[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a writing instrument, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a writing instrument showing my new design, with the cap member in a stored position;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view with the cap member removed for convenience of illustration;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a front elevational view with the cap member in a closed position;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 5;

FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view of FIG. 5;

FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 5; and,

FIG. 9 is a top plan view of FIG. 5.

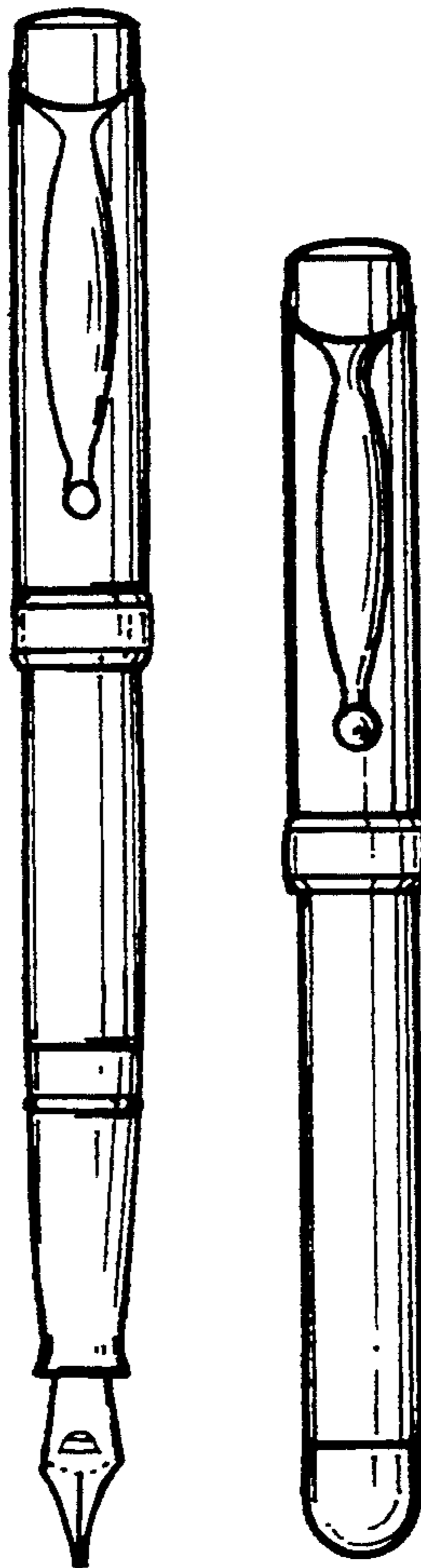

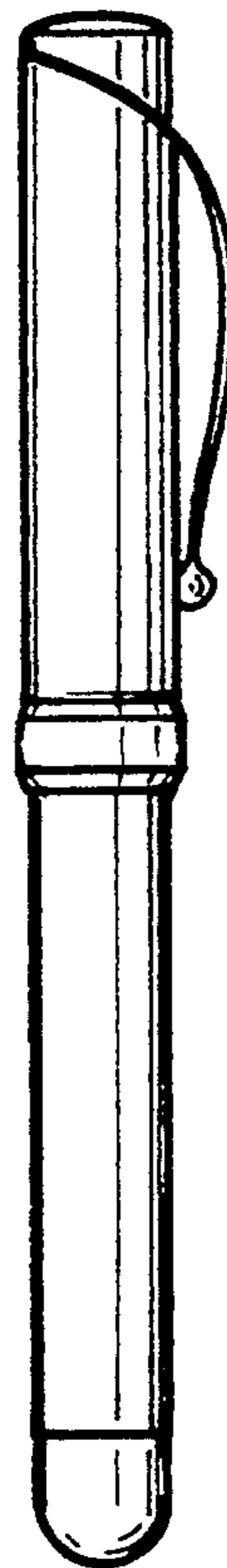
