thereof.

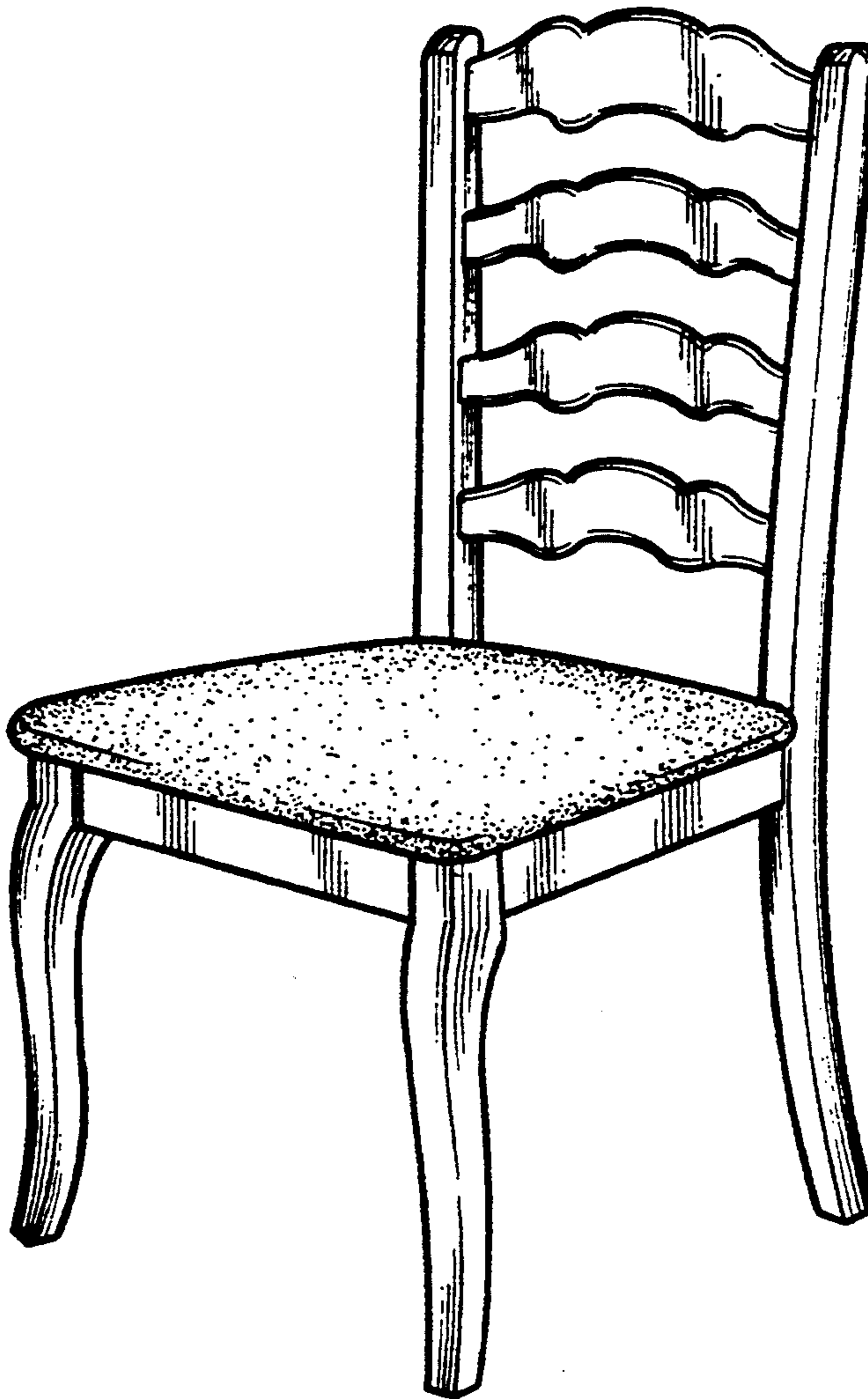

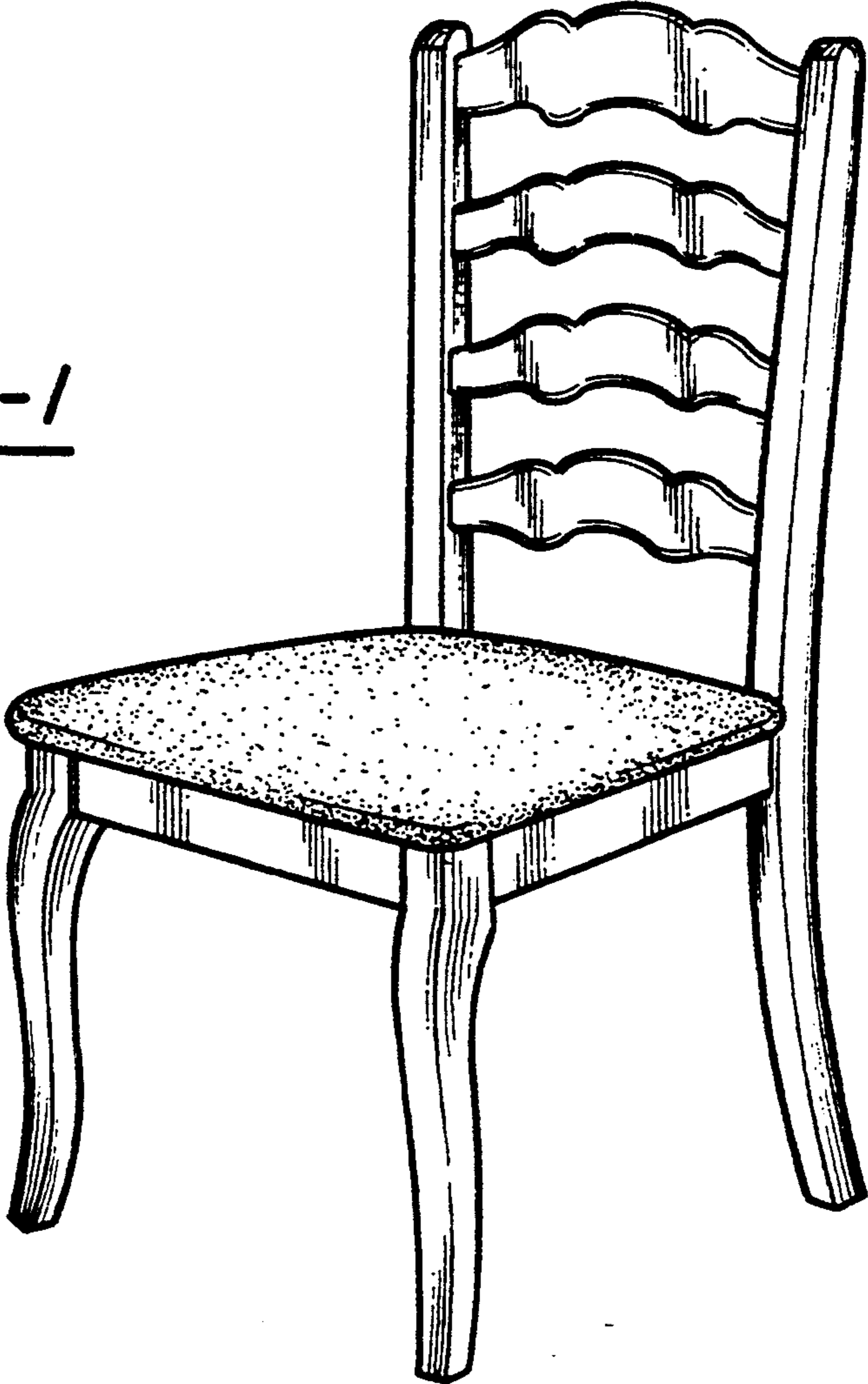
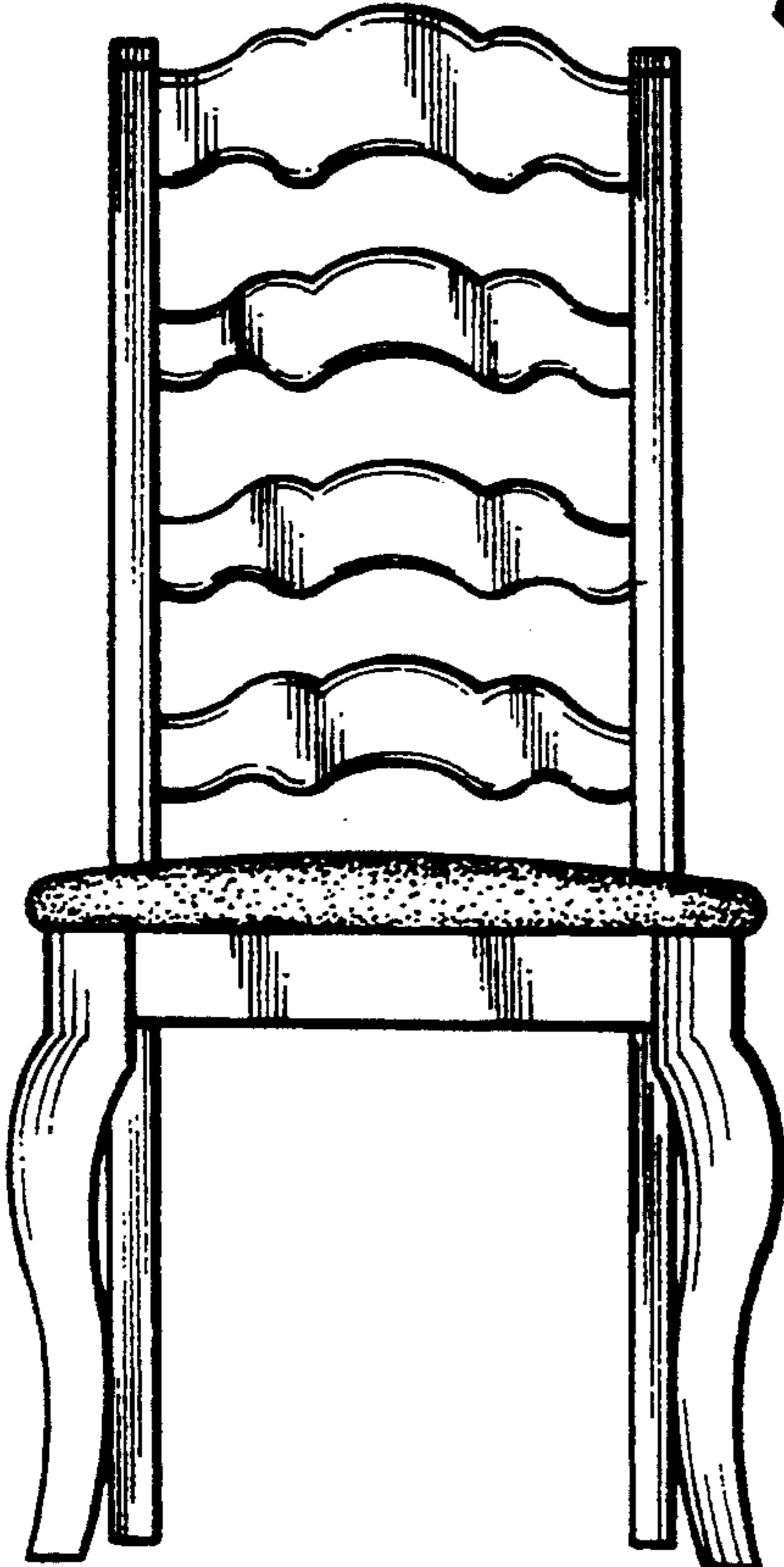

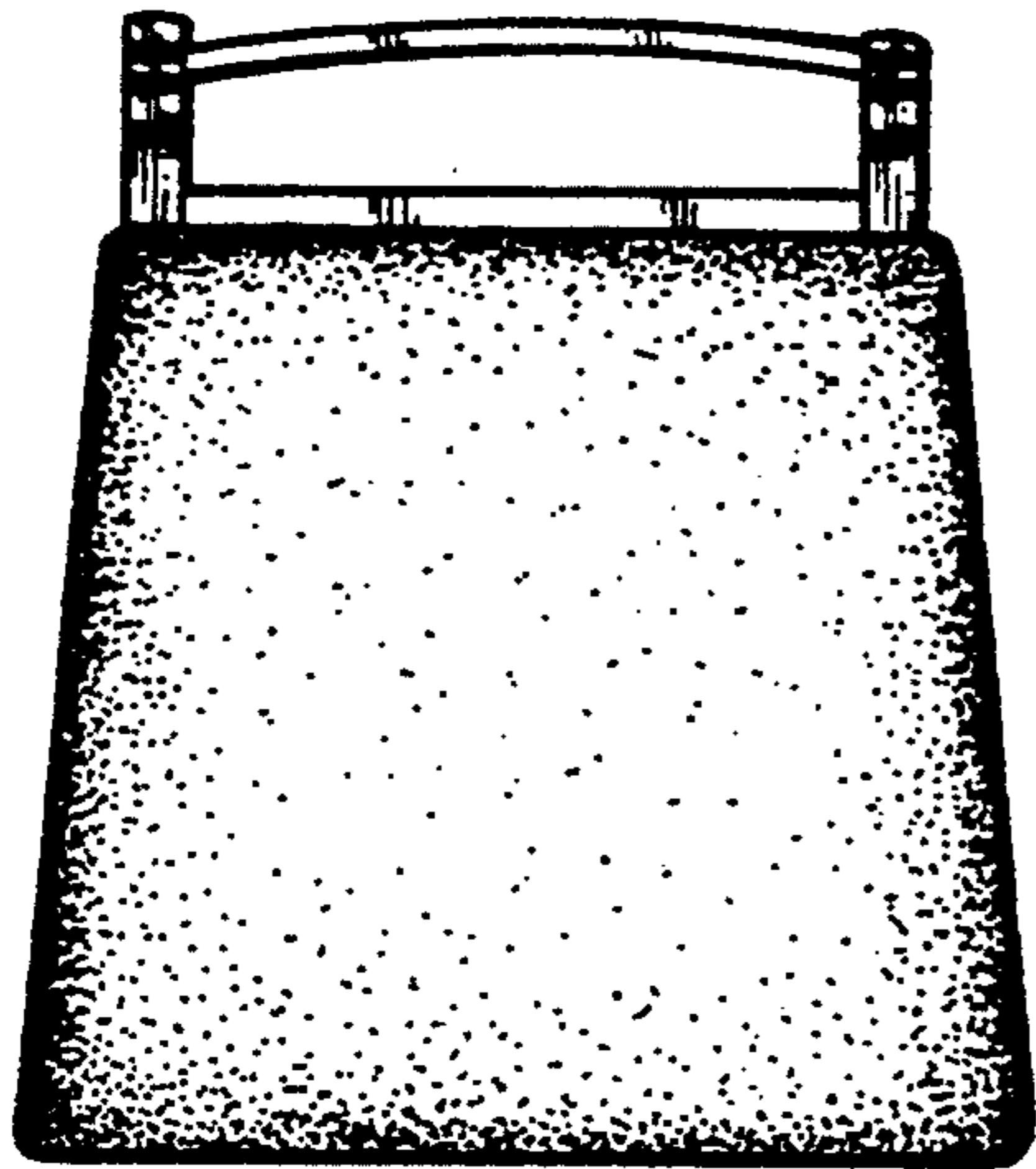

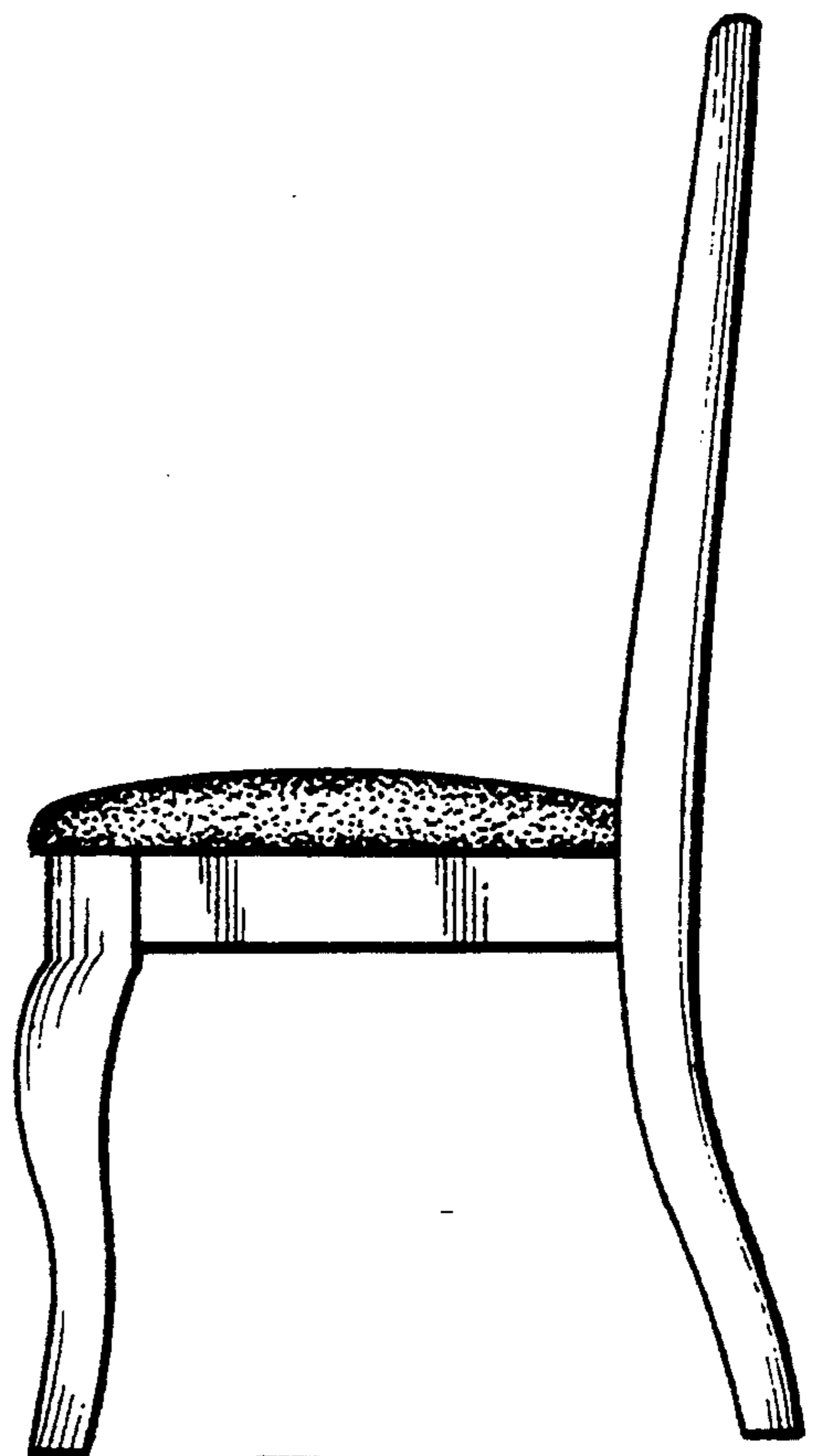

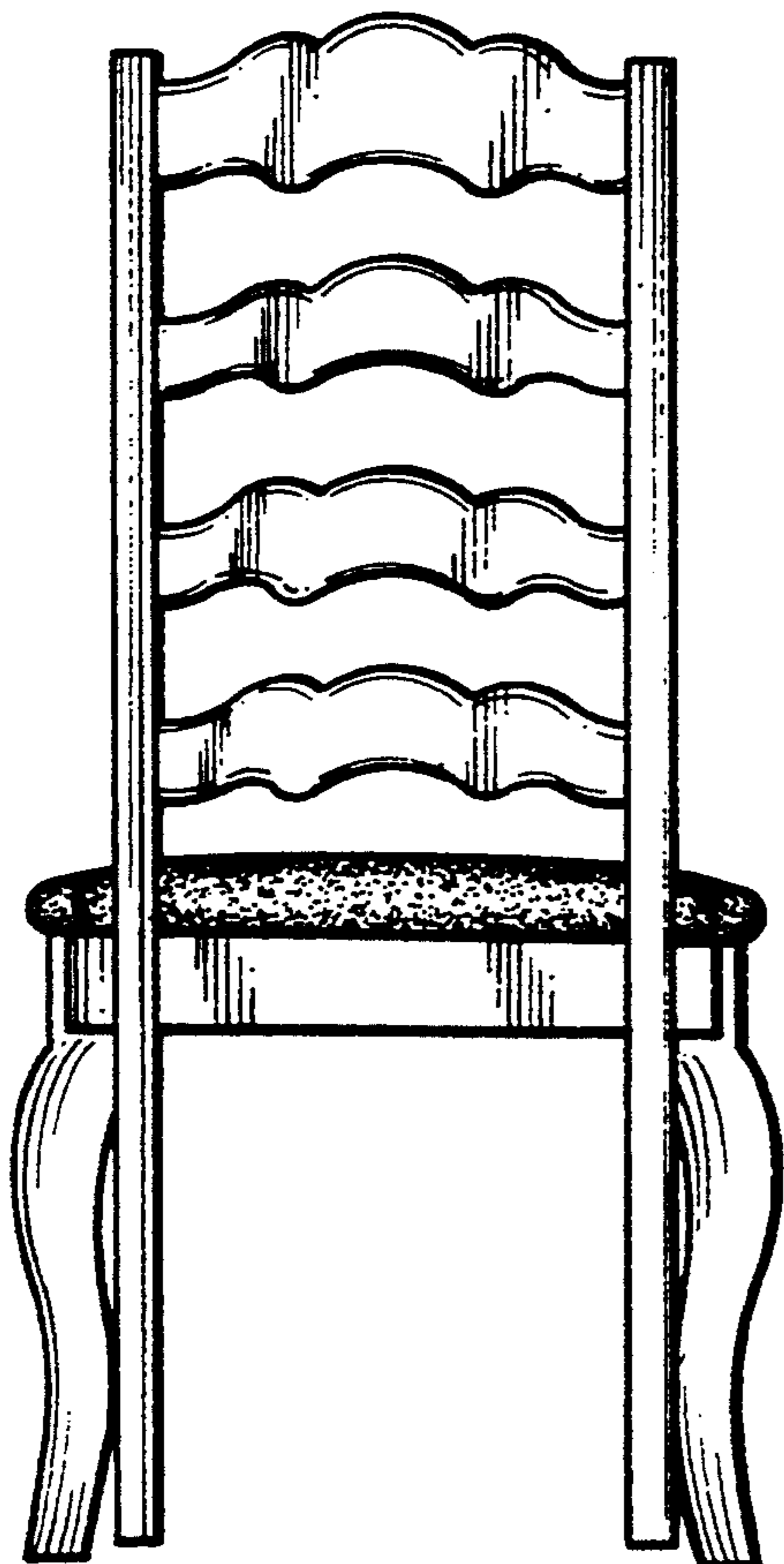

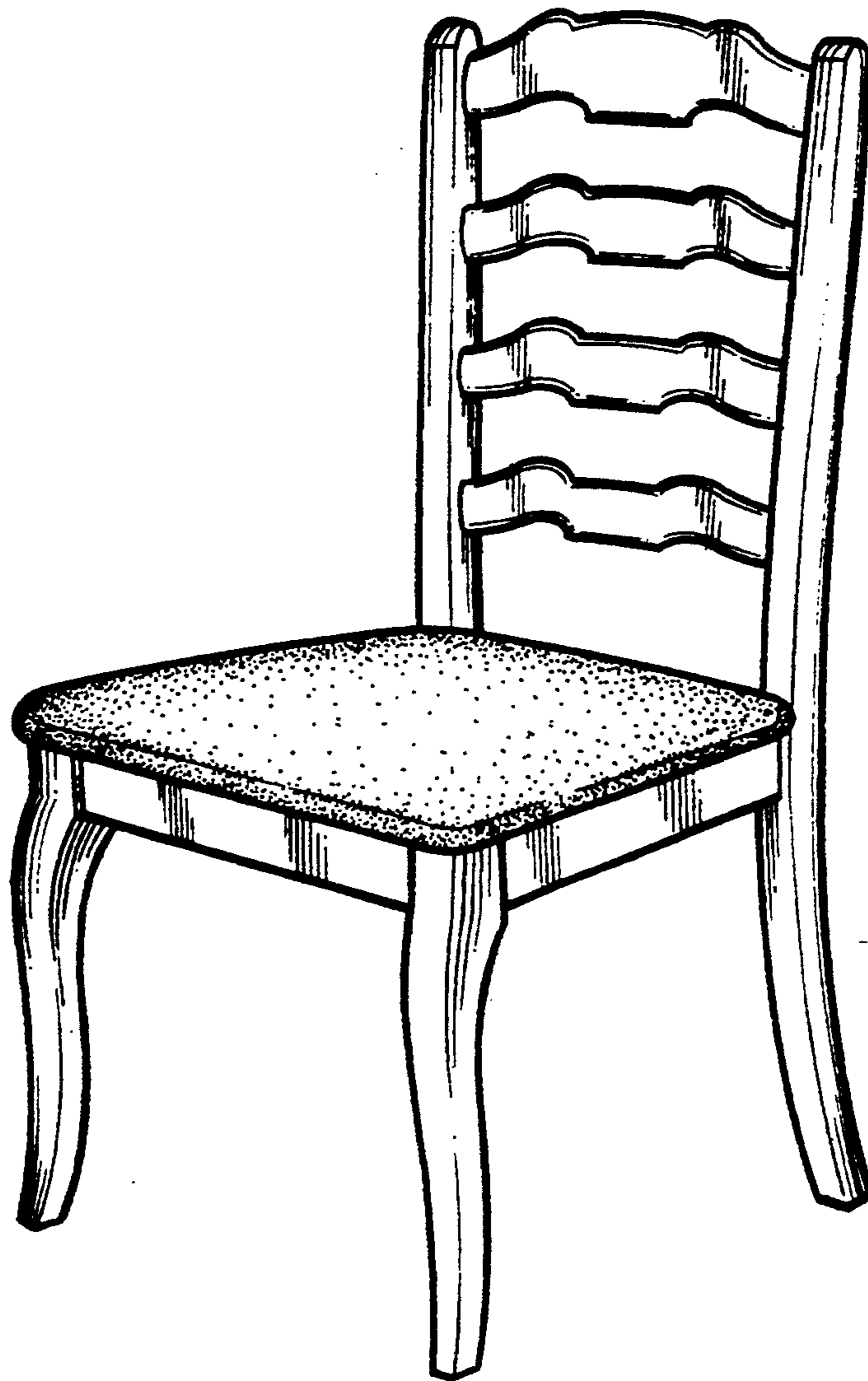
