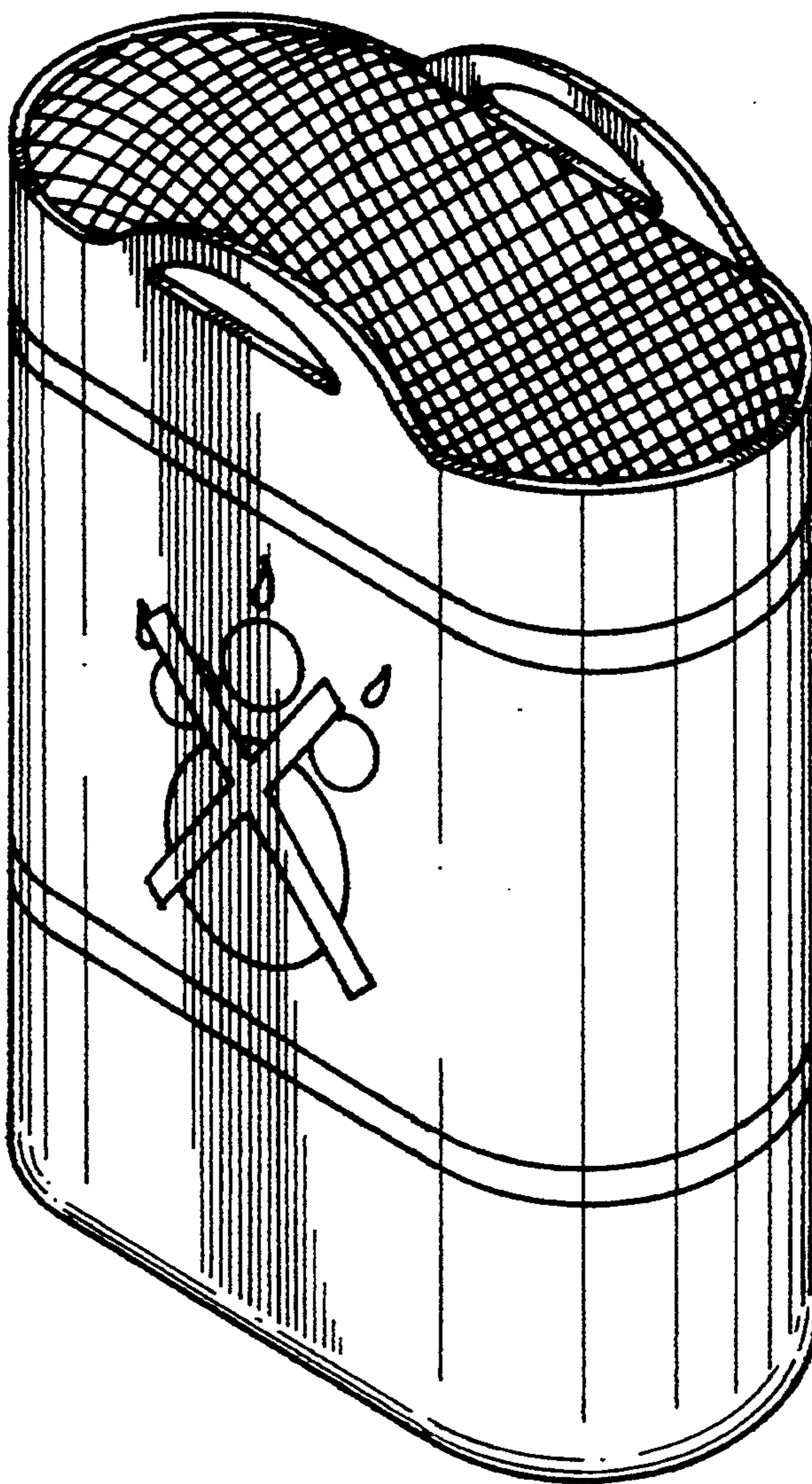
[57] CLAIM

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top and side perspective view of a trash can showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear being a mirror image;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.

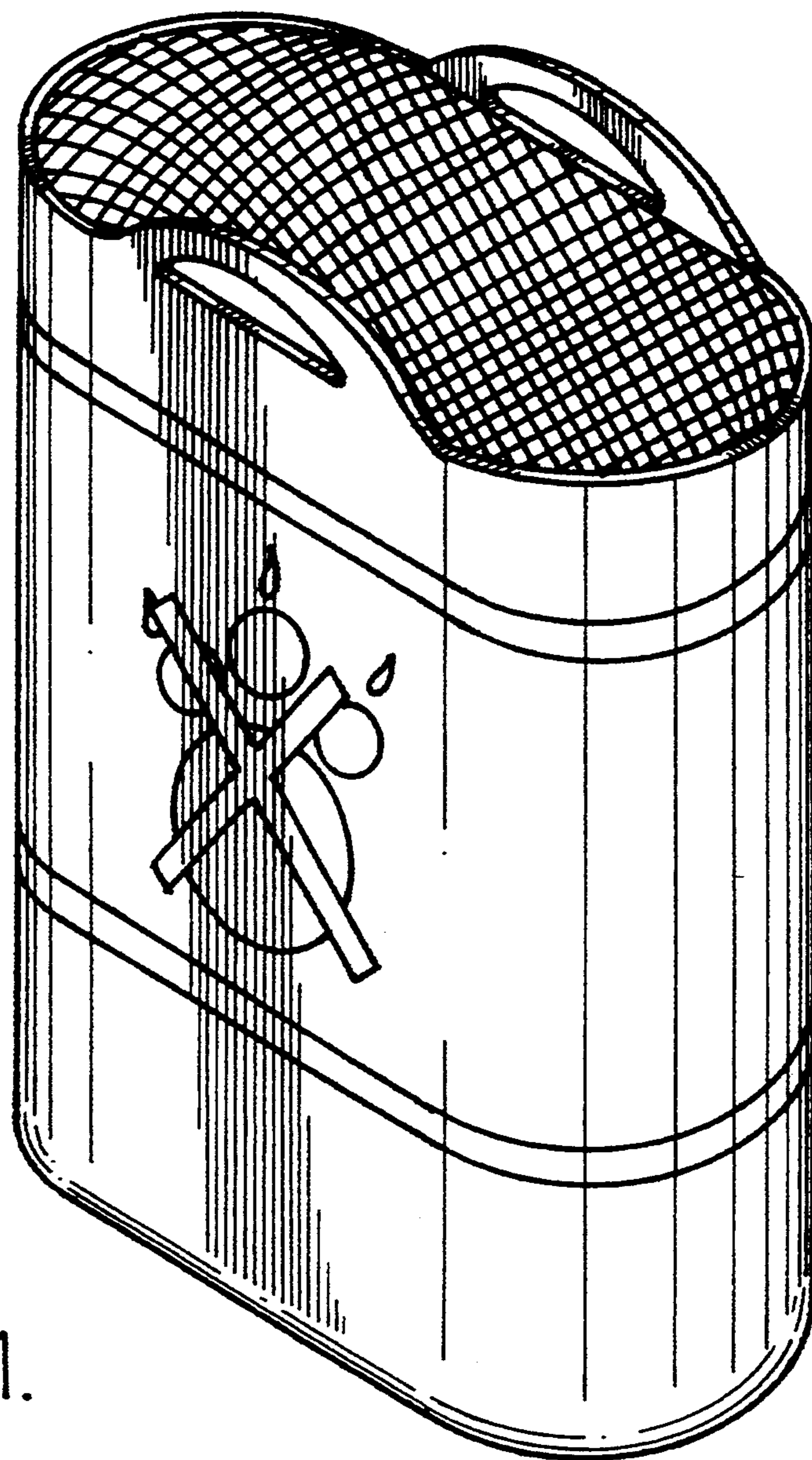

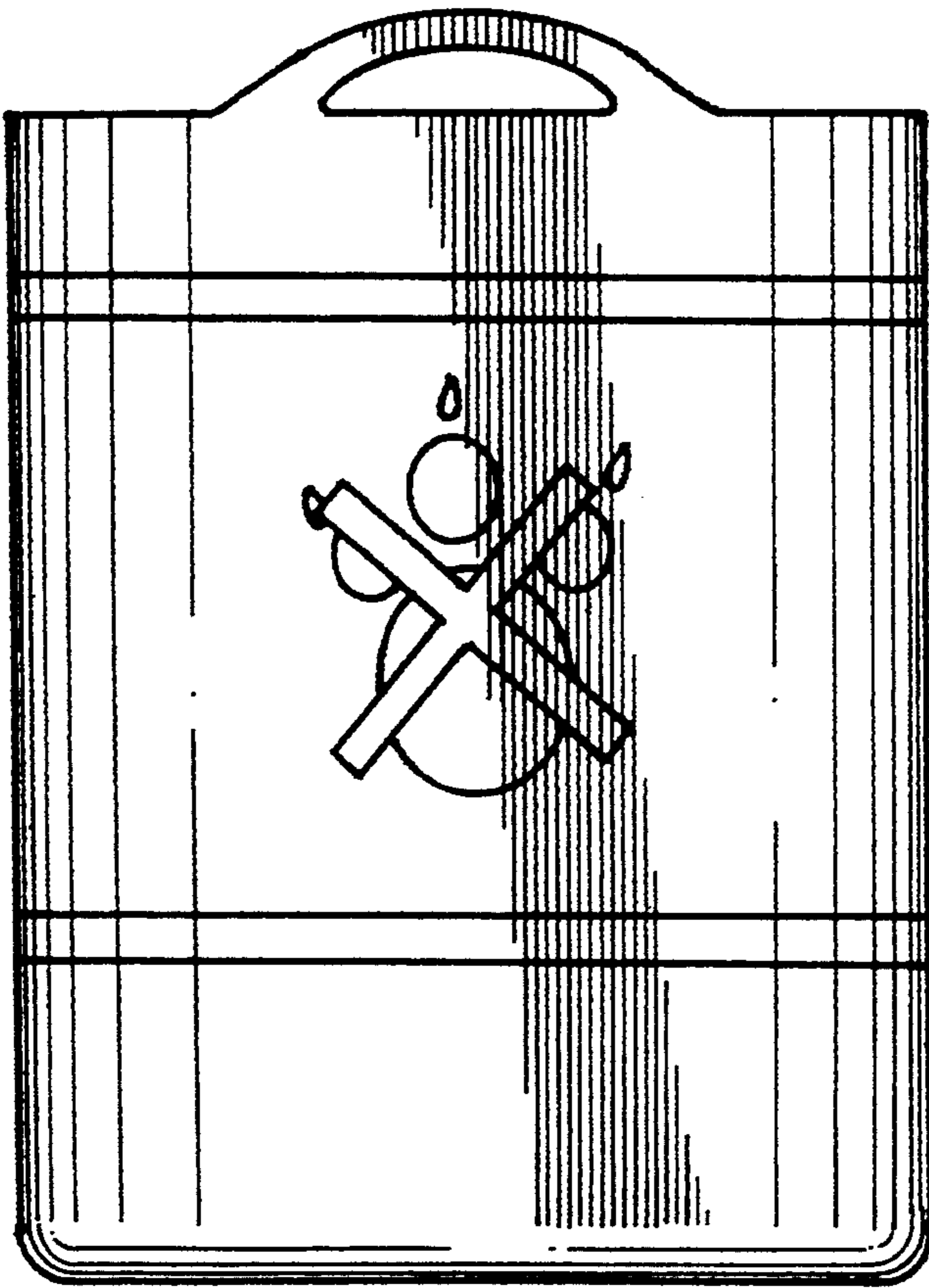

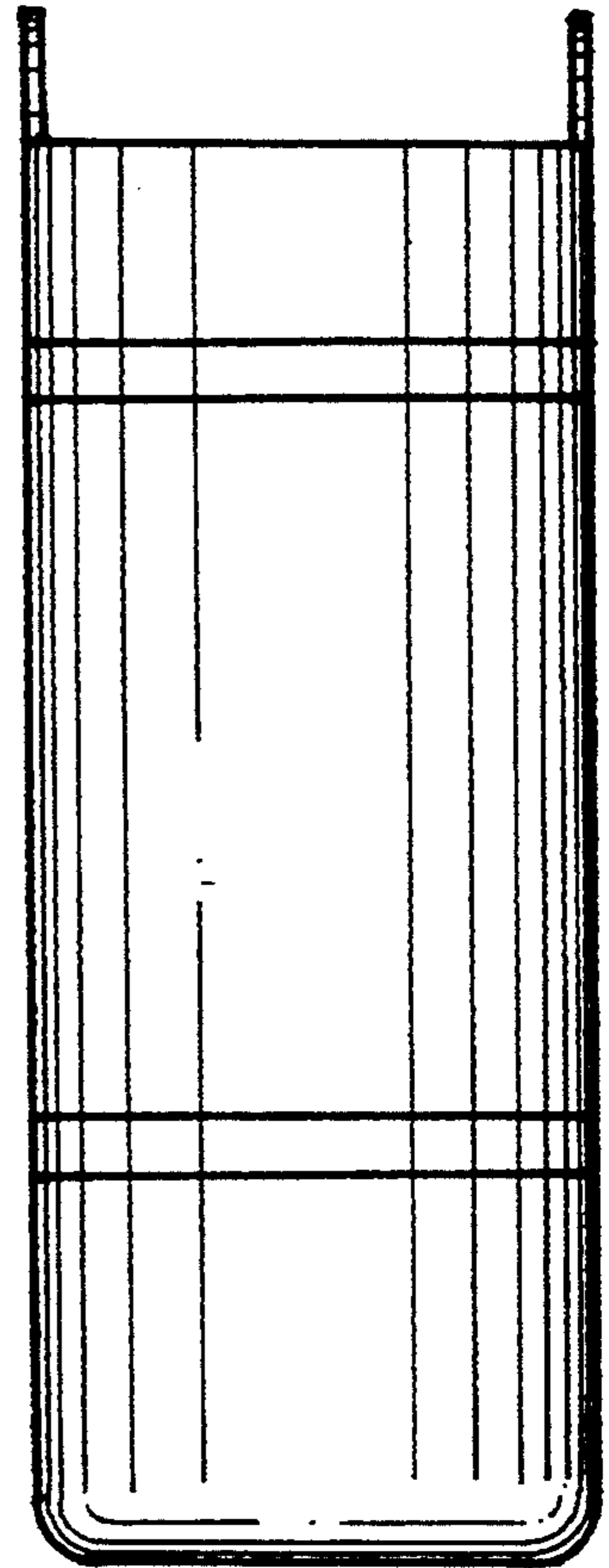

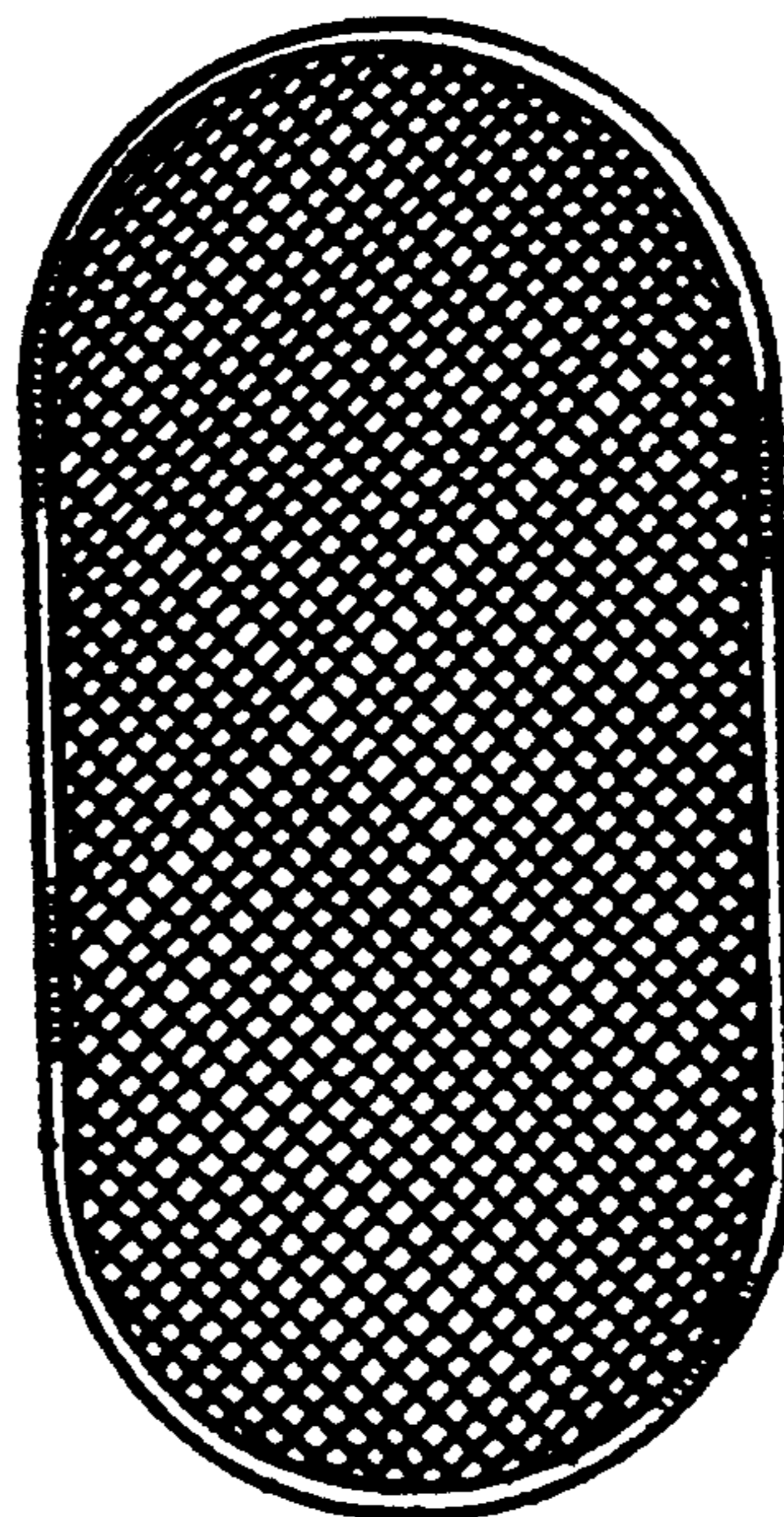
