The bottom of the clock is flat and unornamented.

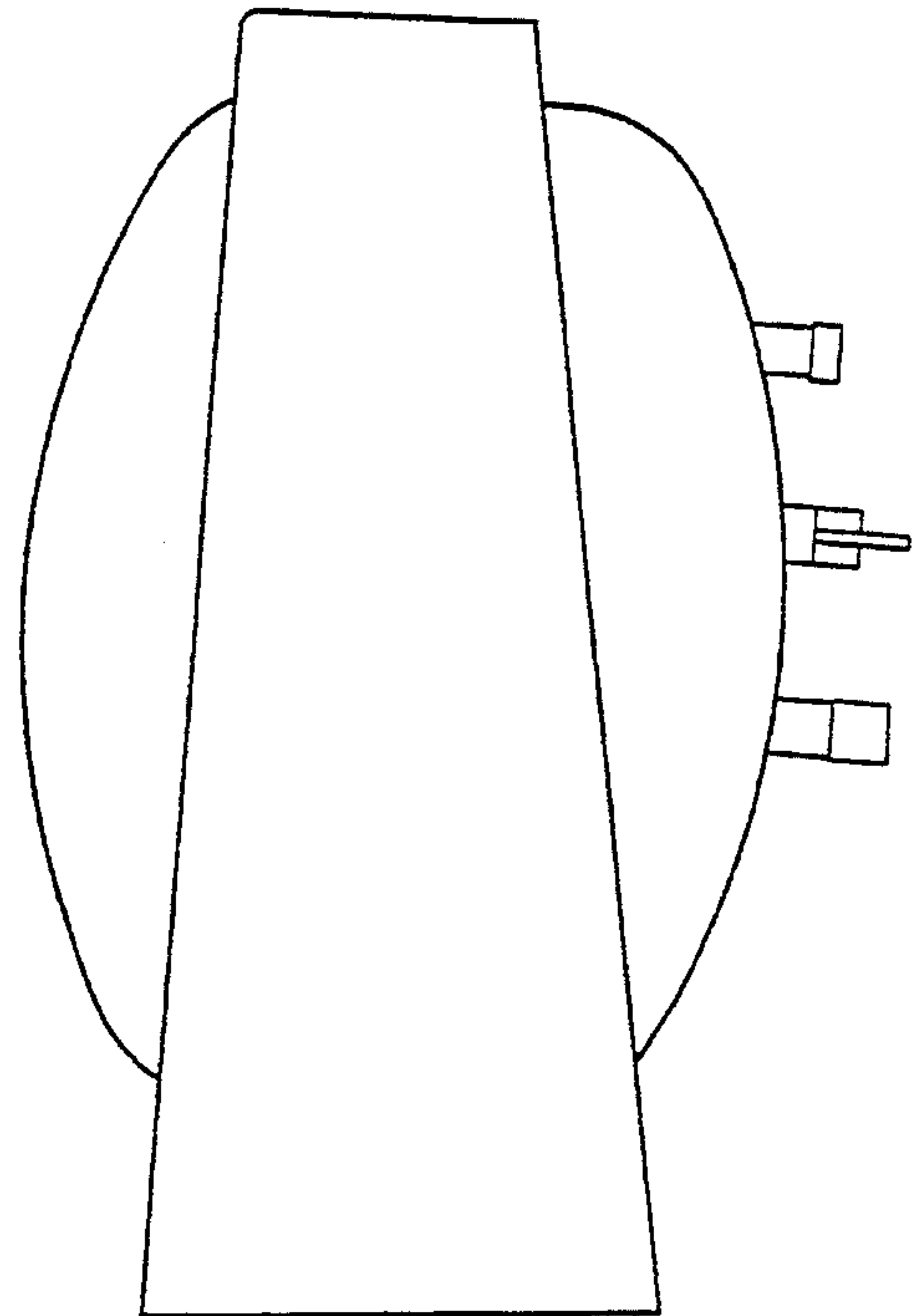
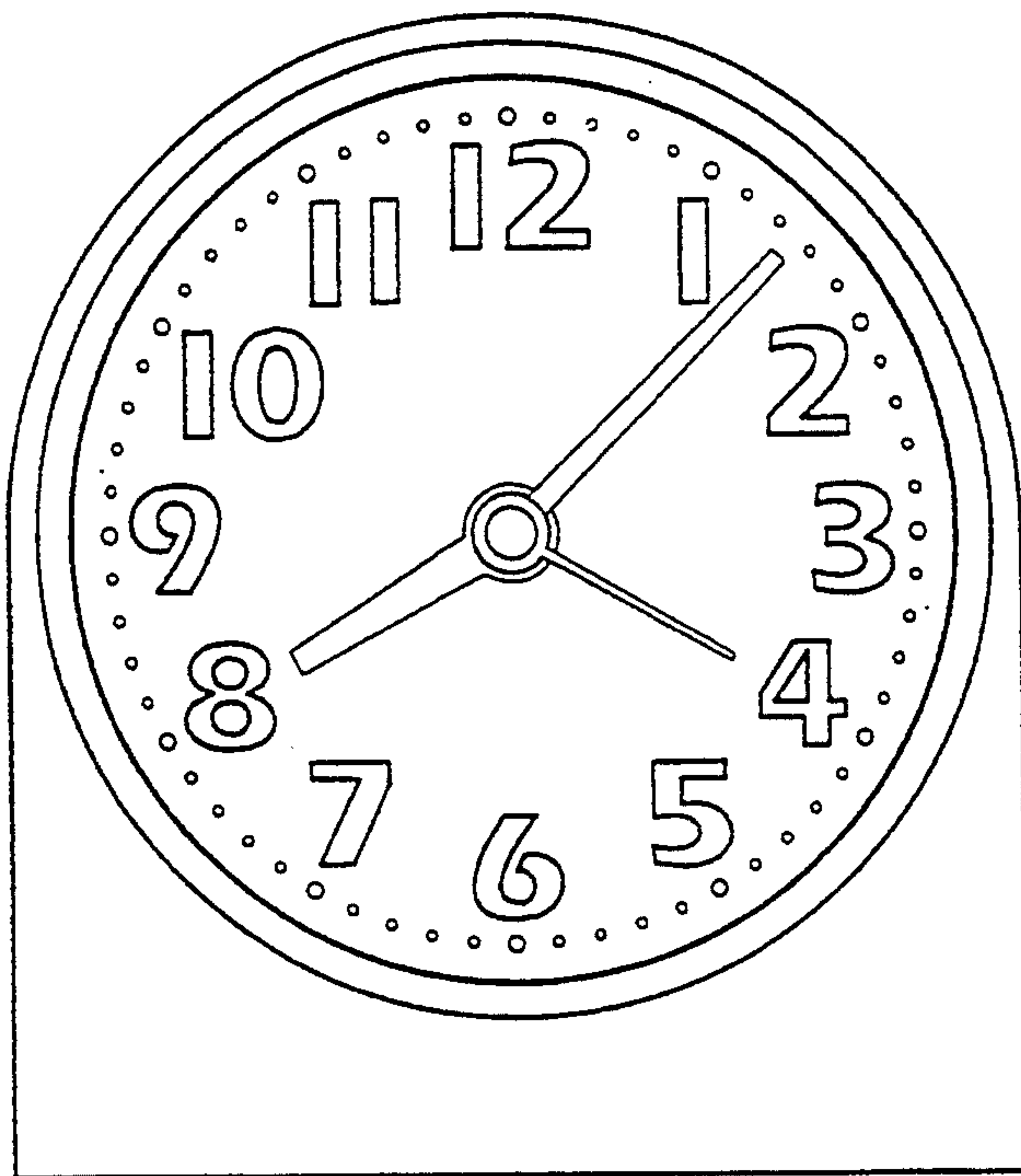

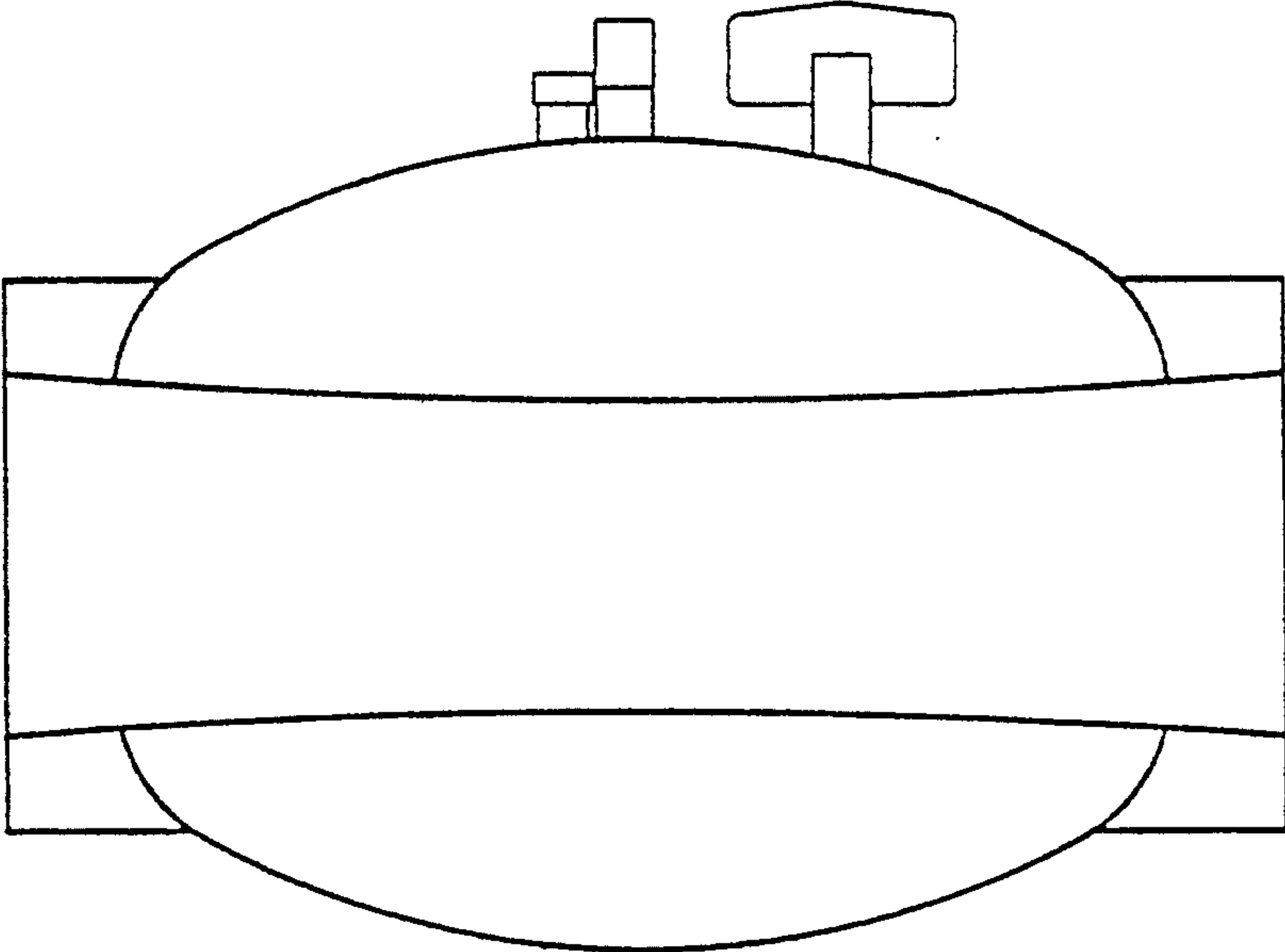

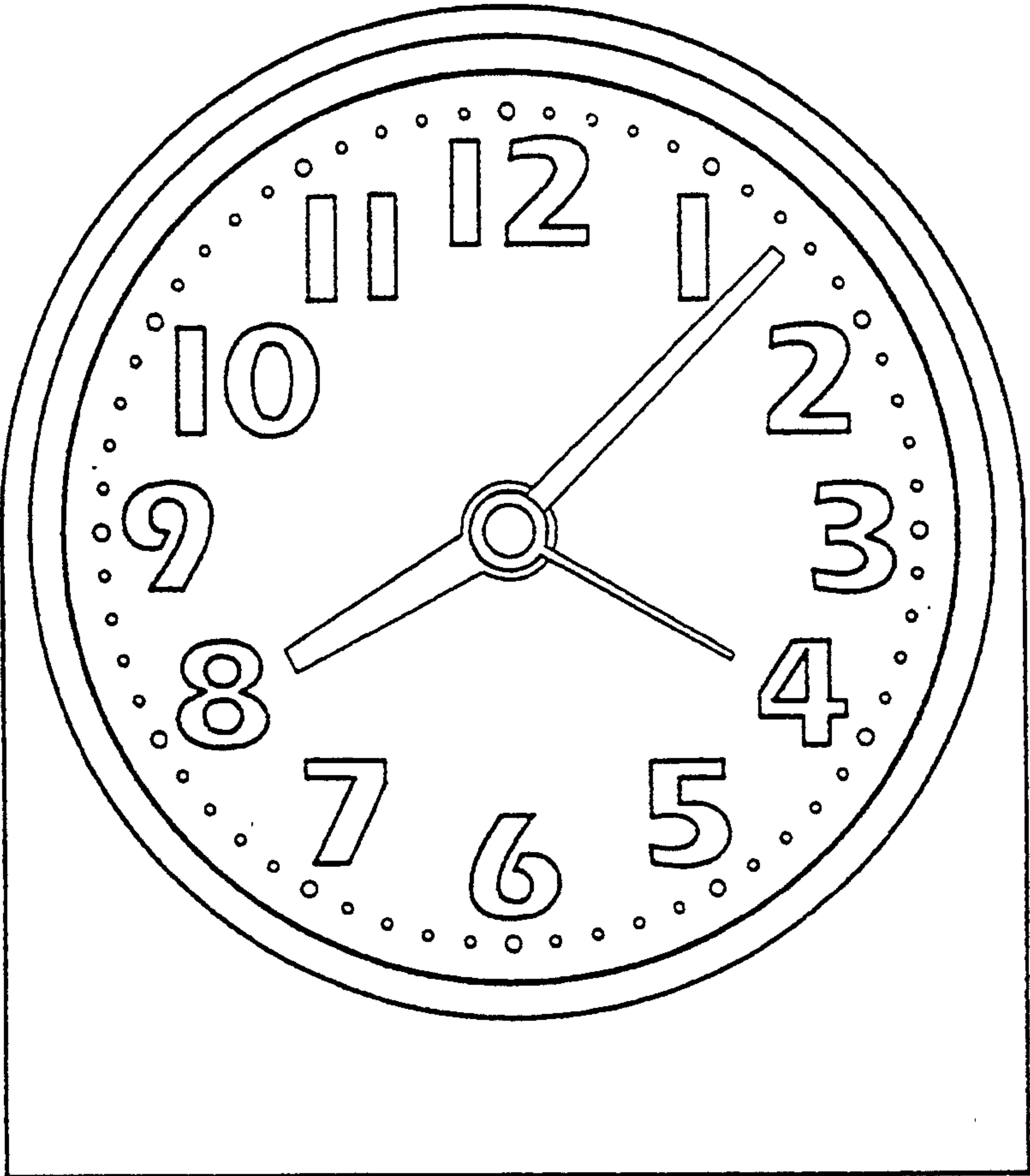

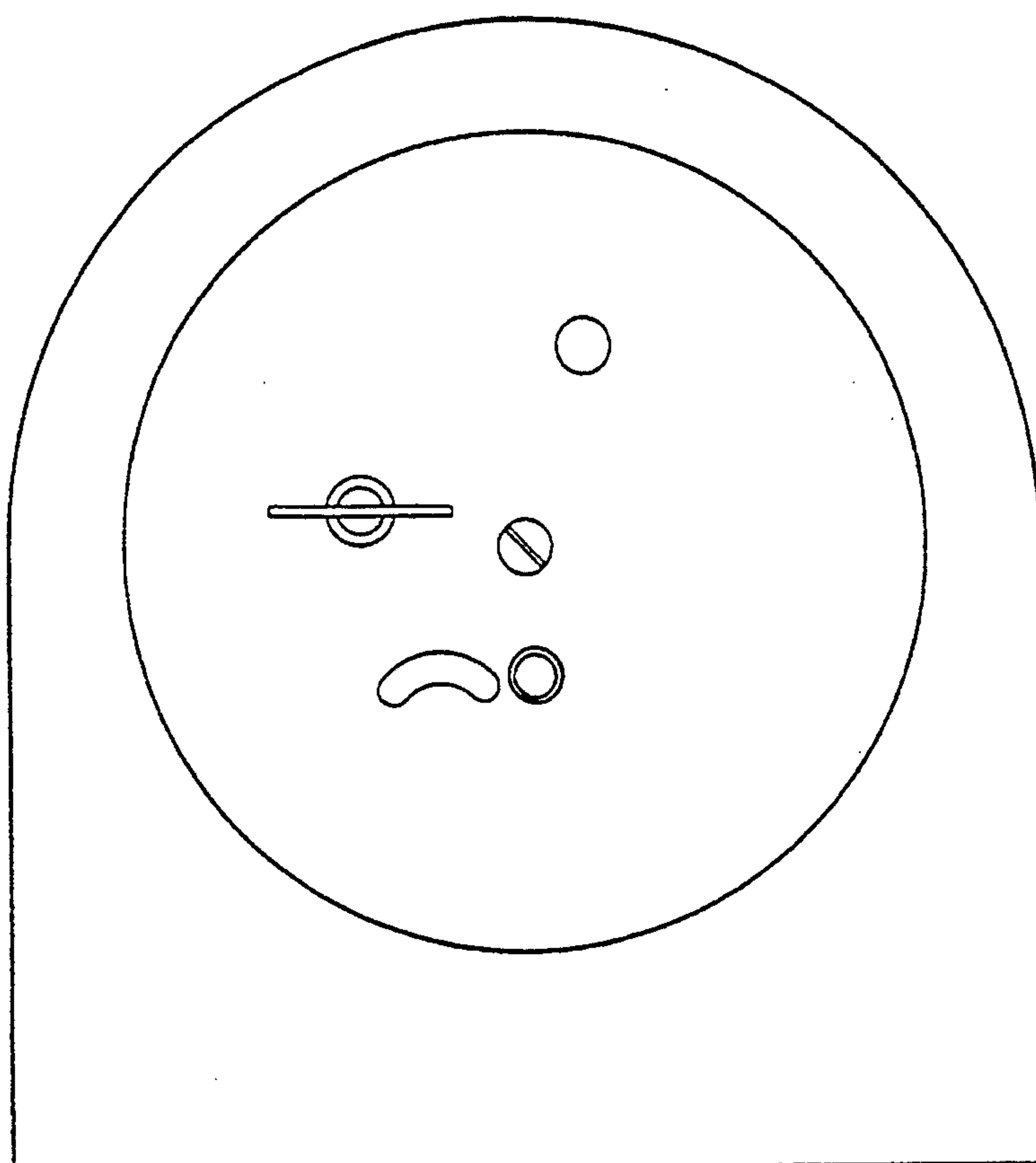
