FIG. 1 is a lateral side elevational view of a shoe sole showing my new design;

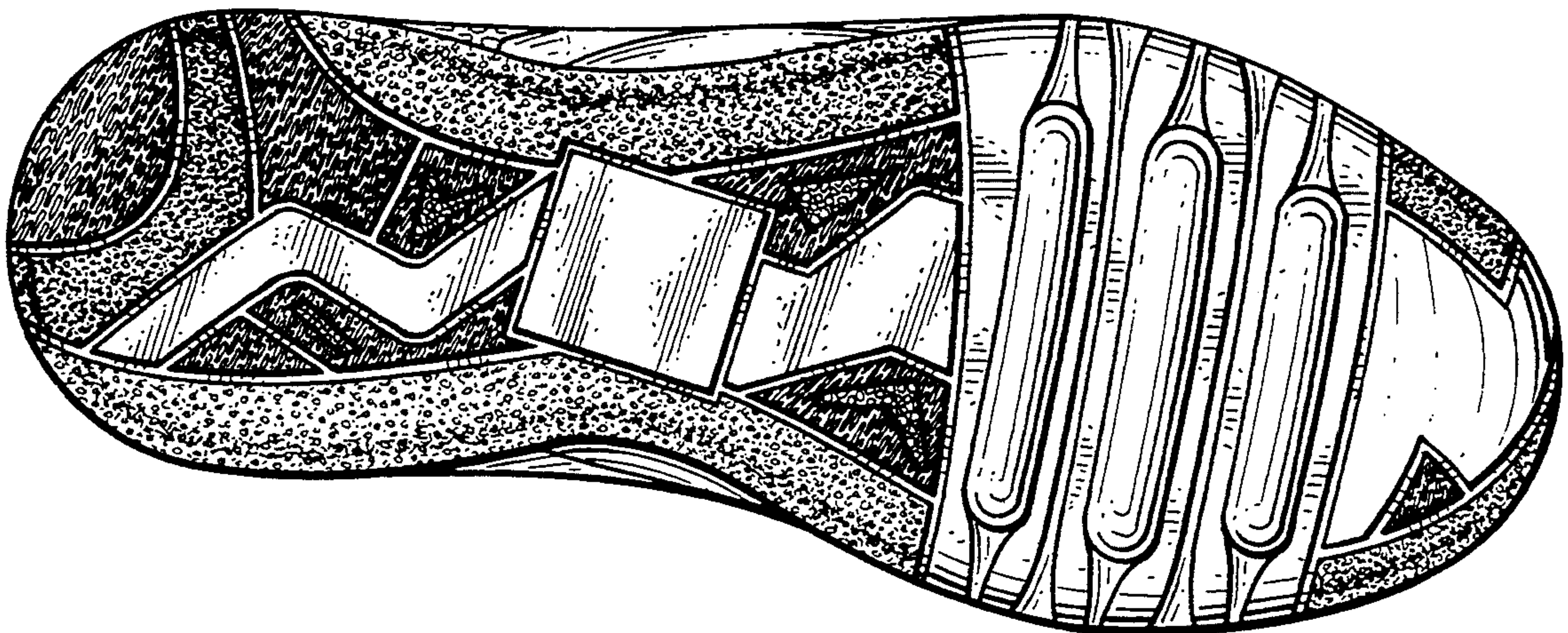
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;

The broken line showing of a shoe upper is for environmental purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



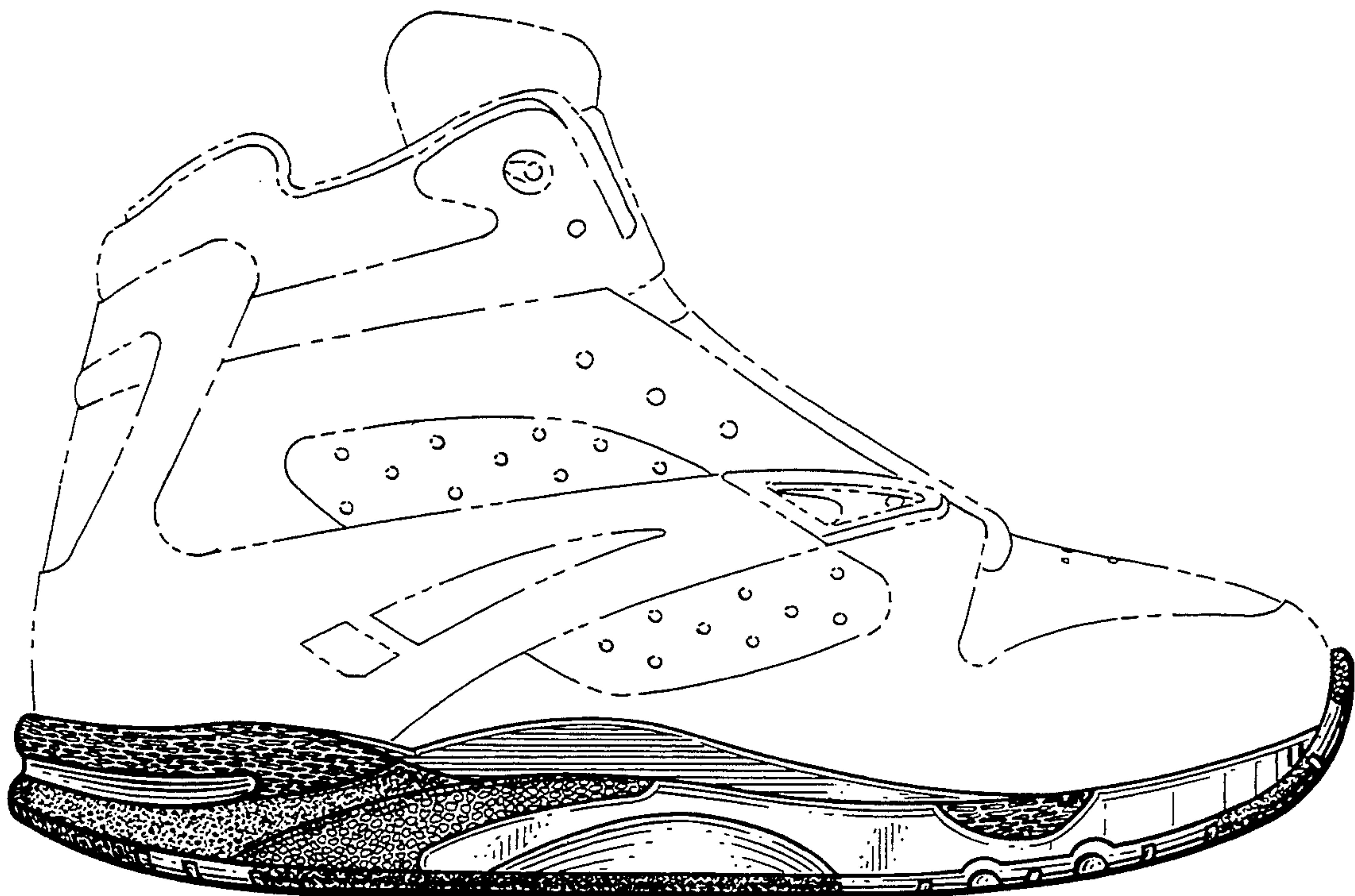

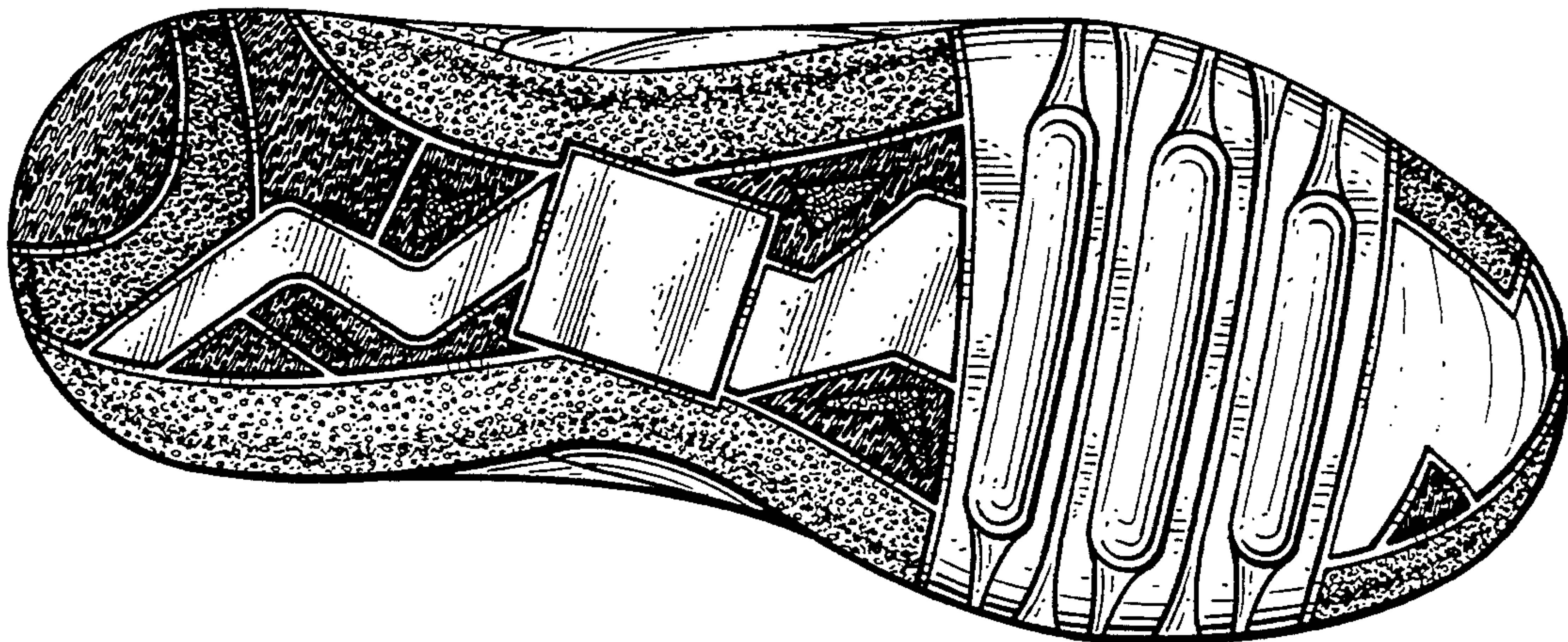

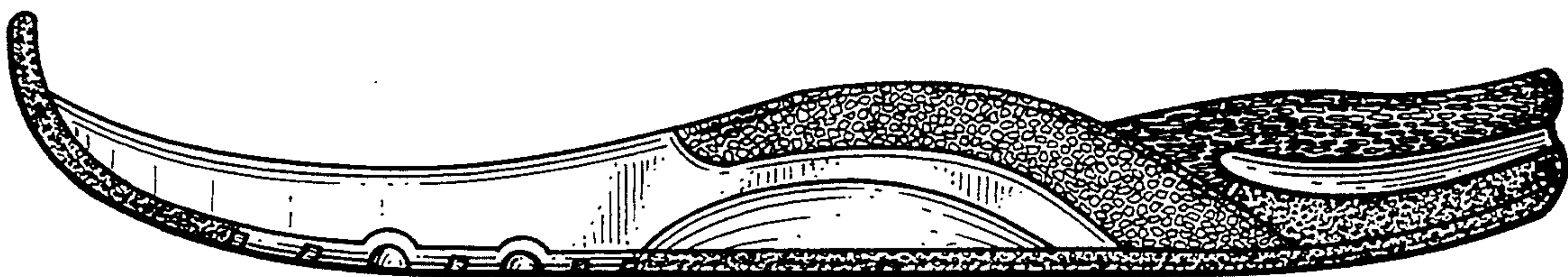

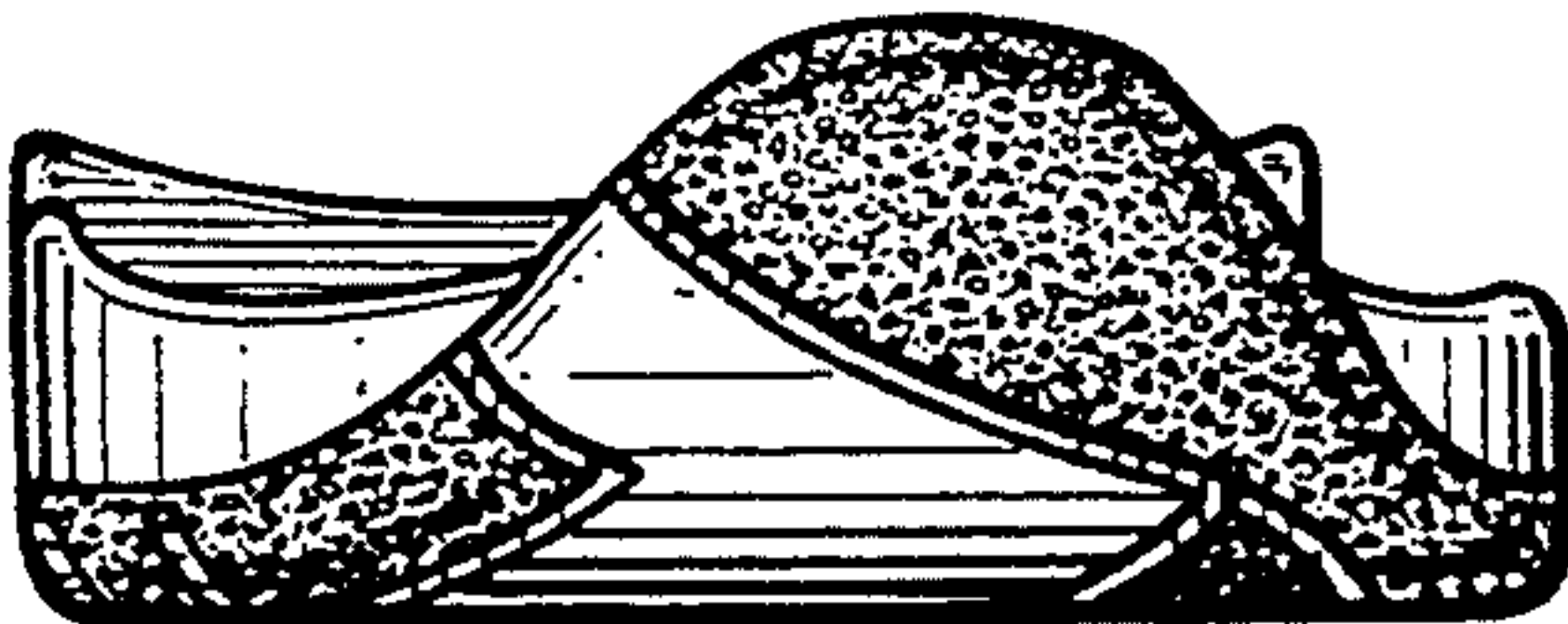

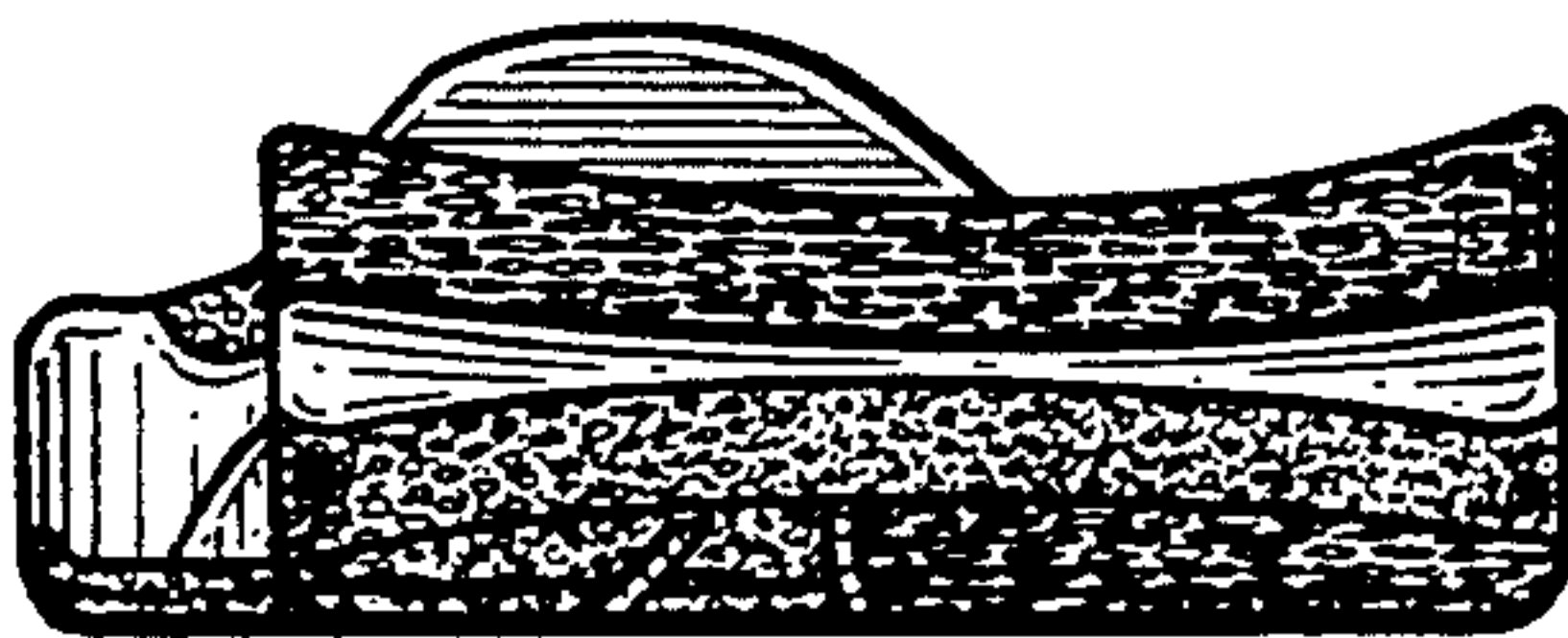
