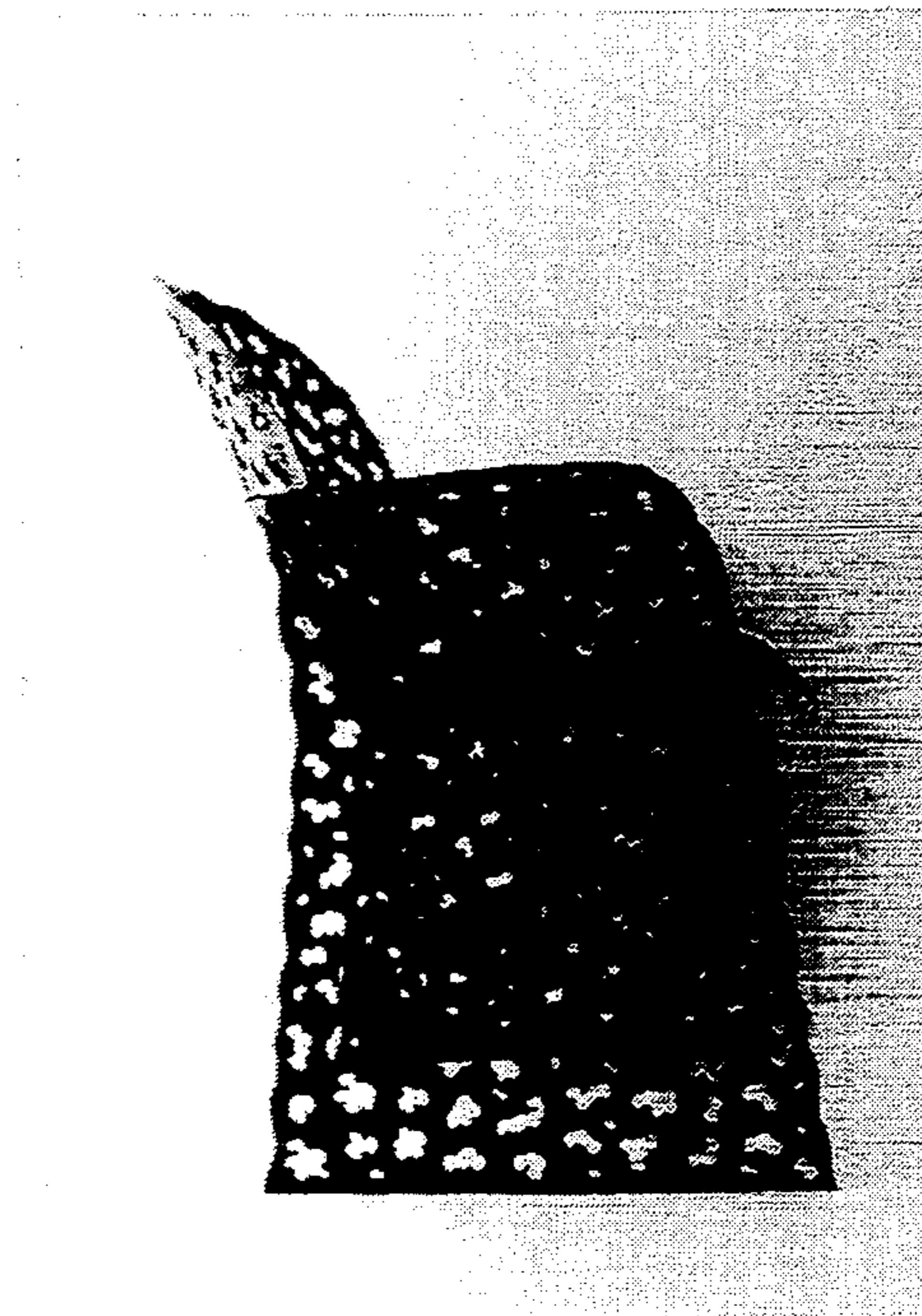
DESCRIPTION

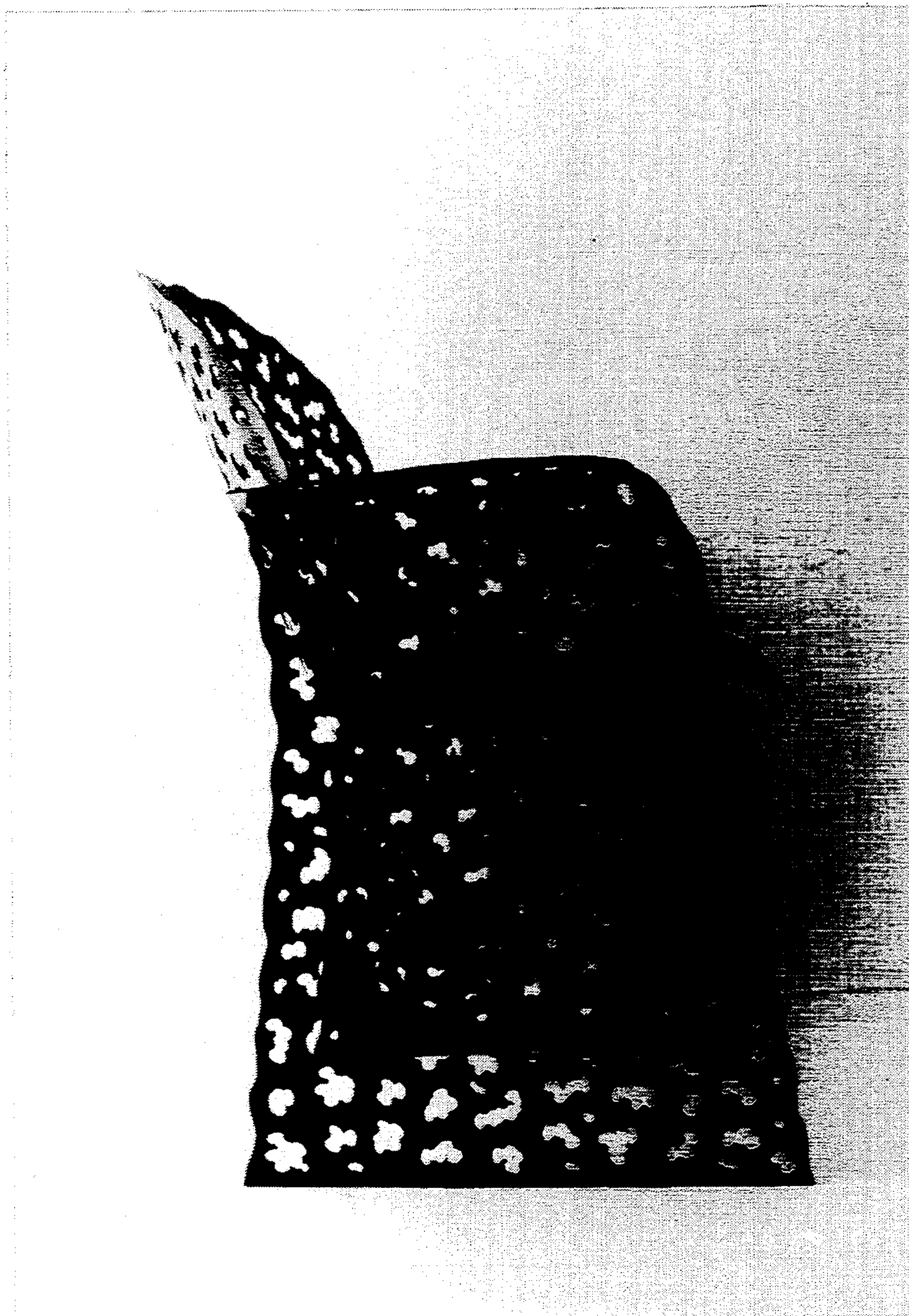

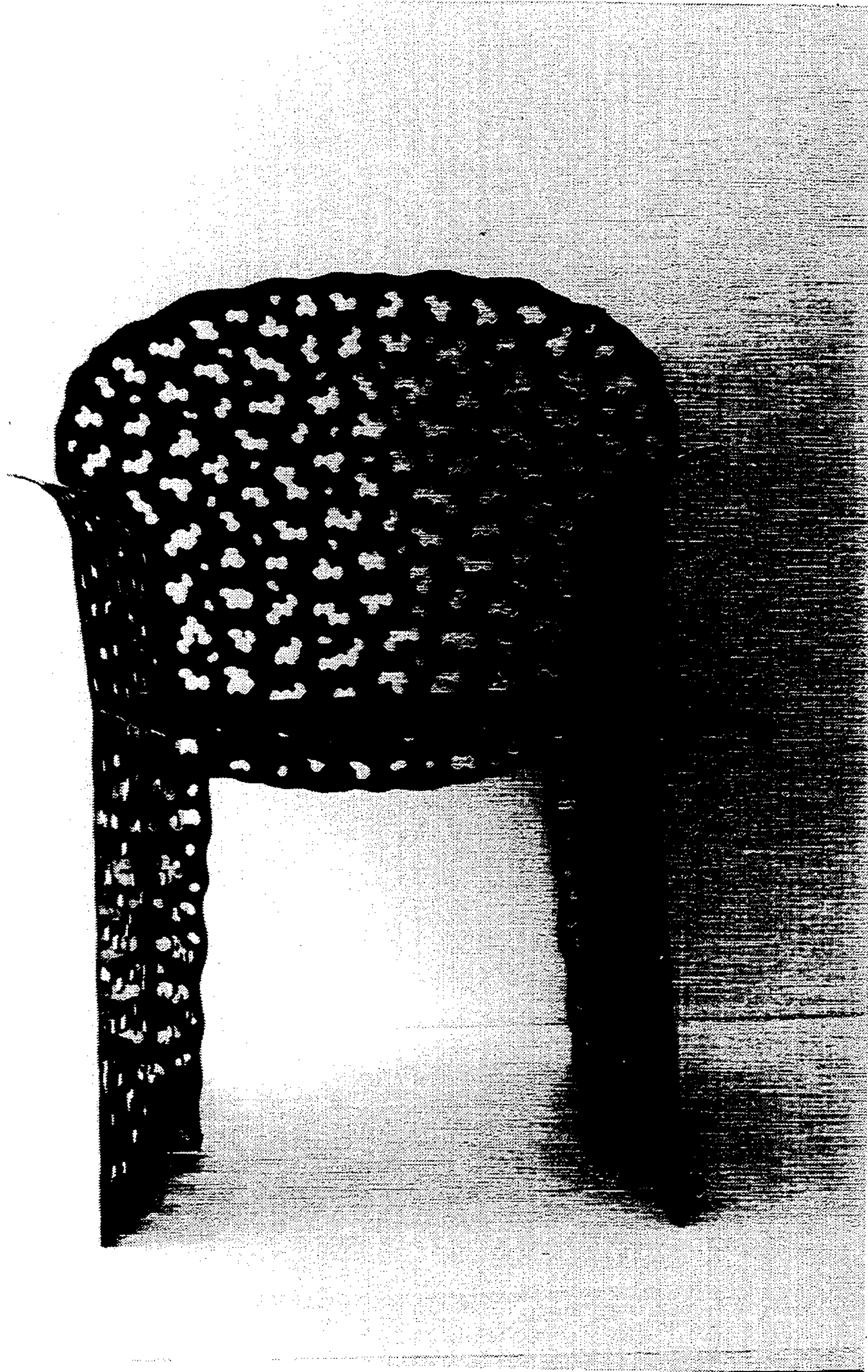

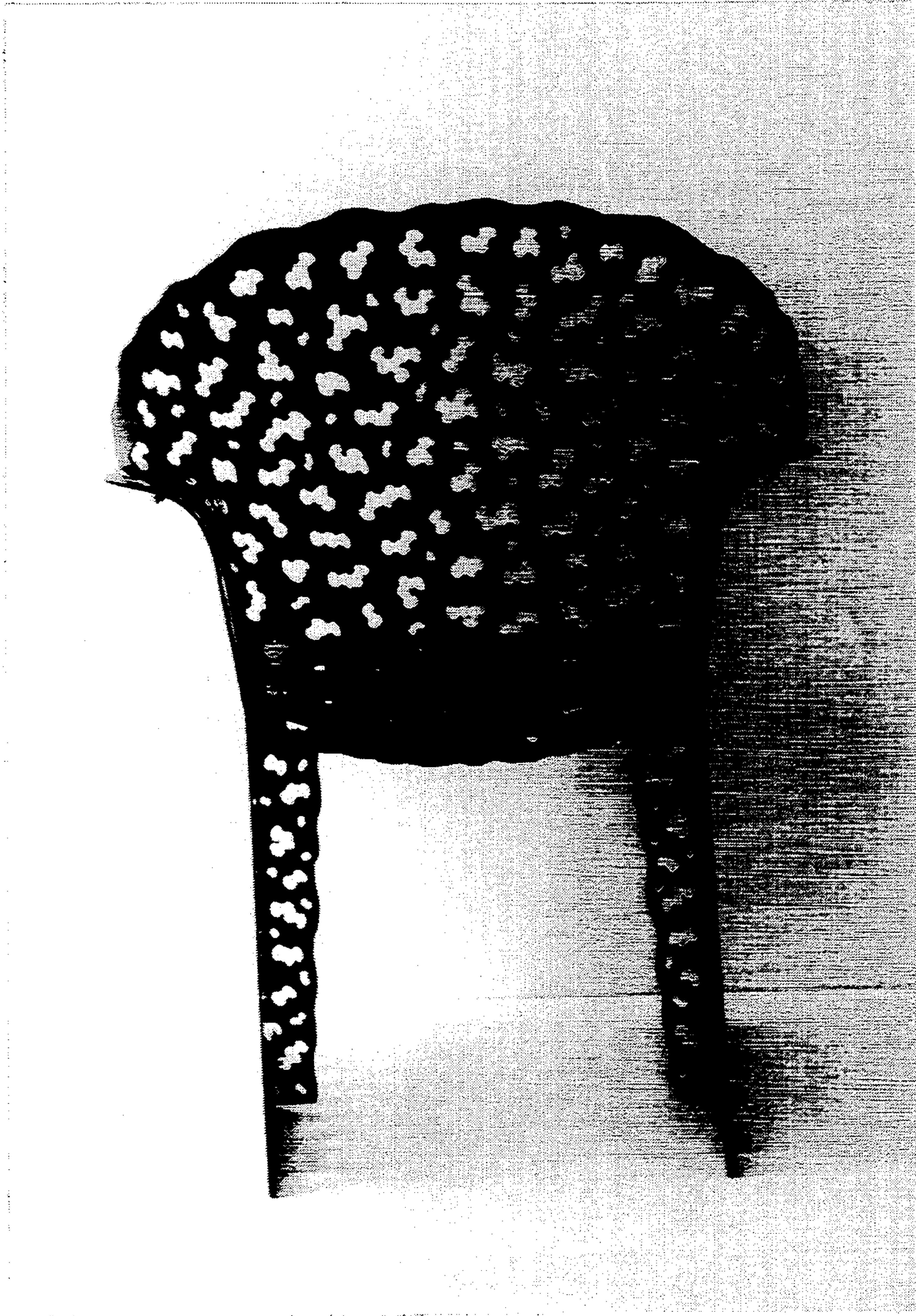

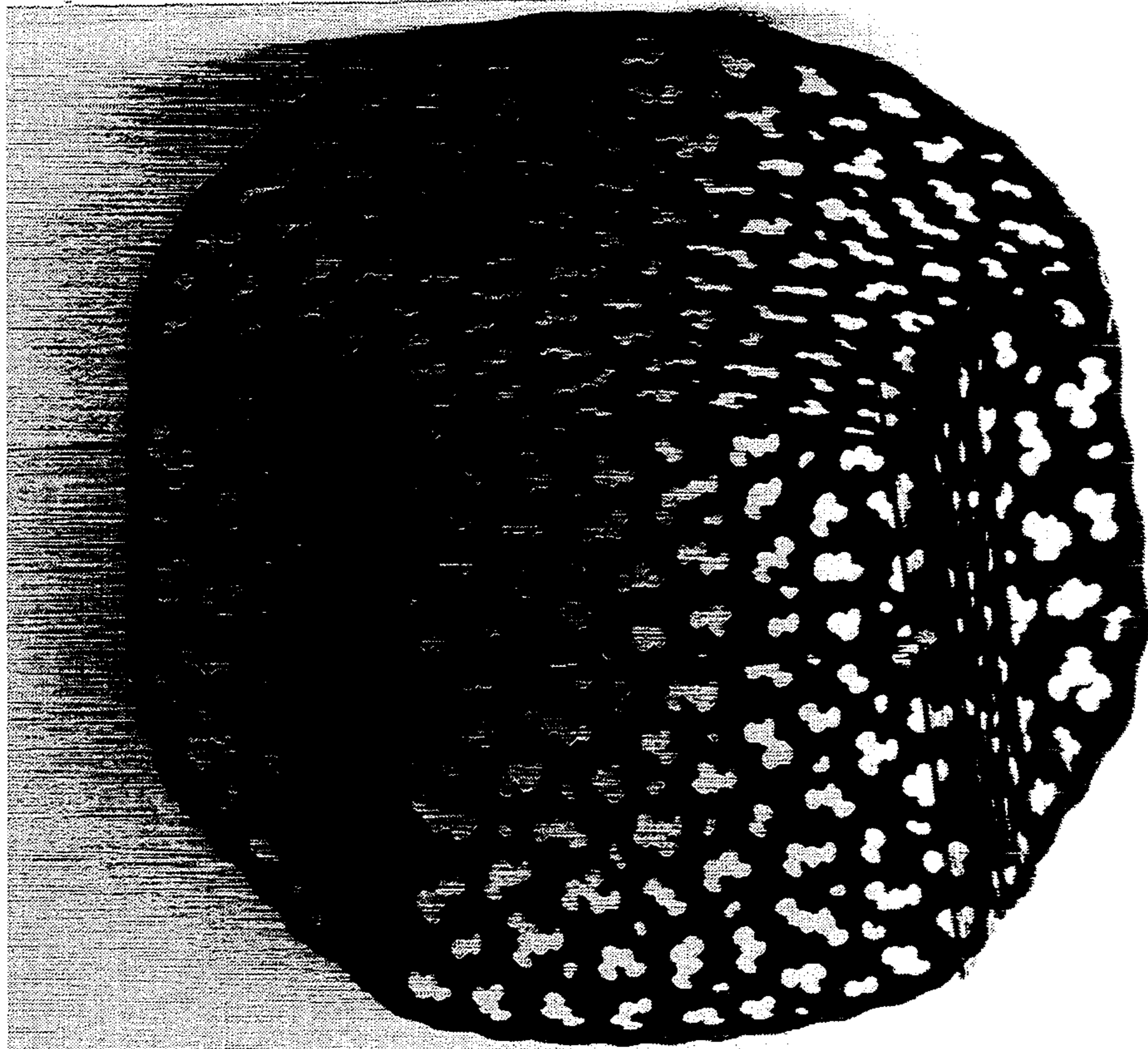

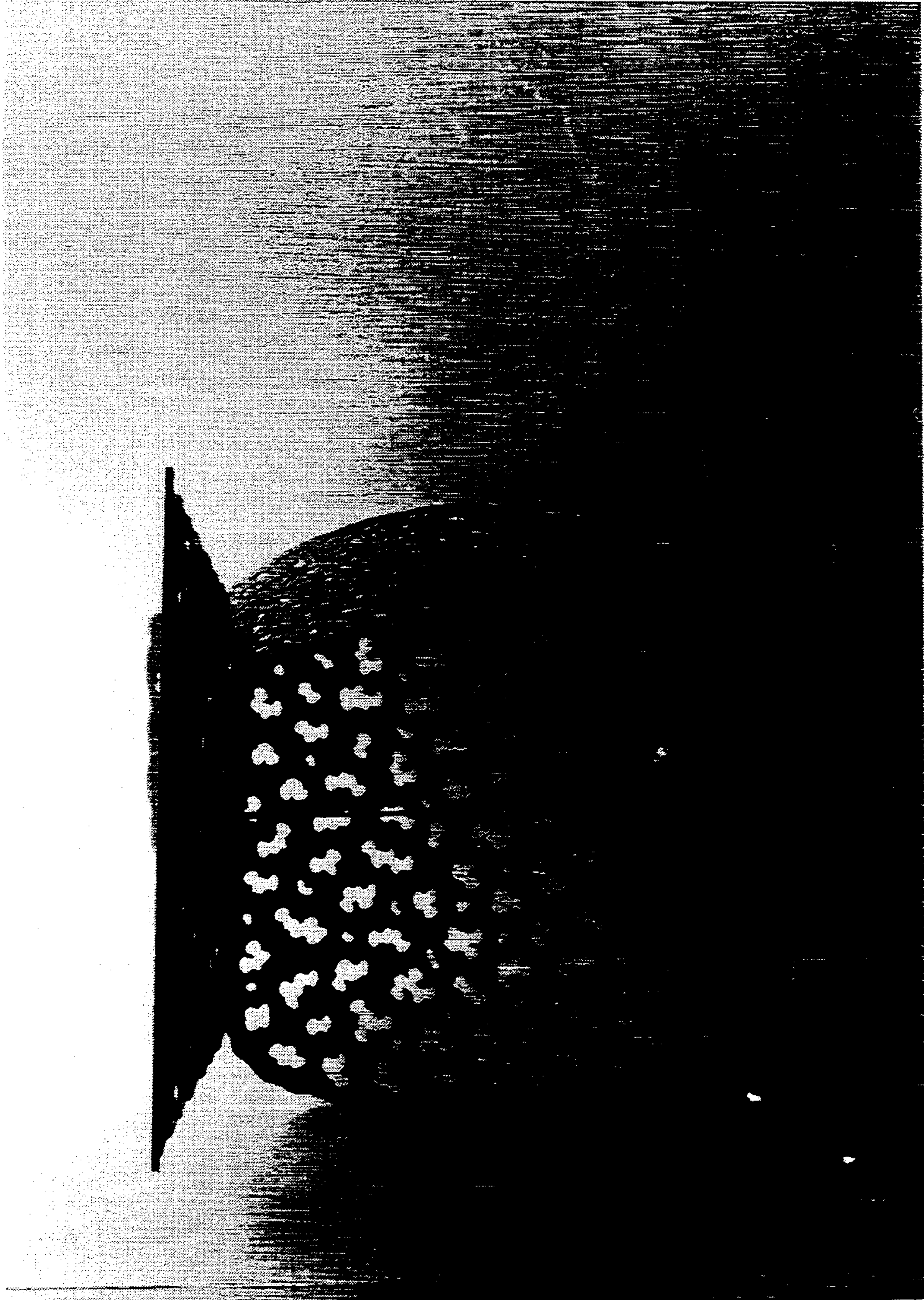
