DESCRIPTION

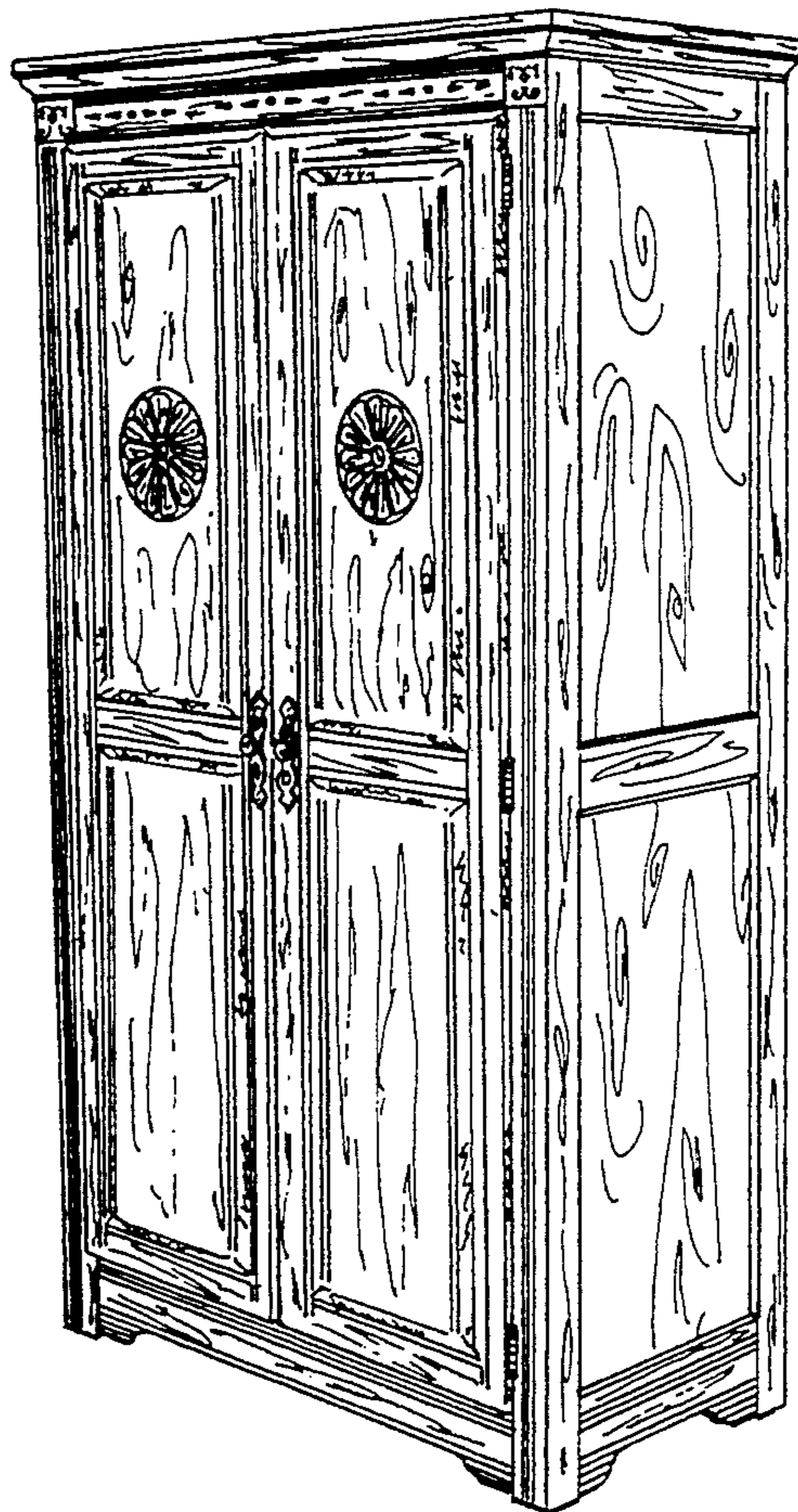
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an entertainment center showing my new design;

The rear of the entertainment center is flat and unornamented.



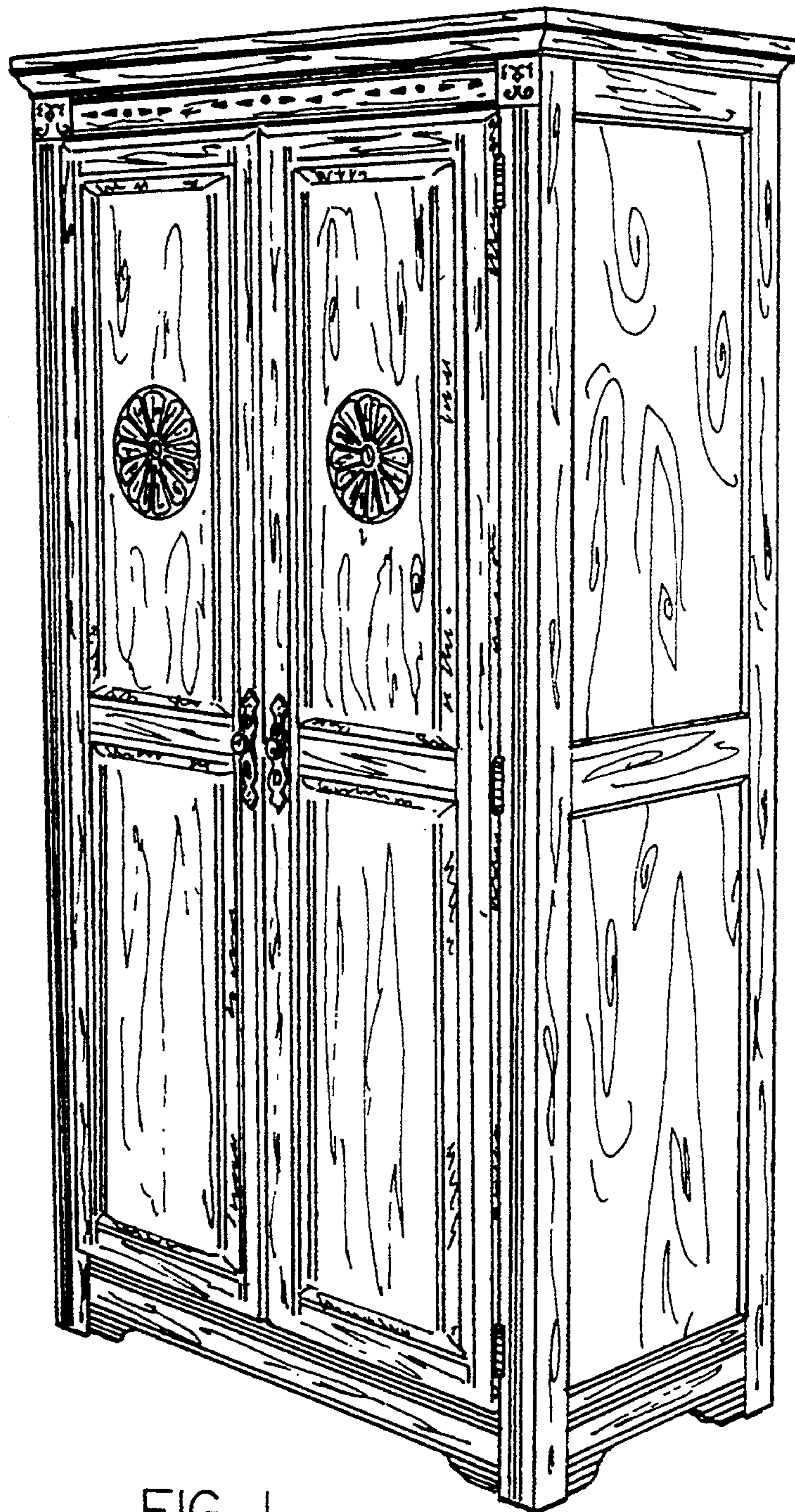

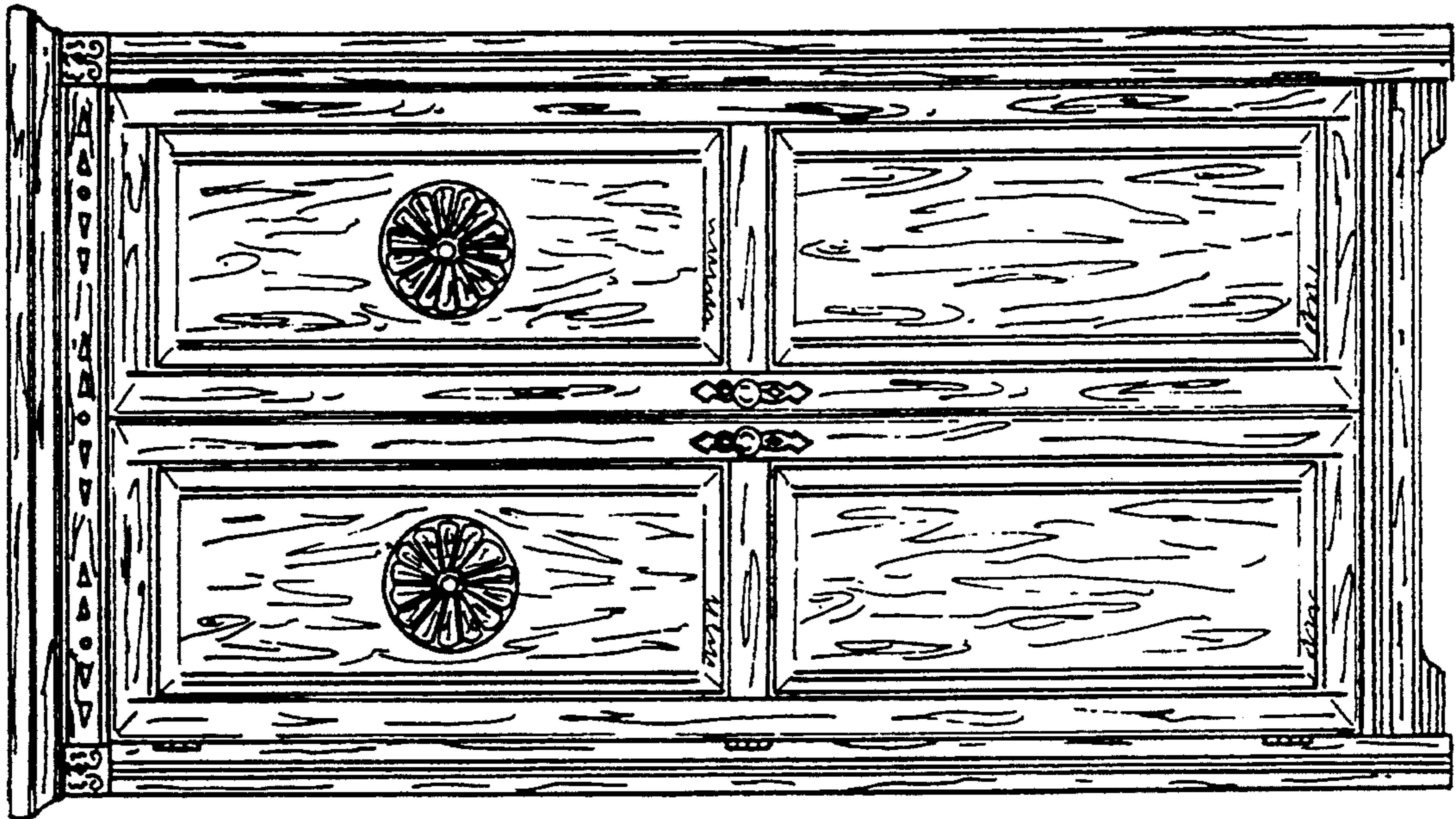
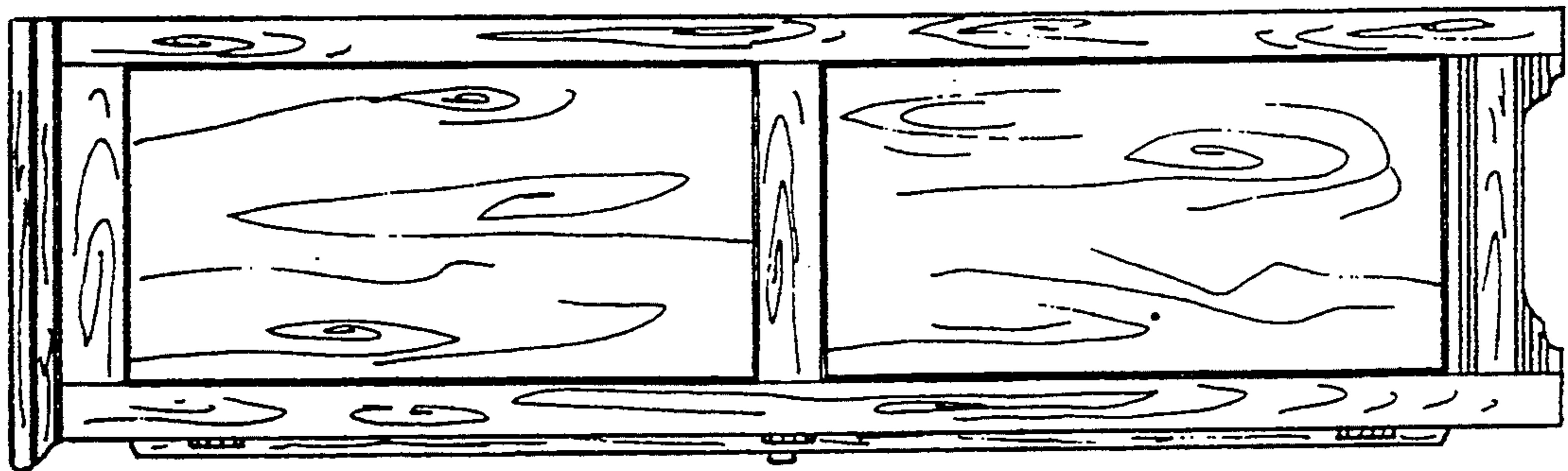

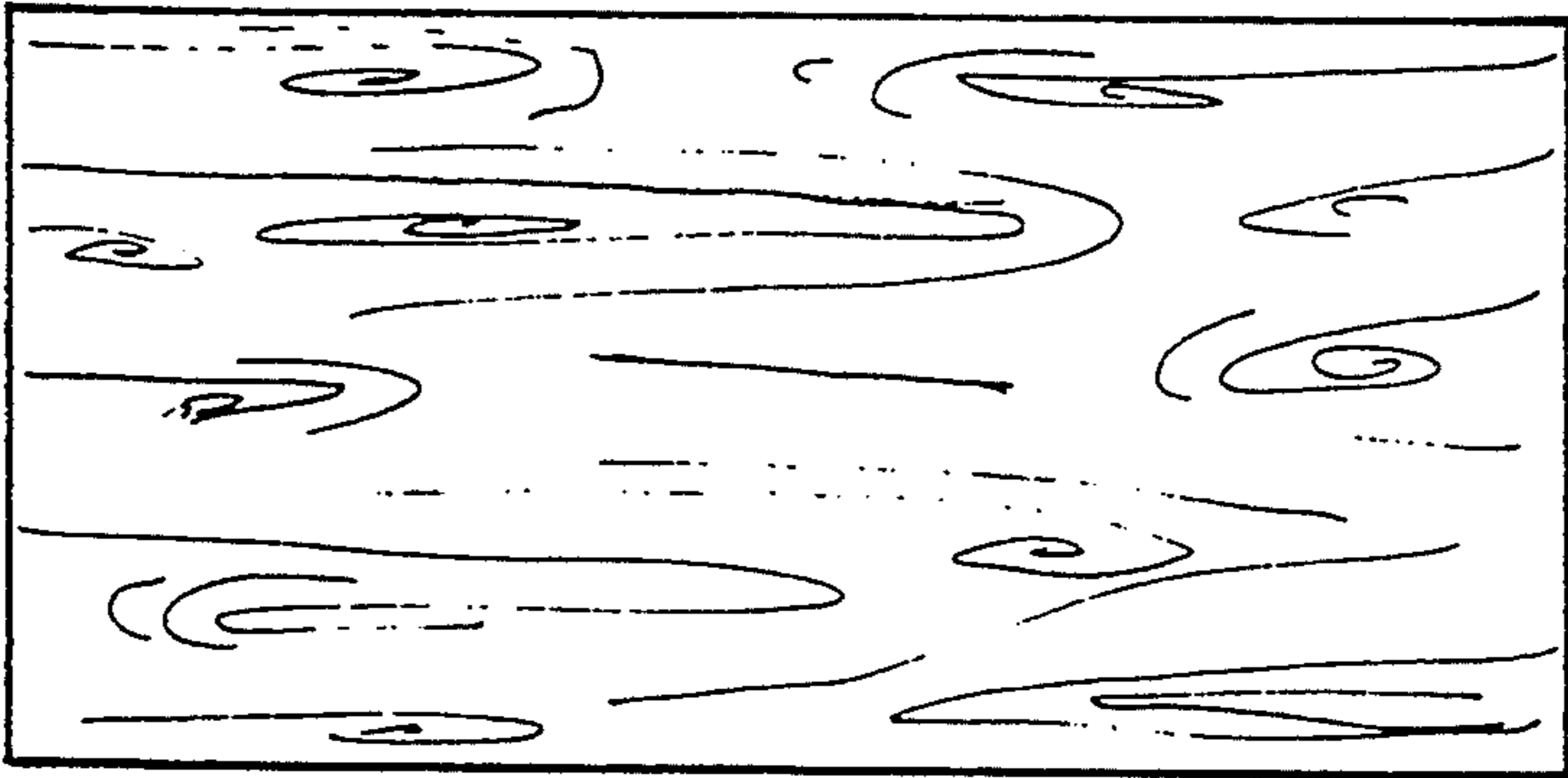
