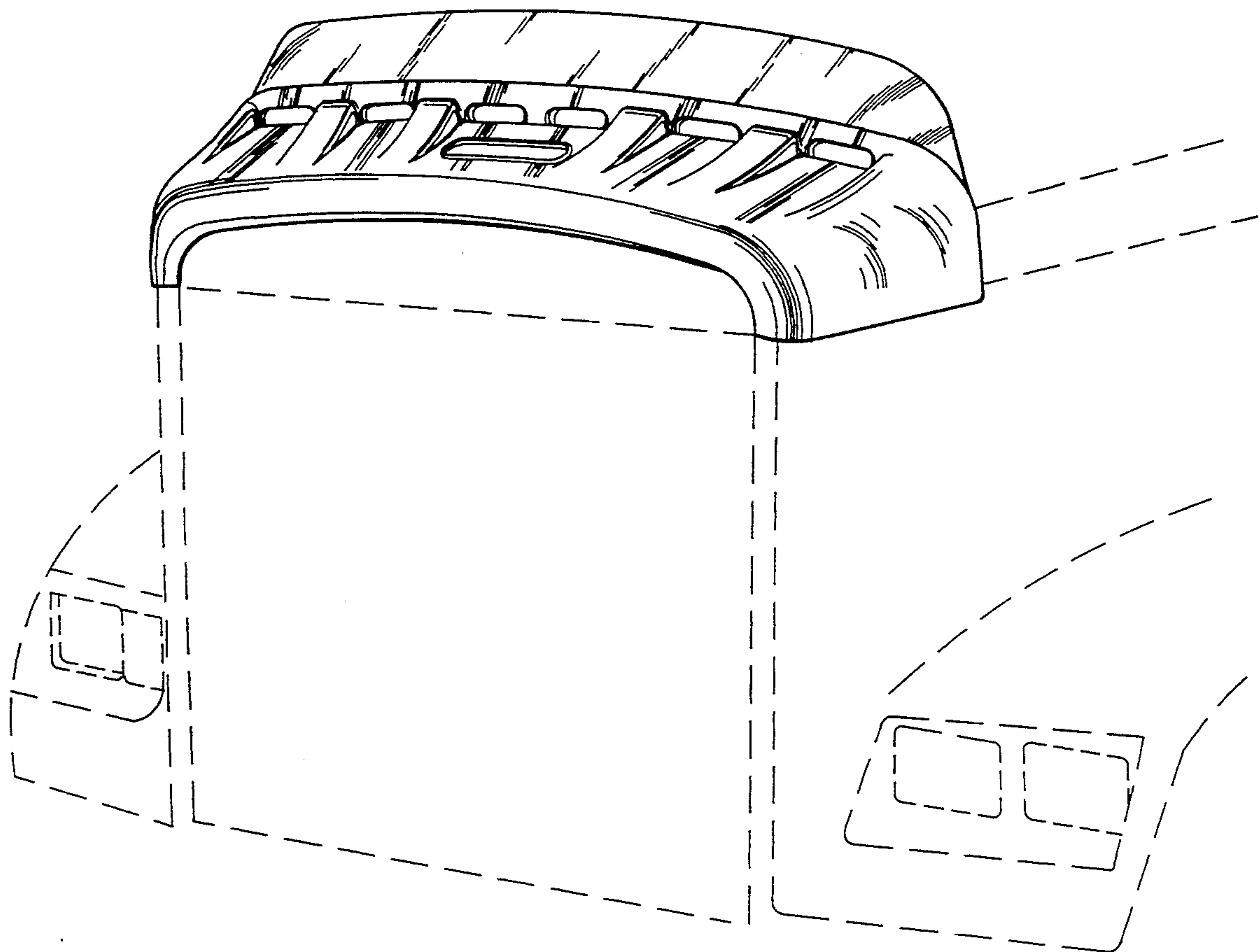

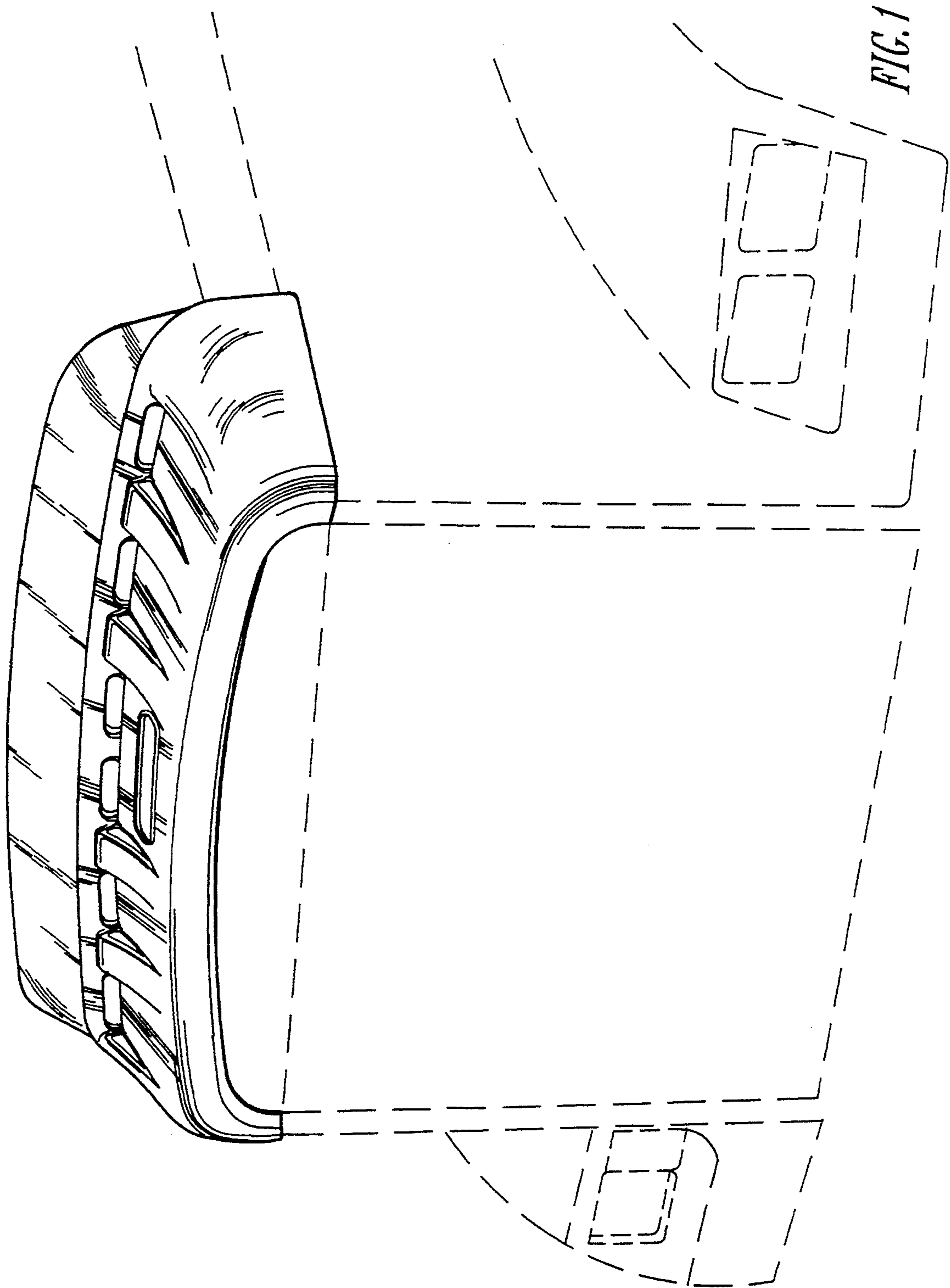

FIG. 5 is an end elevation view thereof, it being understood that the opposite end is a mirror image of that shown.





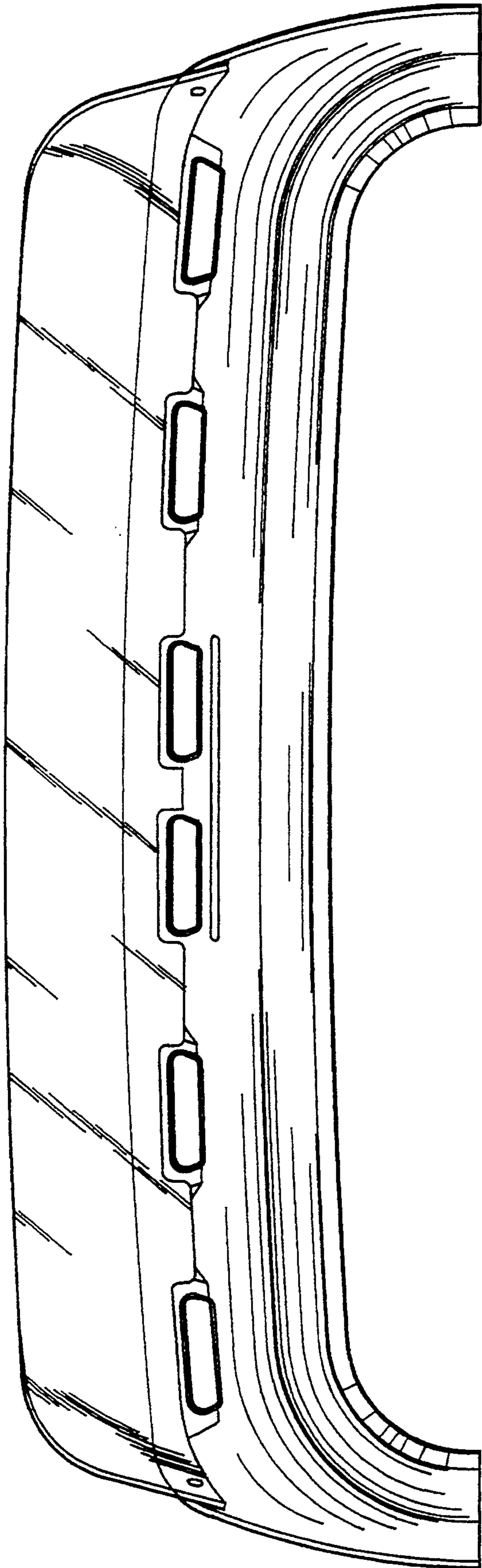

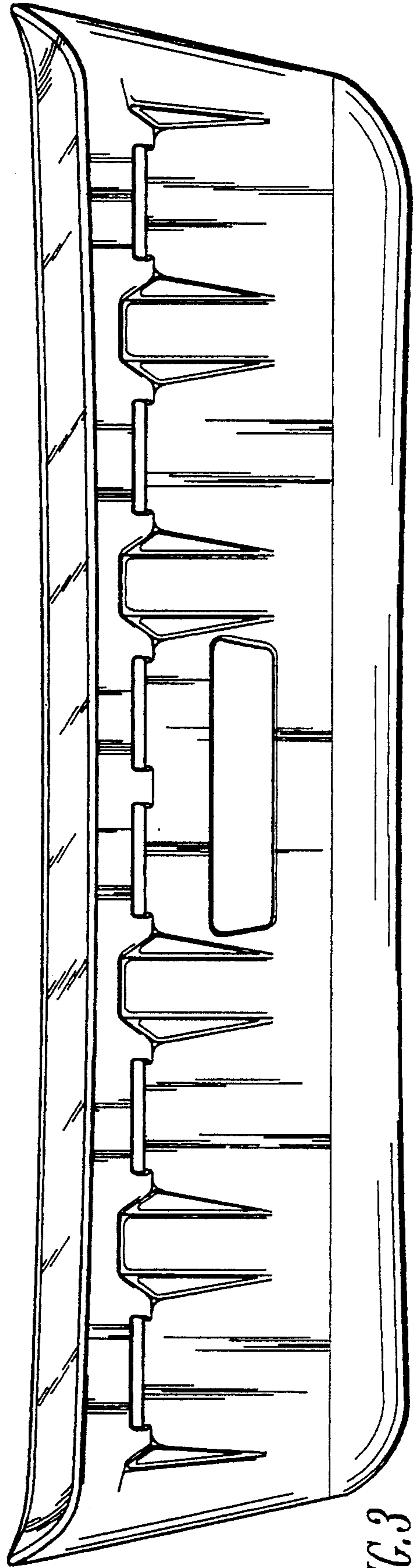

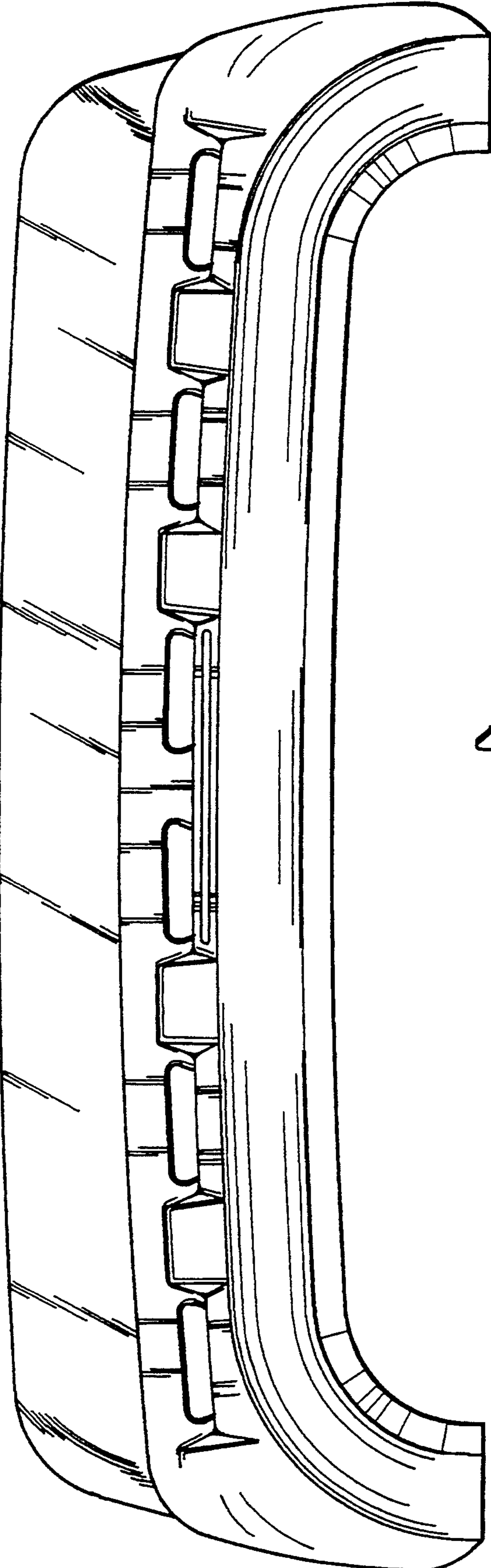

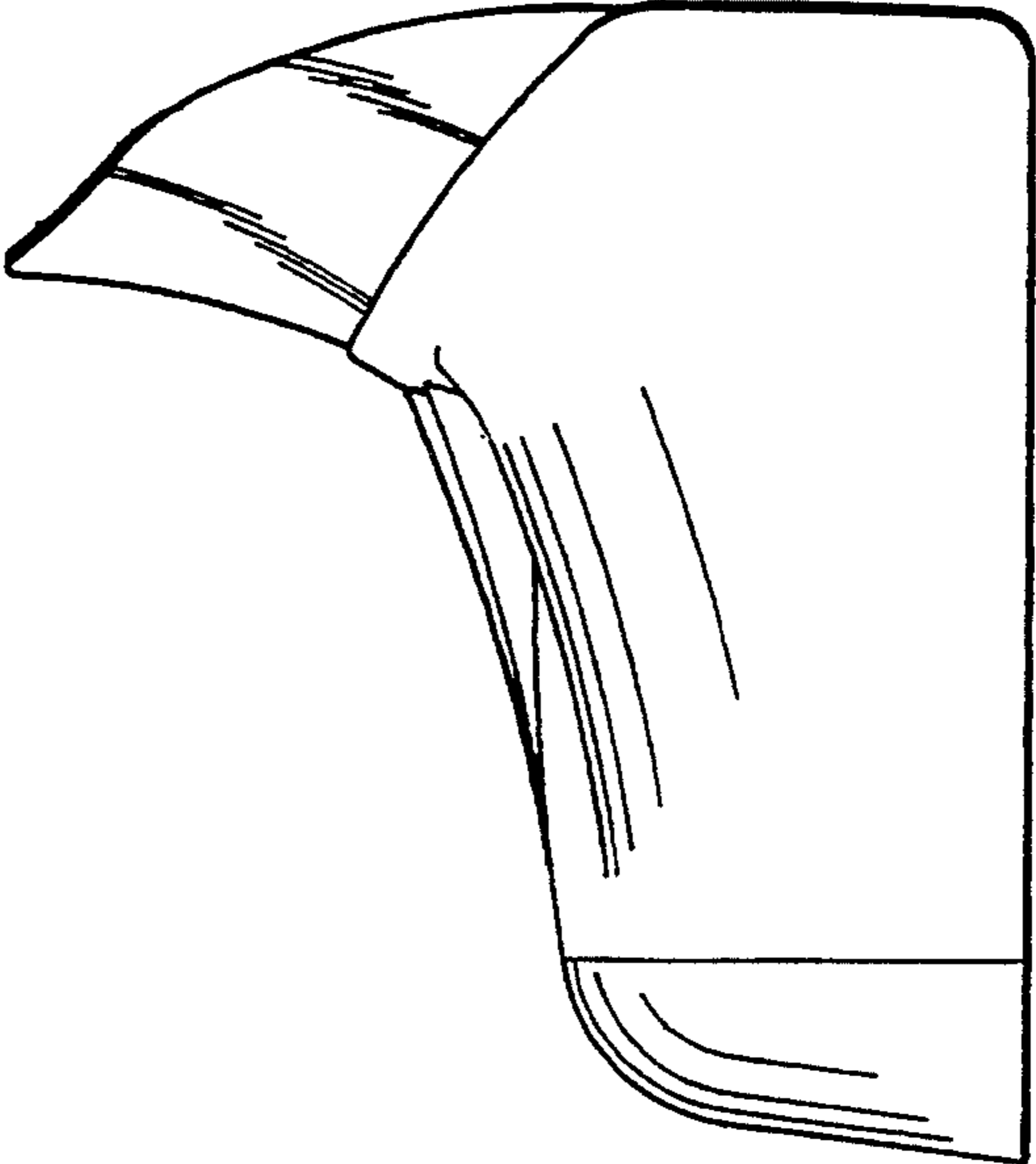
