FIG. 5 is a front perspective view thereof.

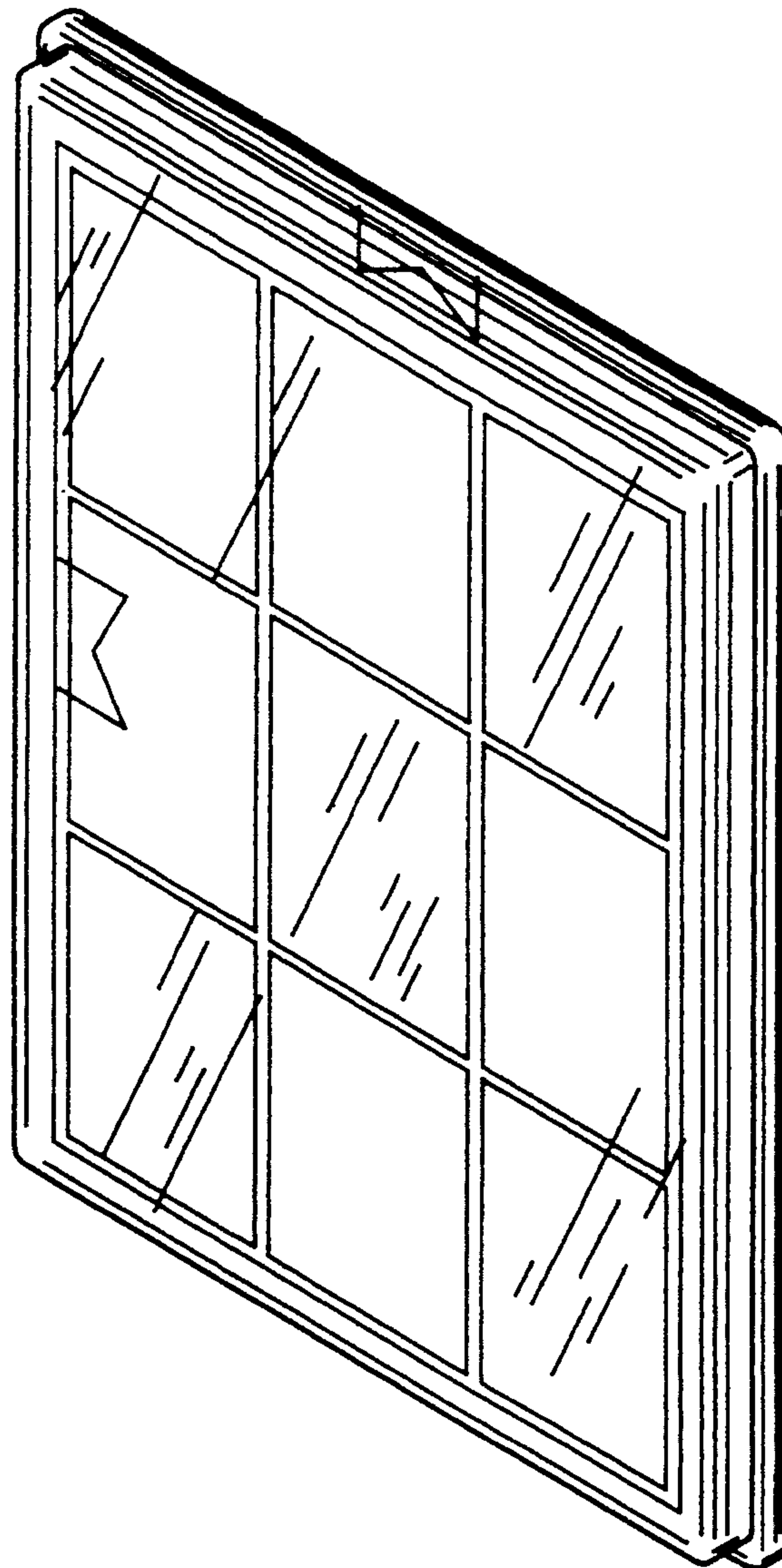

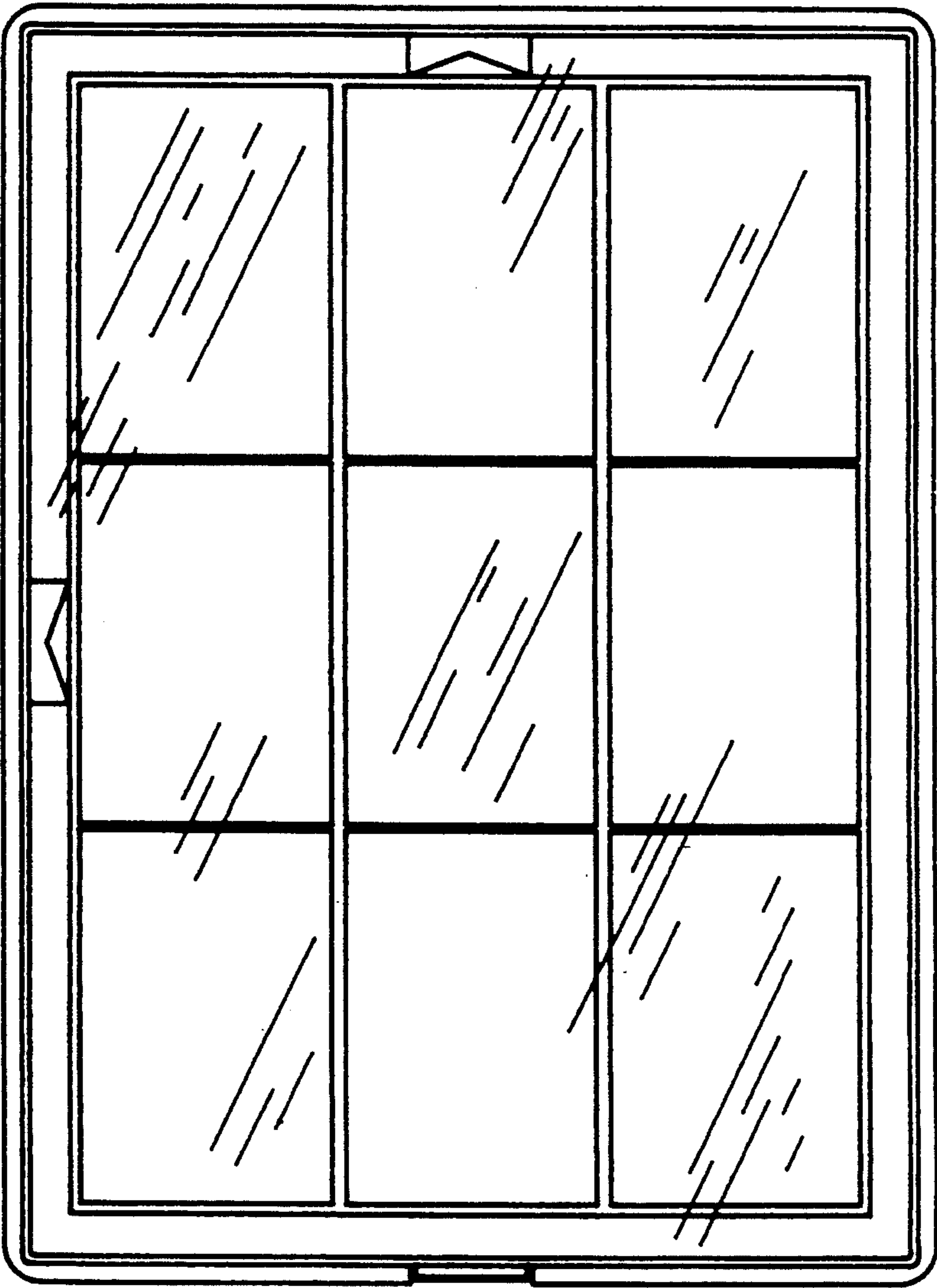

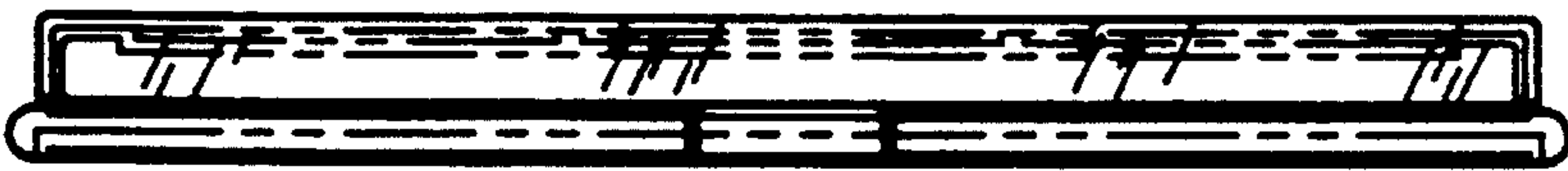

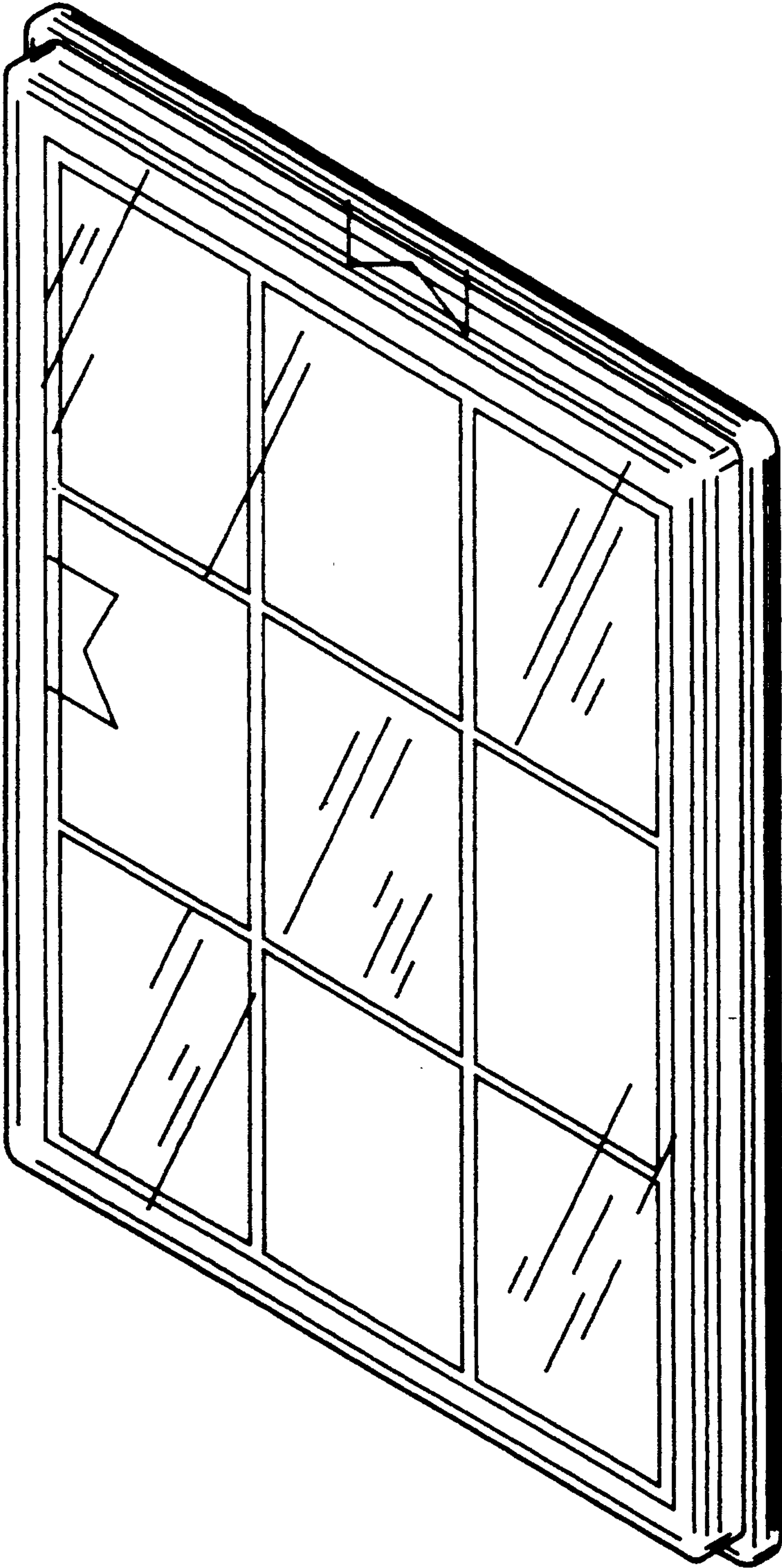
