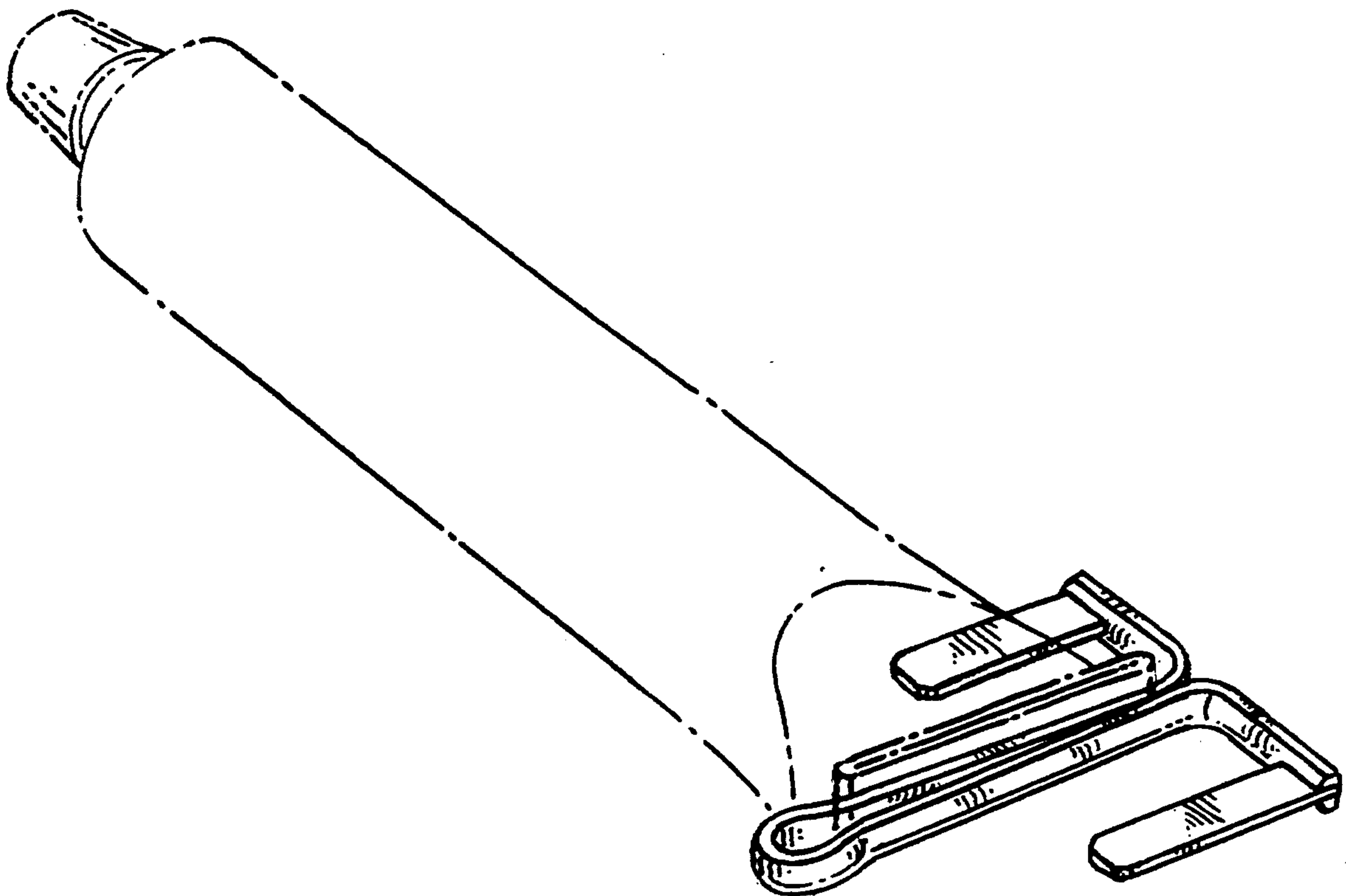

a mirror image of that shown.



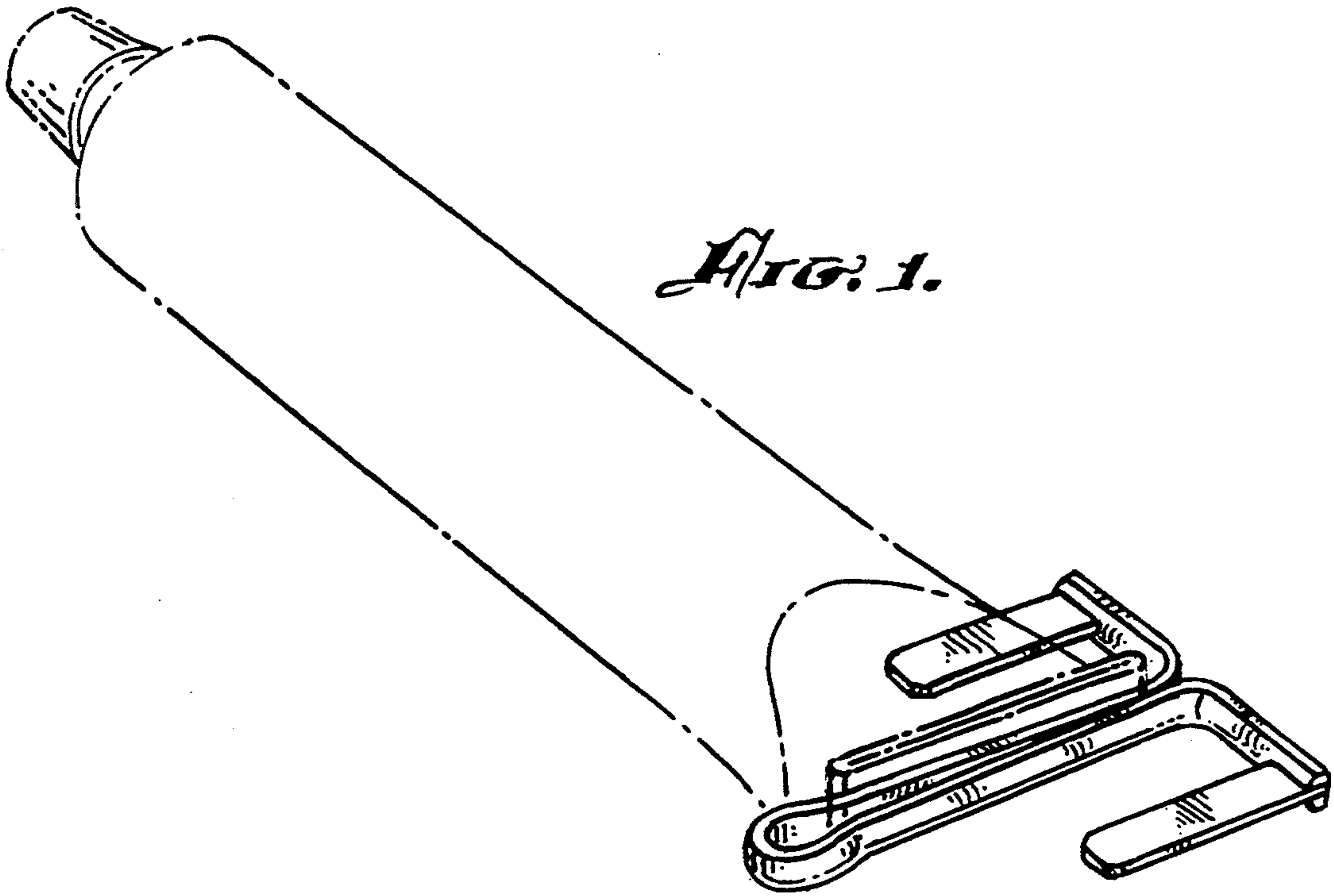

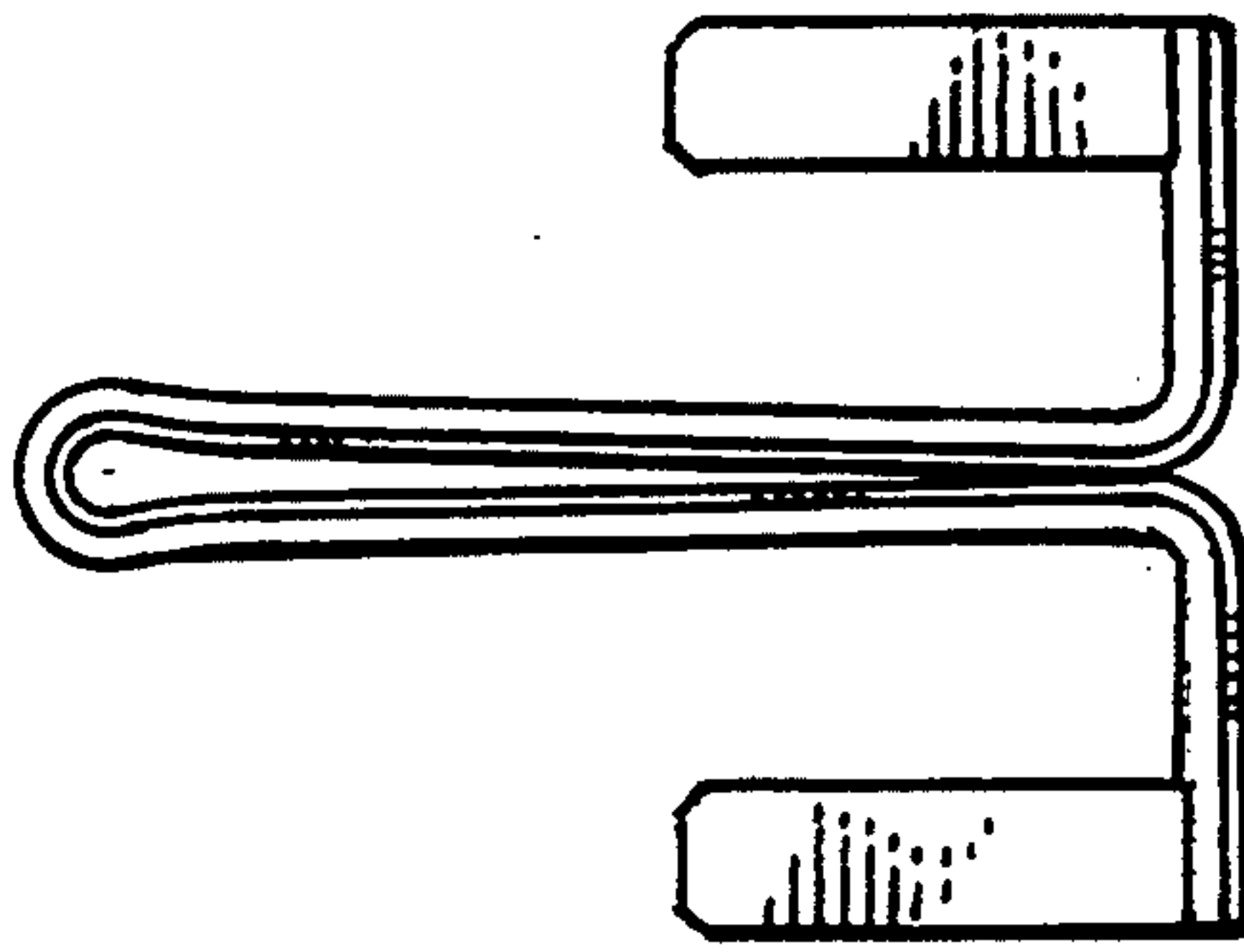
