DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the medallion showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a cross-sectional view taken along the line 3—3 of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.
