DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of the image scanner embodying my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a perspective view with the image scanner being folded;

FIG. 9 is a perspective view as seen from the bottom and rear of FIG. 1.

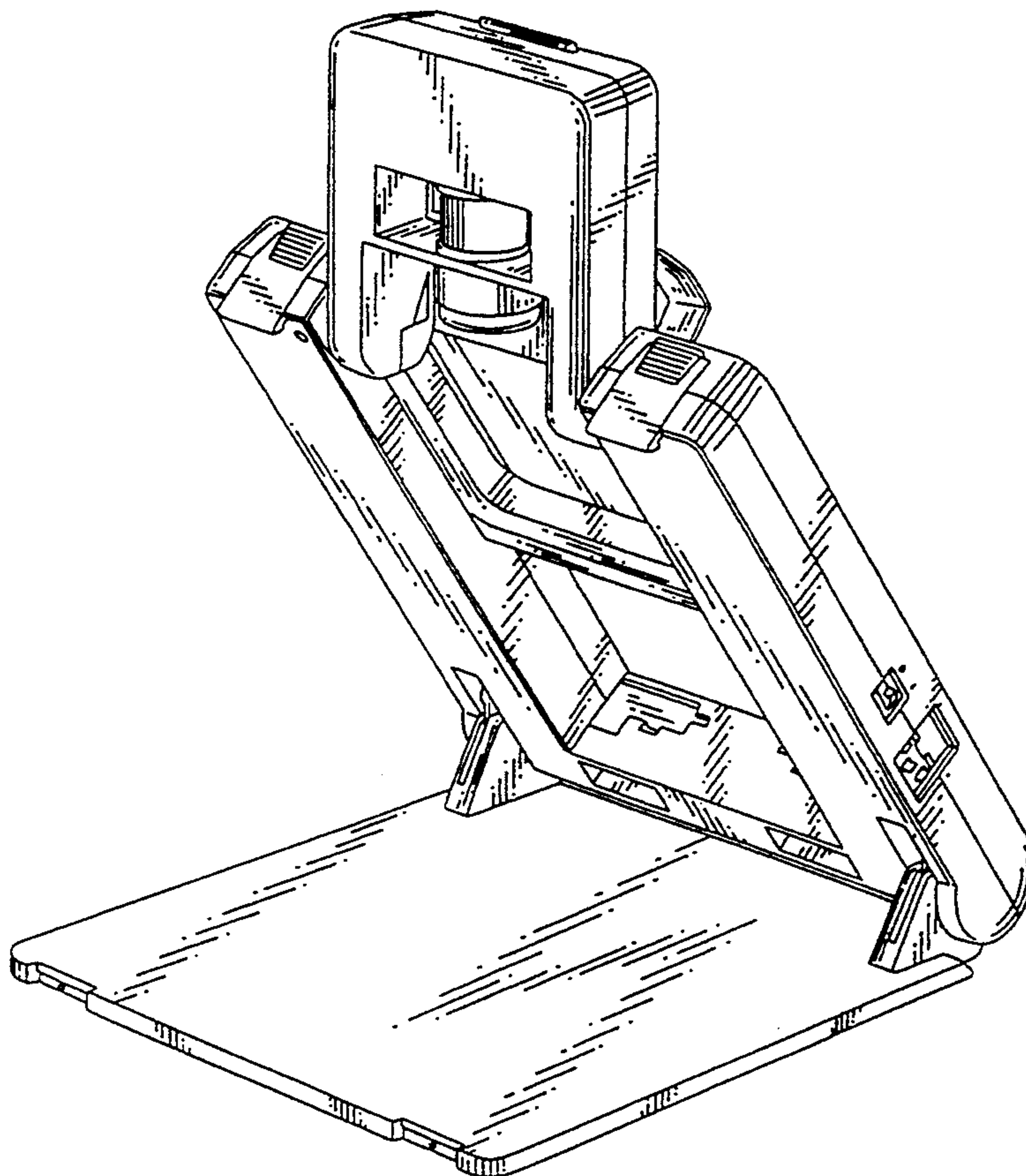

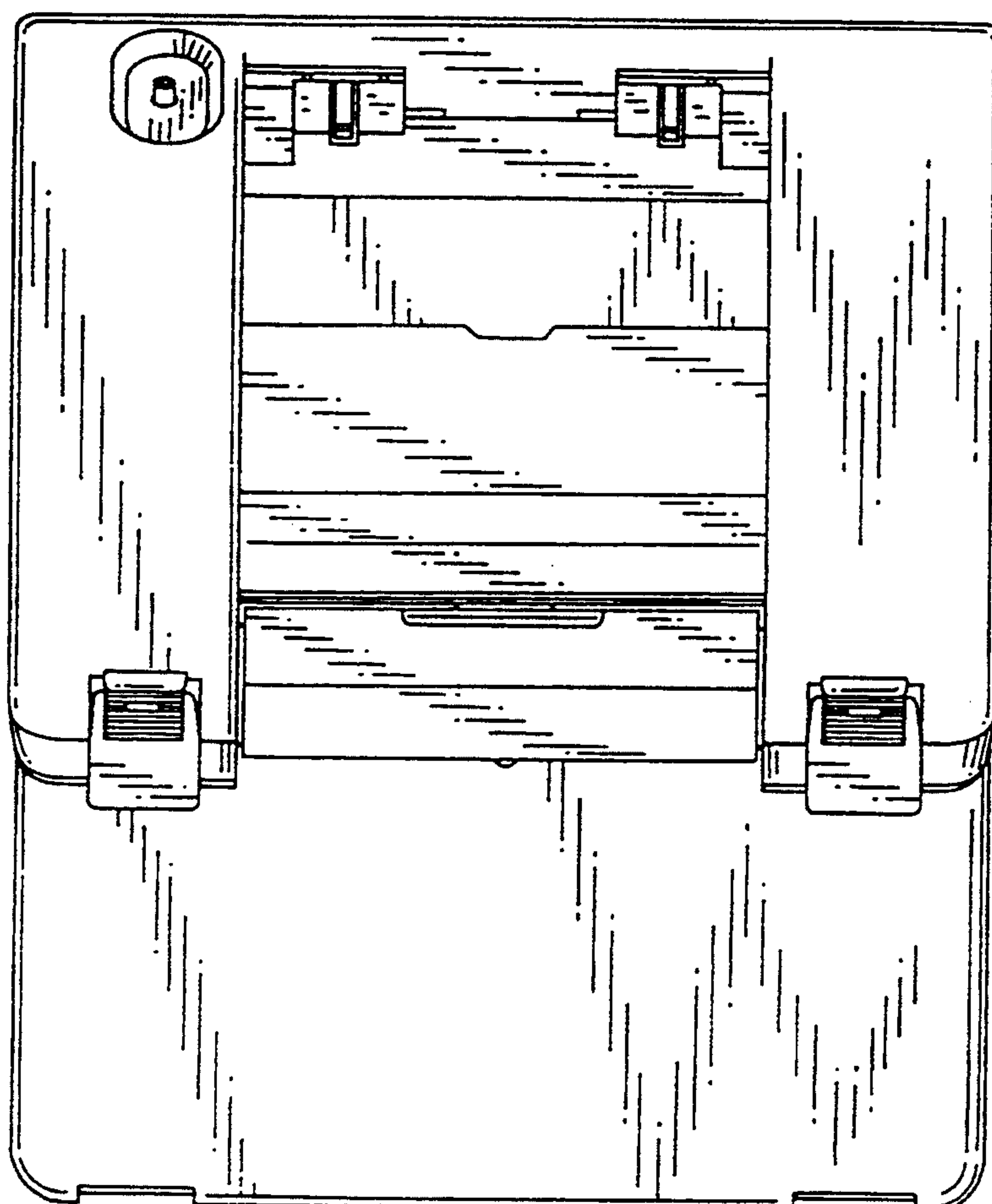

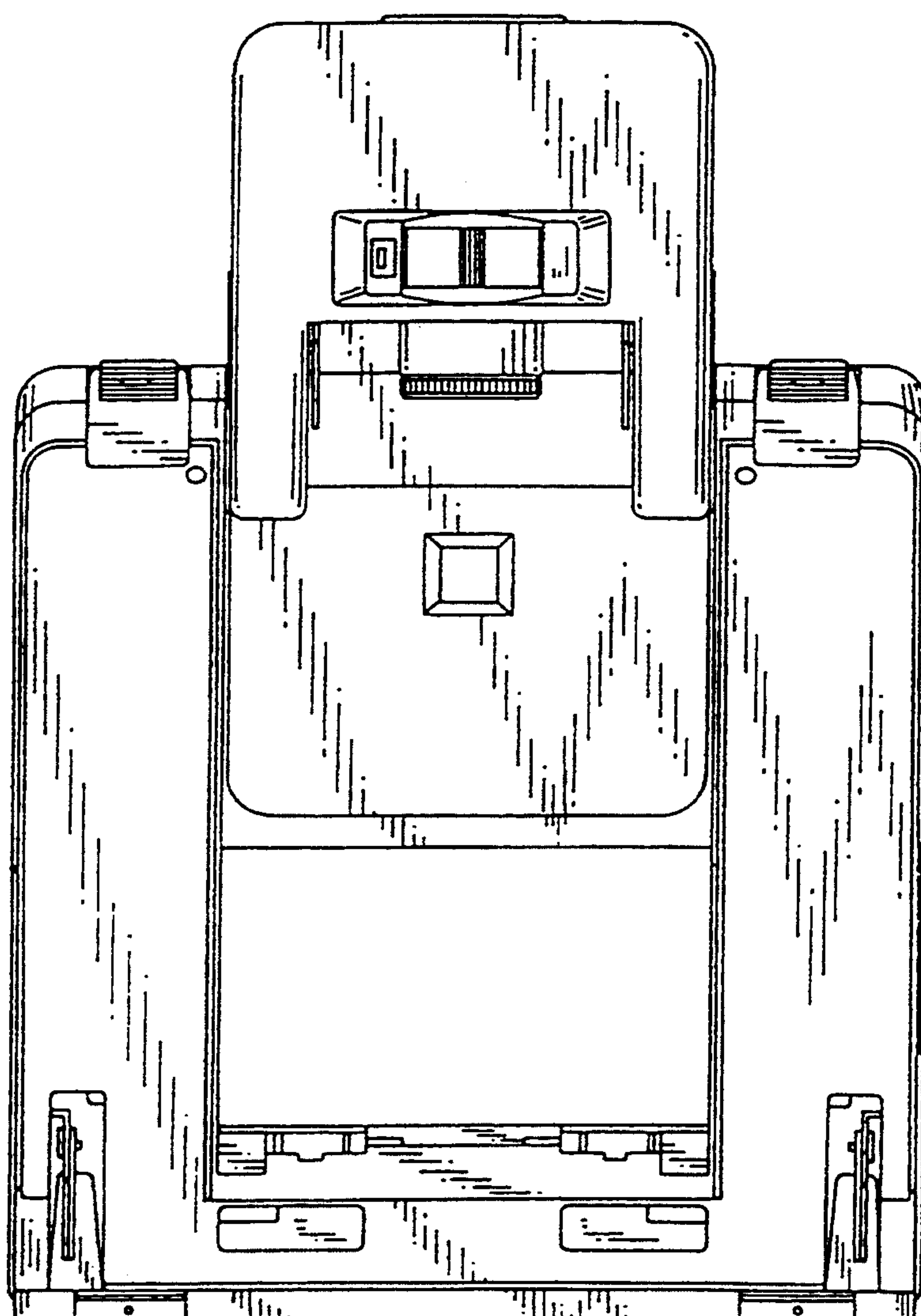

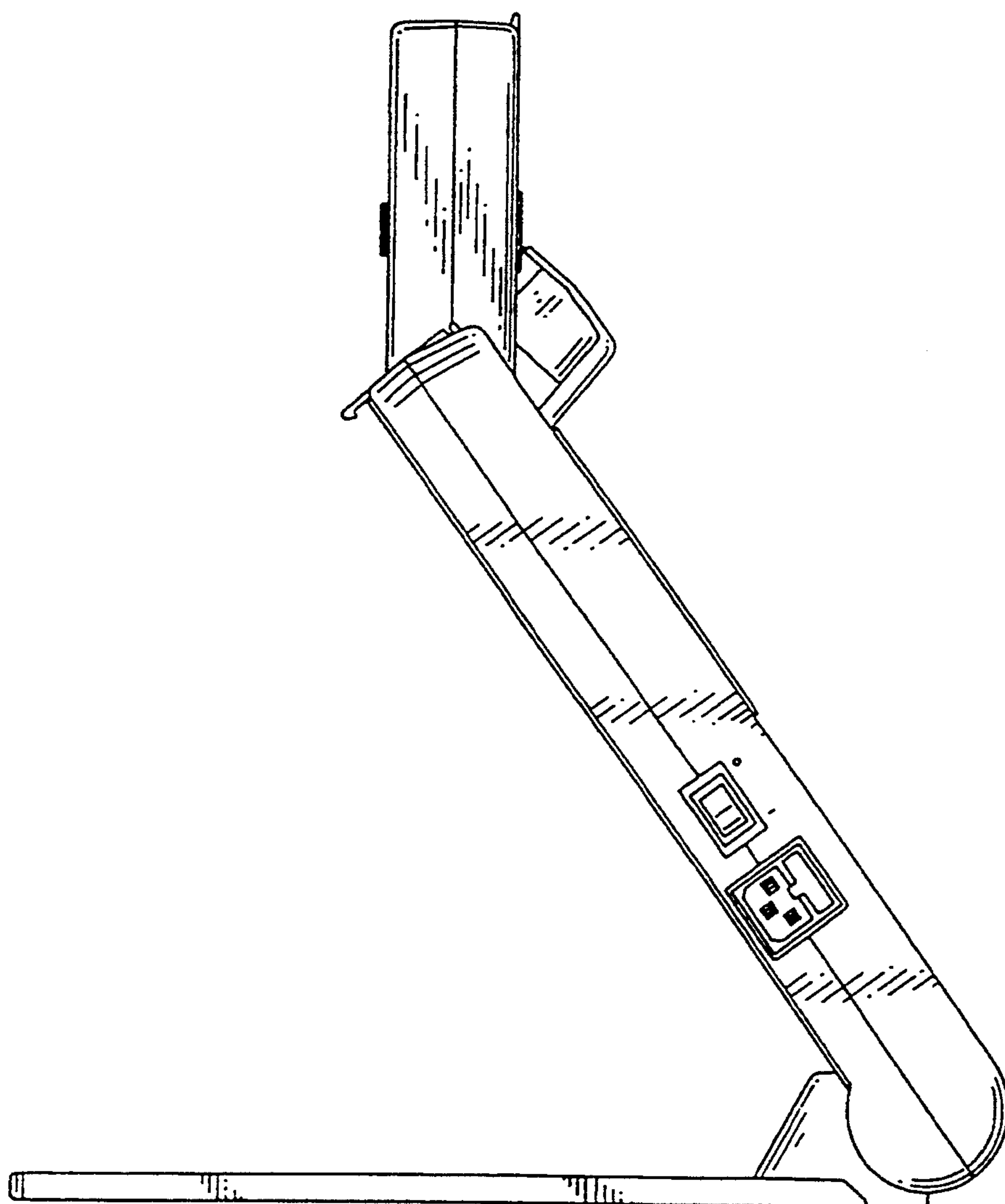

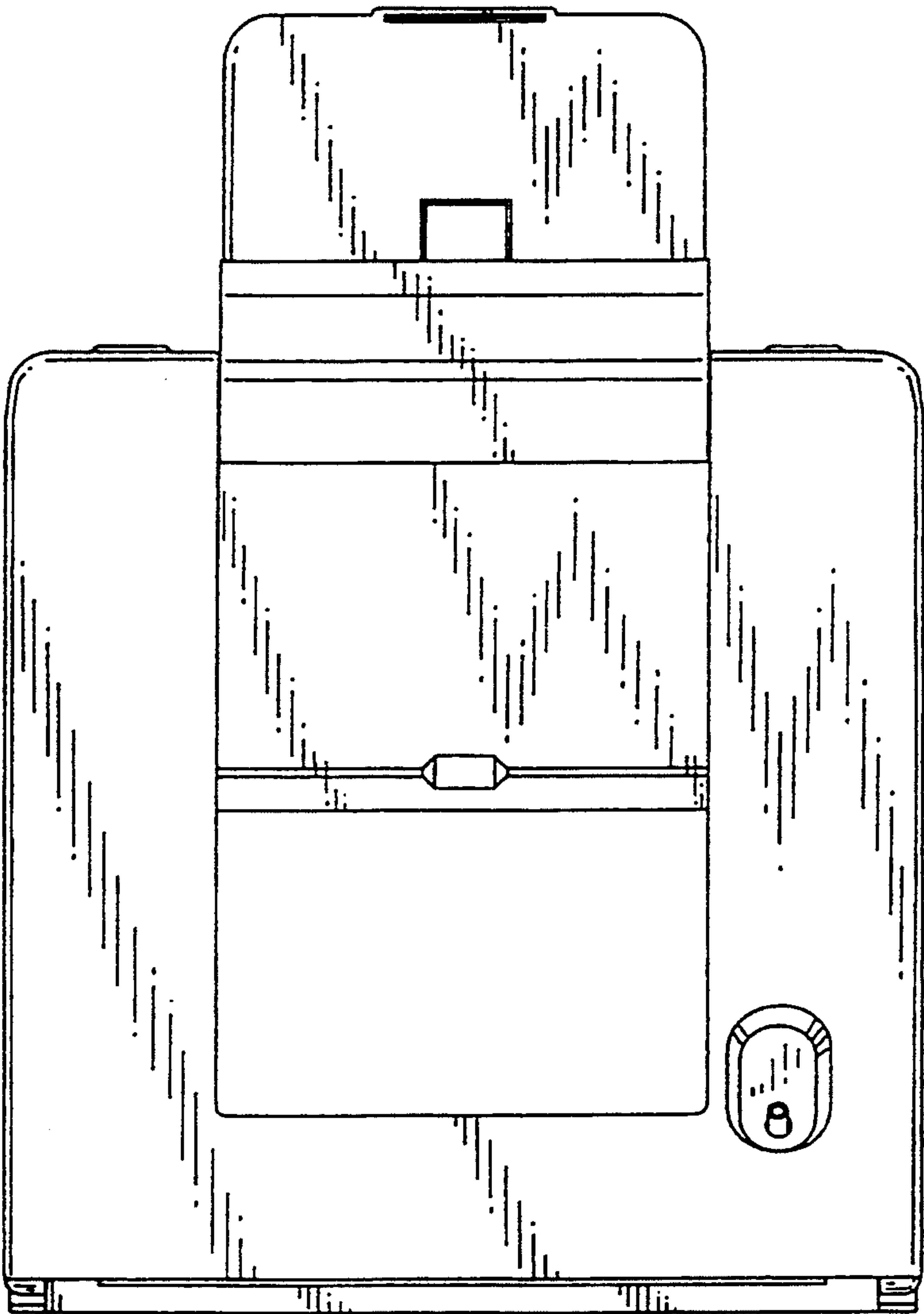

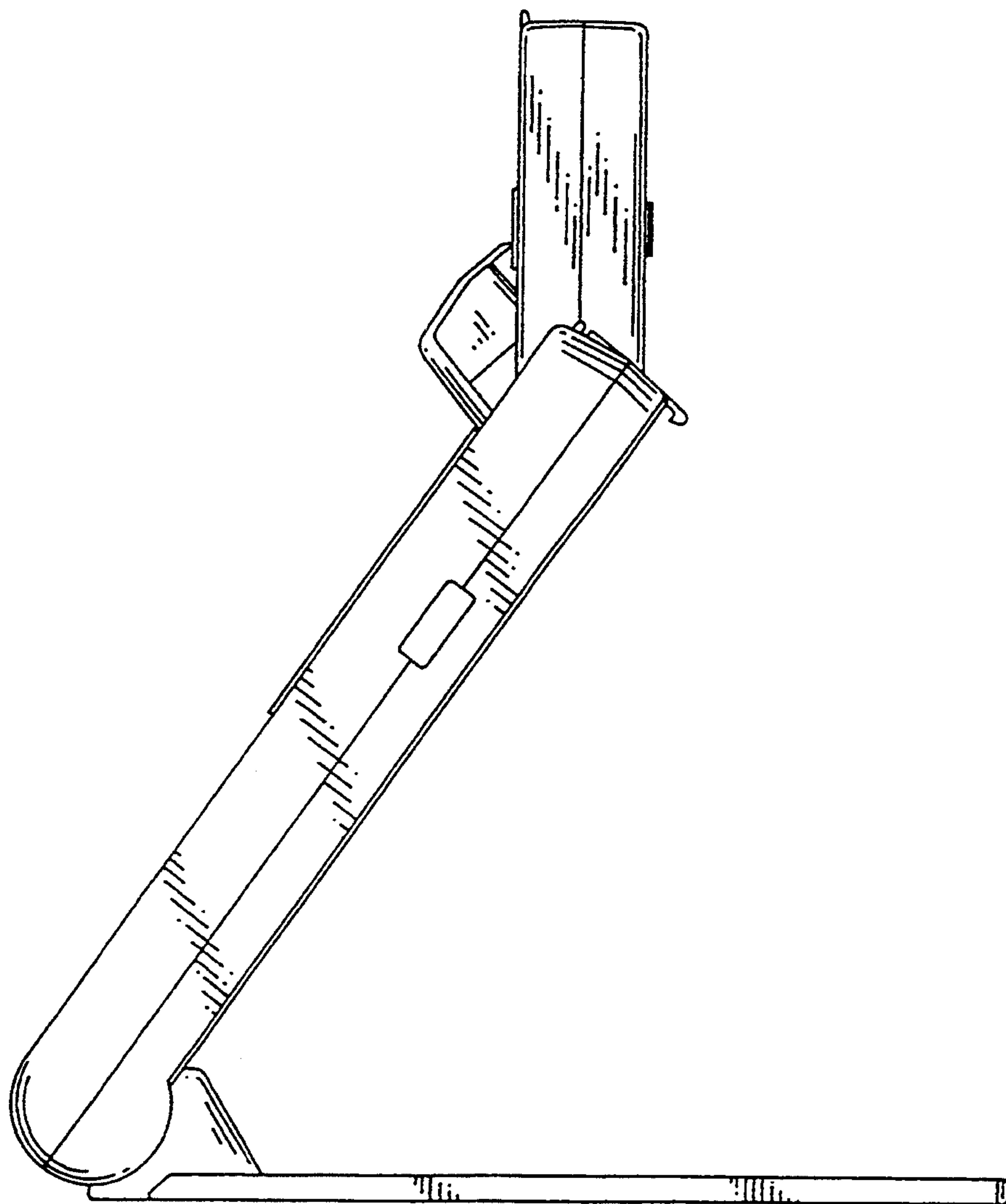

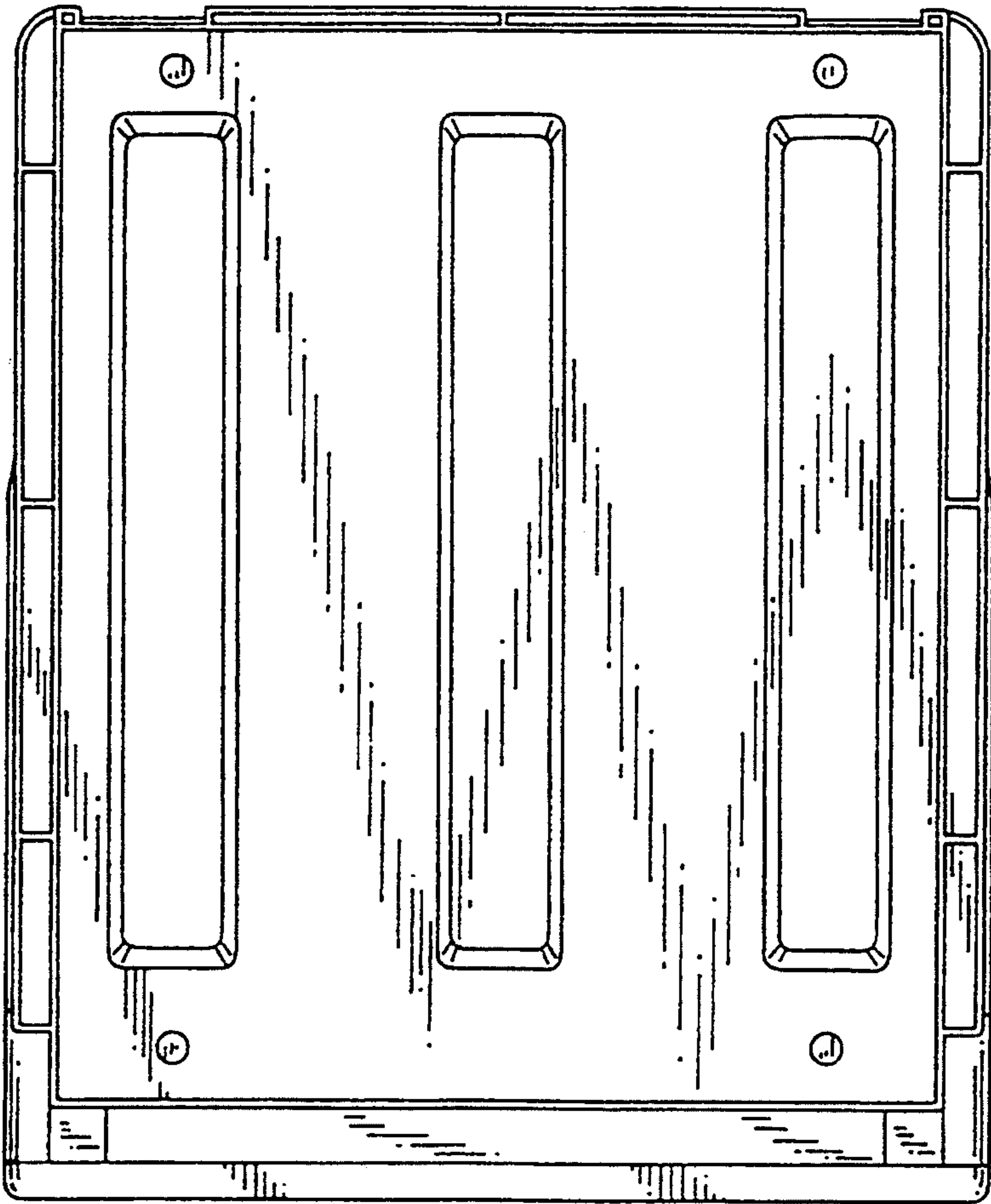

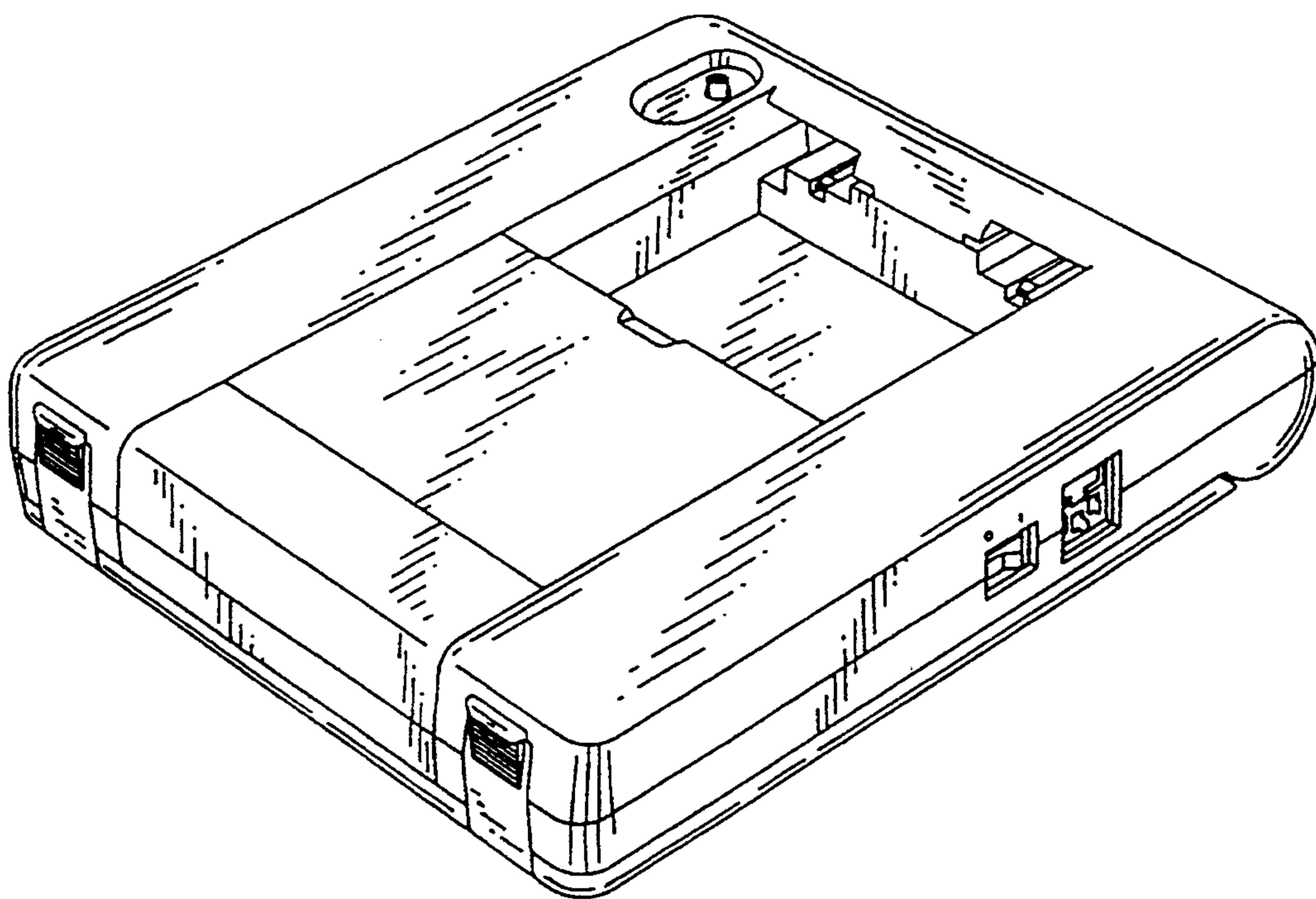

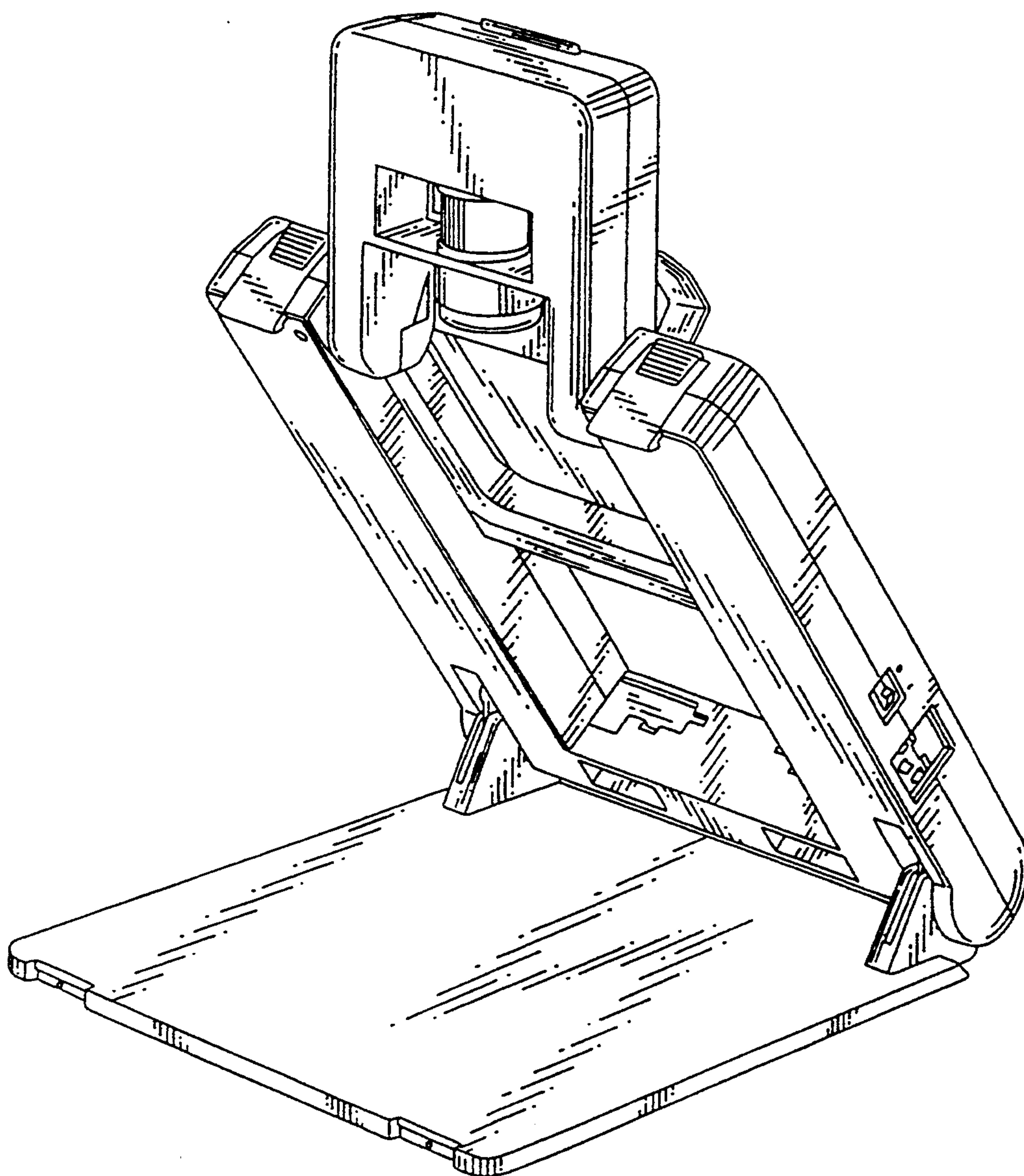
