FIG. 2 is a left side elevational of the recumbent exercise bicycle of FIG. 1;

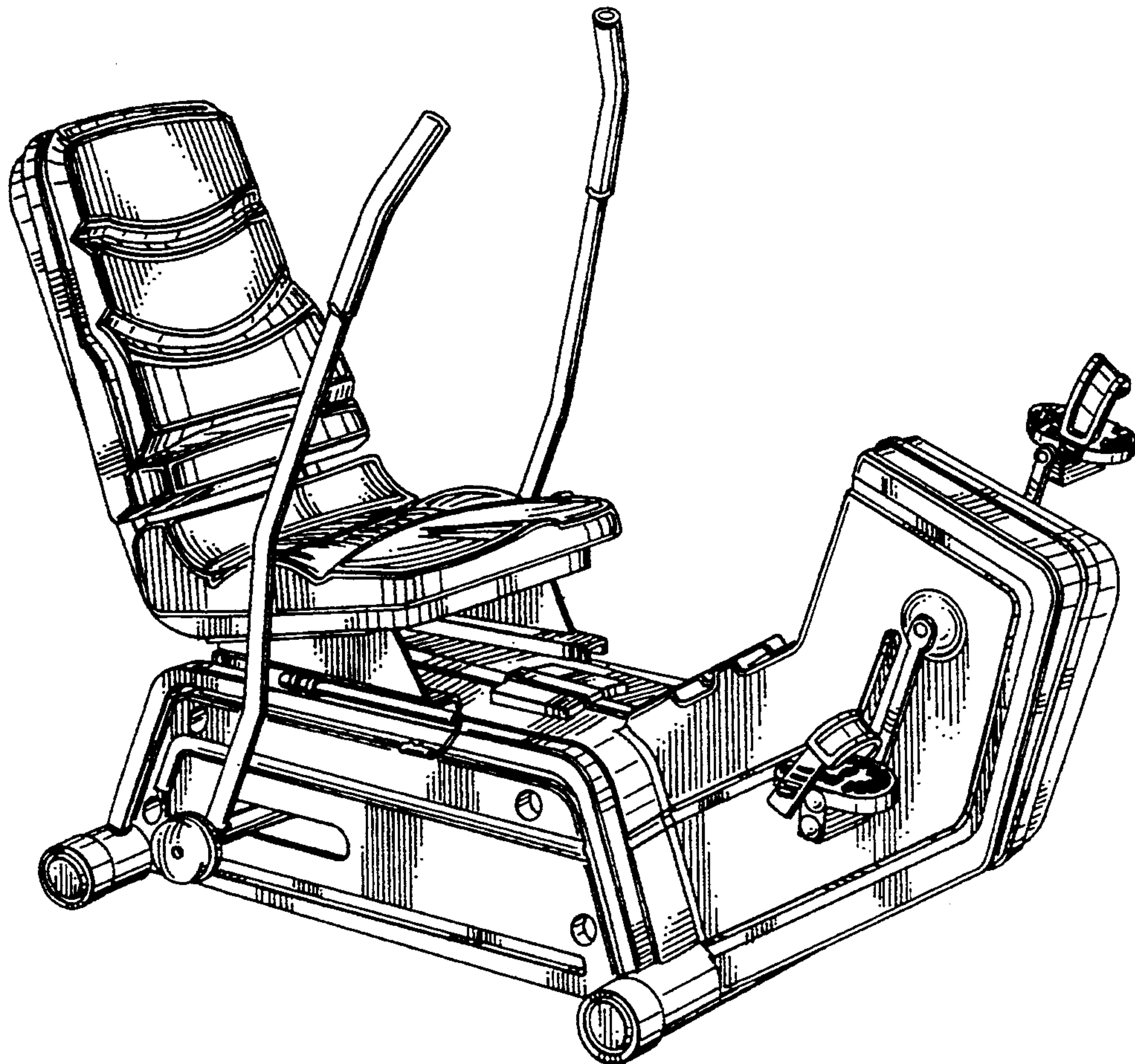
FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the recumbent exercise bicycle of FIG. 1;

FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view of the recumbent exercise bicycle of FIG. 1.



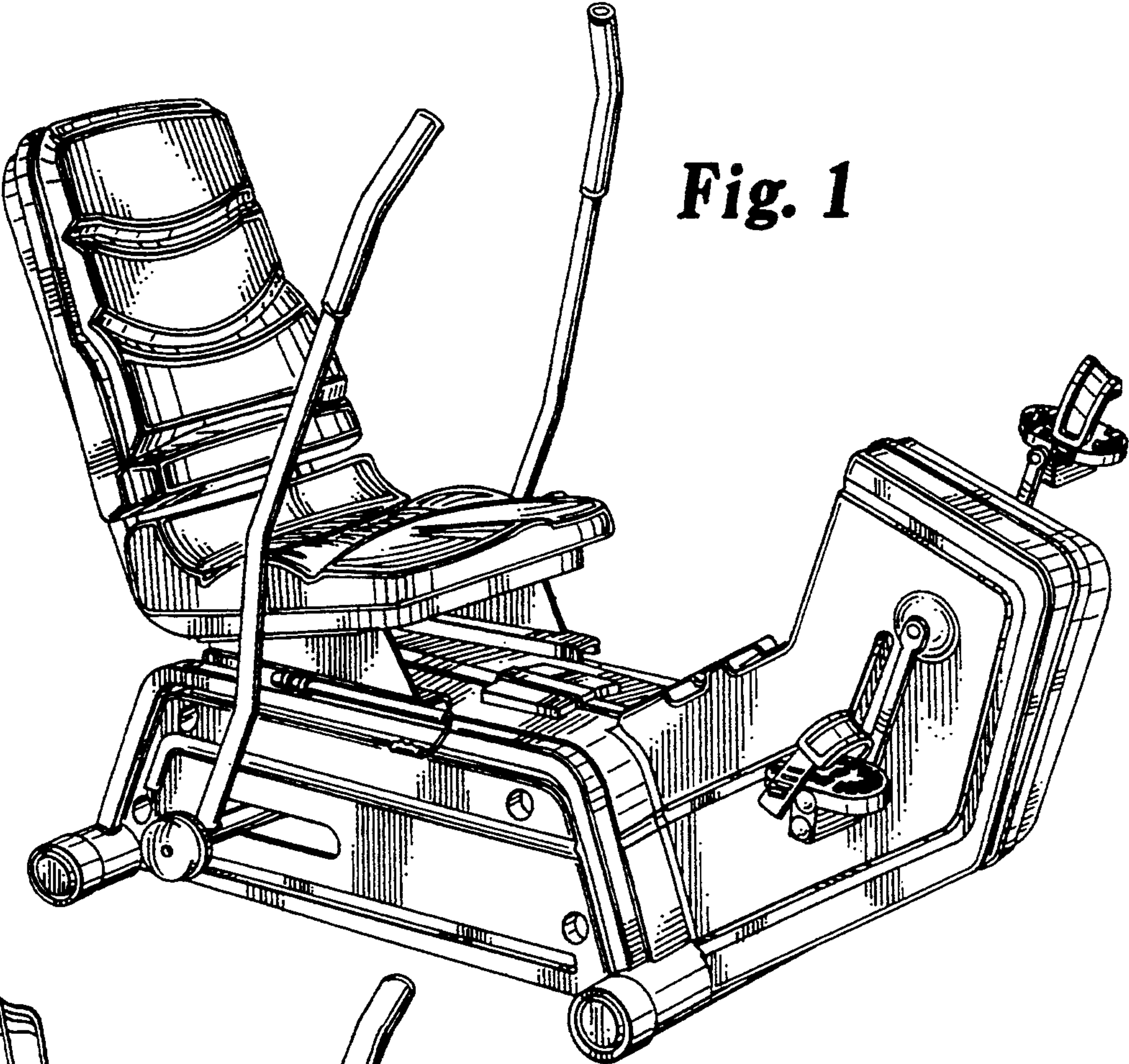

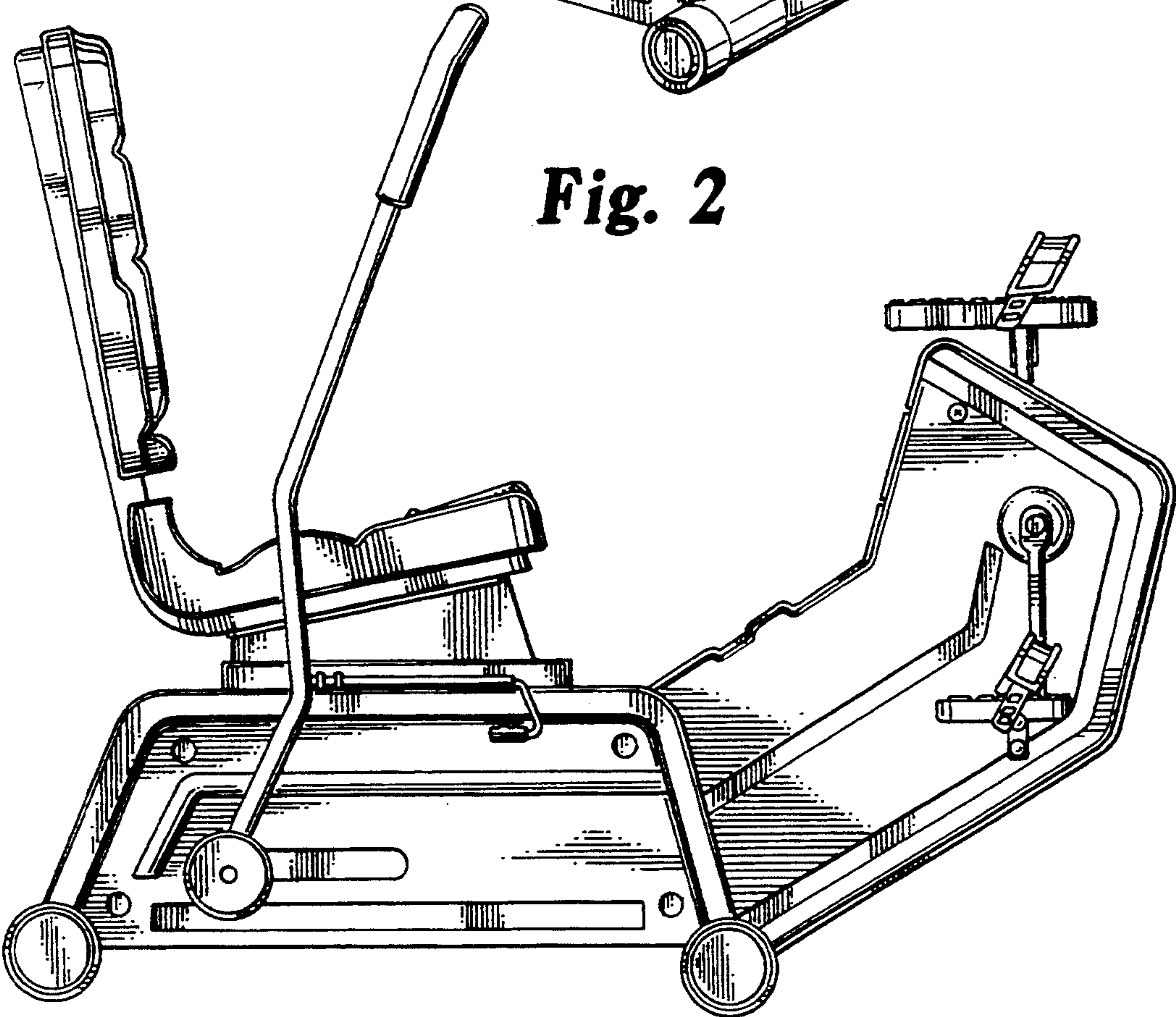

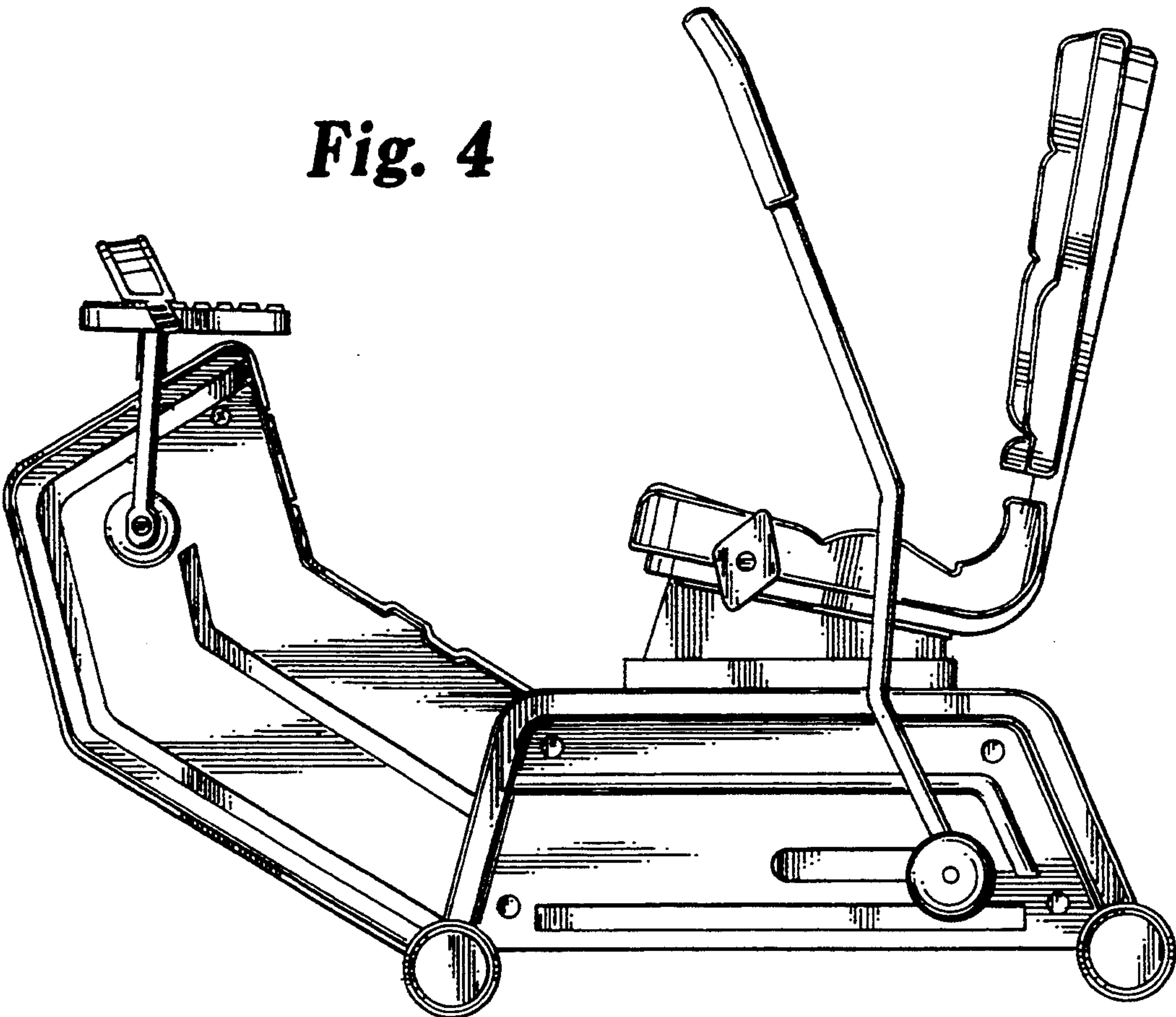
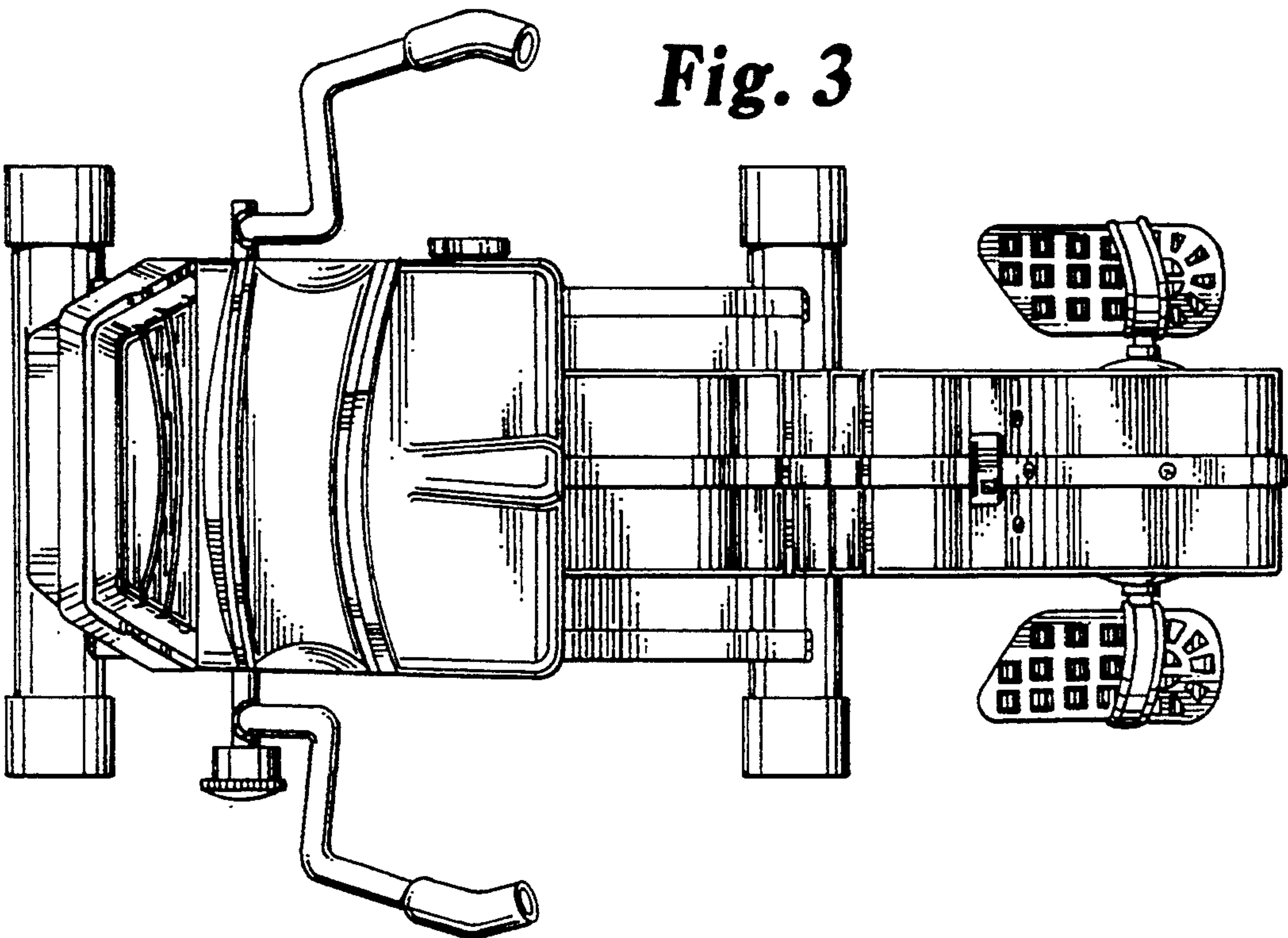

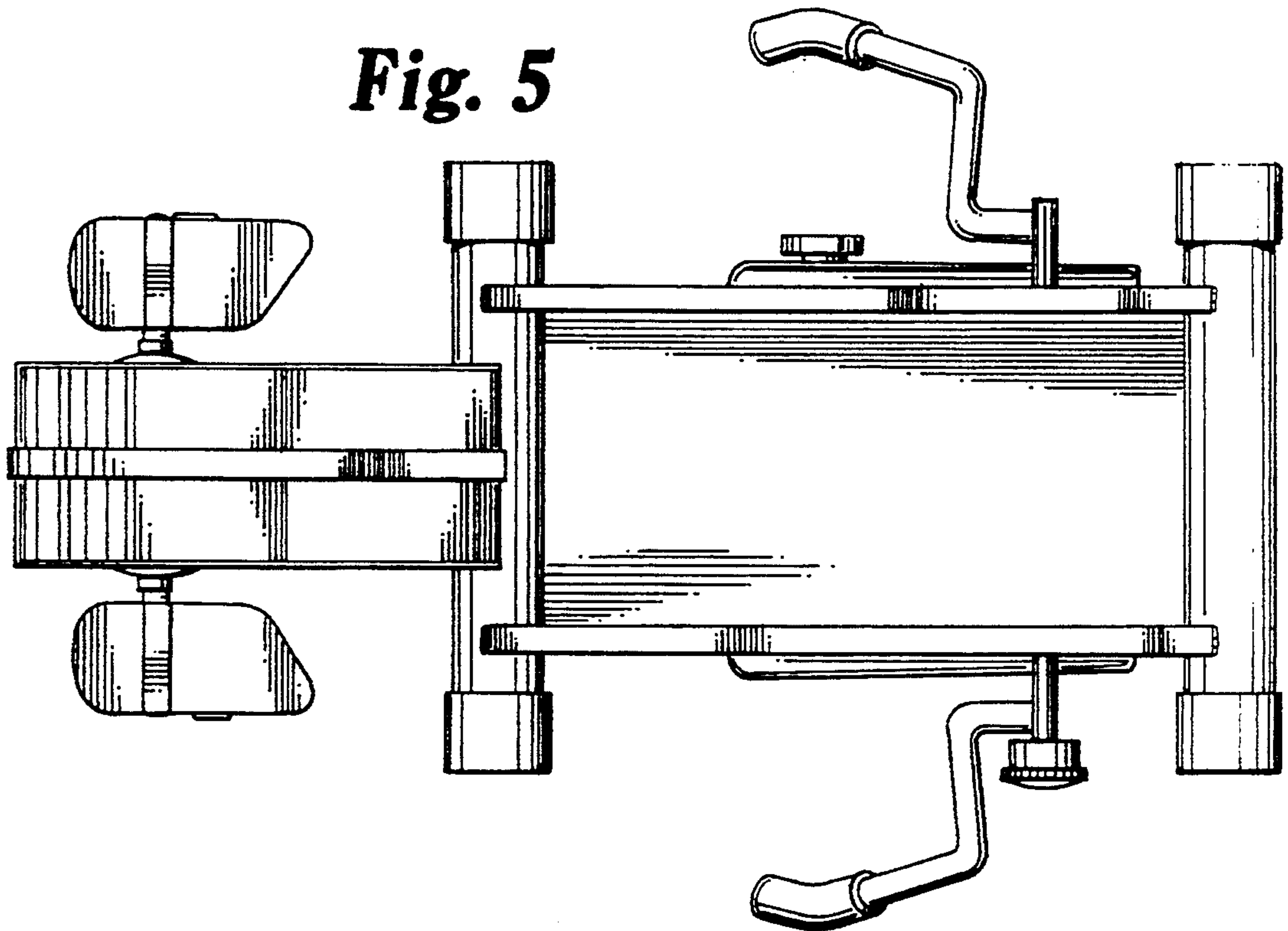

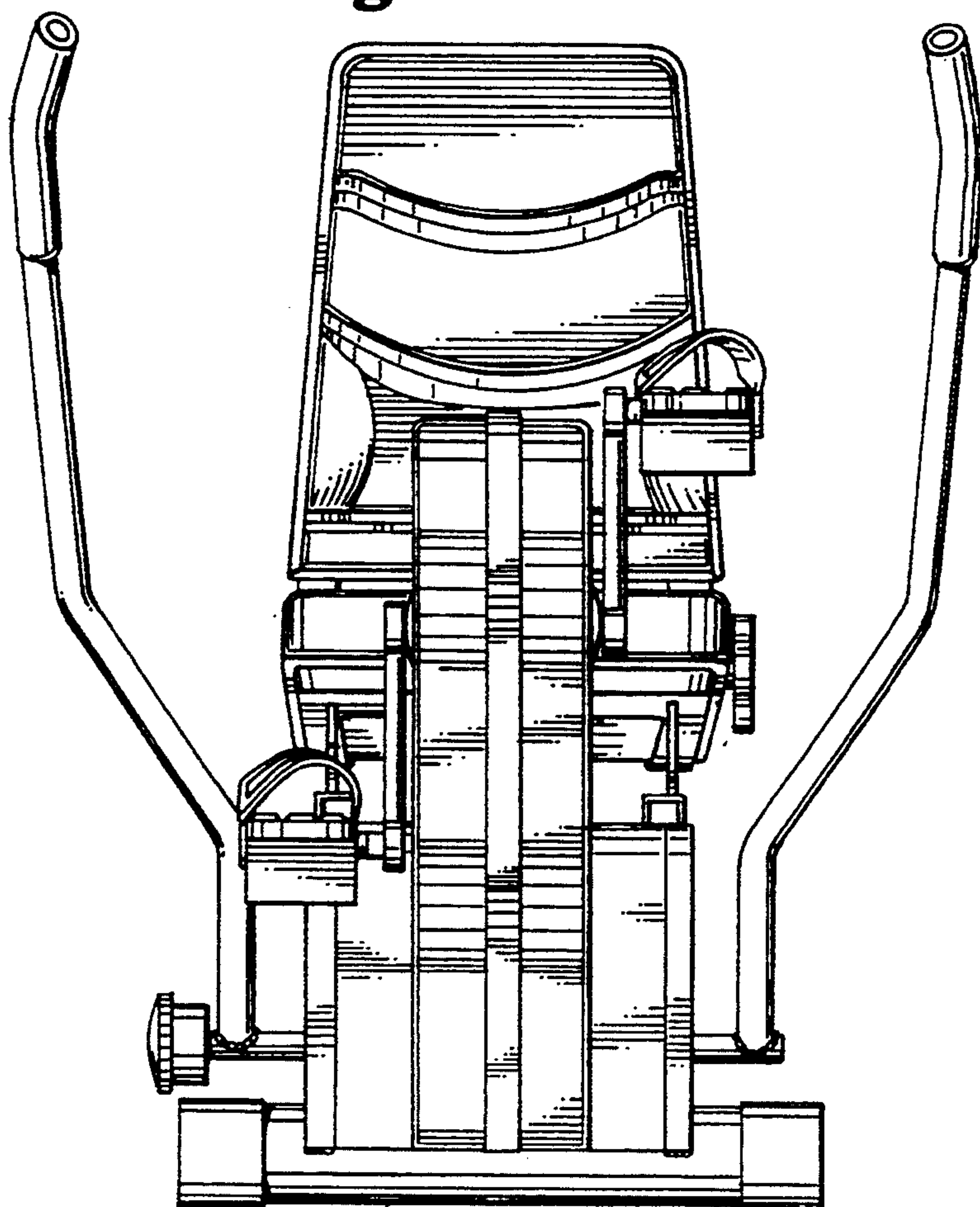
