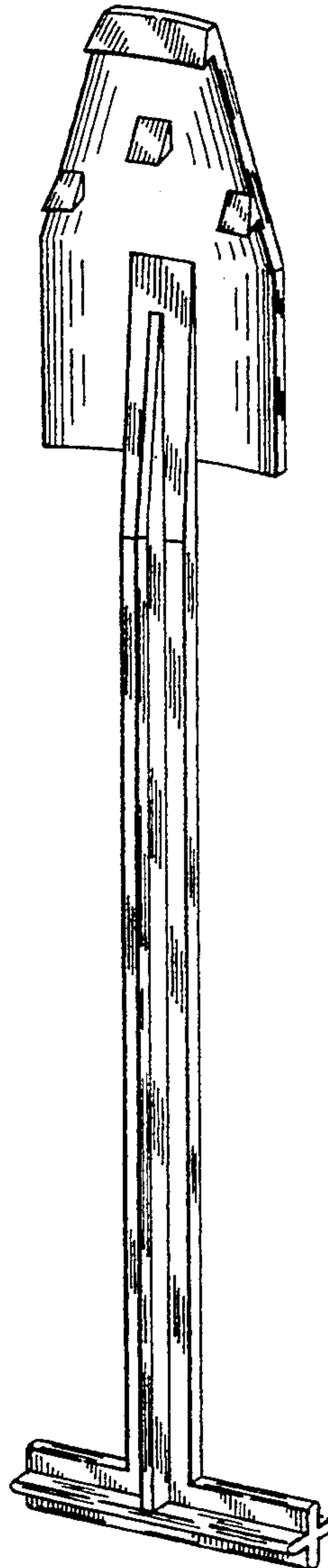

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of the thereof.



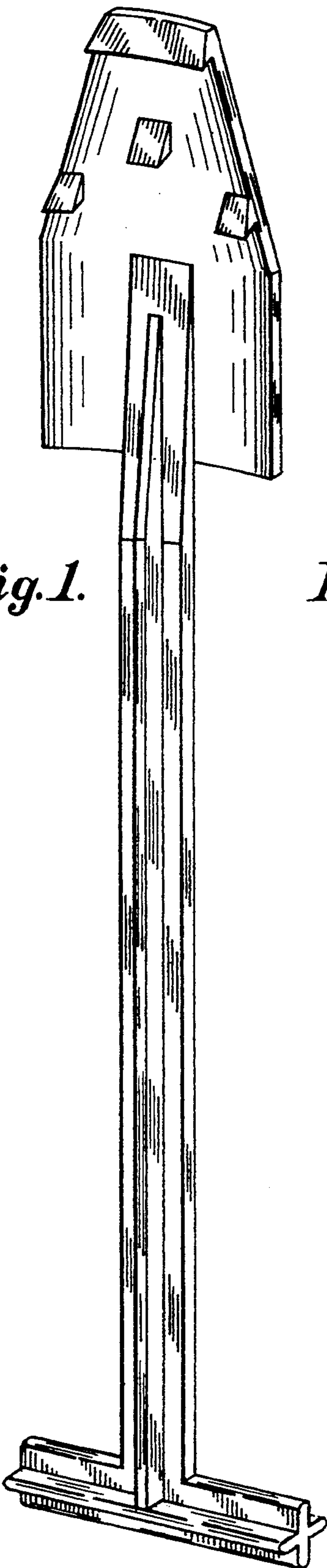

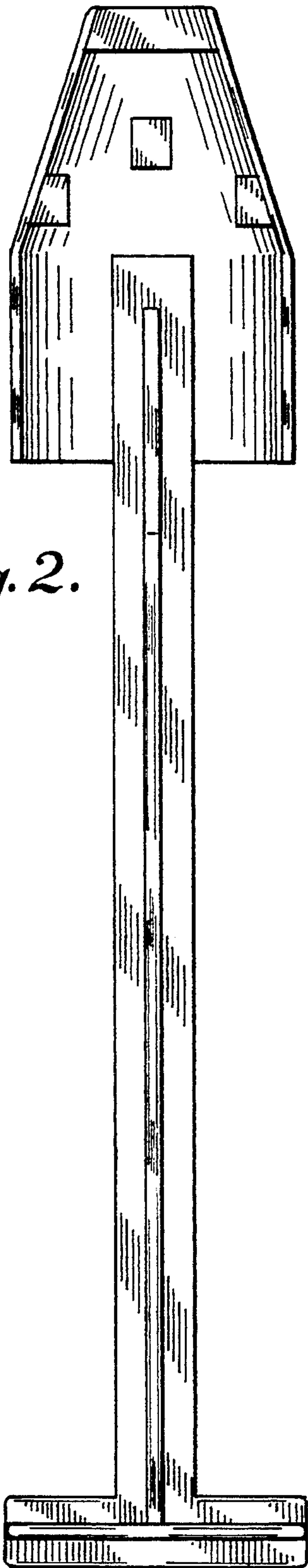

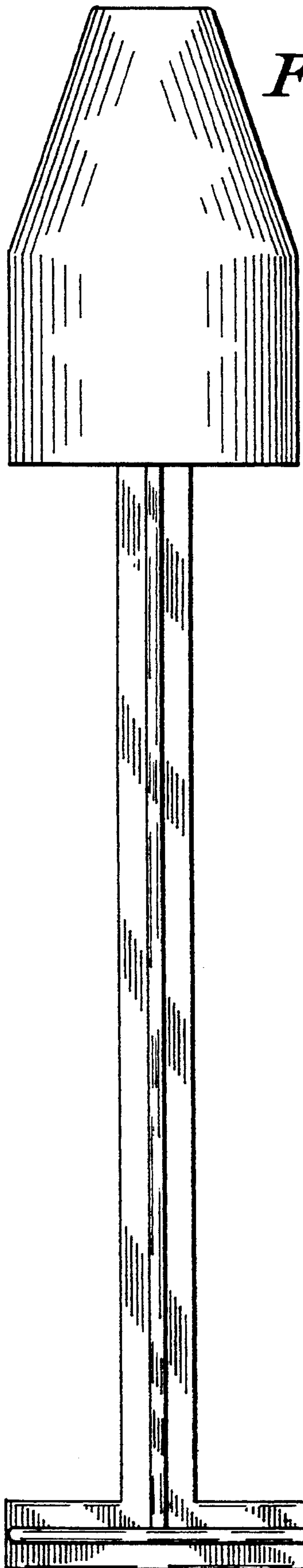

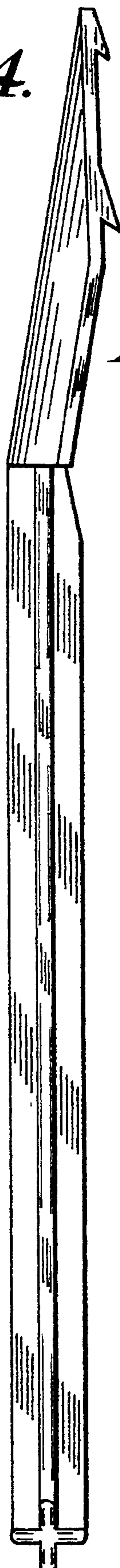

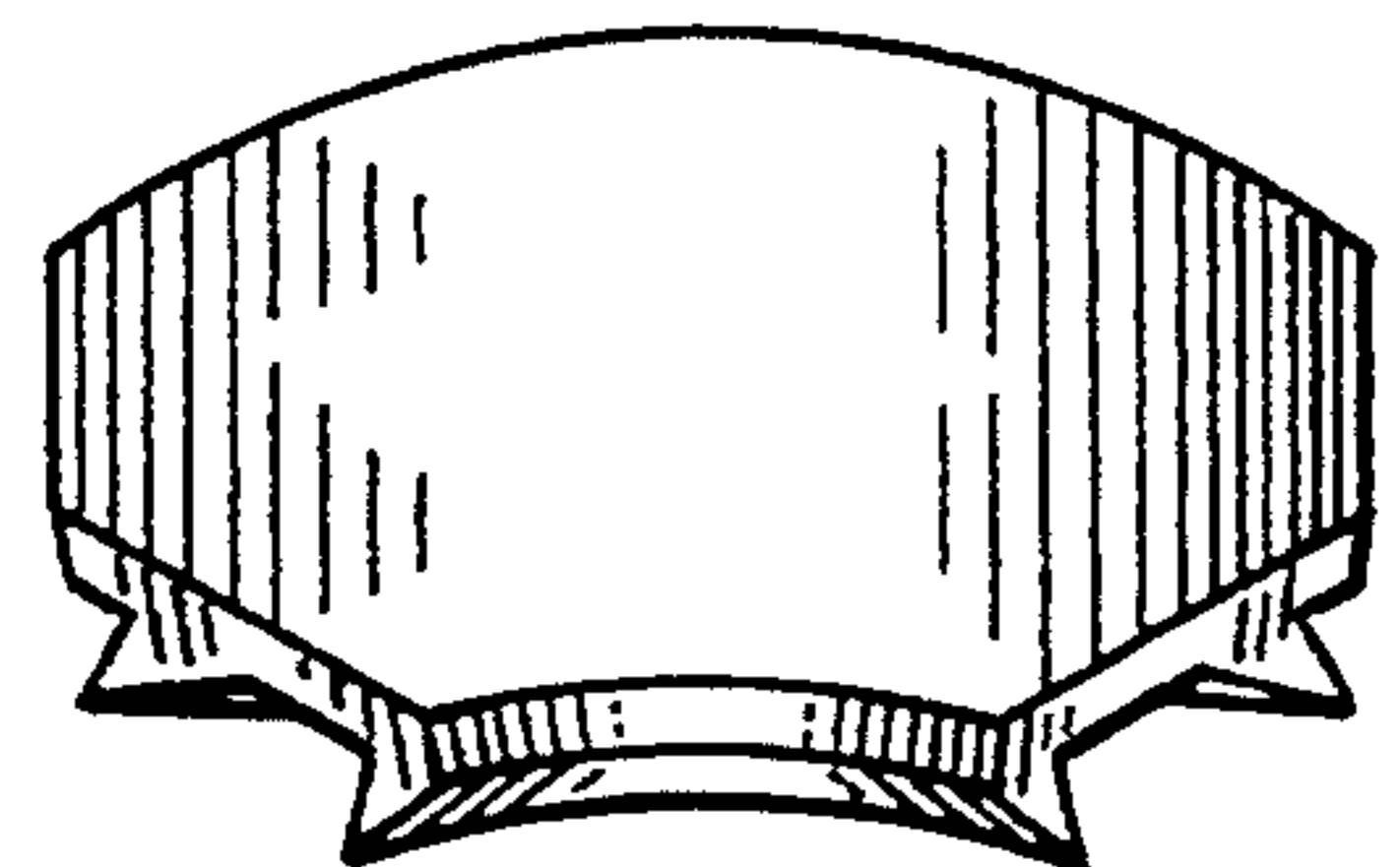

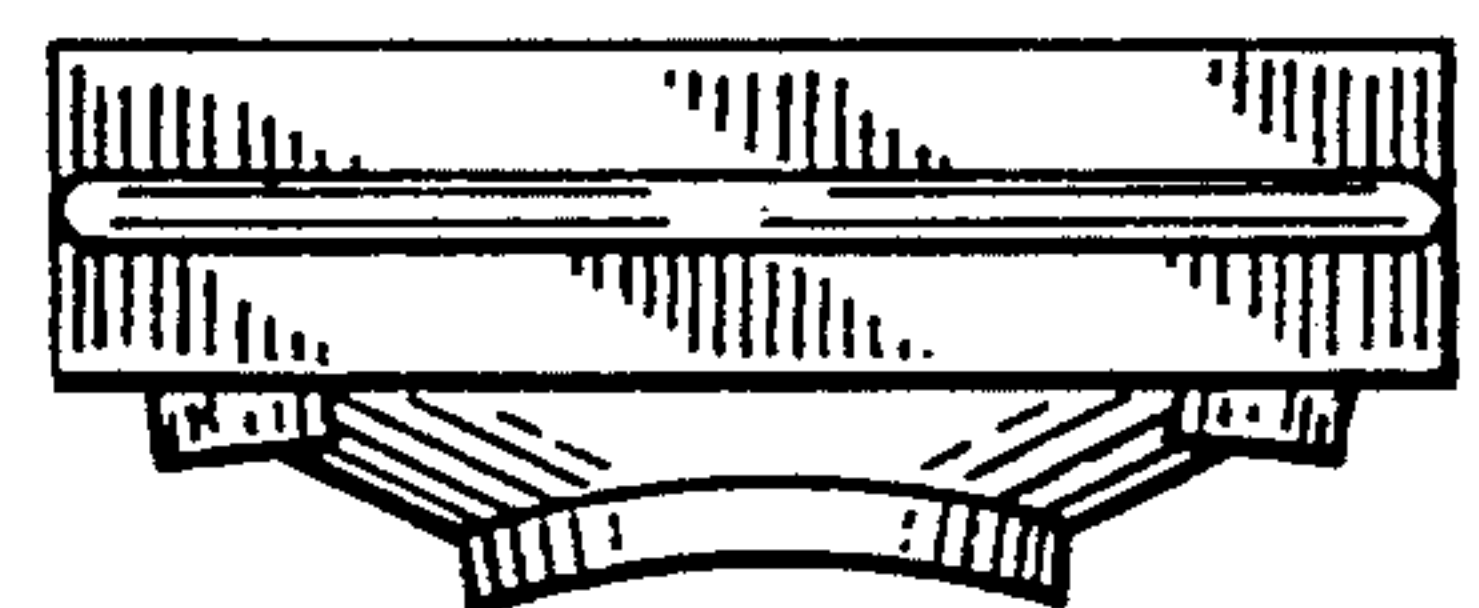
