FIG. 3 is a broken side view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image of the side shown.



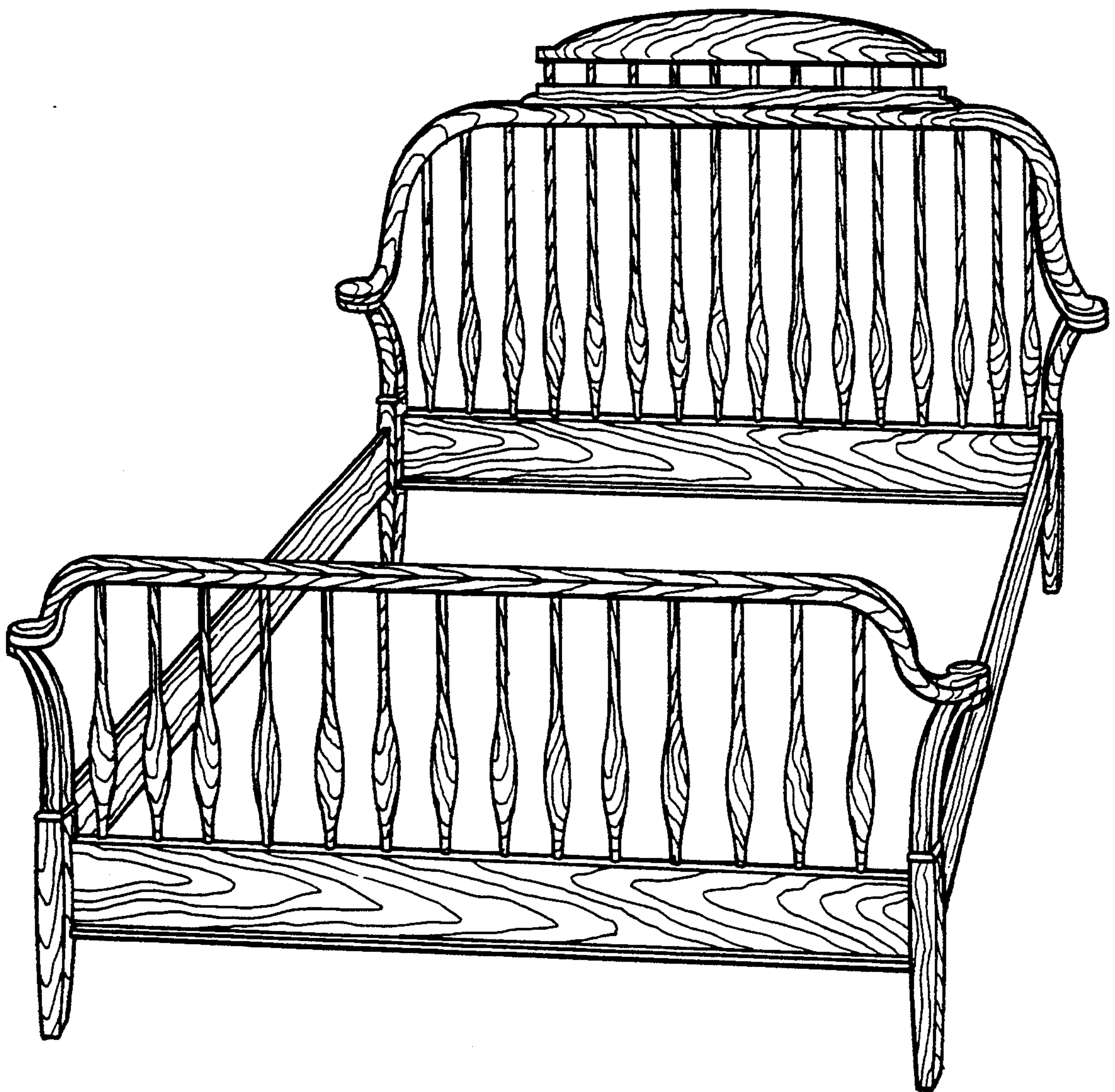

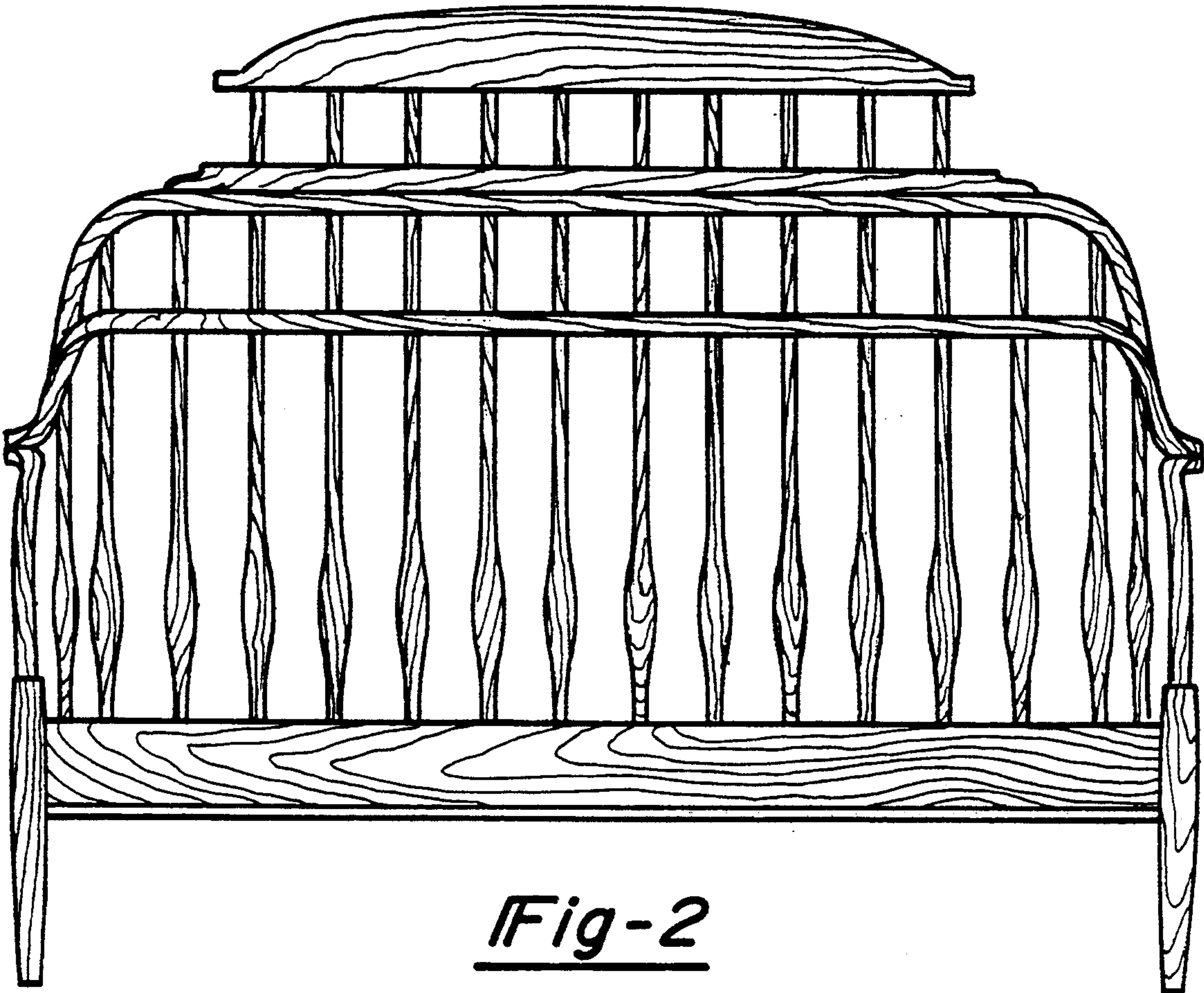

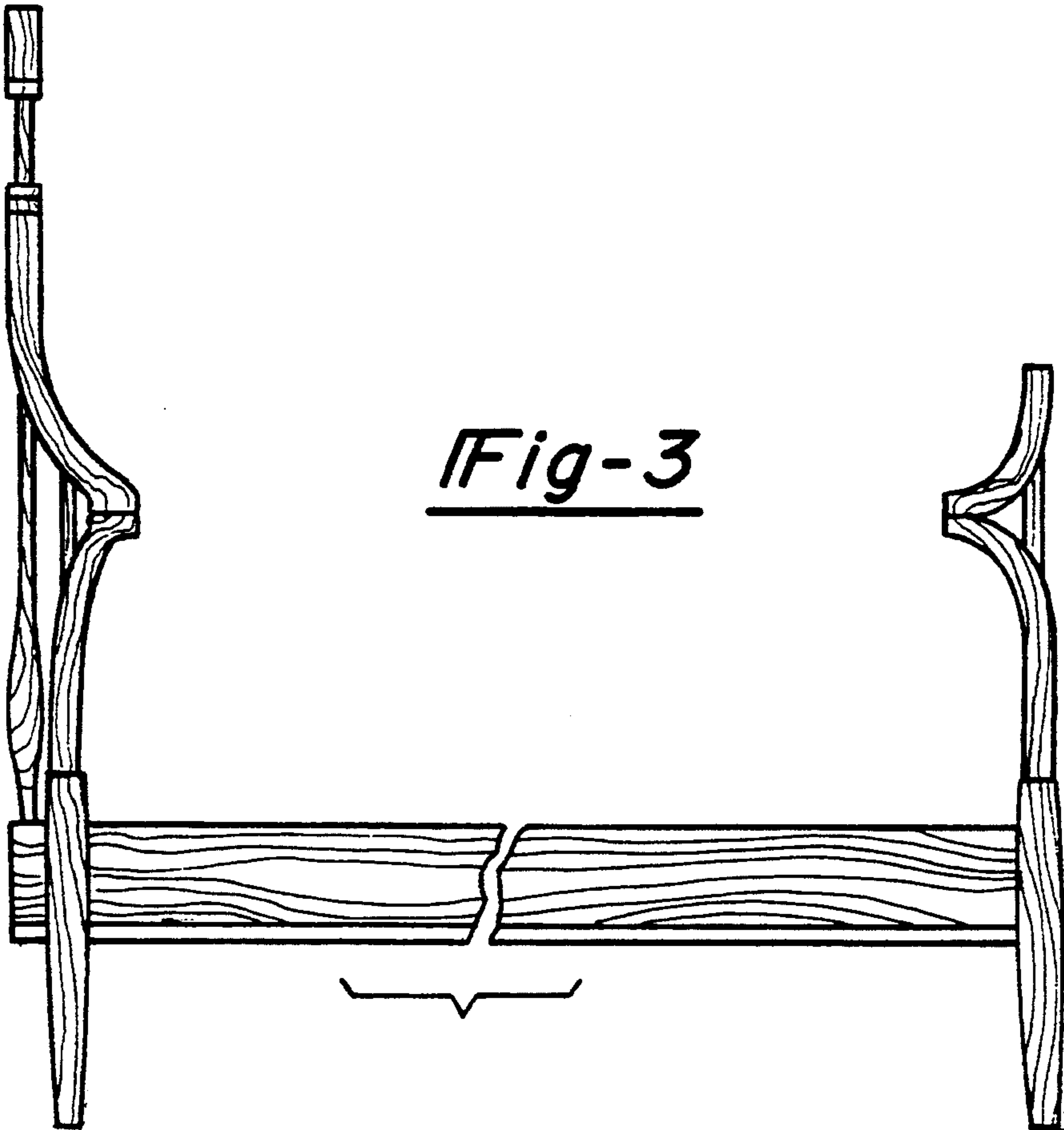
