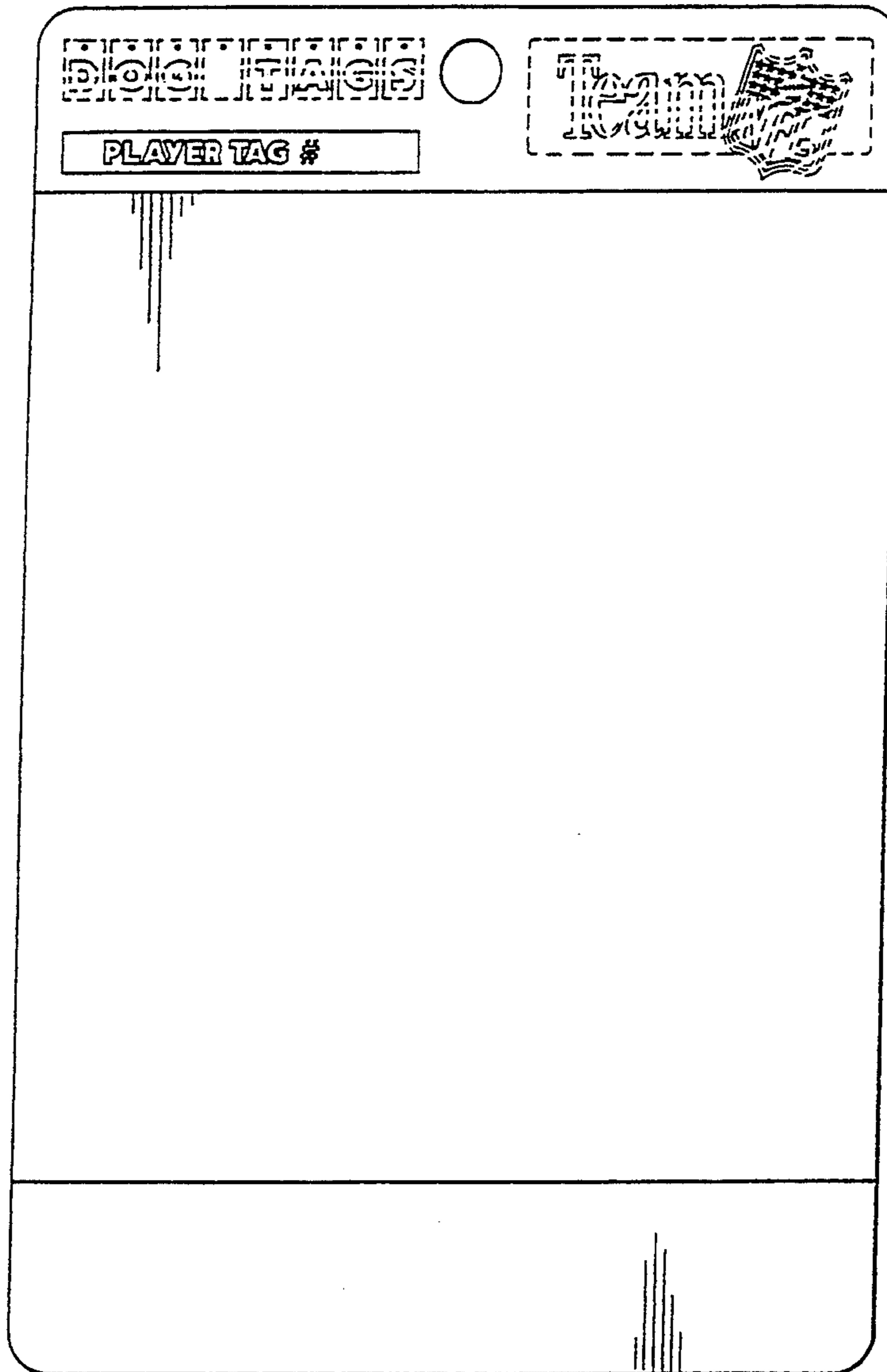

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a sports collector card according to the present invention, with the broken line showing for illustrative purposes only and forming no part of the claimed design and with the sides being of no substantial thickness; and, FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof.



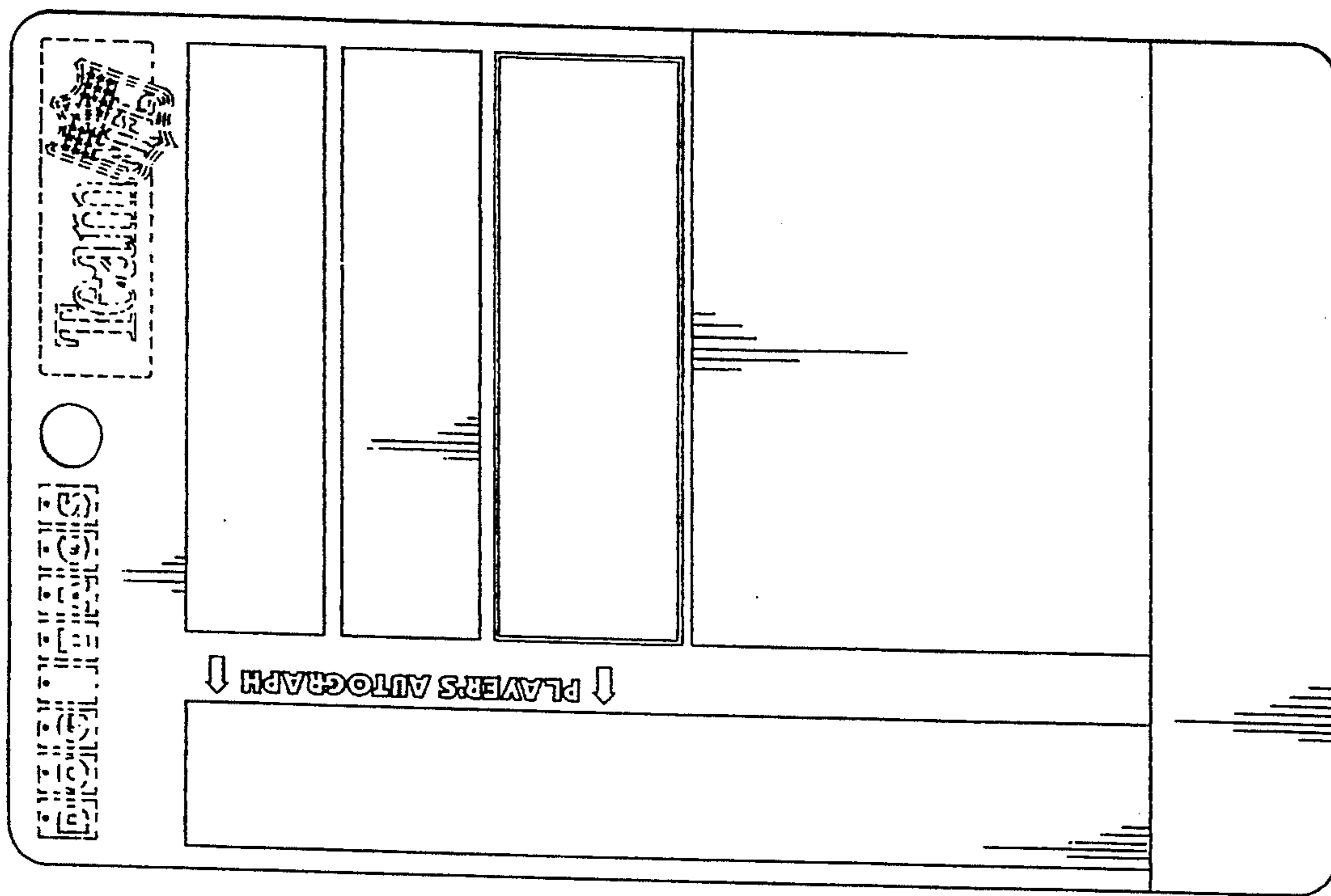

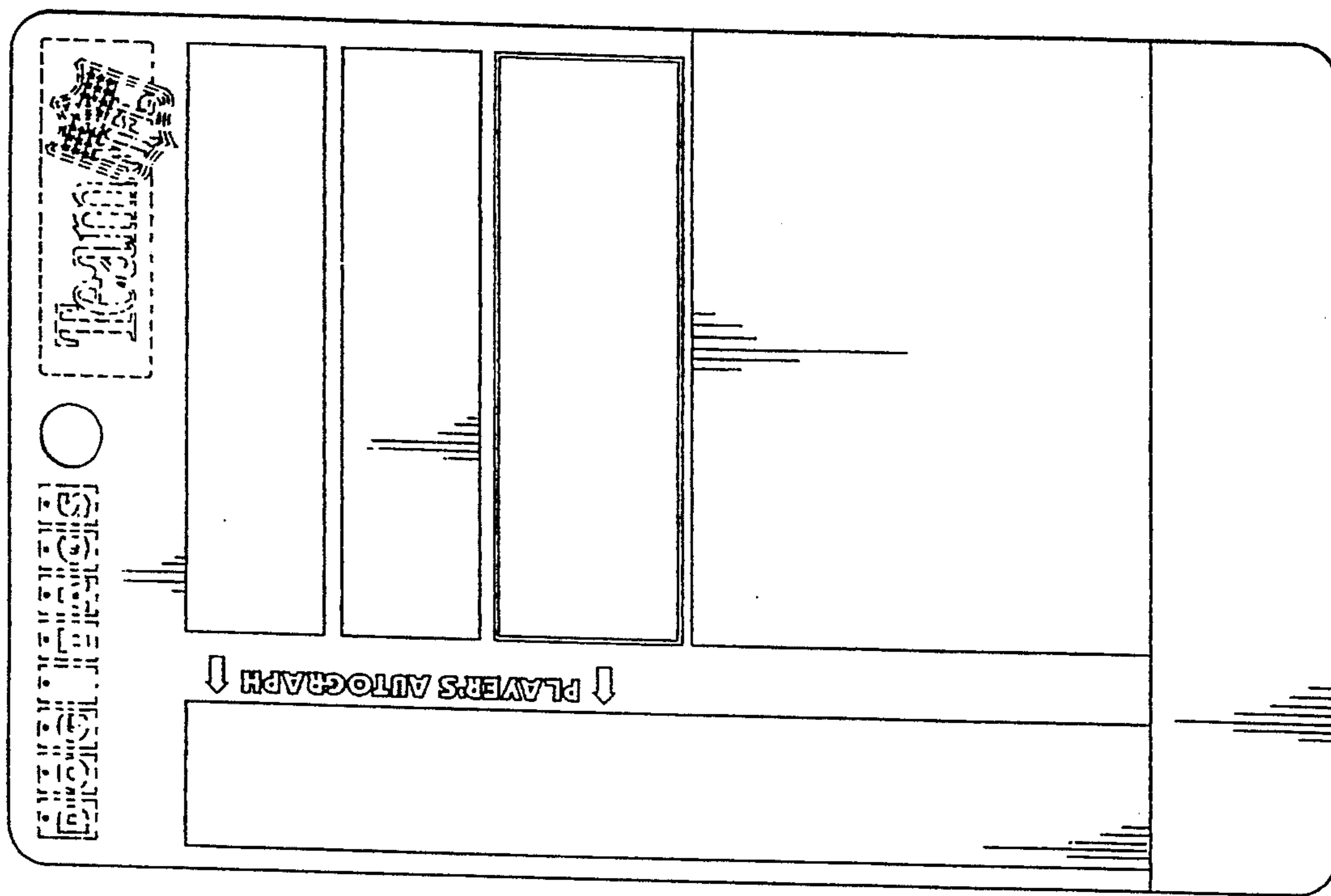
