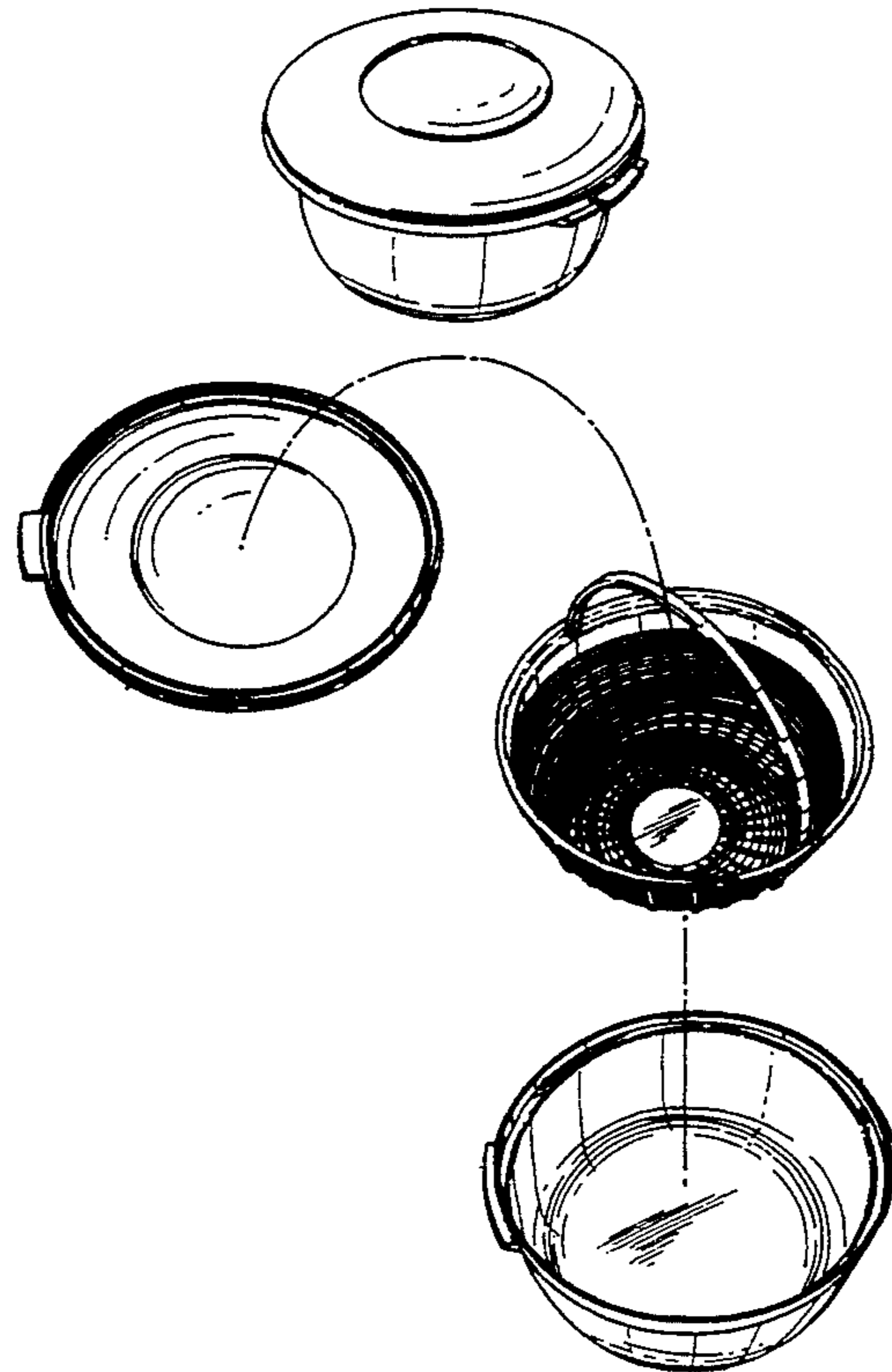

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a combined cooking utensil with lid and strainer, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a combined cooking utensil with lid and strainer showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view, the rear elevational view being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the cooking utensil and strainer;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the cooking utensil without the strainer;
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of the lid;
FIG. 7 is a side elevational view of the strainer;
FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view of the strainer.
FIG. 9 is a perspective view of the combined cooking utensil with lid and strainer; and,
FIG. 10 is an exploded perspective view thereof.



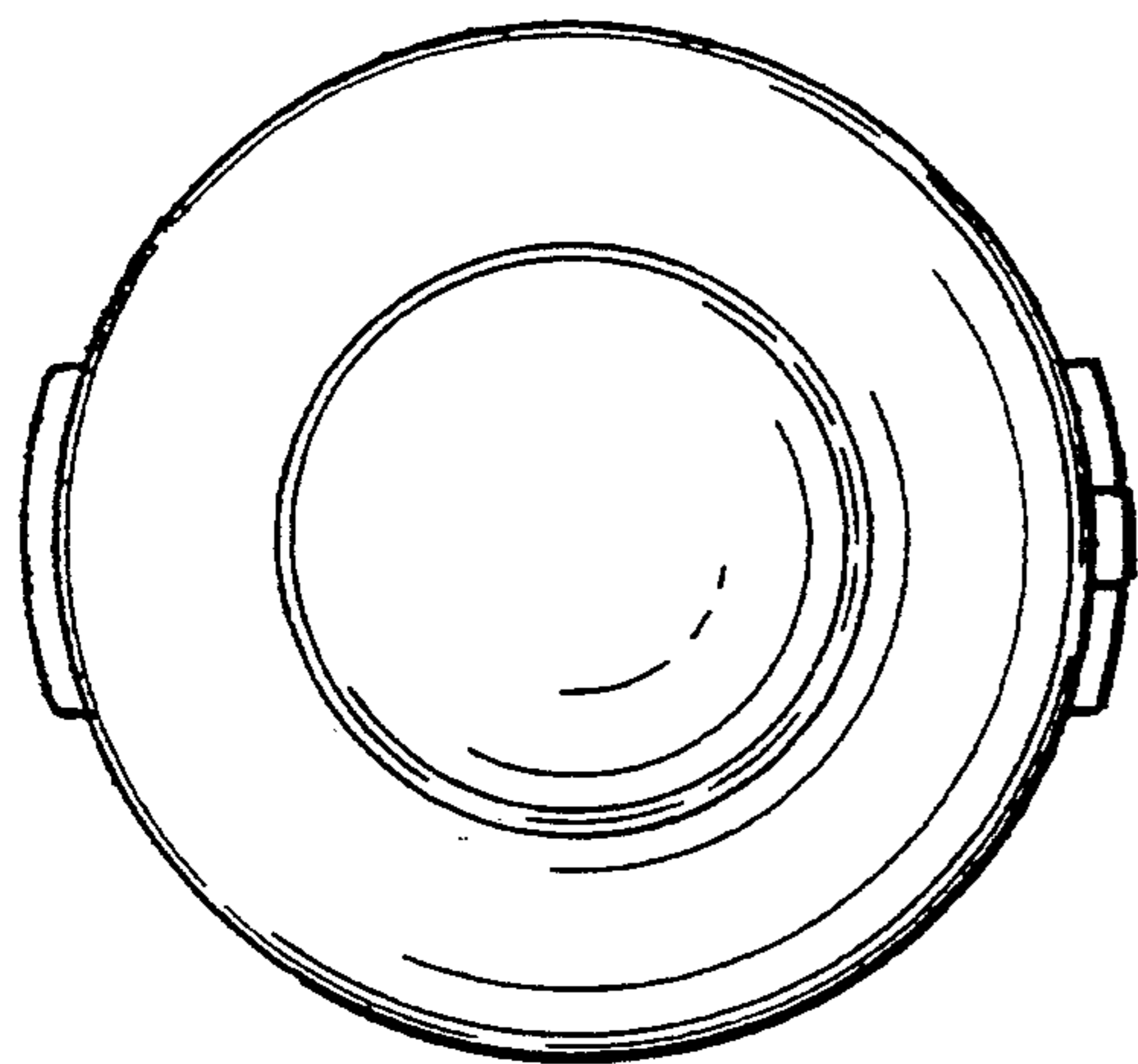

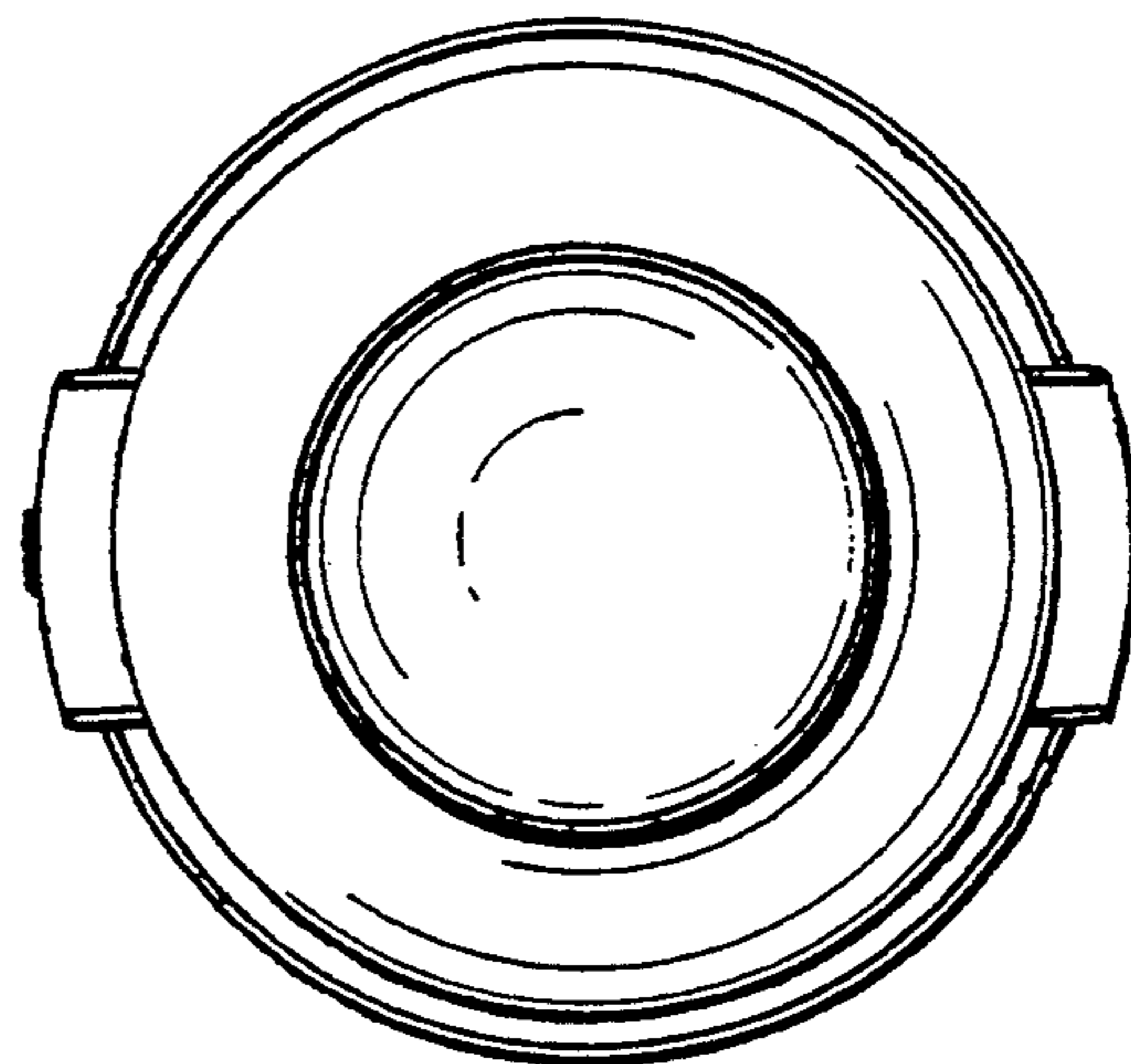

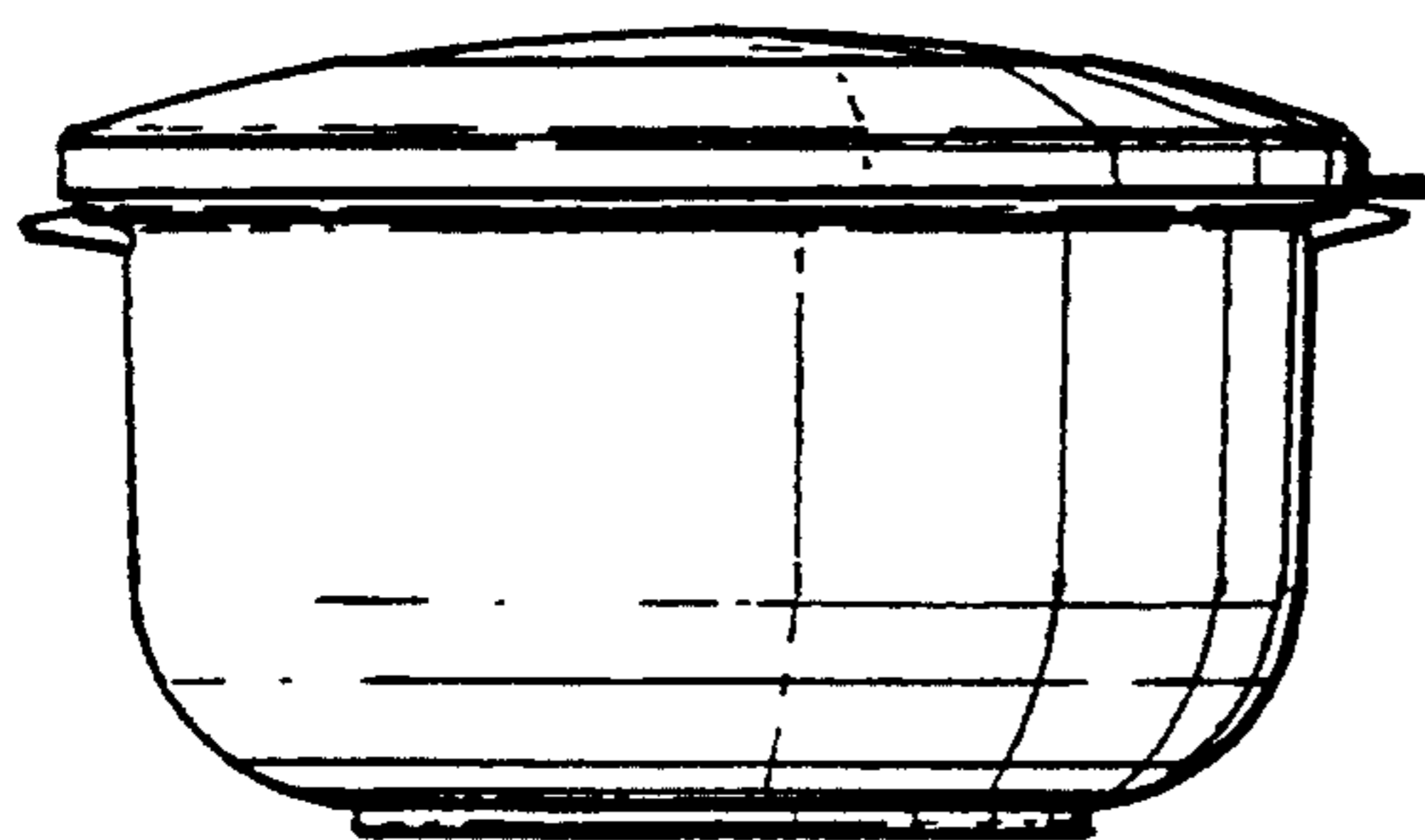

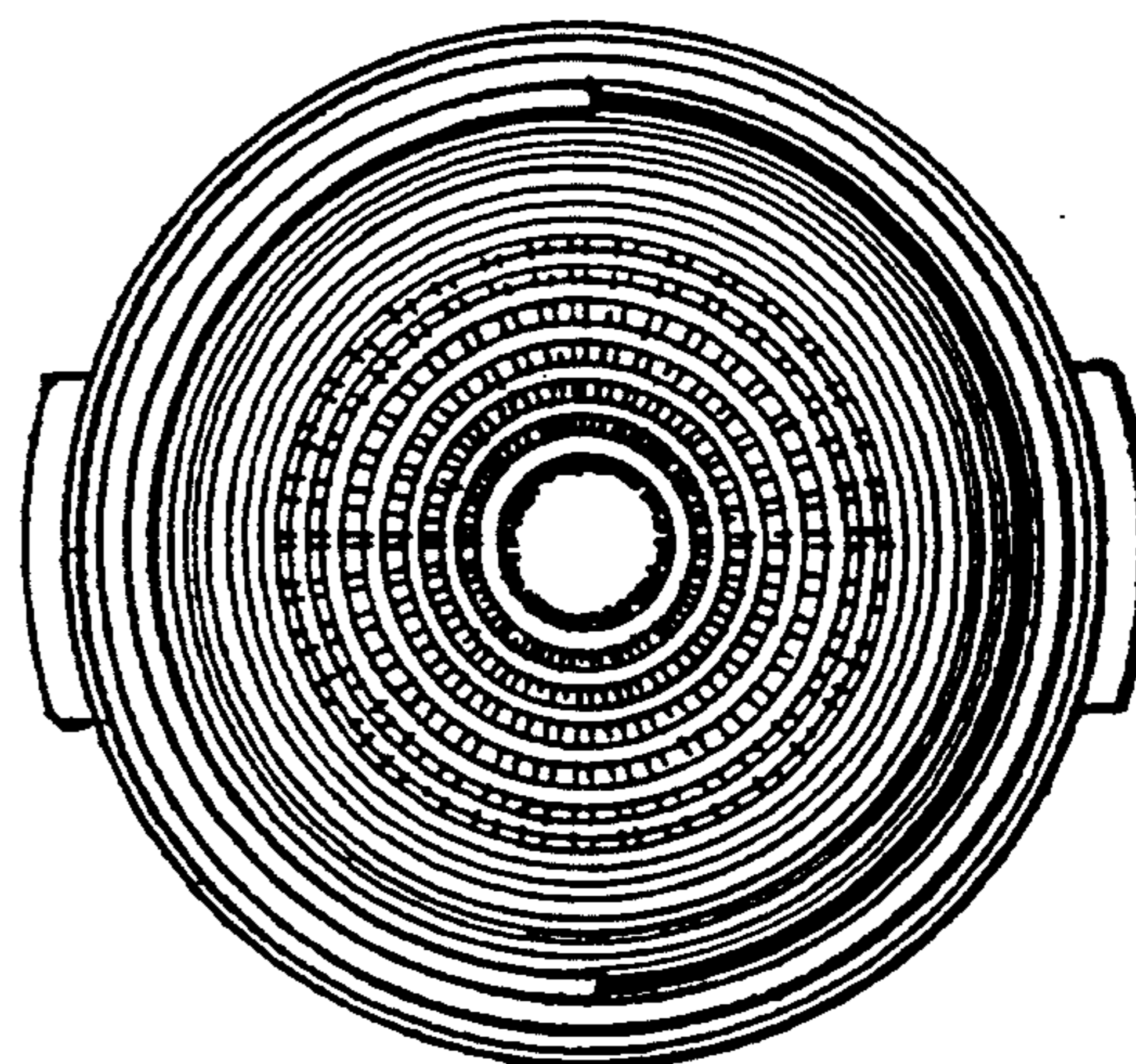

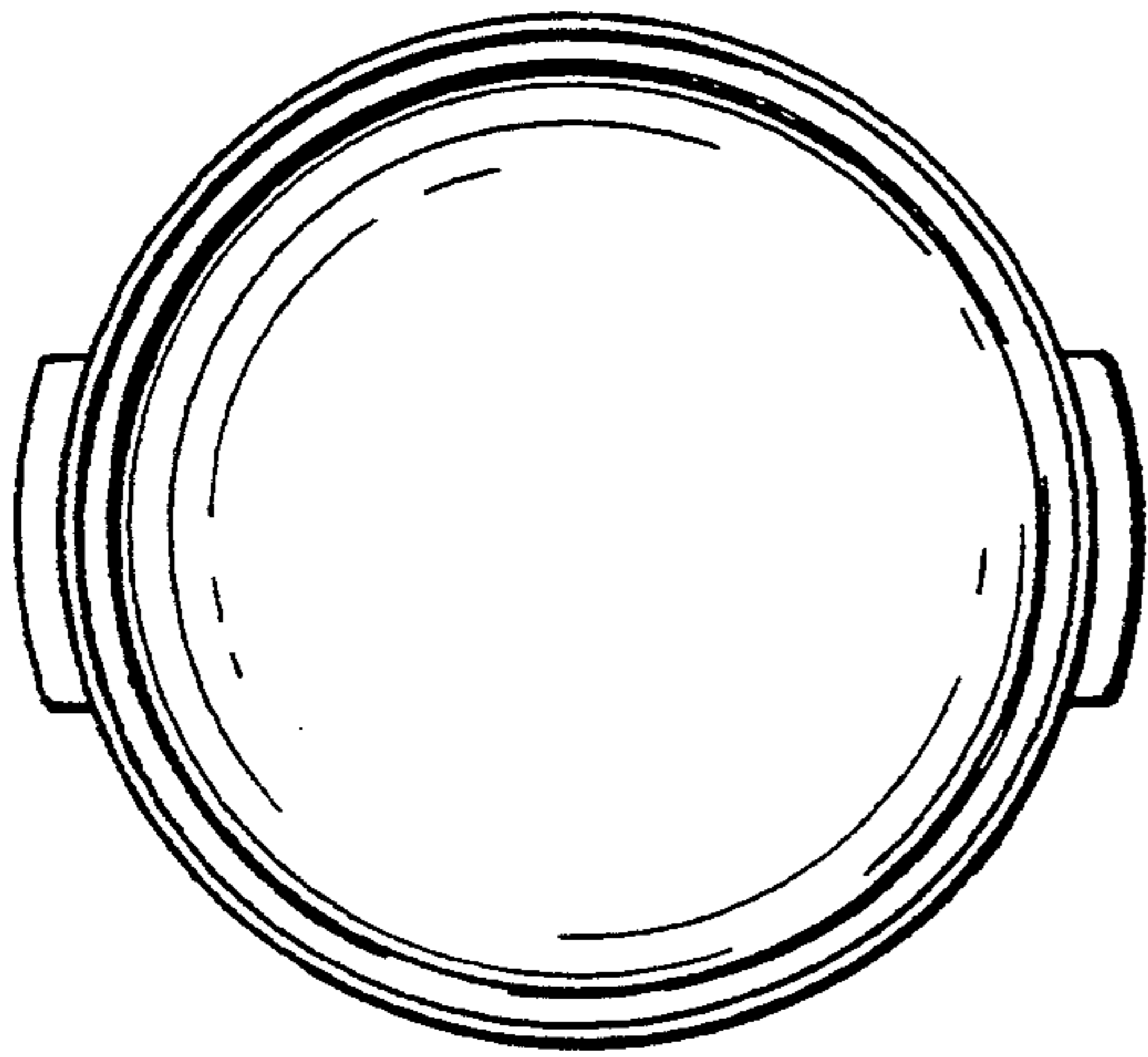

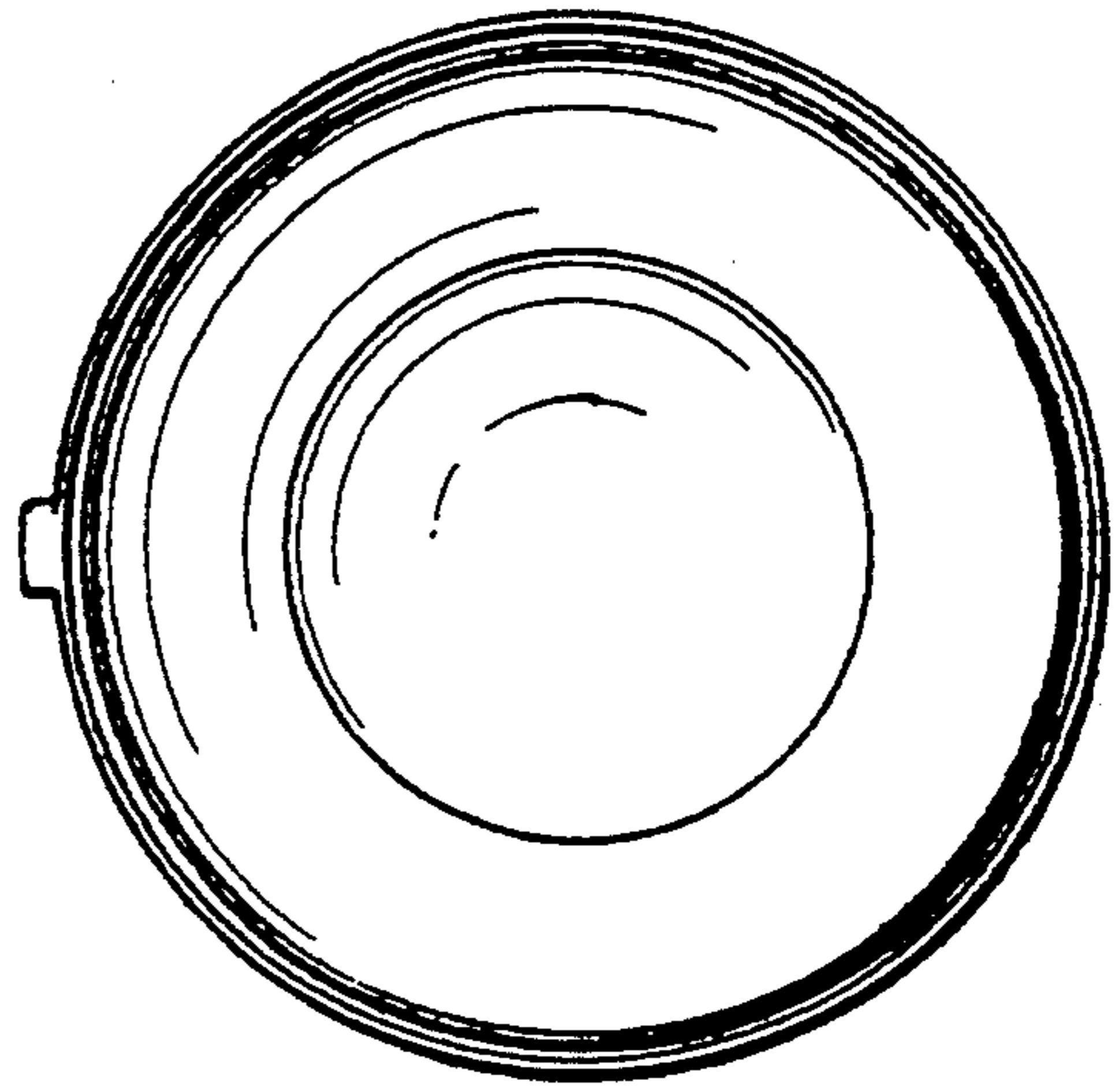

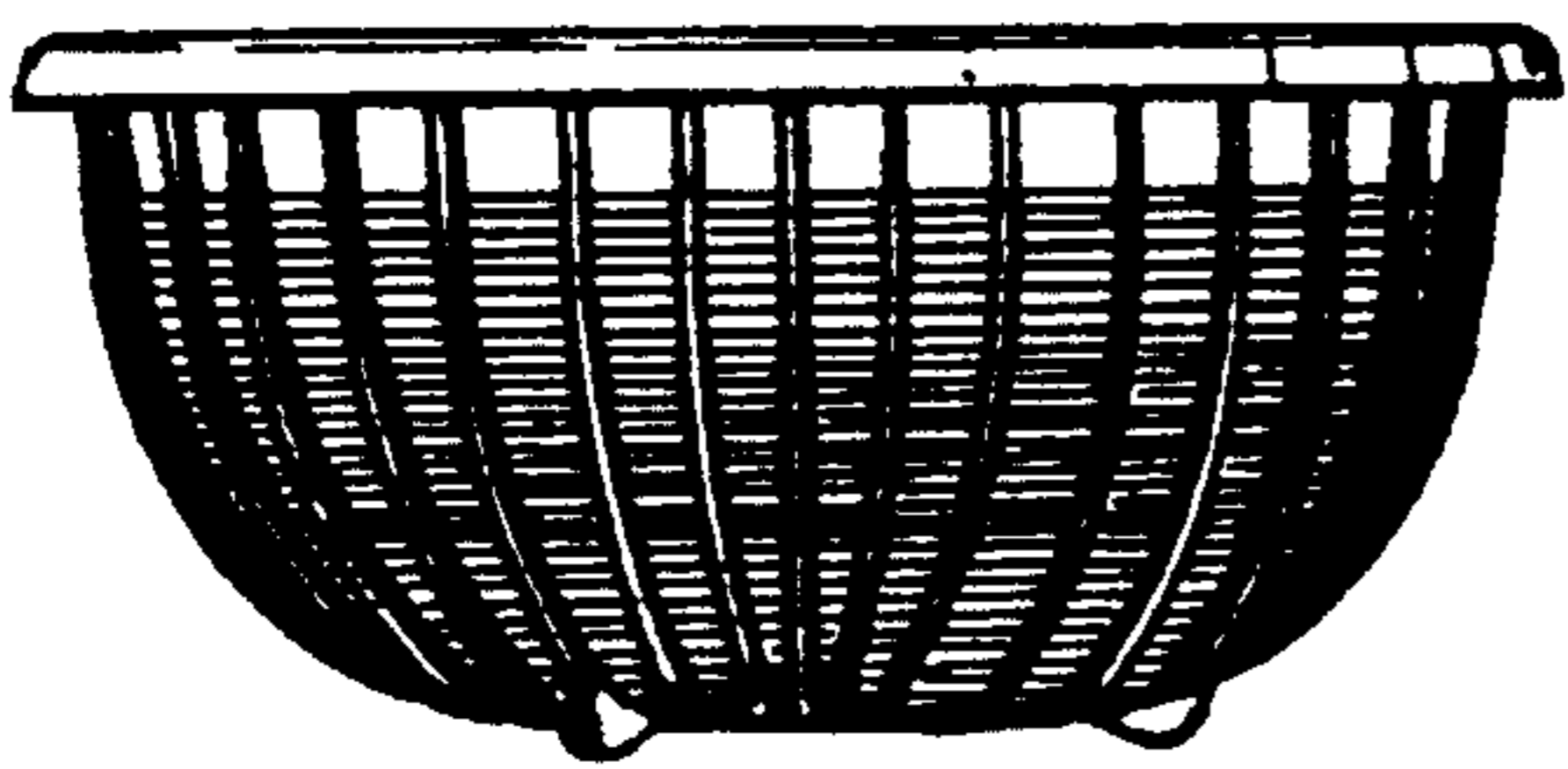

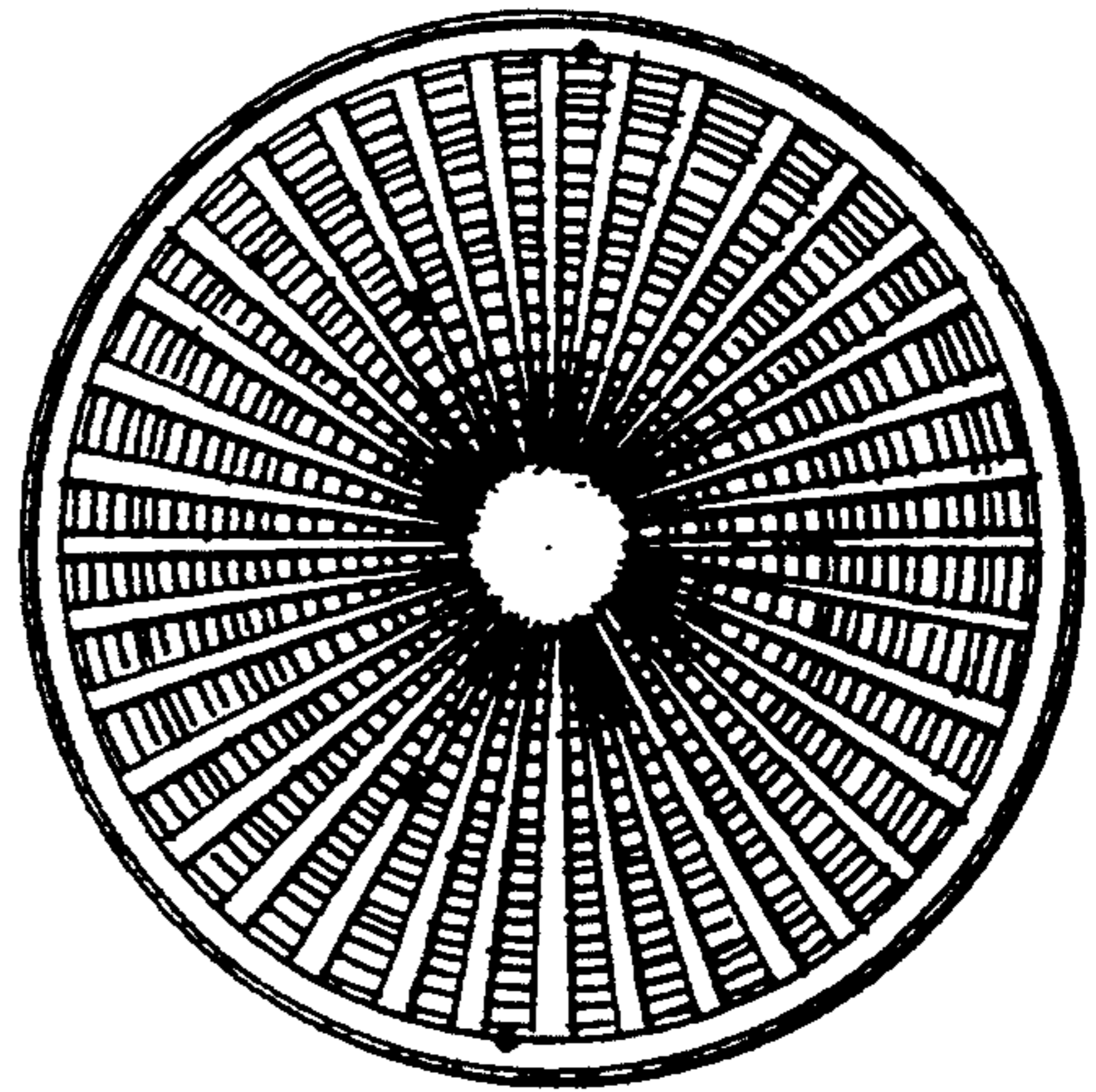

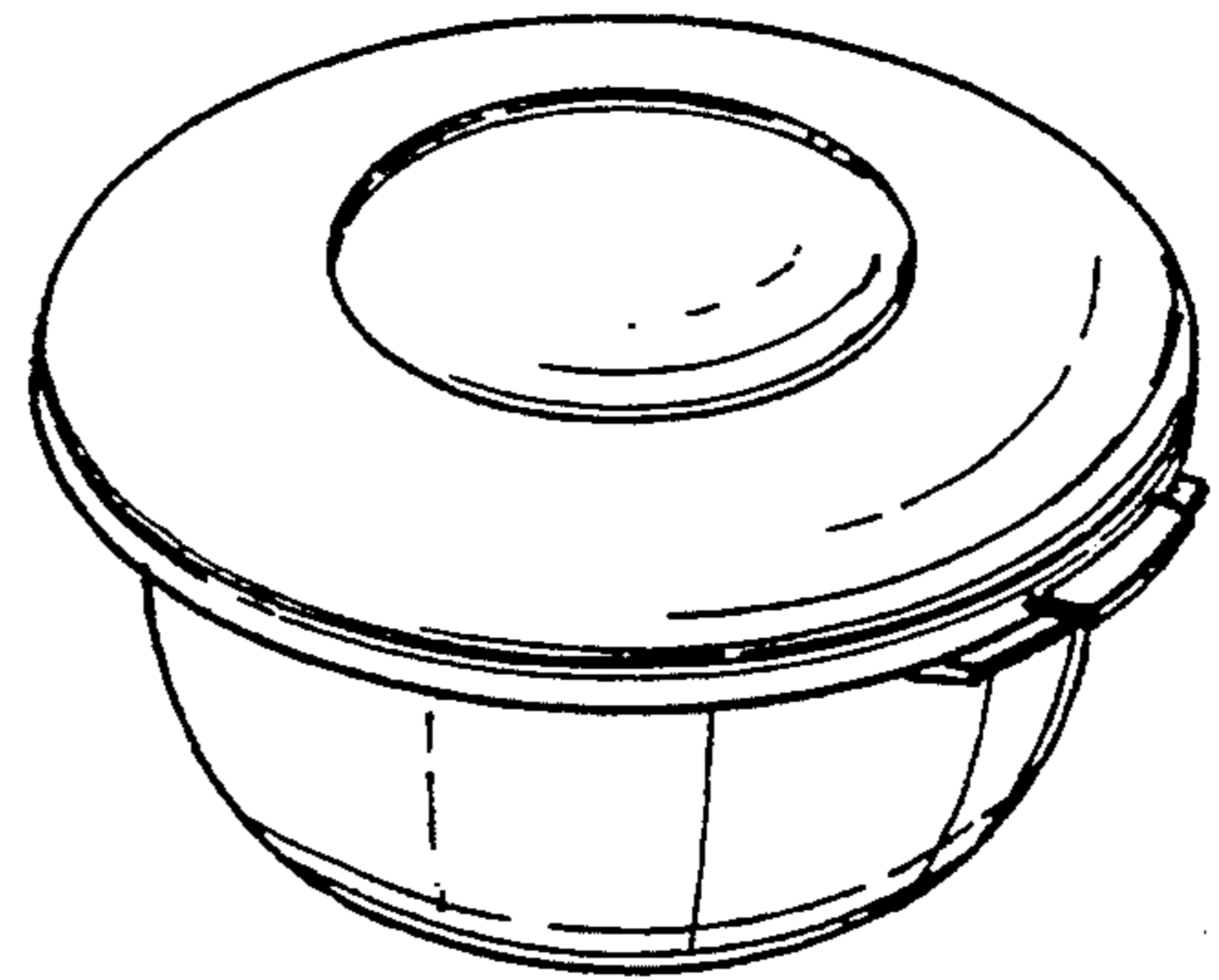

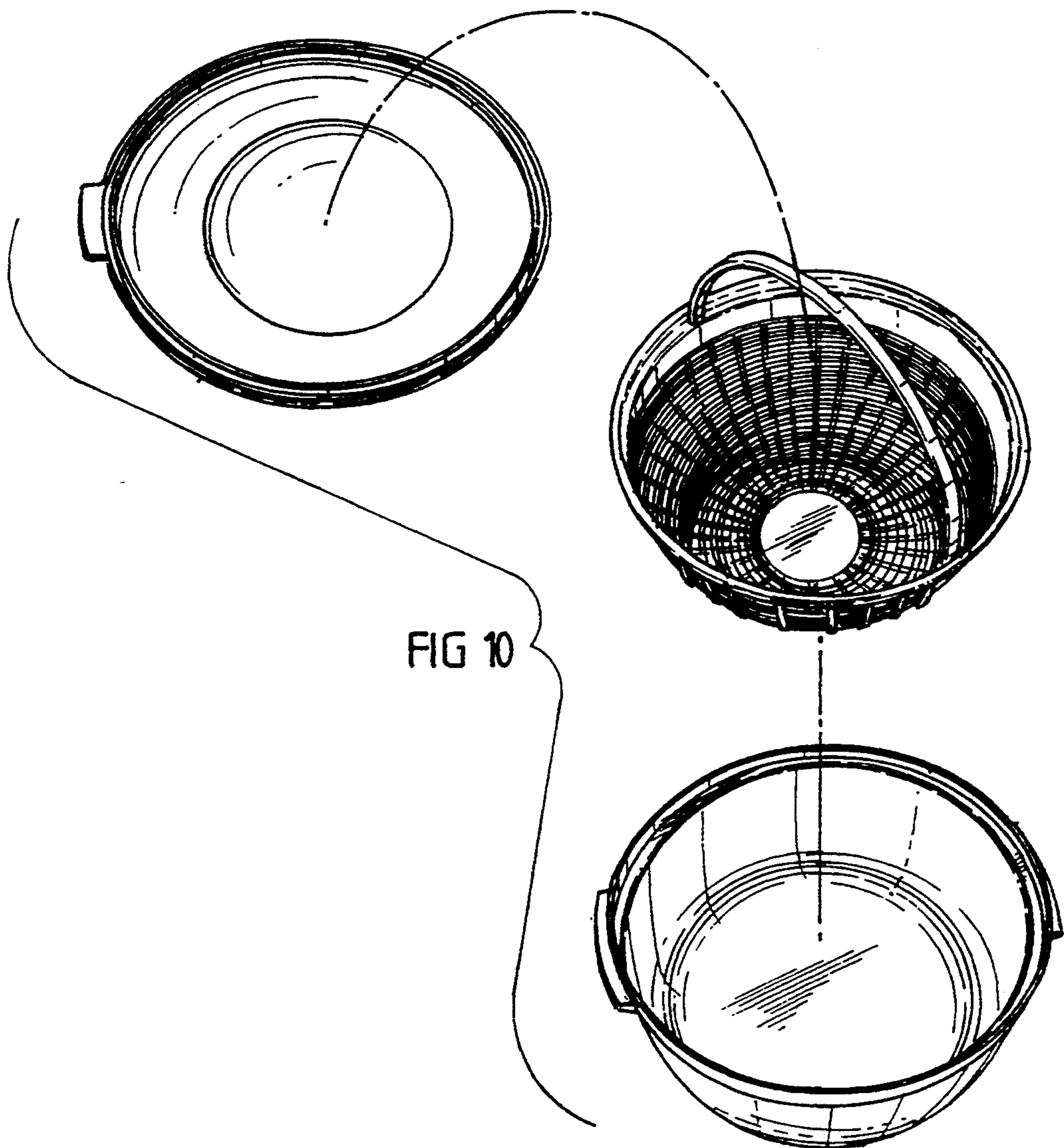
