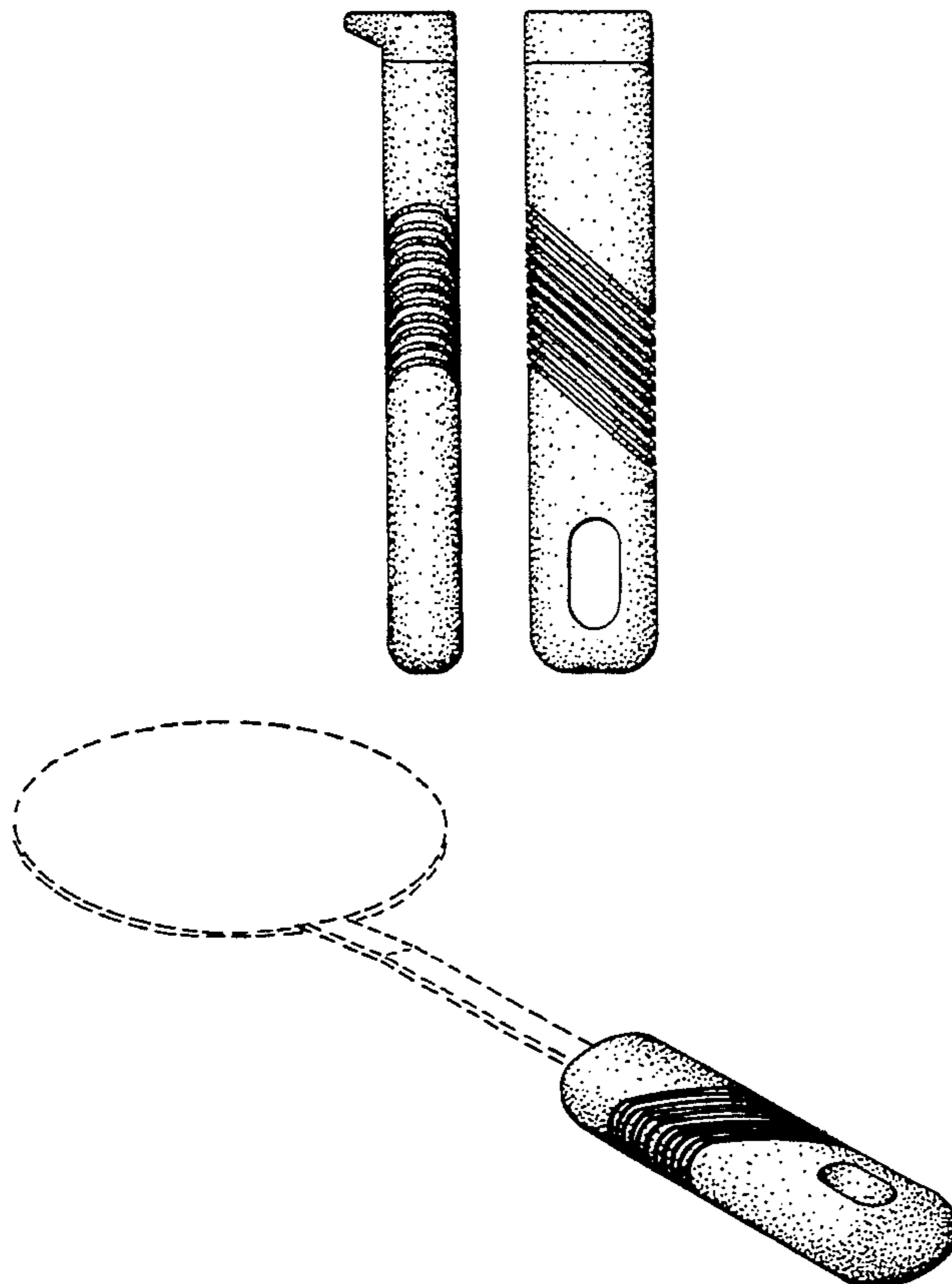

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a cooking utensil handle, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a cooking utensil handle showing my new design;  
 FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;  
 FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;  
 FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;  
 FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof;  
 FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof;  
 FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view thereof;  
 FIG. 8 is a bottom, front, left side perspective view of an alternate embodiment of FIG. 1, all views thereof, including opposite sides of each view, substantially corresponding to those of FIGS. 1 through 7 except in proportion and in the omission of the lateral protuberance toward the utensil portion, shown in broken lines, of the handle of FIGS. 1 through 7; and,  
 FIG. 9 is a bottom, front, left side perspective view of an alternate embodiment of FIG. 1, all views thereof, including opposite sides of each view, substantially corresponding to those of FIGS. 1 through 7 except in proportion and in the omission of the lateral protuberance toward the utensil portion, shown in broken lines, of the handle of FIGS. 1 through 7.  
 The broken lines of the utensil portion shown in FIGS. 1, 8 and 9 are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed cooking utensil handle design.



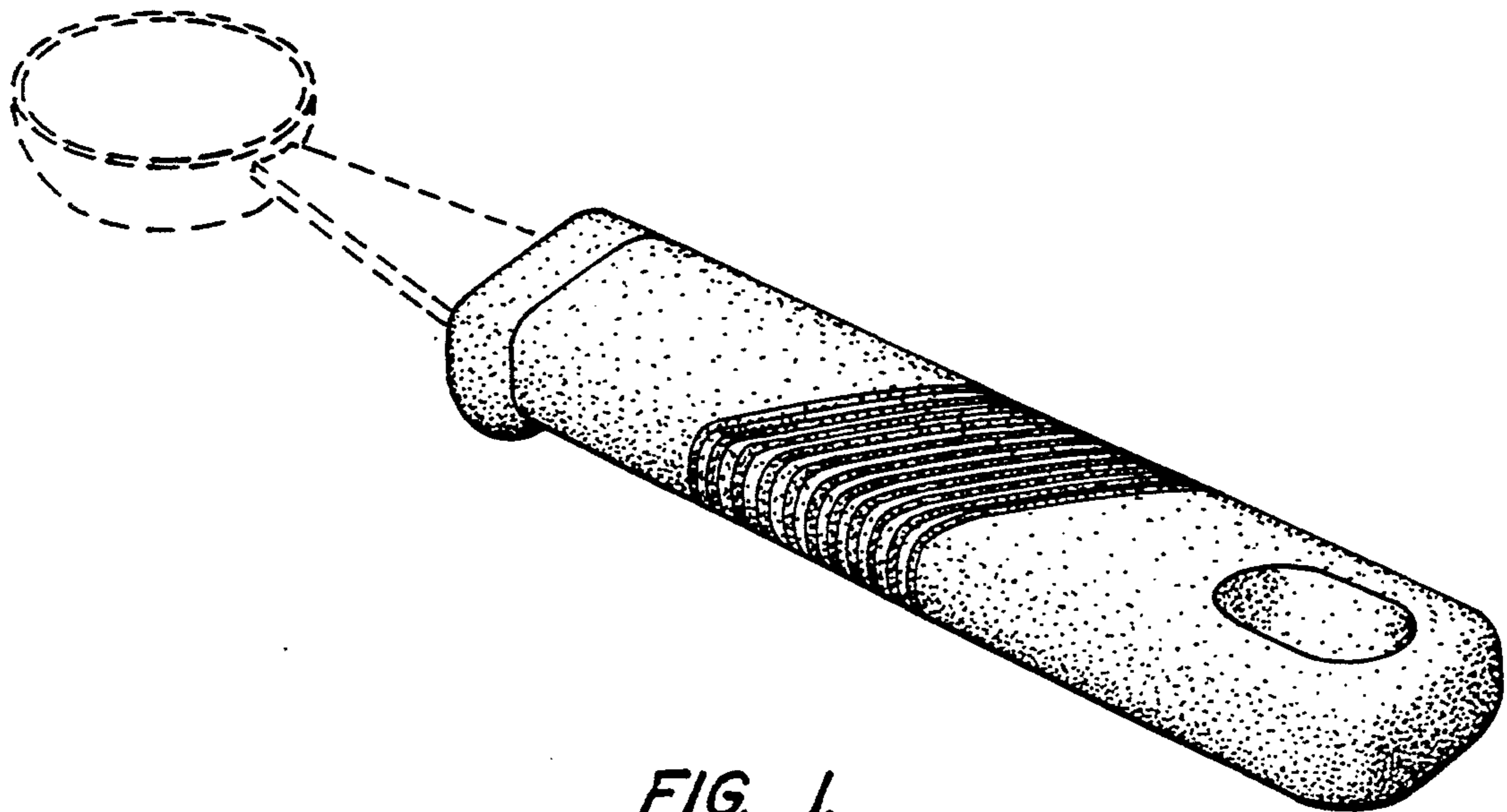

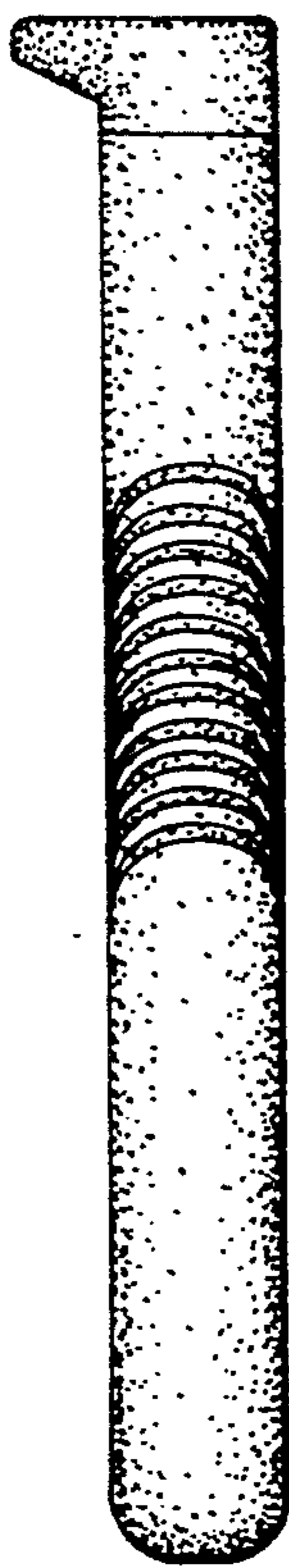

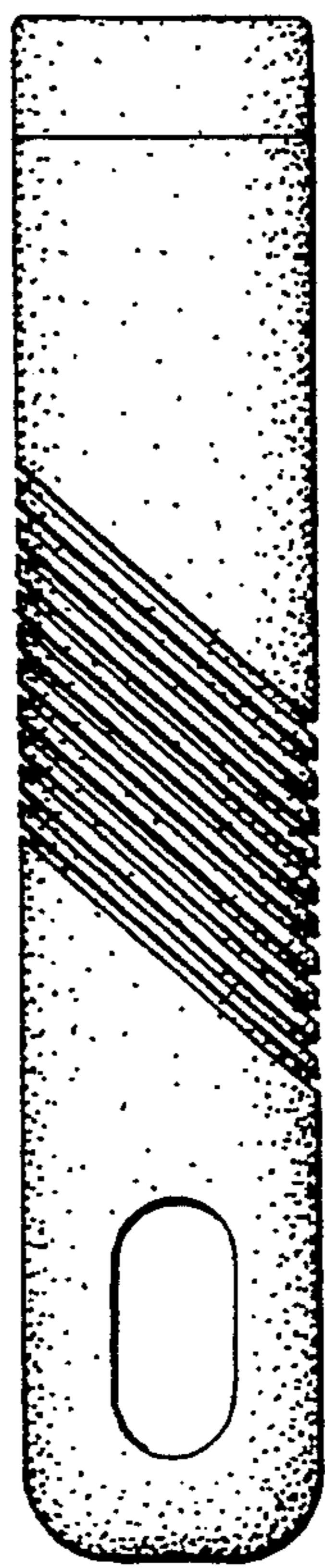

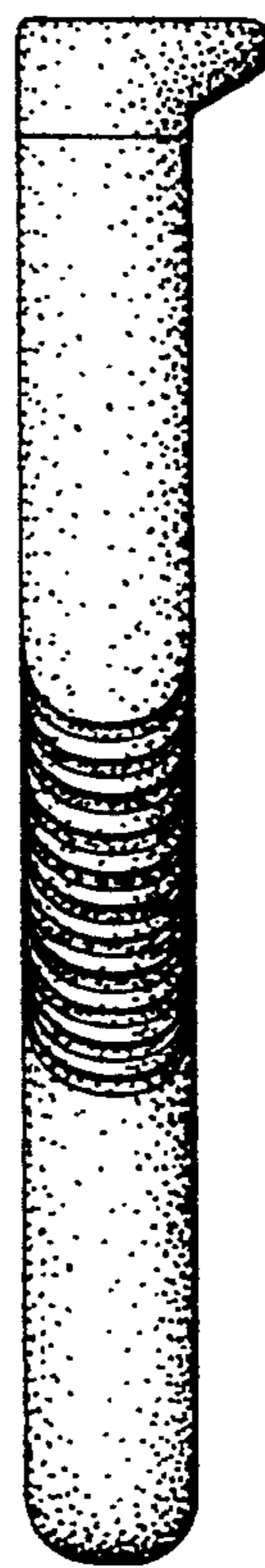

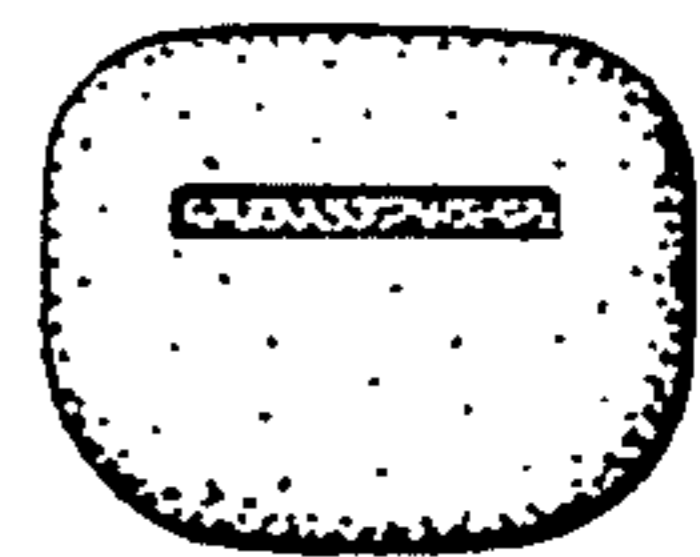

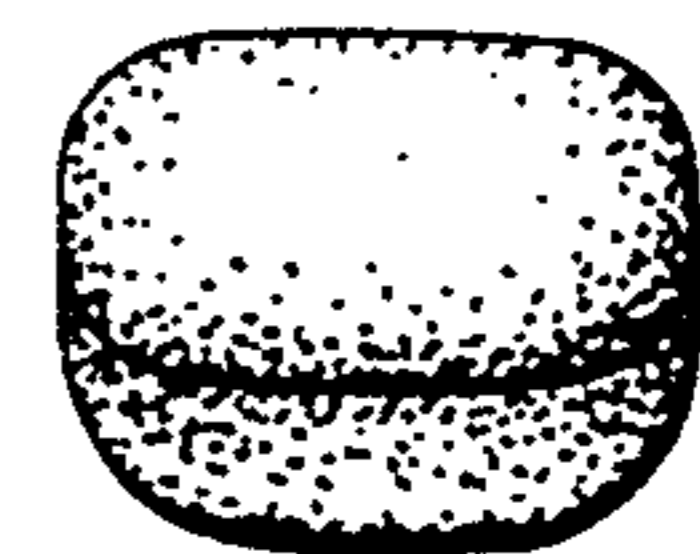

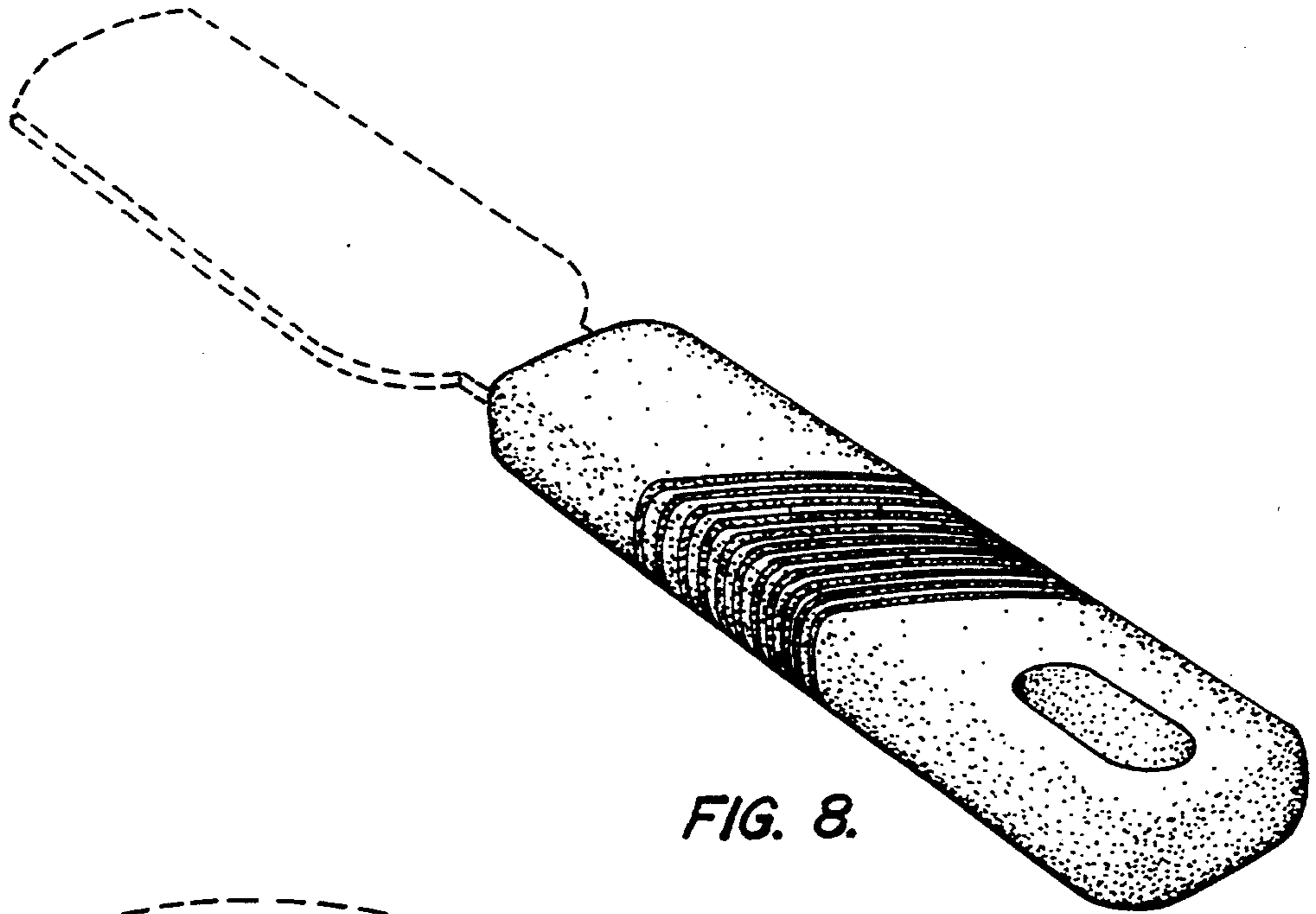

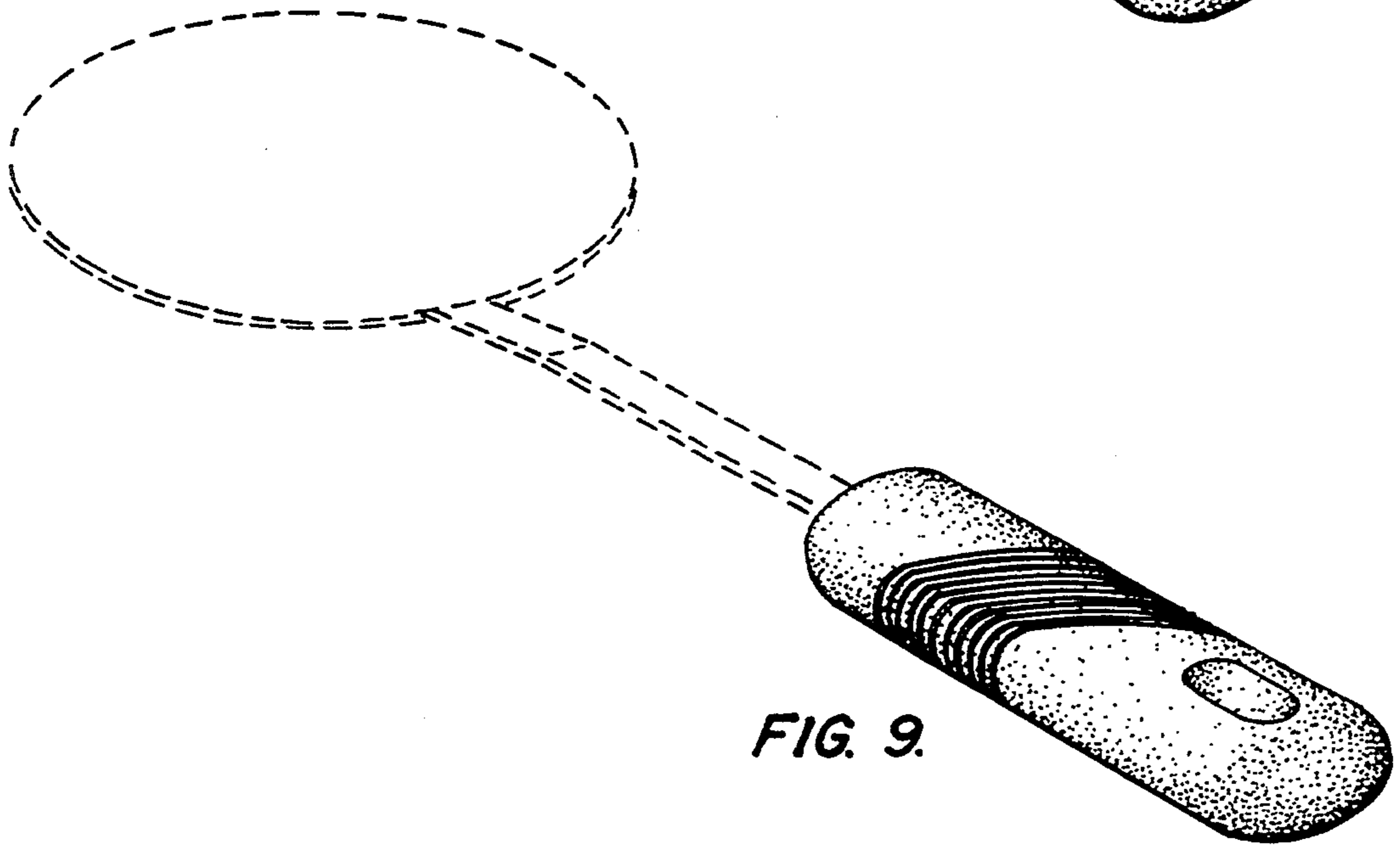
