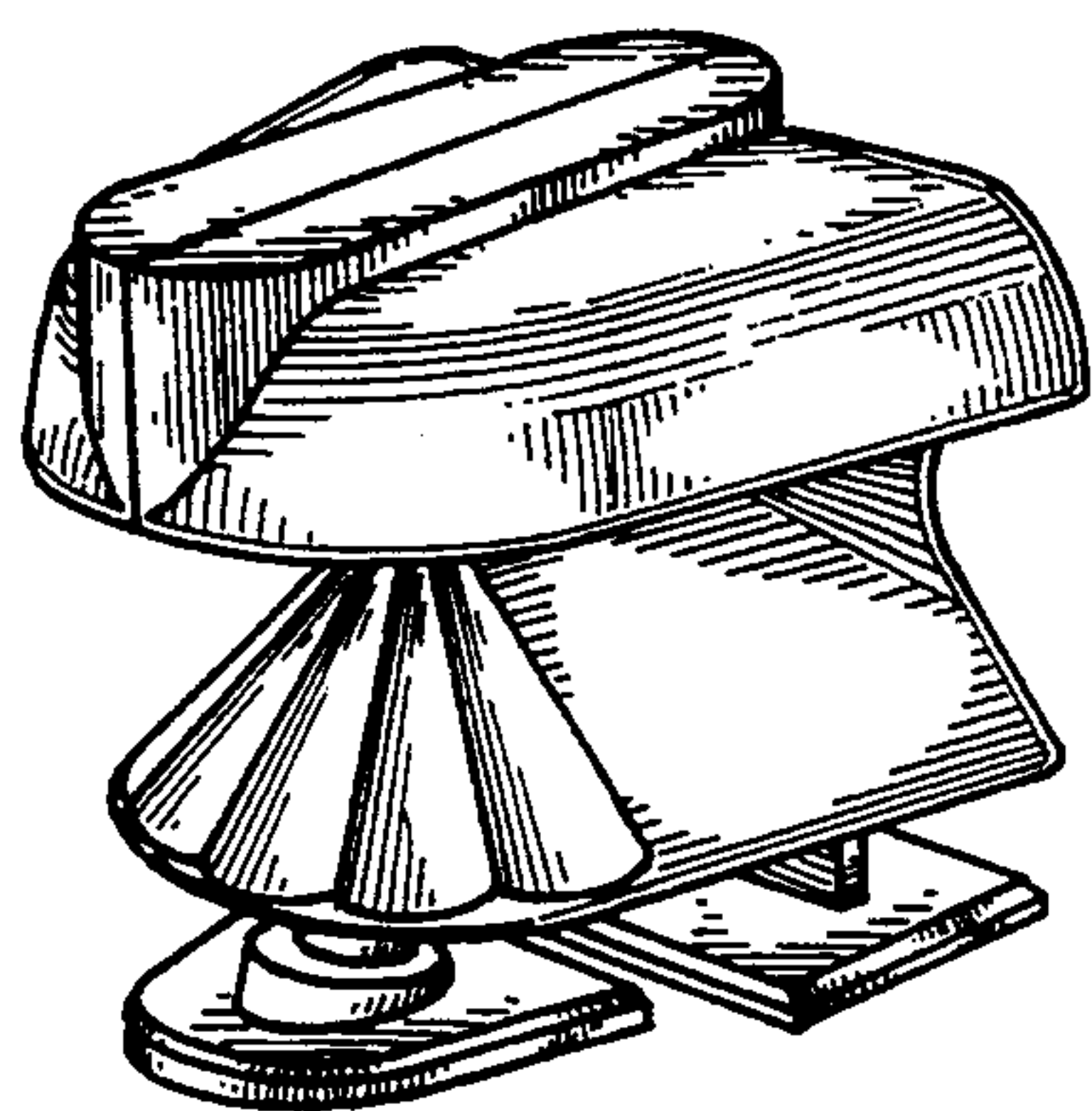

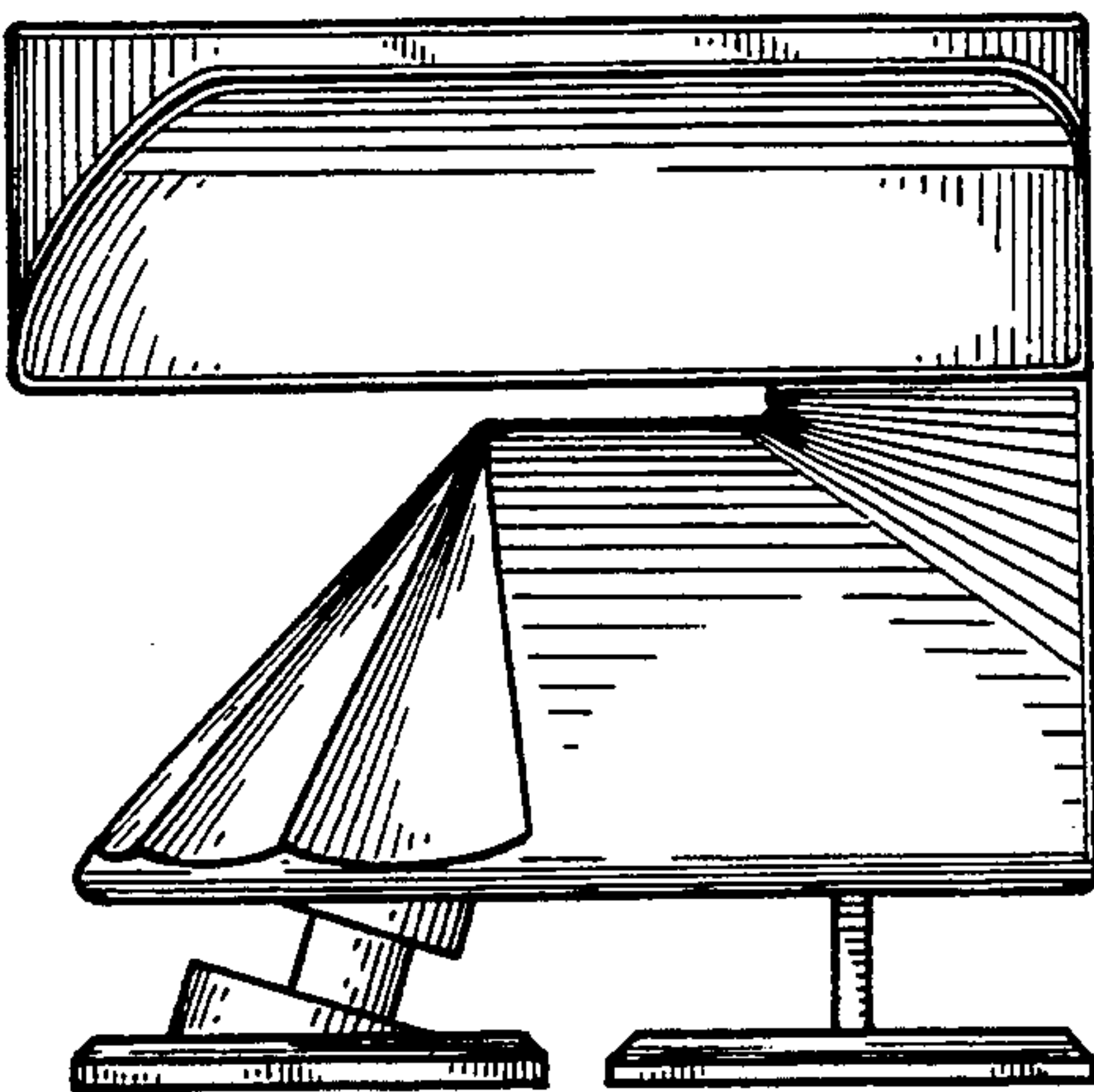

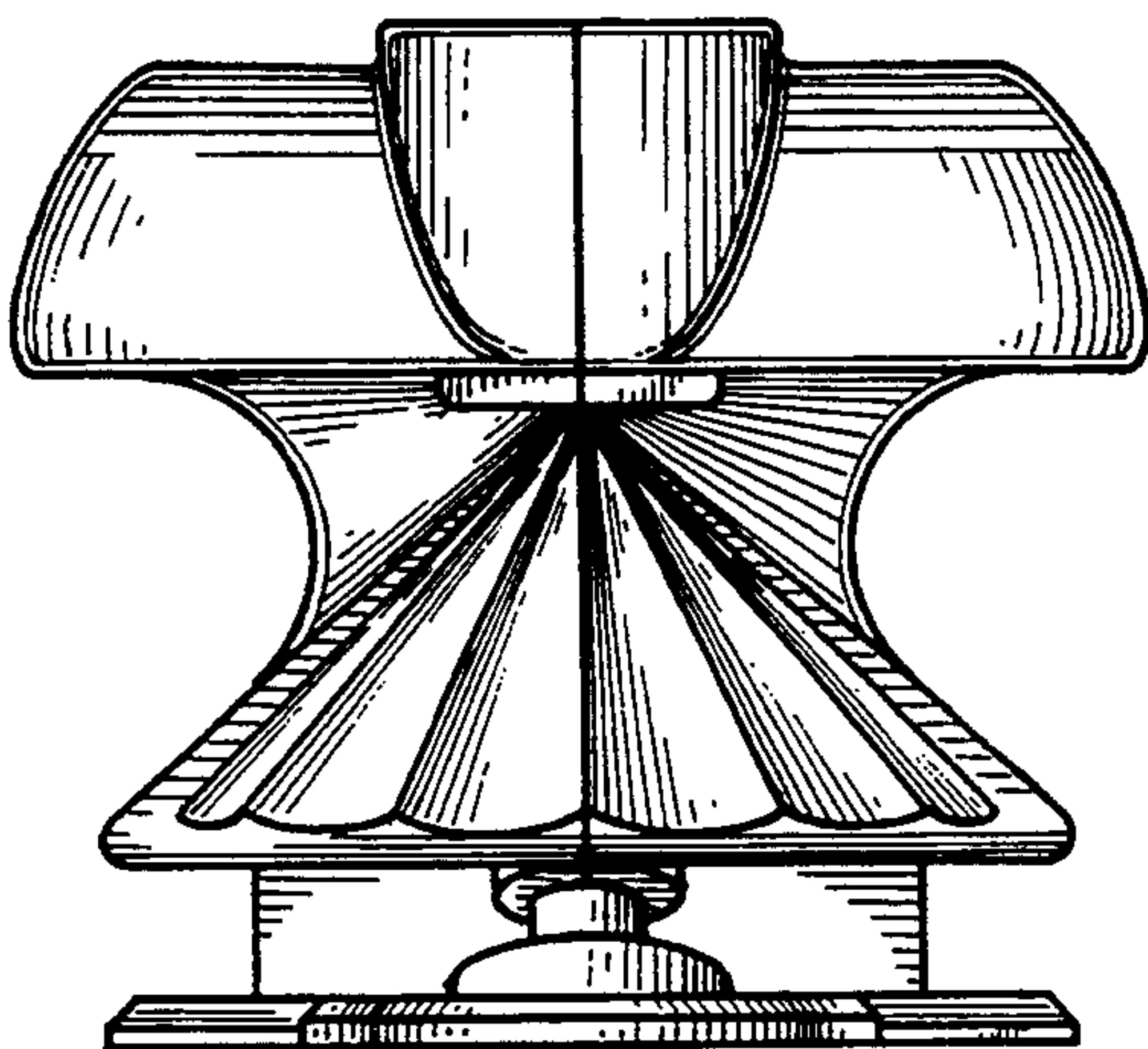

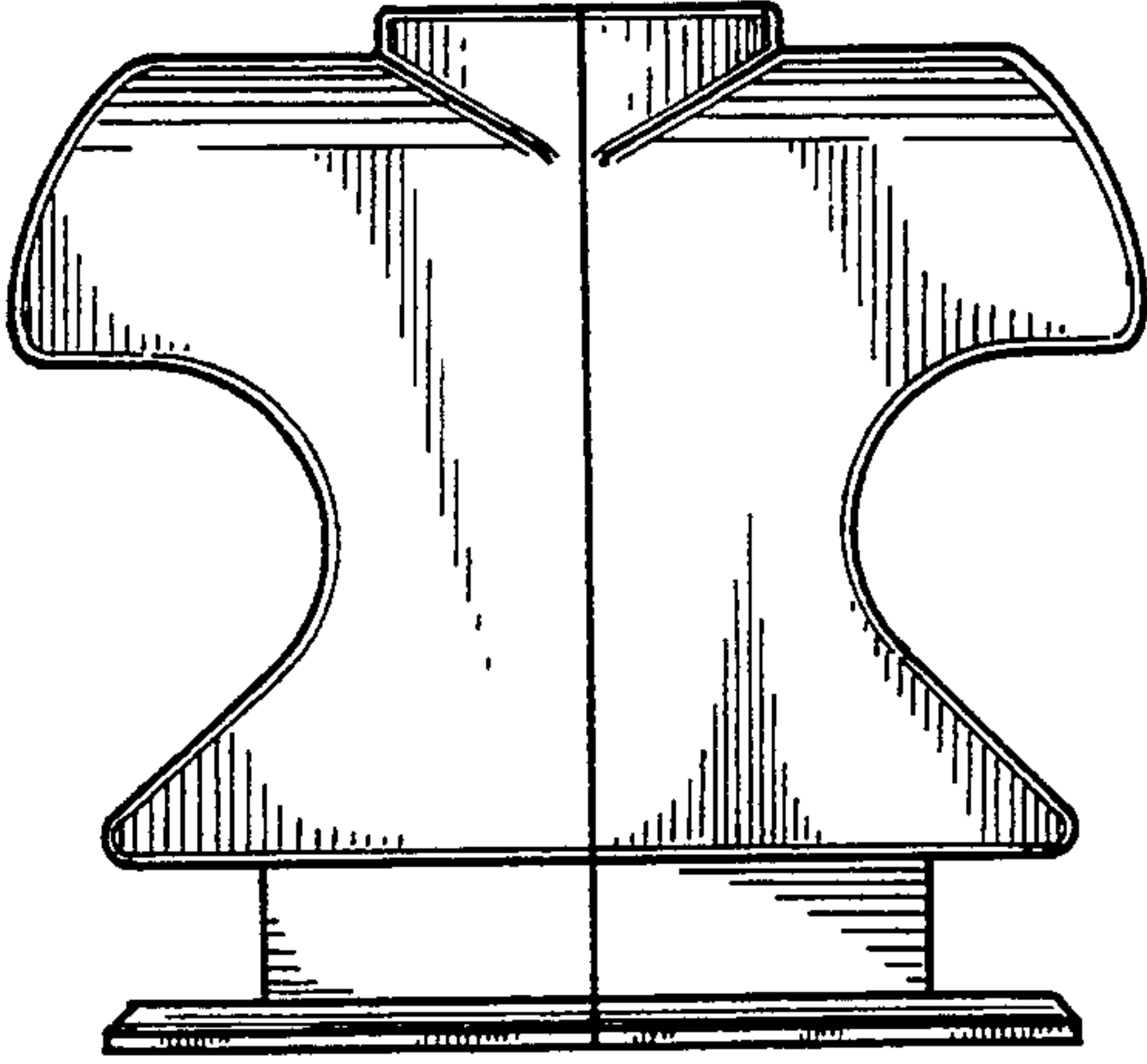

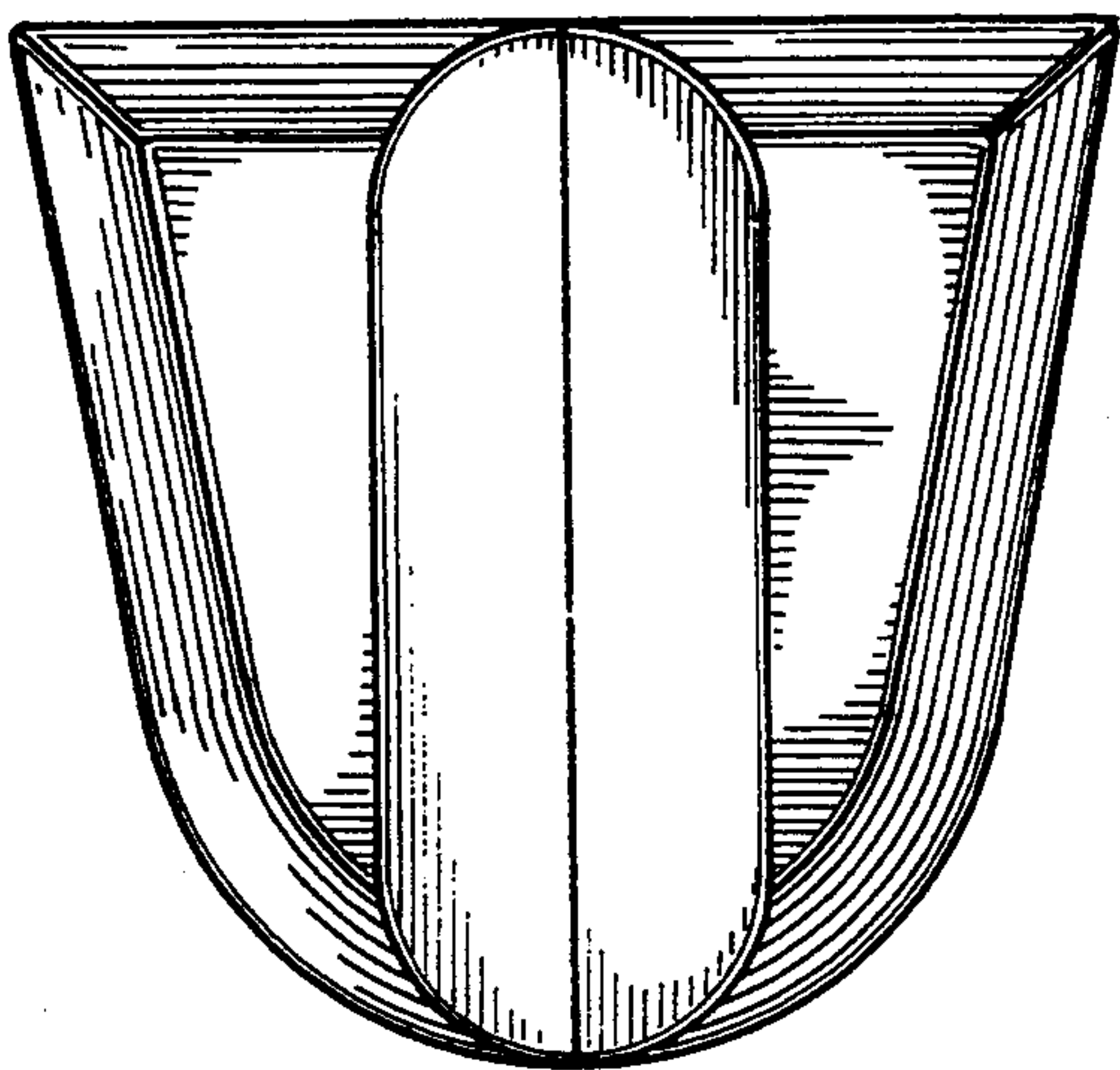
