DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a jewelry clasp showing my new design;

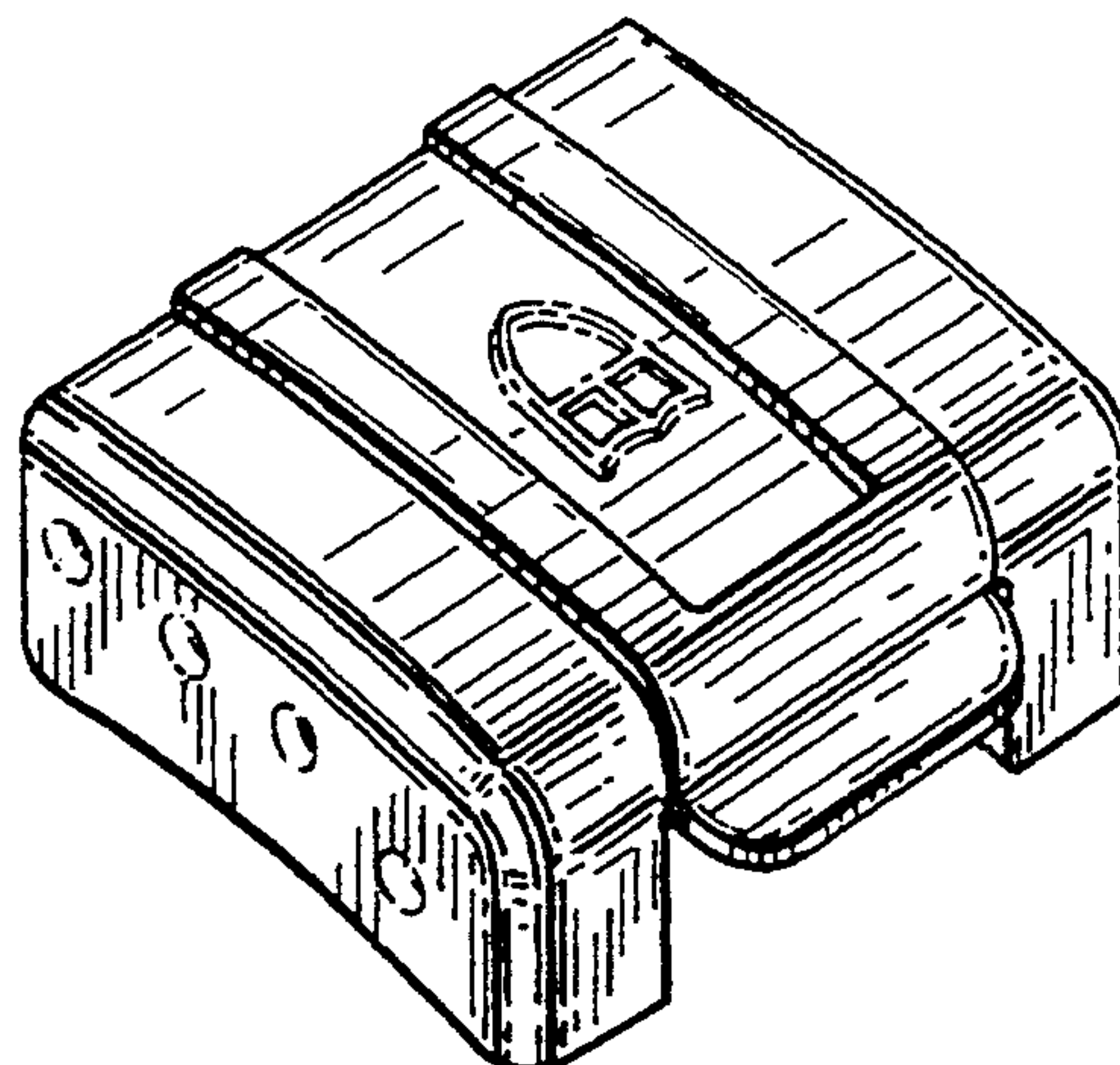
FIG. 2 is a side plan view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof;

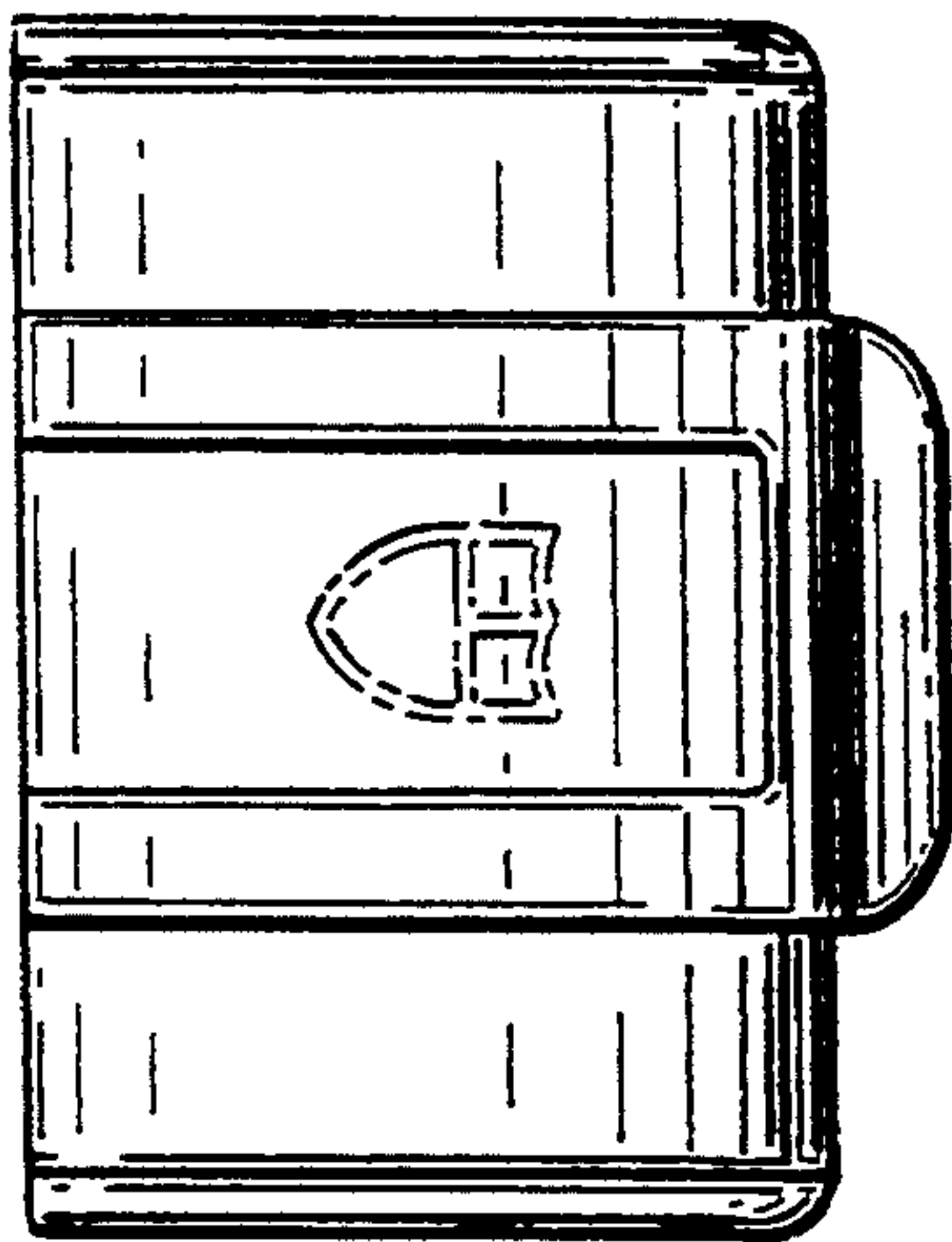

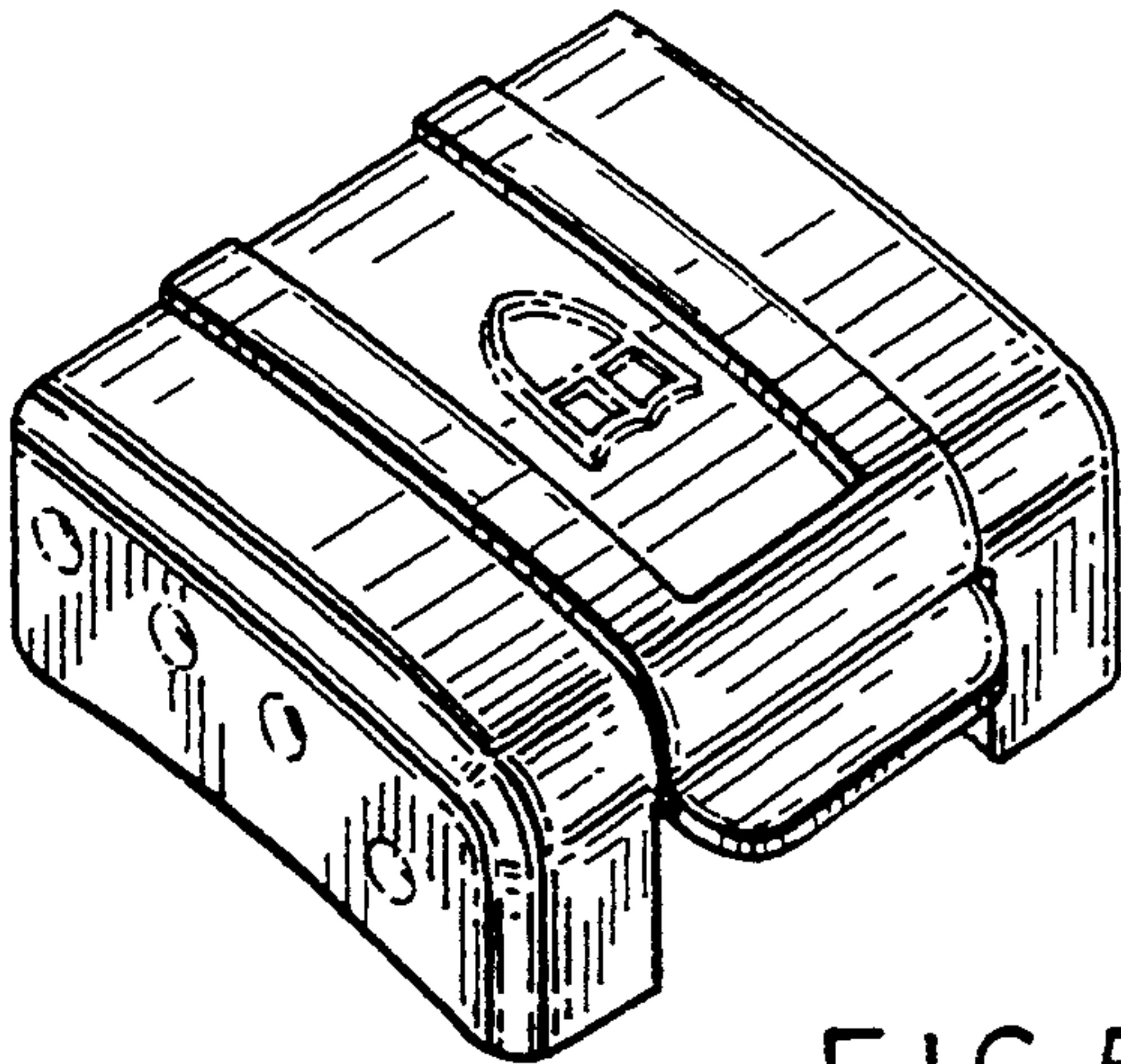

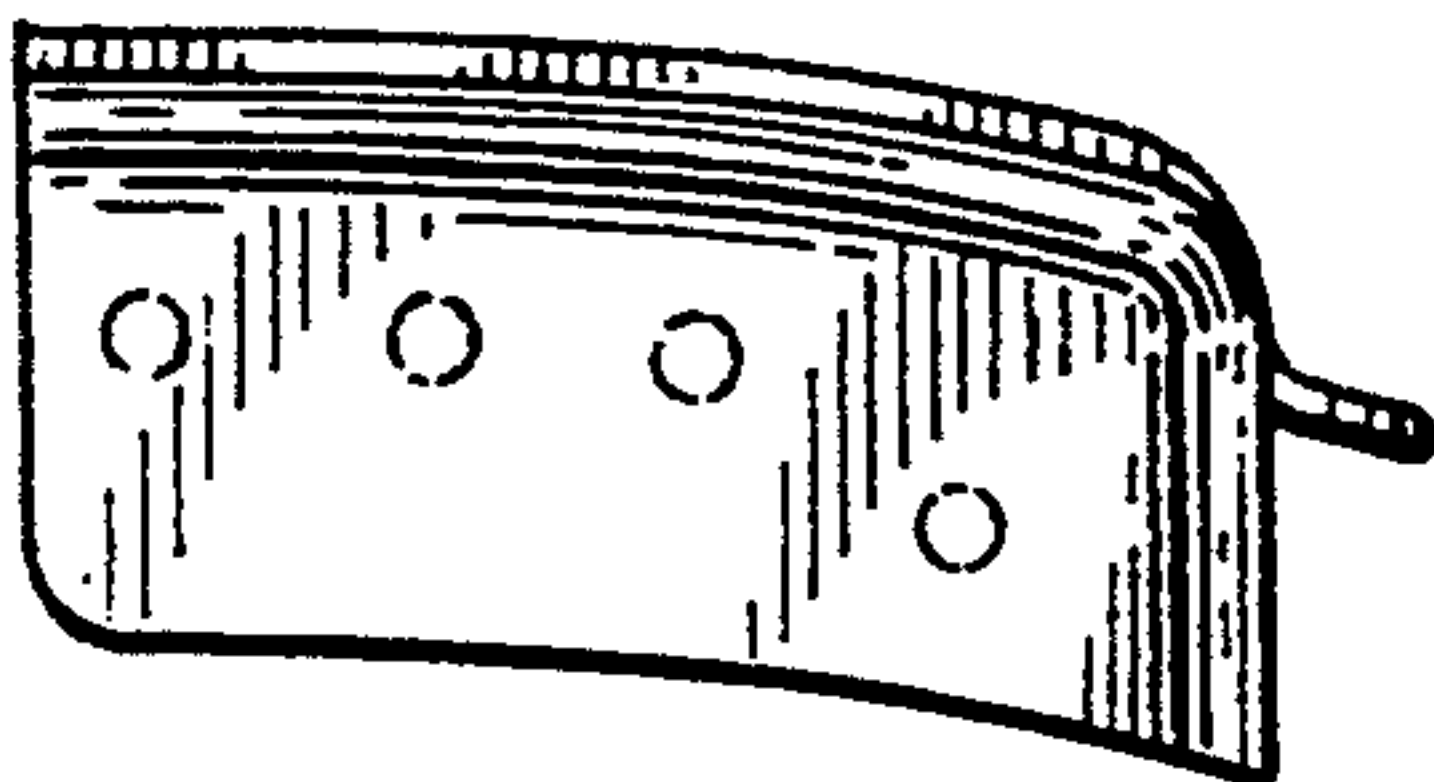

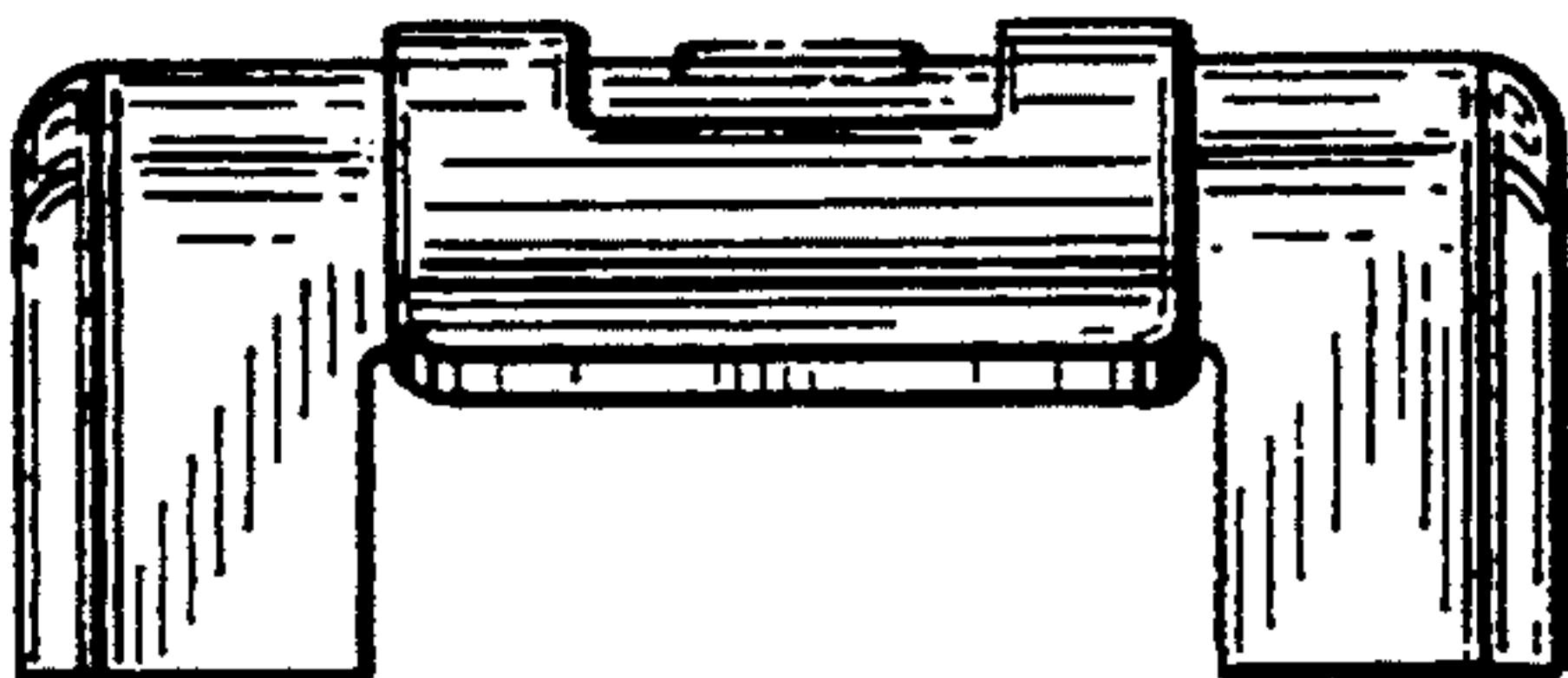

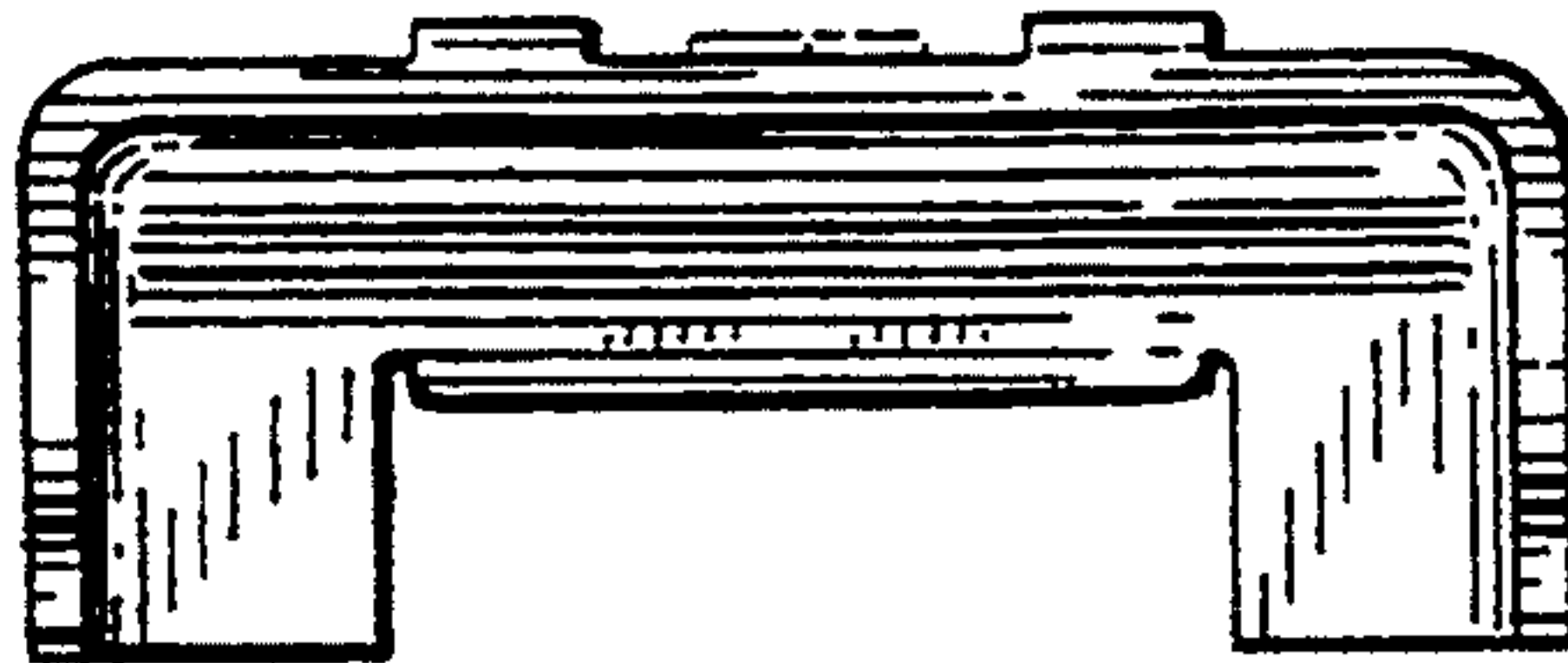
